Notes: Middle Tennessee meets Florida International in the middle of a three-game road stretch ... The two squads have met eight times overall with six of the contests in the past three seasons since Middle Tennessee joined the Sun Belt ... The first two games in the series came during the 1990-91 season ... The Blue Raiders do not return home until February 14.

Middle Tennessee vs. Florida International

Middle Tennessee leads the all-time series, 5-3, but the two teams have split the six meetings since the Blue Raiders joined the Sun Belt. Middle Tennessee has won three in a row in the series after dropping three straight to start SBC play. The Blue Raiders won 80-70 at the end of February last season in Miami and defeated the Golden Panthers, 60-58, in Murfreesboro three weeks earlier on television. Middle Tennessee also won 71-69 in Murfreesboro at the end of the 2001-02 campaign. The Blue Raiders are 2-2 all-time in Miami, with the other victory a 94-77 triumph during the 1990-91 season.

Scouting the Golden Panthers

Florida International has struggled mightily this season, posting a 3-16 overall record and 0-7 mark in Sun Belt play. The Golden Panthers, under head coach Donnie Marsh, have lost nine straight overall, including a 55-42 defeat to West-

ern Kentucky at home last Saturday in their last outing. For the season, Junior Matias leads FIU in scoring and rebounding at 14.8 points and 6.5 rebounds per game, but he was injured in the sixth game of the season and is out for the year. Carlos Morban (13.8) and Marcus Robinson (10.4) are the leading scorers and in SBC play, Robinson's 9.6 ppg average is the highest for the Golden Panthers.

Dean, Gunn Rank in National Statistics

Junior Mike Dean and senior Tommy Gunn entered the national statistics in scoring and three-point FG last week and stayed in the Top 100 despite Middle Tennessee's losses athome. Dean ranks fifth in the nation this week in three-point FG shooting at 48.9 percent. His 3.0 three-pointers per game ranks 27th in the nation as well. Dean leads the Sun Belt in three-point FG shooting and is fourth in the league in three-pointers made with 47. Gunn is 89th in the nation in scoring at 17.3 ppg and ranks third in the SBC, just ahead of Dean in the category.

Jackson Again Productive Off the Bench

Senior Steven Jackson pulled down a team-high seven rebounds at Western Kentucky in 17 minutes, scoring six points and once again giving the Blue Raiders a much-needed spark off the bench. In the last three games, the Memphis, Tenn., native is 7-for-11 from the field and 9-of-12 from the foul line in almost 50 minutes of action. Jackson is averaging 6.3 points and 3.9 boards in just over 15 minutes per game this season. The Memphis,

Tenn., senior netted 11 points with three rebounds and two steals in 18 minutes versus Louisiana-Lafayette last Saturday. Jackson has five double-figure games this season and seven contests with at least five rebounds.

Smithson Dishing It Out

Freshman Bryan Smithson ranks third in the Sun Belt in assists per game at 4.32 heading into this week's contests, trailing only Rodney Billups of Denver and Antonio Haynes of Western Kentucky. Smithson handed out six helpers in the OT win at New Orleans on January 24 and had eight assists in the conference opener versus Arkansas State. Smithson ranks fourth in assist-to-turnover ratio and is also fourth in the league in assists in SBC games at 4.30.

Gunn, Dean Lead in Scoring

Senior Tommy Gunn and junior Mike Dean rank in the top four of the Sun Belt in scoring this week. The duo ranks third and fourth, respectively, in all games, averaging 17.3 and 16.0 ppg this season. In league games only, Dean ranks second at 19.6 ppg and Gunn is fourth with 17.7 per outing. They are the highest scoring pair in SBC games at 37.3, just ahead of ASU's J.J. Montgomery and Dewarick Spencer.

Cuffee Steps Up in League Play

Junior Michael Cuffee has finally gotten healthy and the results have been showing in the seven league games. Cuffee has been slowed this season with injuries, both in the preseason and anotherthat caused him to miss four games in early December. But the Philadelphia, Pa., native has shown well in SBC outings, ranking 15th in points heading into this week's play. Cuffee is also tied for 17th in rebounding in SBC games. He had his best overall game of the season against Arkansas-Little Rock with team-highs of 17 points and seven rebounds in the two-point loss. Cuffee backed up the performance against UALR with 13 points in the victory at South Alabama and then netted a season-high 18 at New Orleans. He pulled down

a game-high eight rebounds on Saturday against Louisiana-Lafayette, tying his career-high. Through the seven contests, Cuffee is averaging 13.3 points and 5.6 rebounds per contest, above his season average in both categories.

Road Warriors

The Blue Raiders have taken to the hard-nosed play desired by head coach Kermit Davis, and especially in Sun Belt road play. Middle Tennessee has posted a 6-4 road mark in SBC games after wins at South Alabama and New Orleans earlier this season, the first league road sweep since the Blue Raiders joined the SBC almost four seasons ago. The six road triumphs is tied for the second most since the start of last season through February 6 of this year:

Dean Lighting Up the League

Junior Mike Dean showed great promise in his first five games as a Blue Raider, averaging 17.2 ppg. The Rome, Ga., native struggled with his shot in the next four outings before coming alive in the Sun Belt opener against Arkansas State, pouring in 30 points on seven three-pointers. He has continued his outstanding play against SBC foes, ranking second in the conference heading into this week's games. Dean is third in SBC play in three-point FG percentage, tied for first in three-pointers made and is 13th in FT percentage heading into this week's play. Dean is averaging 19.6 ppg in SBC outings and making almost 47 percent of his three-point attempts.

Young Cleaning the Glass

Redshirtfreshman Kyle Young has made tremendous strides in rebounding this season, tying for 13th in the Sun Belt in boards per game heading into this week's play. Young has nine contests this season with at least six rebounds and grabbed a season-high 12 boards at Chattanooga on December 29. The Lewisburg, Tenn., native is pulling down 5.5 rebounds per outing thus far in 2003-04.

Blue Raiders Getting Votes

In this week's College Insider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll, Middle Tennessee received four votes to put them at No. 50. Louisiana-Lafayette is ranked 17th this week and is the only other SBC school to receive votes. Middle Tennessee lost to the Ragin' Cajuns on Saturday. The Mid-Major Top 25 consists of a voting panel of 31 head coaches

Gunn Getting Better With Age

Senior Tommy Gunn has upped his scoring and rebounding average in every season as a Blue Raider and is doing so once again, averaging 17.3 points and 4.5 rebounds per game this season. The Syracuse, N.Y., native ranks at the top of four Sun Belt categories heading into this week's play, including scoring (3rd), FG percentage (10th), FT percentage (5th) and three-point FG percentage (10th). Gunn is also tied for the league lead in steals with 2.33 per game in SBC play. He has also been a hot starter this season for the Blue Raiders, as well, averaging 9.6 points per outing in the first half. Gunn has 11 contests this season with double-digits in the opening 20 minutes, including 18 at Chattanooga, 16 against South Carolina State and 15 in the SBC opener versus Arkansas State.

Gunn Watch

Senior Tommy Gunn moved past Jerry Beck (1979-82) into 10th place on the all-time scoring list at Middle Tennessee with his team-high 17 points at Western Kentucky on Thursday. Gunn now has 1,410 career points as a Blue Raider in 104 career contests, an average of 13.6 per outing. The Syracuse, N.Y., native played in his 100th career game at South Alabama on January 22. Gunn is just 17 points from moving past four players into sixth place on the all-time list, including Chris Rainey (1,426 pts), Tim Sisneros (1,426 pts), Greg Joyner (1,424 pts) and Sleepy Taylor (1,421 pts). He is 212 points from becoming the school's all-time leading scorer.

Britt, Scott Out for Season with Injuries

Freshman Ben Britt and sophomore Darrio Scott have both suffered injuries that will sideline them for the remainder of the season. Britt's injury took place at Wyoming on November 29. The Chattanooga, Tenn., native will be forced to take a medical redshirt and miss the remainder of the season. The Chattanooga product averaged 2.5 points and three rebounds during his two games of action. Scott was sidelined during the final minutes of practice on January 1. The Lynchburg, Va., native underwent season-ending surgery on January 5, an injury that significantly hurts and already thin frontcourt for the Blue Raiders.

By the Numbers

- Middle Tennessee is 45-30 all-time in overtime games (2-1 in double OT). The Blue Raiders are 3-5 in their last eight overtime games and 2-2 under Kermit Davis.
- The Blue Raiders have hit at least one threepointer in 237 straight games. The last time Middle Tennessee failed to hit a trifecta was January 20,

1996, at Morehead State.

- Tommy Gunn has tallied double figures in scoring in 76 of his 104 career games. Gunn has scored in double figures in his last 21 games as well, dating to last season.
- The Blue Raiders have won 12 of their last 16 games at Murphy Center dating to 2002-03.
- Kermit Davis is two wins away from 100 in his Division I coaching career, posting a 98-72 (.576) record. Davis recorded a 66-25 mark in three seasons of junior college head coaching for a career record of 164-77 (.680).
- Middle Tennessee's 50 points in the first half against Tennessee Wesleyan are the most in one period under head coach Kermit Davis. The team scored 94 points in the game, also a high under Davis. The Blue Raiders also scored 50 in the first half against South Carolina State.
- Tommy Gunn is one of only three players in Blue Raider history to score 1,000 points and have 100 steals.
- Six opponents on this year's schedule saw action in the postseason in 2002-03. Western Kentucky, Cincinnati, Austin Peay and South Carolina State were in the NCAA Tournament, while UL-Lafayette and Wyoming were in the NIT.
- Middle Tennessee has compiled a record of 328-112 (.746) in the Murphy Center.

Season Tidbits

Middle Tennessee ranks third in the Sun Belt in FG percentage heading into this week's play. The Blue Raiders are shooting 44.9 percent from the field for the year. The squad is second in the SBC and 46th nationally in three-point FG percentage at 38.1 percent ... Dating to last season, Tommy Gunn has scored in double figures 22 straight games ... The Blue Raiders have made the most of free throw opportunities in Sun Belt play. In SBC contests, the club is making 130-of-171 attempts (.760), ranking first in the SBC in FT percentage in league outings ... Junior Mike Dean scored a career-best 30 points, including 18 in the second half, to key Middle Tennessee's win over Arkansas State. Dean's point total equaled the 16th most ever scored in a game at Middle Tennessee and was the most by a Blue Raider since William Pippen rattled in 32 points at Florida International on Feb. 22, 2003. Dean connected on 7-of-18 shots from the field and all his field goals were three-pointers, which tied for the fourth most in game at Middle Tennessee ... The Blue Raiders committed only six turnovers in 45 minutes against Arkansas State, which equaled the second-best effort in school history. The mark for fewest turnovers in a game was set on December 22, 1988, against Arkansas State when the Blue Raiders had just five miscues ... Middle Tennessee connected on a season-high 31 free throws in 44 attempts in the win over Arkansas State. The 44 attempts matched a Murphy Center record, while the 31 makes was the most by a Blue Raider team since Middle Tennessee hit 34 against Chattanooga on December 14, 1996 ... The Blue Raiders shot a season-low 34.4 percent from the field against Louisiana-Lafayette on January 31, including a dismal 5-of-20 shooting from three-point range. Middle Tennessee's 34.4 FG percentage was its worst shooting effort since making only 31.4 percent of its shots at UALR on January 29, 2001 – a span of 86 games.

Wrapping Up Thursday's Game At WKU

Senior Tommy Gunn moved past Jerry Beck (1979-82) into 10th place on the all-time scoring list at Middle Tennessee with his team-high 17 points. Gunn now has 1,410 career points as a Blue Raider in 104 career contests ... Middle Tennessee used a different starting lineup for the first time in 15 games. The fivesome of Smithson, Dean, Gunn, Cuffee and Young had started the previous 14 outings, compiling an 8-6 record. Due to injuries and shaking up the lineup, head coach Kermit Davis used a different starting five for the first time since December 17 at Alabama State ... Freshman Alex Weekes drew his first career start, playing 18 minutes ... Tommy Gunn did not start the contest after an injury kept him out of practice for most of the week. Gunn's stretch of 38 consecutive starts came to an end. His last non-start came against Kennesaw State on December 27, 2002 ... Freshman Bryan Smithson tied his career-high with five rebounds in the contest, the third time Smithson has pulled down five boards ... Middle Tennessee led at halftime, 31-28, but lost the contest, only the second time this season and fourth time under Kermit Davis the Blue Raiders lost when leading at the half. Middle Tennessee is 8-2 this season and 22-4 under Davis when leading at the half ... Tommy Gunn was 4-of-6 from three-point range in the game, his best outing from behind the arc since the first two contests of the season when Gunn was 4-of-5 (vs. Covenant) and 4-for-7 (at Wyoming) ... Senior Steven Jackson pulled down a team-high seven rebounds in the contest in 17 minutes, scoring six points and once again giving the Blue Raiders a much-needed spark off the bench. In the last three games, the Memphis, Tenn., senior is 7-for-11 from the field and 9-of-12 from the foul line in almost 50 minutes of action.

Gunn Named All-Tournament

Senior Tommy Gunn earned All-Tournament honors at the Dr Pepper Classic in Chattanooga, Tenn., December 29-30, averaging 19 points in two games for the Blue Raiders. The Syracuse, N.Y., native also had five steals, eight assists and nine rebounds in the two outings. Gunn tied a season-high with 23 points versus South Carolina

State, making 7-of-9 shots from the field and helping the Blue Raiders open a 21-point halftime lead with 16 points in the opening 20 minutes.

Gunn Honored by Sun Belt

Senior guard Tommy Gunn was named First Team All-Sun Belt by the league's coaches in their Preseason balloting. Gunn, who became the second Blue Raider to earn First Team All-SBC honors at the end of last season, is the first to ever be honored in the preseason. Gunn was a Third Team All-SBC selection at the end of the 2001-02 campaign.

Gunn Picks Up Mid-Major Award

Guard Tommy Gunn continued to roll in the preseason accolades, earning a spot on the CollegeInsider.comMid-MajorAll-America squad. Gunn, who is the first Blue Raider to pick up the award, was one of only two Sun Belt players listed.

Pippen with Globetrotters

Former Blue Raider William Pippen is continuing his playing career with the famous Harlem Globetrotters. Pippen began the fall in camp with the Phoenix Suns but was waived. Pippen then signed a contract with the Globetrotters to play with their competitive squad that tours the country playing exhibition games against college teams. Pippen and the Globetrotters will tour overseas when the team's college tour is completed. Pippen was a Third Team All-Sun Belt performer for the Blue Raiders in 2002-03.

Humphrey Joins ABA

Former Blue Raider John Humphrey played for a time in the *And 1 Street Ball* TV series. He was known as Helicopter for his hops. Humphrey has now joined the Las Vegas Rattlers of the ABA. In a game on January 14, he scored 29 points in a 125-120 loss to the Kansas City Knights. Humphrey gained national attention last year in the slam dunk competition at the Final Four in New Orleans.

Sun Belt Conference Tournament

The Sun Belt Conference Tournament is slated for March 6-9 at E.A. Diddle Arena in Bowling Green, Ky. The event combines the men's and women's tournament at one site. There is a change to this year's format, as only eight teams will be invited to participate. Ticket packages are available through the Western Kentucky ticket office by calling 270/745-5222.

When Kermit Davis came to Middle Tennesse, he had the reputation of turning programs around quickly. It did not take long for Davis to prove the rumor true.

He took a Blue Raider team that was picked

fourth in the Sun Belt's East Division and eighth out of the league's 11 teams and put them in the thick of a division title race that did not end until the final week of the season. For his efforts, Davis was named the Sun Belt Conference Coach of the Year, marking the second time in five years as a Division I head coach he has been so honored.

Davis did not stop there. He took his team to the finals of the Sun Belt Tournament, put together the most wins for a Blue Raider squad since the 1997-98 campaign, and mentored

two All-Sun Belt players.

Davis' reputation as a top-flight recruiter was certainly upheld as well. The Blue Raider coach hauled in three of Tennessee's top 20 players, one player ranked in the top 55 nationally, and a transfer from Georgia who was one of the nation's top shooting quards out of high school. The team's recruiting class was ranked 32nd nationally and No. 1 in the Sun Belt by Hoop Scoop magazine. Ron Briscoe's Southeast Regional Basketball Report ranked the Middle Tennessee recruits

Davis has displayed success at every stop along his career track and has done so with a hard-nosed style of defense, uptempo offensive play, and a strong work ethic.

as 23rd nationally and 10th in

the Southeast.

Davis came to Middle Tennessee after spending five seasons as the associate head coach at LSU under head coach John Brady.

Prior to LSU, Davis spent one season as head coach at the University of Idaho. However, his stint with the Vandals was his second tour of duty in Moscow. He also served as the school's head coach from 1988-1990. During his three years as the head coach at Idaho, he compiled a record of 63-29, the best three-year total in the program's history. Davis posted two of the best single-season tallies in school history during his first stint at Idaho as well, turning in 25-6 marks in both years.

During his first two seasons at Idaho, Davis compiled a 50-12 overall mark, captured two Big West titles, and earned consecutive trips to the NCAA Tournament. He was also named the league's Coach of the Year in 1989.

Davis' first head coaching job came at Southwest Mississippi Community College in Summit, Miss., where he put together a 39-20 record in two seasons. His 1986 squad won 22 games, the school's first 20-win season in 17 years.

His success landed him a spot on Tim Floyd's staff at Idaho, where he served as an assistant for two years prior to taking over the Vandal team.

After spending the 1988-89 and 1989-90 seasons at Idaho, Davis went on to become the head coach at Texas A&M for one season. 1990-91.

From Texas A&M, Davis moved Chipola Junior College to serve as the associate head coach for two seasons before ascending to the top spot for the 1993-94 campaign.

During Davis' season as the team's head coach, Chipola finished the season ranked fourth in the national polls and posted a 27-5 record, the second-most wins in school history.

Davis headed to Utah State as

the team's associate head coach from 1994-96. At Utah State, Davis coached under former lowa State head coach Larry Eustachy and the pair combined to win the Big West Championship in 1995.

His Utah State tenure ended with a return to Idaho as the Vandals' head coach and the rest is history.

Davis, a native of Leakesville, Miss., and his wife Betty have two daughters, Ally (16) and Claire (11).
