**GAME DAY NOTES:** Middle Tennessee hosts the University of Alabama in doubleheader action with the Blue Raiders. The game will be broadcast on ESPN Regional. It is the first time this season the Lady Raiders will appear on television. Alabama holds a 6-0 record against Middle Tennessee. The two teams last meeting was December 9, 1995 as the Crimson Tide defeated the Lady Raiders 68-53. Alabama is the second SEC team the Lady Raiders have faced this season as the team lost 65-50 to Georgia on December 13. Middle Tennessee holds a record of 20-59 against teams from the Southeastern Conference.

**DOUBLE-DOUBLE FOR HOLMES:** Point guard Patrice Holmes recorded her fourth double-double of the season and the 10th of her career with 17 points and 10 boards against Houston. It was also the seventh by the team this year as Krystle Horton owns the other three.

STRONG DEFENSIVE EFFORT: Against a very good Houston team, the Lady Raiders did their part on the defensive end of the floor by holding the Lady Cougars to 38 percent shooting. The Lady Raiders stepped it up even more in the second half by forcing UH into 28 percent shooting from the field and holding them to just 27 points. It wasn't enough, however, as the Lady Cougars owned a five-point advantage from behind the arc to be the difference in the game.

TOO MANY MISCUES: The Lady Raiders were hurt against Houston by committing 20 turnovers, including 19 by the starting five. It marks the most turnovers by the Lady Raiders since registering 24 against Norfolk State on Nov. 29 and is the most this year at home.

AFTERNOON DELIGHT: The unusual mid-week starting time of 2 PM was done in order to accommodate Houston's travel plans. The Lady Cougars needed to fly out Monday night due to their next game being scheduled for Wednesday; therefore, the contest had to tip in the afternoon. It was the first time in the Stephany Smith era the Lady Raiders had played a home mid-week afternoon contest.

**TIDBITS:** The Blue Raiders are now 13-22 against teams from Conference USA ... Jennifer Justice dished out a season-high four assists against Houston ... Chrissy Givens matched her personal-best with four rebounds in the loss to Houston ... The game against Houston was only the second time this year Middle Tennessee has trailed at the half.

IN THE SUN BELT: Patrice Holmes tops the Sun Belt in scoring (18.5), and steals (3.6) and third in the conference in assists (5.1) ... Teammate Keisha McClinic is second in the conference in steals with 2.0 per game ... Tia Stovall is third in blocked shots with 1.45.

**UP NEXT:** Middle Tennessee enters Sun Belt Conference play as the Lady Raiders travel to Arkansas to take on Arkansas State and Arkansas-Little Rock. Middle Tennessee swept both schools in the regular season last year and defeated Arkansas State 65-52 in the Sun Belt Tournament.

THREE INK WITH LADY RAIDERS: Middle Tennessee Head Coach Stephany Smith signed three players in the early signing period. The Lady Raiders received scholarship papers from 6-4 center Lynette Jackson, 6-2 forward Lakira Boyd and 5-8 guard Sara Nuxol. Jackson, from Fayetteville, N.C., is the 32nd ranked center in the country as reported by All Star Girls Report and is also the tallest player to sign with a Sun Belt school in the early signing period. Boyd, daughter of former Memphis standout Dwight Boyd, hails from Kirby High School in Memphis and Nuxol is from Winter Springs High School in Florida.

# Stephany Smith



### **Middle Tennessee Head Coach Seventh Season/11th at MT**



Middle Tennessee head women's basketball coach Stephany Smith begins her seventh season with a squad who got a taste of their first Sun Belt Conference Tournament Finals, and is hungry for more. The Lady Raiders fell in the finals to Western Kentucky, so the 2003-04 squad is anxious to hit the court and take the conference title this season.

The Brookhaven, Miss., native has established herself as one of college basketball's brightest young coaches, and is looking forward to the season ahead.

As she prepares to begin her seventh campaign, Smith's record stands as a testament to her hard work, excellent recruiting skills and knowledge of the game.

Smith enters her seventh season 105-71 and has both an OVC regular season title and an OVC Tournament title to her credit. Three of Smith's teams have competed in postseason play, with an NCAA berth in 1998 and WNIT bids in 1999 and 2001.

Smith did not enter into her first head coaching job blindly. She spent four years as an assistant at Middle Tennéssee to former héad coach Lewis Bivens, heading up the team's recruiting efforts during that time. Smith was promoted to associate head coach in her final season under Bivens.

The 1995-96 squad went 24-6, the second-most victories in school history, before falling to Kansas in the first round of the NCAA Tournament in Lawrence, Kan. The Lady Raiders were OVC Co-Champions in 1994-95 and 1995-96, compiling 64 wins in Smith's first three seasons on the MT staff. Fruits of her labors at Middle Tennessee were shown in 1996 when the Lady Raiders received votes in both collegiate polls, ranking as high as 26th. The school received its first at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament to further attest the program's growing stature.

Smith spent four years as an assistant at UAB before her arrival at Middle Tennessee, coordinating recruiting for the Blazers. UAB went 76-45 during her four seasons on the staff, winning or tying for the Sun Belt Conference crown twice (1990, 91) and sharing the Great Midwest Conference title in 1992. The Ladv Blazers made two WNIT trips (1991, 92) during Smith's association with the UAB program.

She spent one year as a graduate assistant at her alma mater, Harding University, in 1989. Teams associated with Smith have a 255-158 record during her 14 years on the Division I level, including four 20-plus win seasons and two 19-win seasons.

Smith's claim to fame is recruiting, as she has established a reputation as one of the game's top young coaches and as a top-flight recruiter. She is also a teacher of the game as she held a coaching clinic over the summer to instruct other coaches on various offenses. Three of her former players have gone on to play in the professional ranks including former Lady

Raider Joanne Aluka who is playing in Portugal.

Jacque Nero played six years overseas before being selected fourth by Nashville in the 1998 ABL draft. Shyronda Mifflin has played four seasons over-seas and was on the Atlanta Glory's practice squad for part of the 1998 season before returning to Spain.

Her coaching philosophy stresses establishing fun-

damental knowledge of the game in practice. The repitition of fundamentals in practice allows her players the freedom to use that knowledge coupled with their athletic skills over the course of a game. An intense conditioning regimen also lends Smith's squad the opportunity to play an up-tempo style predicated on defensive inten-

Smith graduated from Harding University in Searcy, Ark. with a B.A. in Physical Education in May of 1988 before receiving an M.S.E. with the University of Mis-

before receiving an M.S.E. with the University of Mississippi before transferring to Copiah-Lincoln Community College in Wesson, Miss. She received an associate's degree from Co-Lin in May of 1986. Smith competed in basketball at both Co-Lin and Harding, and also spent a year as the Head Girls Track Coach at Searcy High School in 1989 while completing her Master's degree at Harding. The personable Smith is truly a people-oriented person. She has planned and directed nu-

merous non-profit clinics at Middle Tennessee and UAB for girls to further promote the game of basketball. She now heads up one of the most successful camps in the country, the Middle Tennessee "Stars of Tomorrow" camp, each sum-She is the daughter of Ralph and Betsy Smith. She has three brothers (Ralph, Richard, Cameron) and one sister (Sydney).
