GAME DAY NOTES: Middle Tennessee will try to continue its hot streak of late when the Lady Raiders take on Arkansas State. The Lady Raiders are on a two game winning streak and have won four out of their last five games. Battling on the road, sporting a 4-6 overall record and 1-3 in the conference away from home, Middle Tennessee picked up its first road win in the conference this season with a 70-56 victory over North Texas. Arkansas State is 6-6 overall at home and 3-2 in the conference. The Lady Raiders hold a 4-2 advantage over Arkansas State, defeating them 80-63 on January 9 in the Murphy Center. Middle Tennessee is on a three game winning streak against Arkansas State, with the last Lady Indians victory coming with a 85-63 defeat of the Lady Raiders on January 4, 2001.

LAST GAME: With the scored tied at 65, Patrice Holmes drove in for a lay-up with three seconds left to play in the game to give the Lady Raiders the lead and the win. Leading by five with 6:16 left to play, Middle Tennessee watched Denver go on a 5-0 run to tie the game 57-57 with 4:22 left to play. In a four minute span there were five lead changes and three ties. It was the first Middle Tennessee victory over the Lady Pioneers in four tries.

HOLMES PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Sophomore Patrice Holmes was named Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week for the second time this season. In the Lady Raiders first-ever wins over North Texas and Denver, Holmes averaged 19 points, 7.5 rebounds, 4.5 assists, and five steals while shooting 41.2 percent from the field.

The show will feature comments from the coaches about their team's performances and upcoming games. Each coach will also field questions from audience members.

jury. It was Stovall's fourth start of the year and her first since December 22 against Lipscomb. She pulled down 11 rebounds and scored nine points in only 23 minutes. The 11 boards tied her season-high set earlier this year against Memphis.

THE THIEF CONTINUES TO CLIMB: Sophomore Patrice Holmes continues to climb the list for steals in a season, swiping five more in the victory. Holmes now has 76 steals this season, tying Alice Lawrence, Eva Lemeh and Cortney Neeley for third on the single-season list.

TRAILING TO WIN: For the second straight game, Middle Tennessee came from behind at halftime to win the game. It is only the third time this season the Lady Raiders have come back to win the game. Overall, Middle Tennessee is 3-8 when trailing at the half.

THIS 'N THAT: The Lady Raiders improved to 9-3 overall at home this season, 5-1 in the Sun Belt ... Middle Tennessee improved to 2-2 this season in games decided by five points or less ... The Lady Raiders got their first-ever win over Denver in the two-point win, improving to 1-3 overall against the Pioneers, 1-0 at Murphy Center ... Redshirt freshman Cartia Bailey drew her third straight start ... Keisha McClinic tied her season-high for minutes played with 34 ... Paula Penttila tied her season-high for field goals made with four ... Patrice Holmes tied her career-high with 22 field goals attempts and played the entire 40 minutes for the 10th time this season ... Eboni Kirby made a three-pointer for the fourth time this year.

Middle Tennessee Head Coach Sixth Season as Head Coach/Tenth at MT



Middle Tennessee head women's basketball coach Stephany Smith in her sixhth season at the helm of the Lady Raiders in 2002-03, and her 10th in the MT program. The Brookhaven, Miss., native has established herself as one of college basketball's brightest young coaches, compiling a 100-69 mark in her six seasons as the head coach in Murfreesboro.

As she coaches in her sixth campaign, Smith's record stands as a testament to her hard work, excellent recruiting skills and knowledge of the game.

During her tenure in Murfreesboro, Smith has both an OVC regular season title and an OVC Tournament title to her credit. Three of Smith's teams have competed in postseason play, with an NCAA berth in 1998 and WNIT bids in 1999 and 2001.

Smith did not enter into her first head coaching job blindly. She spent four years as an assistant at MT to former head coach Lewis Bivens, heading up the team's recruiting efforts during that time. Smith was promoted to associate head coach in her final season under Bivens.

The 1995-96 squad went 24-6, the second-most victories in school history, before falling to Kansas in the first round of the NCAA Tournament in Lawrence, Kan. The Lady Raiders were OVC Co-Champions in 1994-95 and 1995-96, compiling 64 wins in Smith's first three seasons on the MT staff. Fruits of her labors at Middle Tennessee were shown in 1996 when the Lady Raiders received votes in both collegiate polls, ranking as high as 26th. The school received its first atlarge bid to the NCAA Tournament to further attest the program's growing stature.

Smith spent four years as an assistant at UAB

coordinating recruiting for the Blazers before her arrival at Middle Tennessee. UAB went 76-45 during her four seasons on the staff, winning or tying for the Sun Belt Conference crown twice (1990, 91) and sharing the Great Midwest Conference title in 1992. The Lady Blazers made two WNIT trips (1991, 92) during Smith's association with the UAB program.

She spent one year as a graduate assistant at her alma mater, Harding University, in 1989.

Teams associated with Smith have a 221-133 record during her 14 years on the Division I level, including four 20-plus win seasons and two 19-win seasons.

Smith's claim to fame is recruiting, and she has established a reputation as one of the game's top young coaches and as a top-flight recruiter. Two of her former players at UAB have gone on to the professional ranks.

Jacque Nero played six years overseas before being selected fourth by Nashville in the 1998 ABL draft. Shyronda Mifflin has played four seasons overseas and was on the Atlanta Glory's practice squad for part of the 1998 season before returning to Spain. Her coaching philosophy stresses establishing fundamental knowledge of the game in practice. The repetition of fundamentals in practice allows her players the freedom to use that knowledge coupled with their athletic skills over the course of a game. An intense conditioning regimen also lends Smith's squad the opportunity to play an up-tempo style predicated on defensive intensity.

Smith graduated from Harding University in

Searcy, Ark. with a B.A. in Physical Education in May of 1988 before receiving an M.S.E. with an emphasis in Physical Education in August 1989.

Smith began her collegiate experience at the University of Mississippi before transferring to Copiah-Lincoln Community College in Wesson, Miss. She received an associate's degree from Co-Lin in May of 1986.

Smith competed in basketball at both Co-Lin and Harding, and also spent a year as the Head Girls Track Coach at Searcy High School in 1989 while completing her Master's degree at Harding.

The personable Smith is truly people-oriented. She has planned and directed numerous non-profit clinics at Middle Tennessee and UAB for girls to further promote the game of basketball. She now heads up one of the most successful summer camps in the country, the Middle Tennessee "Stars of Tomorrow." She is the daughter of Ralph and Betsy Smith. She has three brothers (Ralph, Richard, Cameron) and one sister (Sydney).

Smith's father was inducted into the Mississippi Sports Hall of Fame in 2002. Ralph "Catfish" Smith won two national championships as a member of the Ole Miss football team in 1959 and 1960, and played 10 years in the NFL.
