MT vs. South Alabama

The Jags lead the overall series with Middle Tennessee **5-3**, but the Blue Raiders got the upper hand in the last meeting between the squads. MT held off South Alabama **48-47** in the opening round of last year's Sun Belt Conference Tournament. The Jags took the earlier meeting between the schools last season 59-51.

Blue Raiders Lead the East

The Blue Raiders have turned a few heads as the Sun Belt Conference slate has gotten underway. After a stunning upset of Western Kentucky, the Blue Raiders went on the road and handed Arkansas State a 65-58 loss. The Blue Raiders then took UALR to overtime before falling to the Trojans 71-62 in the extra period. MT's **2-0** start in league play marks the first time since jumping out to the same opening record during the 1998-99 season, the team's last in the Ohio Valley Conference.

Parham Improving

Senior **Eric Parham** has been steady at the point guard spot over the past few contests. The Nashville product has dished out 20 assists while committing only six turnovers in the Blue Raiders' last four games, giving him an assist-to-turnover ratio of **3.3-to-1** during that span. Parham has also seen his scoring numbers increase during this stretch. Over this four-game period, Parham is averaging **7.0** points per game, nearly 2.5 points per contest better than his season average of 4.6.

Gunn Closing on 1,000

Junior guard **Tommy Gunn** is closing in on the 1,000-point mark for his career. The Syracuse, NY, native surpassed the 800 mark with his 16-pointeffortat UALR on Saturday night, giving him **812** career points. That tally leaves him only **188** points shy of the millennium club. To reach the 1,000-point plateau this season, Gunn needs to average about **14.5** points per contest in the team's remaining games. Should Gunn score his 1,000th point, he would become only the 26th player in Middle Tennessee history to do so.

Dean Transfers to MT

Guard **Mike Dean** has transferred to Middle Tennessee from Georgia and will become eligible to play following final exams next December. Dean, who hails from Rome, GA, averaged **31.2** points, **8.2** rebounds, and **six** assists per game during his senior season. Dean was also selected as the **18th-best** off guard in the nation coming out of high school by the *Sporting News*. Dean will be a junior once becoming eligible.

■ Coach Kermit Davis' weekly radio show airs each week from Toot's Restaurant in Murfreesboro. The show will be aired on WBOZ 104.9 FM. The show, which is slated to start in January, is hosted by Chip Walters.

Davis Television Show

■ Coach Kermit Davis' television show is aired each week on Comcast Sports Southeast. Davis and Chip Walters will review the previous week with commentary and highlights as well as preview the week ahead. The Davis show is also aired each week on MTTV Cable 10 Rutherford County.

Glasper's Season Likely Over

Redshirt junior **Derek Glasper** has undergone successful ankle surgery and is likely through for the remainder of the season. The surgery is the second setback in Glasper's career, as he suffered a knee injury and subsequent surgery that limited him to only two games a year ago. This season, Glasper saw action in five games after sustaining a severe ankle sprain in the preseason that kept him out of action for the first five games of the year.

Davis Reaches Milestone

Head Coach **Kermit Davis** picked up a milestone win in his career with the Blue Raiders comeback win over Kennesaw State. The victory is the **75th** for Davis as a Division I head coach. He now owns an overall record of **77-58(.570)** as a DI bench boss. Davis' overall record is now 143-84, including his junior college coaching career.

Rivalries Continue

Of Middle Tennessee's 10 most extensive rivalries, the top four have found their way onto the Blue Raiders' schedule this season. The Blue Raiders came into the season having played 506 combined games against Tennessee Tech, Murray State, Austin Peay, and Western Kentucky through the years. The Golden Eagles hold the distinction of being the longest-standing of these series at 140 games. MT has

Notable

- ➤ Of the 23 possible opponents on this year's schedule, 13 have played MT five times or less and four have played MT 100 times or more.
- ➤ The Blue Raiders' appearance in the Boiler-maker Invitational this season marks the first such appearance since playing in the San Juan Shootout in the 1998-99 season.
- ➤ Former OVC foes Tennessee Tech, Murray State, and Austin Peay are on the Blue Raider schedule for the first time since 1999-00.
- ➤ Seven players on MT's roster began the season with less than 30 games of playing experience.
- ➤ Kermit Davis is one of only two new coaches in the Sun Belt this season. John Pelphrey at South Alabama is the other.
- ➤ Middle Tennessee is **43-30** all-time in overtime games (2-1 in double OT). The Blue Raiders are 1-5 in its last six overtime games.
- ➤ The Blue Raiders have hit at least one threepointer in **201** straight games. The last time MT failed to hit a shot from behind the arc was Jan. 20, 1996 at Morehead State.

Gunn Takes SBC Honor

Junior guard **Tommy Gunn** was named Third Team All-Sun Belt in the league's preseason awards presentation during October. Gunn, who averaged 12.5 points per contest as a sophomore, was named Honorable Mention All-SBC at the conclusion of last season.

Kermit Davis

Head Coach ◆ Mississippi State, 1982 ◆ First Season ◆ 6-9 (.400)



The objective was clear when Middle Tennessee athletic director Boots Donnelly set out to hire the school's 19th men's basketball coach – find the person that could lead the program back to its past glory and

once again contend for conference titles and NCAA appearances.

On April 12, 2002, Donnelly introduced Kermit Davis, Jr., as the man to do just that.

"I wanted to bring someone in here that wanted to be here, not just to be a head coach, but who wanted to take over our program," Donnelly stated. "I wanted a person that believed very, very strongly in discipline, because that's the process that gets it all started. I wanted a heck of a recruiter, and I also wanted a teacher. I think we fulfilled every one of those things with Kemit Davis, Jr."

Davis brings the credentials that Donnelly was seeking along with him to Middle Tennessee. He has shown throughout his career the ability to rebuild programs and put them on the national map in a hurry. He has displayed success at every stop along his career track and has done so with a hard-nosed style of defense, uptempo offensive play, and a work ethic that is second-to-none.

"One thing our team will do is play with a great deal of energy," Davis stated. "We would like to play a hard-nosed, aggressive style that our fans will enjoy watching night in and night out. We're going to share and value the basketball, rebound on both ends, and attempt to get a quality shot on each possession."

Davis' strategic knowledge isn't his only weapon in building a competitive program. The Blue Raider skipper has long been known as an outstanding recruiter that is willing to go after the nation's top talent. His recruits value character, have a high level of toughness, and have a desire to obtain a college degree. He is committed to landing the state's top prospects as well as reaching out to the best players in the region and in the country.

"Our state has produced some outstanding players over the years, and we are going to be very aggressive in our approach to keeping those players at home," said Davis. "The quality of high school and junior college coaching in our state is excellent and we would like to be an extension of the parents and the coach when those student-athletes come to our campus."

Davis comes to Middle Tennessee after spending the past five seasons as the associate head coach at Louisiana State University under head coach John Brady. Prior to Davis' arrival with Brady at LSU, the Tigers had been languishing near the bottom of the Southeastern Conference.

It didn't take long for the team's fortunes to change. After two seasons of putting the pieces together, the Tigers captured the SEC title in 2000 and went on to an appearance in the NCAA Tournament's Sweet 16. The Tigers returned to the post season in 2002 with a trip to the National Invitational Tournament. In the three years immediately preceeding Davis' arrival in Murfreesboro, LSU averaged 20-plus wins per season.

Davis said of his time with the Tigers, "I enjoyed five years at LSU working with a close friend and one of the outstanding coaches in college basketball in John Brady."

Prior to coming to LSU, Davis spent one season as the head coach at the University of Idaho. However, his stint with the Vandals was his second tour of duty in Moscow. He also served as the school's head coach from 1988-1990. During his three years as the head coach at Idaho, he compiled a record of 63-29, the best three-year total in the program's history. Davis posted two of the best single season tallies in school history during his first two seasons at Idaho as well, turning in 25-6 marks in both of those seasons.

His Idaho squad won the Big Sky championship in 1989 and went on to capture the league's tournament crown and a berth into the NCAA Tournament as well. For his efforts Davis was named the Big Sky Coach of the Year at the conclusion of the season.

History repeated itself in 1990 when Davis once again led the Vandals to the Big Sky title in both the regular season and tournament, garnering another NCAA berth.

In fact, Davis himself made history when he became the Vandals' head coach in 1988. Upon his hiring, Davis became the youngest Division I head coach in the nation at age 28.

However, it was not the first time that Davis had been the youngest coach in the country. When Davis took the head coaching position at Southwest Mississippi Junior College in 1984, he became the youngest junior college coach in the nation at age 24. His youth served him well at Southwest Mississippi, putting together a 39-20 record in two seasons. His 1986 squad won 22 games, posting the school's first 20-win season in 17 years.

His success at the junior college level landed him a spot on Tim Floyd's staff at Idaho, where he served as an assistant for two years prior to taking the reigns of the Vandal program.

After spending the 1988-89 and 1989-90 seasons at Idaho, Davis went on to become the head coach at Texas A&M for the 1990-91 campaign.

From Texas A&M, Davis moved to serve as the associate head coach at Chipola Junior College for two seasons before ascending to the top spot for the 1993-94 campaign.

During his season as the team's head coach, Chipola finished the season ranked #4 in the national polls and posted a 27-5 record, giving the team the second-most wins in school history.

Davis headed to Utah State as the team's associate head coach from 1994-96. At Utah State, Davis coached under current lowa State head coach Larry Eustachy and the pair combined to win the Big West Championship in 1995.

His Utah State tenure ended with his return to Idaho as the Vandals' head coach and the rest is history.

Davis' rapid ascent up the coaching ladder is no coincidence. Davis has been around the game for his entire life as he grew up watching one of the preeminent coaches in the country operate on a daily basis.

Kermit Davis, Sr., Davis' father, was one of the most respected college coaches in the nation and the younger Davis spent many hours around his dad in the gym and even on the bench during games.

Upon the completion of his playing career, Davis began his coaching career at his alma mater. He served as a graduate assistant on Bob Boyd's staff at Mississippi State from 1982-

Davis earned his bachelor's degree from Mississippi State in 1982 and went on to receive his master's degree from Mississippi State in 1984.

Davis, a native of Leakesville, Miss., and his wife Betty have two daughters, Ally (14) and Claire (10).
