Freshman Dani DeCamino has been placed on injured reserve after she cut her right hand in the opening game against Western Kentucky. Making a slide into third base, DeCamino sliced her hand which required six stitches.

#### Long Ball U

Senior Laura Brockman hit her third homerun of the year, and the 20th of her career, on Saturday against Western Kentucky.

#### Bringing them In

Brockman also added to her RBI total with three in the series with WKU. It brings her career total to 73 and is good for a tie for third place in the Lady Raider record books.

Jennifer Martinez moved into a tie for fourth place for doubles in a career with 28.

#### 200 Watch

Martinez has 159 strikeouts for the season, and needs just 41 more to hit the 200 mark. If she can accomplish this feat, she will have had 200 or more strikeouts three of her four years as a Lady Raider.
