**Notes:** Middle Tennessee takes on South Alabama for just the second time at the Mitchell Center ... The Lady Raiders are 0-1 all-time in Mobile, with the only meeting two years ago, a 72-58 Lady Jags victory ... Middle Tennessee has played three total games at the Mitchell Center, with contests against Louisiana-Lafayette and North Texas in the 2001 SBC Championships.

### Middle Tennessee vs. South Alabama

South Alabama leads the all-time series, 4-3, with both teams winning twice since Middle Tennessee joined the Sun Belt. Last season Patrice Holmes posted a double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds, while Krystle Horton added 13 points and Ciara Gray had 10 in a 56-55 victory in Murfreesboro. The victory was the first in SBC play for the Lady Raiders in 2004 after an 0-2 start. Three of the seven meetings in school history came in tournaments from 1980-85.

### Co-Leaders Meet

Saturday's meeting between Middle Tennessee and South Alabama will be between division co-leaders in the Sun Belt. The Lady Raiders are 3-0 and are tied atop the East Division with Western Kentucky, while the Lady Jags are 3-1 in SBC play, tied with North Texas and Louisiana-Lafayette for first in the West Divi-

sion. Both teams were picked to win their division by the coaches in the preseason, with USA tallying a league-leading 66 votes for first place overall.

### Holmes Displays Marksmanship of Old

Senior Patrice Holmes showed her deft stroke from the field Thursday night at New Orleans, canning a careerhigh six three-pointers and tallying a season-high 28 points in the 59-51 victory. Holmes was 6-of-10 from behind the arc in the contest, including four treys in the first half. Her buzzer-beater from the wing gave the Lady Raiders a 32-30 edge at the half. The Bishopville, S.C., senior has struggled a bit from the field this season, but regained her form against the Privateers, tying for the team high this season with Tia Stovall (South Florida, 11/12/04). The 28 points were the most for Holmes since her career-high of 31 last season against Tennessee State (12/15/03).

### Defense is the Key

Middle Tennessee has produced 86 victories since the start of the 2000-01 campaign, and the biggest key to the team's success has been defense. The Lady Raiders are 55-11 when holding an opponent under 40 percent from the field during the four-plus-years stretch, including a 16-3 mark during last season's 24-8 campaign and a 8-1 record this season. Seven of the last 10 opponents this season have shot less than 40 percent from the floor, with Middle Tennessee winning six of those contests. The Lady Raiders held New Orleans to 38 percent shooting Thursday night in a 59-51 victory, the team's seventh in the last eight outings.

### Holmes Stepping Up in SBC Play

Senior Patrice Holmes has saved her best for last, averaging 16.5 points per game in Sun Belt play after three games. Holmes' previous high in Sun Belt play was 15.8 during her sophomore campaign. She netted a season-high 28 points against New Orleans on Thursday, her 26th career 20-point effort and 13th against Sun Belt competition.

### Givens a Ball-Hawk

Sophomore Chrissy Givens sets the tone for the Lady Raiders with her defensive intensity, making it difficult for opposing point guards to bring the ball up the court. The Lady Raiders rank fifth in the Sun Belt in scoring defense, allowing just 59.4 points per game with opponents shooting just 41 percent from the field for the season. Givens also grabs almost five rebounds per contest from her guard spot and has 23 steals this season, 1.4 per outing. The Monroe, La., native has nearly doubled her offensive output in her first season as a starter, averaging 8.9 points per game and shooting 48 percent from the field. She led the Lady Raiders in assists with five in Thursday's 59-51 victory over New Orleans, her fifth game this season to lead the squad in assists.

### Gray Returns to Squad

Senior guard Ciara Gray made a decision in the summer to sit out the 2004-05 season because of recurring problems with her injured knee. But the LaVergne, Tenn., native changed her mind one month into the season and joined the Lady Raiders December 2 at Georgia State. Gray provides head coach Stephany Smith with depth and experience off the bench, an aspect the club is short on this season. The senior has started the last four games, helping Middle Tennessee win four straight for the first time this season and seven of the last eight overall.

### **Tidbits**

The Lady Raiders are 9-1 this season when outrebounding their opponents. Middle Tennessee has won the battle of the boards in the last four outings and are winning the rebounding margin by 6.0 in conference play ... Middle Tennessee began Thursday's game at New Orleans with its fourth different starting lineup this season ... The Lady Raiders are allowing just 53.1 points in the last 11 contests, holding opponents to just 37 percent from the floor.

### Horton Doubling Up

Sophomore Krystle Horton has posted the only two double-doubles for the Lady Raiders this season, registering 10 points and 10 rebounds against South Florida before tallying 19 points and 10 boards in a victory over

Austin Peay just before Christmas. Horton owns eight double-doubles in 47 career outings and has half of the team's double-doubles in the last two seasons.

### Road Not Nearly as Nice

Middle Tennessee has posted a stellar 22-7 home record since joining the Sun Belt, but the road hasn't been nearly as nice. The Lady Raiders are 15-17 in four years in the SBC and posted the first winning record in those four seasons in 2003-04, going 4-3 away from Murphy Center. Included in those victories last year was a 79-57 triumph over Western Kentucky in the SBC Championships final in Bowling Green, Ky. The Lady Raiders picked up their first road-opening victory in Sun Belt play Thursday at New Orleans, improving to 1-4 all-time in SBC road openers.

### Scouting the Lady Jags

South Alabama enters Saturday's contest 9-7 overall, 3-1 in Sun Belt play after a 57-47 setback at home to Western Kentucky on Thursday. Under fifth-year head coach Rick Pietri, the Lady Jags are 5-3 at home this season, including 2-1 in conference play. USA averages 58.3 points per game, with JoAnna Williams the only Lady jag in double figures at 10.8 points per contest. Whitney Woodard is averaging 5.3 rebounds per outing, tops on the squad. South Alabama shot just 37 percent from the floor against Western Kentucky on Thursday, scoring just 19 points in the second half after being tied at the half.

### Game Notes from New Orleans

Senior Patrice Holmes knocked down a career-high six three-pointers in the contest. Her previous high of

five last came at Louisiana-Lafayette on January 31, 2004 ... The Lady Raiders held UNO to 38 percent shooting for the contest, improving to 8-1 when holding an opponent under 40 percent from the field. Middle Tennessee is holding opponents to 53 points per game over the last 11 contests ... The Lady Raiders improved to 3-0 in Sun Belt play, the second time in three years the squad has started SBC play 3-0 ... Holmes scored 28 points in the contest, tying for the team high this season with Tia Stovall, who tallied 28 in the season-opener against South Florida ... Middle Tennessee shot just 39 percent from the floor, the second-lowest percentage this season (38 percent vs. Austin Peay) ... Holmes moved into a tie for fourth on the all-time assists list with Kim Webb. She has 399 heading into Saturday's contest at South Alabama ... Ciara Gray tied her career-high with six three-point attempts ... Freshman Starr Orr set season-highs for rebounds (6) and assists (3) and tied her season-high for free throws made (2) and steals (3) ... Chrissy Givens tied her career-high with a team-high five assists ... Holmes had a season-high 28 points and tied her season-high for FG made with nine ... Freshman Lakira Boyd played a career-high 23 minutes.

### In the Sun Belt

Middle Tennessee ranks first in the Sun Belt in steals with 12.2 per game heading into this week's games. That number ranks 21st nationally. The Lady Raiders are third in the Sun Belt in assists (14.1) and third in turnover margin, forcing 22.0 turnovers per outing. The squad is 28th nationally in FG percentage at .452. In the SBC individual statistics, junior Tia Stovall is seventh in scoring (14.7), fifth in FG percentage (.525), and tied for 14th with teammate Krystle Horton in rebounding (5.9). Horton is also right behind Stovall, ranking sixth in FG percentage (.517) and is also 13th in the league in scoring (12.6). The two Lady Raider forwards rank 41 st and 50 th, nationally, in FG percentage, as well. Senior Patrice Holmes is ranked in the Top 10 in the Sun Belt in five categories, including leading the Sun Belt in steals at 3.47 per outing. She also ranks 13th nationally in thefts. She is third in 3-point FG made (30), fifth in assist-to-turnover ratio, sixth in assists (4.0) and eighth in scoring (14.6).

### On This Date

Middle Tennessee is 8-1 all-time on January 22, including a 56-55 victory over South Alabama last season in Murfreesboro. The Lady Raiders have defeated Murray State three times (1977, '79, '81) and Austin Peay, Oral Roberts, Eastern Kentucky, Tennessee State and USA once each. Middle Tennessee's only loss on this date was a 77-76 setback to Western Kentucky in 1981.

### Holmes Climbing Career Lists

Senior Patrice Holmes has started all 107 games in her Lady Raider career and continues to climb several all-time lists during her final season in the Blue and White. The Bishopville, S.C., native ranks seventh in scoring with 1,625 points and is 10th on the career rebounding list with 675. She recorded one assist Thursday at New Orleans and is tied with Kim Webb (1984-87) for fourth with 399 career assists heading into Saturday's contest at South Alabama. Holmes needs five more assists to pass Sherry Smith (403, 1980-83) and move into third place. Holmes is also second in steals (281), fifth in 3-pointers made (151) and fourth in 3-point attempts (495).

### Stovall on Pace for 1,000

Junior Tia Stovall is on pace to become the 17th Lady Raider in history to amass 1,000 career points. The Estill Springs, Tenn., native enters Saturday's contest at South Alabama with 818 career points. With 11 regular season games remaining, the forward would need to average 16.5 points per outing to reach the mark in the final regular season game of the season, February 26 versus Florida International. Stovall currently ranks second on the squad with 14.1 points per game.

### Accolades Come Early for Lady Raiders

The Lady Raiders racked up with preseason awards from Sun Belt coaches during the preseason, claiming three all-conference spots, preseason player of the year honors and the top spot in the Eastern Division. Two-time Sun Belt Championships Most Outstanding Player Patrice Holmes was a First Team All-SBC selection, as was sophomore Krystle Horton. Holmes has been a First Team pick the last two seasons after earning Freshman of the Year in 2002. Horton was a First Team selection after her dynamite freshman campaign, while Tia Stovall was named Third Team in the preseason.

### THE LAST TIME

Ciara Gray provided the spark, and Patrice Holmes took care of the finish Thursday night when MTSU's Lady Raiders overcame numerous obstacles to pull out a 56-55 thriller over South Alabama at Murphy Center. The Lady Raiders snapped a two-game Sun Belt Conference losing streak and improved to 11-5 overall and 1-2 in league play, and handed South Alabama (14-2, 3-1) its first loss in 15 games.

"Obviously we're glad we're not 0-3, who would want to be there?" said MTSU coach Stephany Smith. "We have a talented basketball team, we just kind of lost our way that one weekend.

"I think defense was a huge, huge key in our win tonight. I've said all year long that this team can be a special team because of its ability to defend."

Trailing 43-31 with 12:51 remaining in the game, Gray scored seven straight Lady Raider points to set the stage for a back-and-forth showdown. The Lady Raiders eventually evened the score at 45 with 9:05 remaining after buckets by Justice and Stovall off assists from Holmes.

"I felt like I had to step up and make something happen," Gray said. "I was looking at our team and we looked like we were down. We needed someone to step up."

And then there was Holmes, who had struggled offensively much of the night.

However, trailing 53-51 Holmes scored on a short jumper in the lane to tie the score with 2:13 remaining. After both teams missed, Holmes scored on a 15-footer with 1:09 left to give the Lady Raiders the lead for good.

"I always want the ball in those situations," Holmes said. "I'm a go-to player and it's my job to score when we need to."

Gray was fouled with 19 seconds left, but missed the first free throw before making the second. South Alabama pulled within one on a layup by Donyel Wheeler with 10 seconds left. MTSU got the ball inbounds to Krystle Horton, who was fouled with nine seconds left, but she missed both free throws to set up the exciting finish.

South Alabama got the ball down court quickly and Lady Jaguars' forward Qiana Mitchell got off a good shot on the baseline, but it was long. Holmes grabbed her 10th rebound of the game to preserve the victory.

"They did get a good look on the baseline," Smith said. "It's unfortunate that it got to that situation. Ciara, as phenomenal as she was in our charge and comeback, misses the front end of her one-and-one, and Krystle steps up and she

### misses both of hers.

"You shouldn't have been in that position, but we were in what we call our 21 defense. We were trying to stay between our man and our basket and not let them go helter skelter.

"The game plan was for Patrice to leave her man and go double-team the playmaker. We didn't expect the playmaker to be No. 21 (Whitney Woodard). But she is their go-to player and she got the rebound and took it."

MTSU led 28-27 at halftime after trailing by as many as five points, and the modest advantage was keyed by the Lady Raiders' zone. Although South Alabama hit five first-half 3-pointers, the Lady Jaguars had 10 turnovers.

However, MTSU didn't score in the first 6:47 of the second half while South Alabama reeled off 13 unanswered points to go up 40-28.

"I thought the first ... until the first media timeout of the second half, I was really frustrated with out defense," Smith said. "We knew what was successful for us in the first half and what we needed to do in the second half.

"But we were very lethargic and I was very frustrated trying to get them motivated to pressure the basketball. Once we started pressuring the basketball, I think that took care of our offensive drought. I thought it was a huge defensive game for us."

Holmes led MTSU with 14 points and 10 rebounds, while Horton had 13 points and five rebounds and Gray 10 points and five rebounds.

## **Stephany Smith**

Coach Stephany Smith is entering her eighth year at the helm of the Lady Raider basketball program with high expectations.

Smith made an appearance in the NCAA

Tournament for the second time in her sevenyear reign last season and is looking to repeat that feat in 2005. After garnering the first 20-win mark of her career in 2003-04, Smith led her athletic squad to a Sun Belt Tournament title in just the school's fourth year in the league. She also coached junior stand-out Patrice Holmes to her second straight Sun Belt Tournament Most Outstanding Player award.

For the first time in her career and the second time in school history, the team made it to the second round of the NCAA Tournament with a 67-62 win over No. 12 North Carolina. The win, by No. 13 seed Middle Tennessee, was just the third time in NCAA Tournament history a 13 seed knocked off a No. 4 seed.

The Brookhaven, Miss., native has established herself as one of college basketball's brightest young coaches and is looking forward to the season ahead.

Completing her seventh campaign, Smith's record stands as a testament to her hard work, excellent recruiting skills, and knowledge of the game. In seven seasons, Smith sports a 129-79 record and has not only the 2004 Sun Belt Tournament Title but an OVC regular season title and an OVC Tournament title to her credit. The NCAA berth in 2003-04 was the fourth team Smith has led into postseason play, with an NCAA berth in 1998 and WNIT bids in 1999 and 2001.

Smith did not enter into her first head coaching job blindly. She spent four years as an assistant at Middle Tennessee to former head coach Lewis Bivens, heading up the team's recruiting efforts during that time. Smith was promoted to

associate head coach in her final season under Bivens.

The 1995-96 squad went 24-6, the second-most victories in school history, before falling to Kansas in the first round of the NCAA Tournament in Lawrence, Kan. The Lady Raiders were OVC Co-Champions in 1994-95 and 1995-96, compiling 64 wins in Smith's first three seasons on the MT staff. Fruits of her labors at Middle Tennessee were shown in 1996 when the Lady Raiders received votes in both collegiate polls, ranking as high as 26th. The school received its first at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament to further attest the program's growing

Smith spent four years as an assistant at UAB before her arrival at Middle Tennessee, coordinating recruiting for the Blazers. UAB went 76-45 during her four seasons on the staff, winning or tying for the Sun Belt Conference crown twice (1990, '91) and sharing the Great Midwest Conference title in 1992. The Lady Blazers made two WNIT trips (1991, '92) during Smith's association with the UAB program.

She spent one year as a graduate assistant at her alma mater, Harding University, in 1989. Teams associated with Smith have a 255-158 record during her 14 years on the Division I level, including four 20-plus win seasons and two 19-win campaigns.

Smith's claim to fame is recruiting: as she has established a reputation as one of the game's top young coaches and as a top-flight recruiter. She is also a teacher of the game holding a coaching clinic over the summer to instruct other coaches on various offenses. Three of her former players have gone on to play in the professional ranks including former Lady Raider Joanne Aluka who played in Portugal and was a member of the Nigerian women's basketball team at the 2004 Summer Olympics in Athens.

Jacque Nero played six years overseas



before being selected fourth by Nashville in the 1998 ABL draft. Shyronda Mifflin has played four seasons overseas and was on the Atlanta Glory's practice squad for part of the 1998 season before returning to Spain.

Her coaching philosophy stresses establishing fundamental knowledge of the game in practice. The repetition of fundamentals in practice allows her players the freedom to use that knowledge coupled with their athletic skills over the course of a game. An intense conditioning regimen also lends Smith's squad the opportunity to play an up-tempo style predicated on defensive intensity.

Smith graduated from Harding University in Searcy, Ark., with a B.A. in Physical Education in May of 1988 before receiving an M.S.E. in 1989. She began her career at Copiah-Lincoln Community College in Wesson, Miss. She received an associate's degree from Co-Lin in May of 1986.

Smith competed in basketball at both Co-Lin and Harding and also spent a year as the head girls track coach at Searcy High School in 1989 while completing her Master's degree at Harding.

Smith is truly people-oriented. She has planned and directed numerous non-profit clinics at Middle Tennessee and UAB for girls to further promote the game of basketball. She now heads up one of the most successful camps in the country, the Middle Tennessee "Stars of Tomorrow" camp, each summer. She is the daughter of Ralph and Betsy Smith. She has three brothers (Ralph, Richard, Cameron) and one sister (Sydney).
