Notes: The Blue Raiders take on Louisiana-Lafayette in the backend of a two-game homestretch ... The two teams are 3-3 in the all-time series, with the Ragin' Cajuns taking two of the three games since the Blue Raiders joined the Sun Belt ... Middle Tennessee is 2-1 at home against Louisiana-Lafayette.

Middle Tennessee vs. Louisiana-Lafayette

Louisiana-Lafayette and the Blue Raiders have split the previous six meetings, with the Ragin' Cajuns taking two of the three meetings since Middle Tennessee joined the Sun Belt. The Cajuns won last season, 71-65, in the Cajundome in Lafayette. William Pippen and Tommy Gunn each scored 18 in the loss for the Blue Raiders and Gunn added a career-high 11 rebounds. Michael Southall had 23 and Brad Boyd 18 for the winners. Middle Tennessee is 2-1 all-time at home against the Cajuns, winning 81-72 on December 5, 1959, dropping a 66-64 decision on December 9, 1960, and winning 69-64 on January 12, 2002.

Scouting the Ragin' Cajuns

Louisiana-Lafayette enters the game 10-5 overall, 5-1 in Sun Belt play after a 110-102 victory at Western Kentucky Thursday night. Six Cajun players hit for double figures in the victory, led by Antoine Landry's 27 points. For the season, six

players are averaging double-digits for head coach Jessie Evans, led by Landry's 14.9 ppg. Senior Brad Boyd is second at 13.9, with Brian Hamilton at 12.1, Laurie Bridges at 10.9, just-eligible Orien Green at 10.5, and Cedric Williams at 10.0. Green and Williams come off the bench, as does Auburn transfer Dwayne Mitchell, who averages 9.2 ppg. The Cajuns also like the assist, averaging 17.1 per game as a team. In SBC play, UL is 3-0 on the road and just a three-point loss to South Alabama from being undefeated. Landry, Hamilton, Boyd and Greene all averages in double figures against conference foes.

Dean, Gunn Rank in National Statistics

Junior Mike Dean and senior Tommy Gunn entered the national statistics in scoring and three-point FG this week after the wins at South Alabama and New Orleans. Dean was 8-of-17 from behind the arc in the pair of road victories, pushing his season three-point shooting percentage to .535, ranking third in the nation. His 2.9 three-pointers per game ranks 39th in the country, as well. Gunn is 92nd in the nation in scoring at 17.4 ppg after his 27-point effort at New Orleans on Saturday.

Smithson at the Top

Freshman Bryan Smithson leads the Sun Belt in assists per game at 5.75 in league games only heading into this week's games, ahead of UALR's Zack Graber and Denver's Rodney Billups. Smithson handed out six helpers in the OT win at New Orleans on Saturday and had eight assists in the conference opener versus Arkansas State.

Smithson is second in the league in assists for all games at 4.65 and is second in the league in assist-to-turnover ratio. The Kennesaw, Ga., native has also added scoring punch as the season has progressed, hovering around the 10 ppg mark since the beginning of SBC play. Heading into conference play on January 15, Smithson was first in the SBC among freshmen in assists, steals, FG percentage, FT percentage and minutes played. He was also second in scoring.

Gunn, Dean Lead in Scoring

Senior Tommy Gunn and junior Mike Dean rank near the top of the Sun Belt in scoring and lead the league in SBC contests only. The duo ranks third and fourth, respectively, in all games, averaging 17.4 and 15.8 ppg this season. In league games only, Dean ranks first at 21.8 ppg and Gunn is fourth with 18.2 per outing. They are the highest scoring pair in SBC games at 40.0, just head of ASU's J.J. Montgomery and Dewarick Spencer.

Cuffee Steps Up in League Play

Junior Michael Cuffee has finally gotten healthy and the results have been tremendous for the Blue Raiders, showing up in the five league games. Cuffee has been slowed this season with injuries, both in the preseason and another that caused him to miss four games in early December. But the Philadelphia, Pa., native has shown well in SBC outings, ranking 11th in points at 14.0 per game heading into this week's play. Cuffee also ranks seventh in FG percentage and 18th in rebounding in SBC games only. He had his best overall game of the season against Arkansas-Little Rock with team-highs of 17 points and seven rebounds in the two-point loss. Cuffee backed up the performance against UALR with 13 points in the victory at South Alabama last Thursday and then netted a seasonhigh 18 at New Orleans on Saturday. He ranks seventh in FG percentage (.556) and 12th in FT percentage (.833) in league games only.

Dean Lighting Up the League

Junior Mike Dean showed great promise in his first

five games as a Blue Raider, averaging 17.2 ppg. The Rome, Ga, native struggled with his shot in the next four outings before coming alive in the Sun Belt opener against Arkansas State, pouring in 30 points on seven three-pointers. He has continued his outstanding play against SBC foes, leading the conference at 21.8 ppg. Dean is tied for first in SBC play in three-point FG percentage (18-for-30, .600) and three-pointers made and is 11th in FT percentage (.840) heading into this week's play.

Young Cleaning the Glass

Redshirt freshman Kyle Young has made tremendous strides in rebounding this season, tying for ninth in the Sun Belt in boards per game with 5.9 heading into this week's play. The Lewisburg, Tenn., native is the only underclassmen in the SBC Top 10. Young has eight contests this season with at least seven rebounds and grabbed a season-high 12 boards at Chattanooga on December 29.

Blue Raiders Getting Votes

In this week's CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll, Middle Tennessee received 43 votes to put them at No. 36. Louisiana-Lafayette (77 votes) and Arkansas State (62 votes) are the only SBC schools rated ahead of the Blue Raiders. MT, however, defeated the Indians earlier this year and will face the Ragin' Cajuns for the first time on Saturday night. The Mid-Major Top 25 consists

lina State and 15 in the SBC opener versus Arkansas State. He hit double figures in the first half in the opening five games of the season as well as six of his last nine outings.

Road Warriors

The Blue Raiders have taken to the hard-nosed play desired by head coach Kermit Davis, and especially in Sun Belt road play. Middle Tennessee has posted a 6-3 road mark in SBC games after last weekend's wins at South Alabama and New Orleans, the first league road sweep since the Blue Raiders joined the SBC almost four seasons ago. The six road triumphs is tied for the second most since the start of last season through January 25. Louisiana-Lafayette is first with a 7-2 record, followed by Middle Tennessee's 6-3 and Arkansas-Little Rock's 6-5 mark. New Mexico State is 5-6 and Western Kentucky 5-5 over that stretch, South Alabama is 4-6, North Texas is 3-6, Denver is 3-7, Arkansas State and New Orleans are 3-8, and Florida International is 1-9.

Gunn Watch

Senior Tommy Gunn moved into 11th place alltime on the Middle Tennessee scoring list against Arkansas-Little Rock, scoring 13 points. The senior moved past Tim Gaither (1993-96) for 11th place on the all-time scoring list. Gunn now has 1,377 career points and stands 25 shy of taking over 10th place from Jerry Beck. The Syracuse, N.Y., native played in his 100th career game against South Alabama and is averaging 13.5 points per game in his career. He is 245 points from becoming the school's all-time leading scorer.

Britt, Scott Out for Season with Injuries

Freshman Ben Britt and sophomore Darrio Scott have both suffered injuries that will sideline them for the remainder of the season. Britt's injury took place at Wyoming on November 29. The Chattanooga, Tenn., native will be forced to take a medical redshirt and miss the remainder of the season. The Chattanooga product averaged 2.5 points and three rebounds during his two games of action. Scott was sidelined during the final minutes of practice on January 1. The Lynchburg, Va., native underwent season-ending surgery on January 5, an injury that significantly hurts and already thin frontcourt for the Blue Raiders.

- Middle Tennessee is 45-30 all-time in overtime games (2-1 in double OT). The Blue Raiders are 3-5 in their last eight overtime games and 2-2 under Kermit Davis.
- The Blue Raiders have hit at least one threepointer in 235 straight games. The last time Middle Tennessee failed to hit a trifecta was January 20, 1996, at Morehead State.

- Tommy Gunn has tallied double figures in scoring in 74 of his 102 career games. Gunn has scored in double figures in his last 20 games as well, dating to last season.
- The Blue Raiders have won 12 of their last 15 games at Murphy Center dating to 2002-03.
- Kermit Davis is two wins away from 100 in his Division I coaching career, posting a 98-70 (.583) record. Davis recorded a 66-25 mark in three seasons of junior college head coaching for a career record of 164-75 (.686).
- Middle Tennessee's 50 points in the first half against Tennessee Wesleyan are the most in one period under head coach Kermit Davis. The team scored 94 points in the game, also a high under Davis. The Blue Raiders also scored 50 in the first half against South Carolina State.
- Tommy Gunn is one of only three players in Blue Raider history to score 1,000 points and have 100 steals.
- Six opponents on this year's schedule saw action in the postseason in 2002-03. Western Kentucky, Cincinnati, Austin Peay and South Carolina State were in the NCAA Tournament, while UL-Lafayette and Wyoming were in the NIT.
- Middle Tennessee has compiled a record of 328-111 (.747) in the Murphy Center.

Tidbits

Middle Tennessee ranks second in the Sun Belt and 80th nationally in FG percentage heading into this week's play. The Blue Raiders are shooting 46.0 percent from the field for the year. The squad is second in the SBC and 28th nationally in three-point FG percentage at 38.9 percent ... Dating to last season, Tommy Gunn has scored in double figures 20 straight games ... The Blue Raiders have made the most of free throw opportunities in the month of January and especially in Sun Belt play. For the month, the squad is 158-for-207 (.763) from the stripe in eight outings. In Sun Belt contests, the club is even better, making 104-of-132 attempts (.788), ranking first in the SBC in FT percentage in league outings ... Junior Mike Dean scored a career-best 30 points, including 18 in the second half, to key Middle Tennessee's win over Arkansas State. Dean's point total equaled the 16th most ever scored in a game at Middle Tennessee and was the most by a Blue Raider since William Pippen rattled in 32 points at Florida International on Feb. 22, 2003. Dean connected on 7-of-18 shots from the field and all his field goals were three-pointers, which tied for the fourth most in game at Middle Tennessee ... The Blue Raiders committed only six turnovers in 45 minutes against Arkansas State, which equaled the second-best effort in school history. The mark for fewest turnovers in a game was set on December 22, 1988, against Arkansas State when the Blue Raiders had just five miscues ...

Middle Tennessee connected on a season-high 31 free throws in 44 attempts in the win over Arkansas State. The 44 attempts matched a Murphy Center record, while the 31 makes was the most by a Blue Raider team since Middle Tennessee hit 34 against Chattanooga on December 14, 1996.

Wrapping Up Thursday Game Vs. NMSU

After accounting for more than half of the team's points just one time in their first nine games together, the duo of Tommy Gunn and Mike Dean has accomplished the feat three times in the past five outings. In conference play, the combo is averaging an even 40.0 points a game to lead the Sun Belt ... Junior guard Mike Dean has been scorching the nets from three-point land over the past six games. During that span, the Rome, Ga., native has connected on 57.1 percent (24-of-42) of his trifectas. For the year, Dean leads the Sun Belt Conference with an overall percentage of .531. Middle Tennessee's single-season percentage record is 50.5 set by Jonathan Whitworth during the 1999-00 campaign ... NMSU shot 60.9 percent from the field, its best effort since hitting the same percentage against Valparaiso in 2001 ... Middle Tennessee has now had single-digit turnovers six times this season after registering only nine against the Aggies ... Five of Middle Tennessee's seven losses have come when giving up 80 or more points ... The Blue Raiders are now 0-3 all-time against NMSU at home ... Middle Tennessee's last three losses have been by a combined 12 points ... The Blue Raiders had just nine assists on their 25 baskets in the loss to NMSU ... Over the last four games, Middle Tennessee has done an excellent job of converting at the charity stripe. During that span, the Blue Raiders have made 73 of 88 attempts for a percentage of .830. The pinpoint shooting has increased the team's overall percentage from .652 to .694. MT went 17-for-22 at the line against NMSU.

Gunn Named All-Tournament

Senior Tommy Gunn earned All-Tournament honors at the Dr Pepper Classic in Chattanooga, Tenn., December 29-30, averaging 19 points in two games for the Blue Raiders. The Syracuse, N.Y., native also had five steals, eight assists and nine rebounds in the two outings. Gunn tied a season-high with 23 points versus South Carolina State, making 7-of-9 shots from the field and helping the Blue Raiders open a 21-point halftime lead with 16 points in the opening 20 minutes.

Gunn Honored by Sun Belt

Senior guard Tommy Gunn was named First Team All-Sun Belt by the league's coaches in their Preseason balloting. Gunn, who became the second Blue Raider to earn First Team All-SBC honors at the end of last season, is the first to ever be honored in the preseason. Gunn was a Third Team All-SBC selection at the end of the 2001-02 campaign.

Gunn Picks Up Mid-Major Award

Guard Tommy Gunn continued to roll in the preseason accolades, earning a spot on the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major All-America squad. Gunn, who is the first Blue Raider to pick up the award, was one of only two Sun Belt players listed.

Pippen with Globetrotters

Former Blue Raider William Pippen is continuing his playing career with the famous Harlem Globetrotters. Pippen began the fall in camp with the Phoenix Suns but was waived. Pippen then signed a contract with the Globetrotters to play with their competitive squad that tours the country playing exhibition games against college teams. Pippen and the Globetrotters will tour overseas when the team's college tour is completed. Pippen was a Third Team All-Sun Belt performer for the Blue Raiders in 2002-03.

Humphrey Joins ABA

Former Blue Raider John Humphrey played for a time in the *And 1 Street Ball* TV series. He was known as Helicopter for his hops. Humphrey has now joined the Las Vegas Rattlers of the ABA. In a game on January 14, he scored 29 points in a 125-120 loss to the Kansas City Knights. Humphrey gained national attention last year in the slam dunk competition at the Final Four in New Orleans.

Sun Belt Conference Tournament

The Sun Belt Conference Tournament is slated for March 6-9 at E.A. Diddle Arena in Bowling Green, Ky. The event combines the men's and women's tournament at one site. There is a change to this year's format, as only eight teams will be invited to participate. Ticket packages are available through the Western Kentucky ticket office by calling 270/745-5222.

Kermit Davis

Head Coach ● Mississippi State, 1982 ● 2nd Season ● 27-21 (.563)



When Kermit Davis came to Middle Tennesse. he had the reputation of turning programs around quickly. It did not take long for Davis to prove the rumor true.

He took a Blue Raider team that was picked

fourth in the Sun Belt's East Division and eighth out of the league's 11 teams and put them in the thick of a division title race that did not end until the final week of the season. For his efforts. Davis was named the Sun Belt Conference Coach of the Year, marking the second time in five years as a Division I head coach he has been so honored.

Davis did not stop there. He took his team to the finals of the Sun Belt Tournament, put together the most wins for a Blue Raider squad since the 1997-98 campaign, and mentored

two All-Sun Belt players.

Davis' reputation as a top-flight recruiter was certainly upheld as well. The Blue Raider coach hauled in three of Tennessee's top 20 players, one player ranked in the top 55 nationally, and a transfer from Georgia who was one of the nation's top shooting guards out of high school. The

ranked 32nd nationally and No. 1 in the Sun Belt by Hoop Scoop magazine. Ron Briscoe's Southeast Regional Basketball Report ranked the Middle Tennessee recruits as 23rd nationally and 10th in

team's recruiting class was

the Southeast. Davis has displayed success at every stop along his

career track and has done so with a hard-nosed style of defense, uptempo offensive play, and a strong

work ethic.

Davis came to Middle Tennessee after spending five seasons as the associate head coach at LSU under head coach John Brady.

Prior to LSU, Davis spent one season as head coach at the University of Idaho. However, his stint with the Vandals was his second tour of duty in Moscow. He also served as the school's head coach from 1988-1990. During his three years as the head coach at Idaho, he compiled a record of 63-29, the best three-year total in the program's history. Davis posted two of the best single-season tallies in school history during his first stint at Idaho as well, turning in 25-6 marks in both years.

During his first two seasons at Idaho, Davis compiled a 50-12 overall mark, captured two Big West titles, and earned consecutive trips to the NCAA Tournament. He was also named the league's Coach of the Year in 1989.

Davis' first head coaching job came at Southwest Mississippi Community College in Sum-

> mit, Miss., where he put together a 39-20 record in two seasons. His 1986 squad won 22 games, the school's first 20-win season in 17 years.

His success landed him a spot on

Tim Floyd's staff at Idaho, where he served as an assistant for two vears prior to taking over the Vandal team.

After spending the 1988-89 and 1989-90 seasons at Idaho. Davis went on to become the head coach at Texas A&M for one season, 1990-91.

From Texas A&M, Davis moved Chipola Junior College to serve as the associate head coach for two seasons before ascending to the top spot for the 1993-94 campaign.

During Davis' season as the team's head coach. Chipola finished the season ranked fourth in the national polls and posted a 27-5 record, the second-most wins in school history.

Davis headed to Utah State as

the team's associate head coach from 1994-96. At Utah State. Davis coached under former lowa State head coach Larry Eustachy and the pair combined to win the Big West Championship in

His Utah State tenure ended with a return to Idaho as the Vandals' head coach and the rest is

Davis, a native of Leakesville, Miss., and his wife Betty have two daughters, Ally (16) and Claire (11).
