Notes: Middle Tennessee trails the all-time series with Vanderbilt, 39-19, dating to 1976, including 10-15 at home ... The Blue Raiders won last year's meeting in Nashville, 6-4, breaking a three-game losing streak in the series ... Middle Tennessee has lost three of the last four contests played in Murfreesboro, including a 9-3 defeat in 2005 ... The Blue Raiders enter the game winners of 11 of its last 14 games overall this season dating to March 22 ... Tonight's contest ends a season-high six-game homestand. Middle Tennessee is currently 4-1 on the homestand.

Middle Tennessee vs. Vanderbilt

The Blue Raiders trail the all-time series, 39-19, dating to 1976, including 10-15 at home. The Commodores have won three of the last four meetings in Murfreesboro, including a 9-3 victory last season. In the last 10 meetings Middle Tennessee is 4-6, sandwiching victories around a pair of threegame winning streak by Vanderbilt.

Last Time Against the Commodores

In the last meeting between the two teams, Middle Tennessee head coach Steve Peterson was absent from the May 11, 2005, contest after the passing of his father. Associate head coach Jim McGuire helped the Blue Raiders to a 6-4 victory behind a strong pitching performance from Jeff Kasser (5.2 IP, 3 R, 4 K) and a 12-hit attack led by Marcus Taylor's three RBIs and a home run. Jeff Beachum had three hits and scored twice for the Blue Raiders and Allan Woodward picked up the save with a scoreless inning. (Box Score at the end of these notes).

Beachum Breaks Hits Record

Senior Jeff Beachum became the all-time hits leader at Middle Tennessee last Tuesday against Austin Peay, doubling in the third inning to tie the record and then homering, his first of the season, in the fourth inning to pass Clay Snellgrove (269, 1994-97) for the career record. Beachum enters Tuesday's outing against Vanderbilt with 281 career hits. He also ranks in the Top 10 in seven other categories, including runs scored (152, 6th), at-bats (828, 3rd), singles (1st, 221), doubles (49, 5th), total bases (359, 6th), games played (201, t9th) and sacrifices (23, 3rd). The Cordova, Tenn., native is only nine RBIs from tying Jayhawk Owens (129, 1988-90) for 10th on the all-time list. For the season Beachum leads the Blue Raiders in batting average (.397) and ranks first in hits (56), doubles (10) and runs scored (35), and third in on-base percentage (.438). He also has just seven strikeouts in 141 at-bats, ranking 15th nationally in toughest-to-strikeout category. A full listing of the career lists appears on page 14 of these notes.

More on Beachum

In addition to becoming the all-time hits leader at Middle Tennessee, the senior enjoyed a spectacular week at the plate, going 13-for-25 (.520) in five games with 10 runs scored and five RBIs, helping the Blue Raiders to a 4-1 record and a series win over Western Kentucky. Against Austin Peay the Cordova, Tenn., native was 2-for-5 with two RBIs and three runs scored and followed that up with three hits and three runs scored on Wednesday against Belmont. In the weekend series versus WKU, the four-year starter registered eight hits in 15 at-bats (.533) with four runs scored and three RBIs. He had two hits on Friday and went 4-for-5 with one RBI and two runs scored on Saturday, tying his career-high for hits. In Sunday's finale Beachum was 2-for-5 with two RBIs and two runs scored. For the season Beachum leads the Blue Raiders with a .397 batting average and also leads the club with 10 doubles, 56 hits and 35 runs scored. He also has 21 RBIs, hitting almost exclusively from the leadoff spot, and seven stolen bases.

Kendrick Taking Advantage of Starting Role
Junior Wayne Kendrick has stepped into the second base role vacated by departed senior Eric
McNamee and picked right up where McNamee
left off, hitting for average, drawing walks and most
importantly, scoring runs for the Blue Raiders. The
Murfreesboro, Tenn., native ranks second on the
club with 33 runs scored heading into Tuesday's
contest against Vanderbilt and is tied for second on
the squad with 18 walks. His .454 on-base percentage is second-best on the team. Kendrick's
career-long 12-game hitting streak ended in
Sunday's win over Western Kentucky. During the

For the season the Riverdale HS product ranks third for the Blue Raiders in batting average (.353), hits (42) and stolen bases (5), starting all but one game at second base. Pitchers Returning/Lost7/4

Pete's Hunch Pays Off

Head coach Steve Peterson is famous for playing hunches with position players and pitchers, going with his gut feeling in certain situations. One of his hunches paid big dividends over the weekend against Western Kentucky with a decision to start Matt Campbell at first base. Campbell, a redshirt junior who had just six at-bats last season after two years of surgeries, got his first opportunity last Tuesday against Austin Peay, going 1-for-3 with a double, two walks, a run scored and three RBIs. He drew the start at first base in all three games against WKU and was 4-for-11 (.364) with three runs scored. But Campbell's biggest hit of the week-

Senior Jeff Kasser gets the start in Tuesday's contest versus Vanderbilt at home, another opportunity for the righthander to defeat the Commodores. Kasser had perhaps the best game of his Blue Raider career last year against Vandy in Nashville, working 5.2 innings and allowing three runs on eight hits with one walk and four strikeouts. Kasser helped the Blue Raiders to a 6-4 victory, backed up his longtime buddy Jeff Beachum, who had three hits and scored twice in the victory.

Edwards Gets First Win

Freshman Chad Edwards picked up his first win of the season Sunday in a victory over Western Kentucky, and the righthander worked hard to make it through the deciding inning. Edwards found himself with the bases loaded and no one out in the top of the first, but wiggled his way out of the jam with just an unearned run scoring. The Blue Raiders gave him a lead with a five-run second inning and the righthander made it stand up. The Paducah, Ky., native worked 6.0 innings, giving up three earned runs on six hits with four strikeouts. He became the first Blue Raider weekend starter to make it through five innings other than Matt Scott and only the third starting pitcher this season (Tyler Copeland) to work through the fifth.

over Western Kentucky, tossing 6.1 scoreless innings and allowing just one hit. Stanley tossed 4.2 scoreless frames on Saturday, giving up one hit, walking one and striking out three. The righthander kept WKU at bay while Middle Tennessee tried to make a comeback. Woodward struck out the final two batters of the game in Friday's 6-5 win to pick up his second save of the year. He then worked a scoreless ninth on Sunday, as well, striking out the side. For the year Woodward is 2-1 with two saves and a 3.72 ERA in a team-leading 15 appearances, striking out 31 in 19.2 innings of work. Stanley has been up-and-down all season, compiling a 2-4 mark with two saves and a 5.52 ERA in 13 appearances, striking out 29 in 31.0 innings of work.

Blue Raiders in the National Statistics

Middle Tennessee ranks in the Top 50 in five national team categories this week and has two players in the individual statistics. The Blue Raiders are 18th in the country in home runs per game (1.19) and 19th in slugging percentage (.491). The squad is also 31st in the country in triples per game (.39) and 42nd in both batting average (.314) and scoring (7.4). Individually, senior Jeff Beachum ranks 69th in batting average (.397) and 15th in toughest-to-strikeout (20.1). Junior Michael McKenry is 76th in batting average (.395), 34th in home runs per game (.29), 47th in RBIs per game (1.16), 17th in slugging percentage (.763) and 34th in walks (.81).

Notes from Western Kentucky

Friday: Matt Campbell started at first base for the first time in his career. It was also Campbell's firstever start in a Sun Belt game. He belted a solo homer to leadoff the eighth inning, his first career home run and the game-winning run in the 6-5 victory ... Adam Warren collected his third home run of the season with a three-run shot in the third ... Allan Woodward's save gives him six for his career, tying him with Steve Kline (2001-04) and Dean Hanks (1991-92) for 10th on the all-time list. Saturday: Jeff Beachum tied his career-high with four hits in the contest, his first four-hit game since May 15, 2005, at Louisiana-Lafayette and the sixth four-hit outing of his career ... Chase Eakes tied his career-high with two runs scored and two walks ... Dillon Heath drove in a career-high two runs with a pinch-hit single in the eighth ... Michael McKenry stole his second base of the season and eighth of his career.

Sunday: Freshman Chad Edwards made his fifth start of the season and his first career weekend start ... Matt Campbell extended his hitting streak to four games with a single in the second ... Jeff Beachum extended his hitting streak to nine games with a single in the second. Beachum had a pair of his in the contest, his 88th career multi-hit game in 201 career contests ... Nathan Hines recorded his first home run of the season with a three-run shot in the second inning, the fifth round-tripper of his career ... Marcus Taylor extended his hitting streak to four games with a double in the fifth ... Adam Warren's single in the eighth extended his hitting streak to seven games ... Rawley Bishop hit his first career home run, a solo shot, in the eighth ... Josh Horn tied his career-high for the fourth times this season with two walks in the game.

McKenry Named Player of the Week

Michael McKenry was voted the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week on April 10 after homering in all three games over the weekend at New Orleans. McKenry went 9-for-15 (.600) in four games, doing most of his damage over the weekend at UNO. In Tuesday's win at Lipscomb, the junior doubled, walked twice, scored a run and drove in another in a 12-7 victory. Over the weekend at UNO, the Knoxville, Tenn., native was 8-for-13 (.615) with two doubles, three home runs, six RBIs and six runs scored, posting a 1.462 slugging percentage in the series. In Friday's victory the catcher doubled, homered and had three hits, driving in three runs and scoring twice. On Saturday McKenry tied his career-high with four hits, including another double and homer, driving in two runs and scoring twice. On Sunday he played rightfield for the first time since April 10-11, 2004, at Florida International, running into the rightcenter field wall to make a catch as well as going 1-for-3 with a walk and two runs scored.

Beachum Named Player of the Week

Senior Jeff Beachum was named Sun Belt Player of the Week on March 28, Middle Tennessee's first POW honor this season. Beachum went 10-for-20 (.500) in four games, leading Middle Tennessee to a 3-1 mark and a series win over the weekend against Arkansas-Little Rock to start conference play. He had three doubles, a triple, scored four times and drove in four other runs as well as stealing a base. In Wednesday's win at Tennessee Tech the four-year starter was 2-for-5 with a run and one RBI. He was 8-for-15 (.533) in the three games against UALR, collecting multi-hits in all three outings. On Friday Beachum was 3-for-6 with a double and two RBIs and came back with a 2-for-4 effort on Saturday with a double, triple, run scored and one RBI. In Sunday's finale the shortstop had three hits, including a double, stole a base and scored twice, including the tying run in the bottom of the eighth. The honor was the third of Beachum's career (May 10, 2004; May 9, 2005) and the eighth Player of the Week honor since Middle Tennessee joined the Sun Belt in 2001.

Blue Raiders Ink Four in the Fall

Middle Tennessee signed four players to national letters-of-intent during the fall signing period in November, including three players from the state of

Tennessee — Overton HS outfielder Zach Hudson, Ravenwood HS catcher Drew Robertson, Ooltewah HS first baseman Blake McDade and St. Louis, Mo., pitcher Tyler Hyde. Hudson's Overton team reached the state finals last season, with the 6-foot-2, 215-pounder batting .354 with 13 doubles and 38 RBIs along with 11 stolen bases. Hudson played mostly rightfield last season but should see some time in centerfield this year for coach Mike Morrison. Robertson is not the prototypical Blue Raider catcher under Peterson, standing 6-foot-2 and 170 pounds. Every catcher under Peterson has been drafted at the end of their career, and Robertson should add to the program's success behind the plate. McDade was an All-District and All-Region selection last season after batting .400 with three home runs, 42 RBIs and 15 doubles at OHS. He also added six home runs and 35 RBIs to go with a .390 average as a sophomore for the Owls. The 6-foot-1, 200-pounder is breaking with family tradition after his father played football at Tennessee. Hyde will be breaking from family tradition, as well, after his father was a quarterback at Missouri in the 1980's. The Chaminade Prepatory School product struck out 33 in 43 innings of work last season, posting a 2.93 ERA with opponents batting .195.

McKenry on Wallace Watch List Junior Michael McKenry was named to the Preseason Wallace Watch List by the College Baseball Foundation in November, an award presented annually to the national college baseball player of the year. McKenry, a 5-foot-10, 195-pound catcher, batted .328 with 13 home runs and 42 RBIs in 49 games in 2005, his first as a starter behind the plate. He showed tremendous power during the season, becoming the first Blue Raider to belt a home run into the football stadium during a game since Floyd Stadium's renovation in 1998. The Knoxville, Tenn., native also scored 44 runs, had 11 doubles and walked 20 times for the 32-23 club. His most impressive statistic may have been throwing out 38 percent of attempted base stealers. The Farragut High School product is one of only six catchers among the 130 nominees for the Brooks Wallace Award, while McKenry joins P.J. Walters (P, South Alabama), Tay lor Fowler (P, Arkansas State) and Elih Villanueva (P, Florida International) as the only nominees from the Sun Belt Conference. The Wallace Watch will be trimmed to 12 semifinalists by late May. Then the selection committee will narrow the list to three finalists following the NCAA Super Regionals at a press conference in Omaha, Neb, at the College World Series. The finalists, their head coaches and their parents will be invited to Lubbock, Texas, for a schedule of special events tied to the award banquet, which will again be nationally televised by Fox Sports Network. The selection committee for the Wallace Award is comprised of a national panel of preeminent coaches, sports information directors, former winners and beat media who most closely follow the sport. Screening Committee members will evaluate the candidates and will continue their review throughout the entire baseball season. The list will expand and contract during the regular season and additional Wallace Watch candidates may be added as the season progresses. Voting for the three finalists and the Wallace Award winner will be conducted by confidential balloting with totals tabulated by the J.W.Anderson & Associates accounting firm in Lubbock, Texas. Steve Peterson

Head Coach ● Jacksonville State/1973 ● 19th Season ● 591-463-2 (.560), 744-557-2 (.571) overall



There are many adjectives to describe the job Steve Peterson has done as Middle Tennessee's highly successful baseball coach since 1988. Coach, fundraiser, teacher, recruiter and architect are just a few, but if you are looking for one word to sum his contributions as the Blue Raiders' long-

time skipper, try winner.

Peterson begins his 19th season heading the Blue Raider program as the school's all-time winningest coach with 574 victories and a stockpile of conference championships and NCAA Tournament berths to his credit, demonstrating the consistency with which the driven skipper has quided the club.

Middle Tennessee has been a model program on Peterson's watch and the proof is in the success the Blue Raiders have achieved. The veteran coach has led Middle Tennessee to 10 regular-season conference championships, eight conference tournament titles and seven NCAA Regional berths, including two at-large selections in the past five years. Peterson guided the Blue Raiders to seven consecutive championships – either regular-season or tournament – during one stretch, proving Middle Tennessee doesn't rebuild. it reloads.

Peterson, who enters the 2006 season with a sterling 574-449-2 mark, has produced 11 seasons with 30 or more wins, including a school-record 42 victories in 1990. He also has three campaigns of at least 40 wins, including 2004's 40-22 club.

The constant manner in which Middle Tennessee has enjoyed success during Peterson's tenure is a direct reflection on recruiting and developing talent, and the proof was never more evident than in 2001 – the Blue Raiders' first season as a member of the Sun Belt Conference after years of success in the Ohio Valley.

Asked how the move into the Sun Belt, rated one of the nation's Top 5 baseball leagues at the time and consistently a Top 10 conference, would change his recruiting philosophy, Peterson quickly responded, "none at all." The 2001 Blue Raiders then went out and shared the Sun Belt championship with South Alabama during their first year in the high-profile league and the majority of the chief contributors were the same performers who led Middle Tennessee to the 2000 Ohio Valley Conference championship.

The move to a higher-rated conference has not hurt Middle Tennessee's status. If anything, it has helped. In their first five years in the Sun Belt, Peterson's teams have won two regular-season championships, a tournament championship and earned three NCAA Regional berths, including two at-large selections for the first time in school history. The 2001 squad earned national acclaim for its pitching and hitting and the season concluded with pitcher Dewon Brazelton being selected as the No. 3 overall pick of the Tampa Bay Devil Rays in the Major League Baseball First-Year Amateur Player Draft. Brazelton was one of six players from the team to earn a spot on a professional baseball roster that season.

A program cannot enjoy consistent success without quality players and Peterson, a three-time Coach of the Year, has not only made a habit of making sure Middle Tennessee has its share of quality performers, but he's won by constantly signing prep players and developing them at the college level. The proof is in the fact Peterson has coached a Sun Belt Player of the Year and six OVC Players of the Year, a Sun Belt Pitcher of the Year and an OVC Pitcher of the Year, a First-Team All-American, five Third-Team All-Americans, four Freshman All-Americans, and 38 first-team All-Conference performers.

Players who have honed their skills under Peterson also have had an outstanding rate of continuing their careers at the professional level. Professional baseball has seen 47 former Peterson performers earning the chance to play at the game's highest level, with four making their way to the Major Leagues.

If that's not enough, Peterson's recruits have established most of the offensive records held at Middle Tennessee and four players he has developed have hit .400 or better in a season, along with the school's single-season and career home run record holders. His 1997 squad established the all-time record for batting average with a .323 clip.

Peterson's players not only have been solid on the field at the collegiate level and continued their careers professionally, but a large majority have taken the skills and fundamentals learned at Middle Tennessee and are earning a living as coaches at various levels. Thirty-four former Blue Raiders are currently coaching at the high school, college or professional levels.

Peterson's peers have recognized his achievements and contributions to the game by bestowing several honors on him. He was named the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association College Coach of the Year in 1992 and again in 2000. He was also inducted into the Rutherford County Old Timers Baseball Hall of Fame in 2003. Fellow coaches have named Peterson Coach of the Year on three occasions – twice in the Ohio Valley and again in 2004, his first such honor in the Sun Belt.

Peterson's outgoing and personable style has made him a hit with fans, boosters, players and recruits, alike. Baseball enthusiasts throughout the Middle Tennessee community clearly appreciate his hard-nosed and aggressive style of play, as fans continue to flock to Reese Smith Field at a record pace. The Blue Raiders established a single-game attendance record in 2001 at Reese Smith Field with a crowd of 2,733 against South Alabama. The team went on to set the single-season attendance mark with 26,218 coming through the gates at Reese Smith Field. The 2001 squad saw 15 crowds of 1,000 or more during the season. Those numbers were surpassed in 2004 when the team set a single-game attendance record of 3,020 against Vanderbilt, as well as setting a new single-season attendance mark of 30,319, ranking 46th nationally in attendance for the season. Fifteen contests drew more than 1,000 patrons during the record-setting campaign.

Not only has Peterson been a winner on the field, but he's been a successful fundraiser during his career as well. Events such as the annual Chuck Taylor Golf Tournament, the Groundhog Day Luncheon and the Grand Slam Fish Fry in the fall have become mainstays on calendars of Blue Raider baseball supporters across middle Tennessee and have served to raise thousands of dollars for the improvement of Blue Raider baseball.

Peterson spearheaded the efforts to pay for the construction of the Stephen B. Smith Clubhouse and Indoor Training Facility, which opened its doors in 1998. One look inside the facility shows the time and effort spent toward this endeavor. It has become known as one of the finest collegiate clubhouses and training facilities in the country.

Reese Smith Field also has benefited from Peterson's fundraising abilities. He has helped transform the park into a fan-friendly area by expanding the seating area, putting up a new information center just inside the gate, and expanding the restroom and concession facilities.

Peterson guided efforts during the summer of 2001 to expand the dugouts at Reese Smith Field. He also is currently spearheading an effort that would totally renovate the stadium. The plans would call for a significant remodeling of the concession stand, improved and expanded restroom facilities and a modern press box that would accommodate radio and television, along with print media.

While Peterson has spent 18 seasons leading the Middle Tennessee baseball program, his tenure with the program is much longer. He took two separate tours with the Blue Raiders as an assistant coach under John Stanford prior to becoming the team's head coach. During his runs between 1976-78 and 1985-87, the Blue Raiders won two OVC titles and four southern division crowns.

During the interim, Peterson served as the head coach at Roane State Community College in Harriman, Tenn. During his tenure from 1979-84, Peterson's teams won a Tennessee state title in 1981 and he was twice named TJCAA Coach of the Year (1981, '84). While at Roane State, Peterson put together a sparkling record of 153-96, a .614 winning percentage.

A native of Huntsville, Ala., Peterson stood out as a catcher under the legendary Rudy Abbott at Jacksonville State. He earned his bachelor's from Jacksonville State in 1983 and later earned a master's from Middle Tennessee in 1977

Peterson is married to the former Rita Albert and the couple has three children, Jill, Jenny and John, and one grandchild, Hayden Wright. Away from the diamond, Peterson enjoys fishing for smallmouth bass.
