The Lady Raiders lost at New Orleans last season 65-59 and then won their next meeting in the Sun Belt Tournament 69-55. The Lady Raiders hold a 3-1 record over UNO and are 2-0 at home over the Privateers. New Orleans is coming off a 84-60 loss to Western Kentucky on Thursday. UNO is on a two-game losing streak and is 1-4 in their last five games.

STREAK BREAKERS: Middle Tennessee upset South Alabama on Thursday night, 56-55, to end the Jaguars 14-game winning streak. USA lost the opening game of the year then reeled off 14 straight victories before seeing it come to an end against MT. Ironically, both of USA's losses this year have come to teams from the state of Tennessee (MT and Vanderbilt).

MCCLINIC MATCHES CAREER-HIGH ... AGAIN: For the second time this season, senior Keisha McClinic matched her career-best with seven steals. McClinic also added seven steals earlier this season against Alabama. The seven thefts against USA gives McClinic 54 on the season which ties Patrice Holmes for the team lead and also matches her career season-best total set during the 2001-02 campaign.

BY ONE: Middle Tennessee's one-point win is the 28th time in school history the Lady Raiders have won by a single digit. The Lady Raiders are 14-14 in one-point games.

MORE IN THE GAME: Middle Tennessee played nine players against South Alabama, the most to see action in a game since December 22 against South Carolina State.

GRAY GETS NOD: Junior Ciara Gray got the starting nod against USA for the fourth time this season and played a career-high 30 minutes. Her 10 points is the third time this season she has scored in double figures. Gray's four free throws was a career-high.

TIDBITS: The Lady Raiders had just six assists on 21 field goals against USA ... The Lady Raiders owned a 15-8 advantage on the offensive glass in the win over USA ... MT ran its record to 10-1 on the season when leading at the half ... Tia Stovall came of the bench for the first time this season and added eight points and six boards ... Middle Tennessee shot below 40 percent for the third time in the last four games (.382) ... The Lady Raiders made 14 free throws and USA only attempted six all night ... The last three home games have been decided by four points or less and one went to overtime.

UP NEXT: Middle Tennessee heads back out on the road next week to take on New Mexico State and Louisiana-Lafayette. The road hasn't been kind in the Sun Belt so far, as the Lady Raiders are 0-2. New Mexico State leads the series 2-1 and it is tied 1-1 at New Mexico State. The Lady Raiders are 5-0 against Louisiana-Lafayette and Middle Tennessee is 1-0 at ULL.

Middle Tennessee Head Coach **Seventh Season/11th at MT**



Middle Tennessee head women's basketball coach Stephany Smith begins her seventh season with a squad who got a taste of their first Sun Belt Conference Tournament Finals, and is hungry for more. The Lady Raiders fell in the finals to Western Kentucky, so the 2003-04 squad is anxious to hit the court and take the conference title this season.

The Brookhaven, Miss., native has established

herself as one of college basketball's brightest young coaches, and is looking forward to the season ahead.

As she prepares to begin her seventh campaign, Smith's record stands as a testament to her hard work, excellent recruiting skills and knowledge of the

Smith enters her seventh season 105-71 and has both an OVC regular season title and an OVC Tournament title to her credit. Three of Smith's teams have competed in postseason play, with an NCAA berth in 1998 and WNIT bids in 1999 and 2001.

Smith did not enter into her first head coaching job blindly. She spent four years as an assistant at Middle Tennessee to former head coach Lewis Bivens, heading up the team's recruiting efforts during that time. Smith was promoted to associate head coach in her final season under Bivens.

The 1995-96 squad went 24-6, the second-most victories in school history, before falling to Kansas in the first round of the NCAA Tournament in Lawrence, Kan. The Lady Raiders were OVC Co-Champions in 1994-95 and 1995-96, compiling 64 wins in Smith's first three seasons on the MT staff. Fruits of her labors at Middle Tennessee were shown in 1996 when the Lady Raiders received votes in both collegiate polls, ranking as high as 26th. The school received its first at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament to further attest the program's growing stat-

Smith spent four years as an assistant at UAB before her arrival at Middle Tennessee, coordinating recruiting for the Blazers. UAB went 76-45 during her four seasons on the staff, winning or tying for the Sun Belt Conference crown twice (1990, 91) and sharing the Great Midwest Conference title in

1992. The Lady Blazers made two WNIT trips (1991, 92) during Smith's association with the UAB program.
She spent one year as a graduate assistant at

her alma mater, Harding University, in 1989. Teams associated with Smith have a 255-158 record during her 14 years on the Division I level, including

four 20-plus win seasons and two 19-win seasons.

Smith's claim to fame is recruiting, as she has established a reputation as one of the game's top young coaches and as a top-flight recruiter. She is also a teacher of the game as she held a coaching clinic over the summer to instruct other coaches on various offenses. Three of her former players have gone on to play in the professional ranks including former Lady Raider Joanne Aluka who is playing in

Jacque Nero played six years overseas before being selected fourth by Nashville in the 1998 ABL draft. Shyronda Mifflin has played four seasons over-seas and was on the Atlanta Glory's practice squad for part of the 1998 season before returning to Spain.

Her coaching philosophy stresses establishing fundamental knowledge of the game in practice. The repitition of fundamentals in practice allows her players the freedom to use that knowledge coupled with their athletic skills over the course of a game. An interest conditioning regime place leads Smith's intense conditioning regimen also lends Smith's squad the opportunity to play an up-tempo style predicated on defensive intensity.

Smith graduated from Harding University in

Searcy, Ark. with a B.A. in Physical Education in May of 1988 before receiving an M.S.E. with the University of Mississippi before transferring to Copiah-Lincoln Community College in Wesson, Miss. She re-ceived an associate's degree from Co-Lin in May of

Smith competed in basketball at both Co-Lin and Harding, and also spent a year as the Head Girls Track Coach at Searcy High School in 1989 while completing her Master's degree at

personable Smith is truly a people-oriented person. She has planned and directed numerous

non-profit clinics at Middle Tennessee and UAB for girls to further promote the game of basketball. She now heads up one of the most successful camps in the country, the Middle Tennessee "Stars of Tomorrow" camp, each summer.

She is the daughter of Ralph and Betsy Smith. She has three brothers (Ralph, Richard, Cameron) and one sister (Sydney).


