Quick Hitters: Middle Tennessee is opening the season with a conference game for the first time since 1998 when the Blue Raiders defeated Tennessee State, 28-27 ... This marks just the second time in the I-A era the Blue Raiders have started a season at home (2003) ... FIU defensive coordinator Kevin Fouquier was the defensive line coach for Middle Tennessee last year ... MT is just 2-3 in Sun Belt Conference openers and has lost two in a row (last league opening victory came against New Mexico State in 2003) ... Rick Stockstill can become the eighth coach, and the first since 1970, to win his opening game with a victory over FIU (the Blue Raiders have had 15 total coaches) ... MT is beginning its 92nd season of football and just its eighth as a I-A member ... Blue Raiders have 2-2 mark all-time in Thursday games ... Clint Marks needs four more completions to tie Kelly Holcomb for second place on the all-time list.

SERIES RECORD

■ Thursday's football game between Middle Tennessee and Florida International will be just the second meeting between the two schools on the gridiron. FIU defeated the Blue Raiders in the final game of 2005, 35-31, in Miami.

SEASON OPENERS

■ Middle Tennessee has an overall mark of 55-32-2 in season-opening games and has won 17 of its last 25. The Blue Raiders have won their season-opening game just twice since elevating to the I-A level. MT defeated SEC member Vanderbilt in 2001 on the road and then upset Akron on the road in 2004. This marks the first time Middle Tennessee has started a season at home since 2003.

SEASON OPENERS AT HOME

■ The MT-FIU season opener marks just the second time the Blue Raiders have started a season at home in the I-A era. The only other time MT opened at home during this time came in 2003 against FAU. Overall, the Blue Raiders are 33-5-1 since 1913 when they open the season at home and have won six of the last seven.

BLUE RAIDERS IN SBC

■ Middle Tennessee has an overall mark of 18-16 in Sun Belt action all-time, including a 12-6 mark at home and a 6-10 record on the road. The 18-16 mark equals the second most wins in league history behind North Texas'

BLUE RAIDERS ON THURSDAYS

■ The Middle Tennessee-Florida International game will mark the Blue Raiders' fourth Thursday night game in the modern era and their first since the 2003 season. Overall, Middle Tennessee is 2-2 in Thursday night tilts. The Blue Raiders have picked up wins over Arkansas State (2003), Vanderbilt (2001), and UT-Martin (1991), while the two setbacks have come against FAU (2003) and Georgia Southern (1989). This will mark just the second home Thursday night game since 1991 for the Blue Raiders (FAU in 2003 was most recent).

FRANKLIN, SABB, SMITH ALL-SBC

■ Three Middle Tennessee football players were honored as preseason first team All-Sun Belt selections as announced by the league office at its annual Football Media Days earlier this summer. Offensive lineman Germayle Franklin, linebacker J.K. Sabb, and punter Colby Smith were all voted to the first team by the league's eight head coaches and selected media members.

FIRST GAME FOR STOCK, STAFF

■ The season opener against FIU is not only the start of the 2006 campaign, but it marks the first game for new Head Coach Rick Stockstill and his staff. The FIU contest will be the first game for Stockstill as a collegiate head coach.

COACHING DEBUTS

■ Since starting football in 1911, Middle Tennessee has had 15 total head coaches and only seven have won their opening games. E.W. Midget, Charles Murphy, Bill Peck, Johnny Floyd, Frank Faulkinberry, and Alfred Miles are the only Blue Raider head coaches to win their first games at the helm. New coach Rick Stockstill can be the eighth with a win over FIU and the first at Middle Tennessee since Peck and the Blue Raiders defeated UT-Martin at home in 1970.

BLUE RAIDERS ON TV

■ Middle Tennessee is scheduled to play a school record eight games on television in 2006, including two

2006 Rule Changes

- 1. Eye Shields: Only clear shields are allowed
- **2. Kicking Tee:** Tee height has been lessened from two inches to one inch.
- **3. Halftime:** Shall be 20 minutes but home team may lengthen or shorten the 20 minutes by previous agreement
- **4. When Clock Starts:** When the ball is free-kicked, the game clock will be started and subsequently stopped when the ball is dead by rule. When Team B is awarded a first down, the clock will be stopped and will start on the ready for play signal.
- **5. Opportunity to score:** If a TD is scored during a down in which time in the fourth period expires, the try shall not be attempted unless the point would affect the outcome of the game.
- **6. Instant Replay:** Any member institution may use instant replay. The rule is permissive, not a requirement. If used, it must be in full compliance with rule.

SABB ON BUTKUS WATCH LIST

■ The Downtown Athletic Club of Orlando announced its preliminary list of candidates for the prestigious Butkus Award to honor the nation's top linebacker and Middle Tennessee's **J.K. Sabb** made the list of 65. The award will be trimmed to 10 semi-finalists on Oct. 19 with the winner being named on Dec. 9. Sabb joins FIU's Keyonvis Bouie and North Texas' Phillip Graves as the only Sun Belt Conference players on the list.

WHAT'S NEW IN 2006

■ Not only is this a new season and a new beginning, but there are a number of other new things surrounding the Blue Raider football program in 2006. Along with a new head coach and coaching staff, the Blue Raiders will be playing on a new surface in Floyd Stadium and will be wearing new Nike uniforms.

RECEIVING THREAT

■ One of the most versatile players in the Sun Belt Conference, running back Eugene Gross is the complete offensive package. In 2005, Gross led the Blue Raiders in rushing (724 yards), paced all Sun Belt backs in receptions with 33, and led the league in scoring (84 points). The Statesboro, Ga., native ranks among the career leaders in rushing attempts, rushing touchdowns, and scoring, and is the all-time leader at Middle Tennessee in receptions by a running back with 82 catches. Gross needs just 17 receptions this season to move into the all-time Top 10 list at MT.

MARKS MAKES HISTORY

■ In a less than spectacular year for the Middle Tennessee offense, quarterback Clint Marks still found a way into the record books in 2005. The Fort Myers, Fla., native became the first signal-caller in school history to record back-to-back 2,000-yard passing seasons when he attained the mark in the final game of the year. After throwing for a school record 2,749 yards in 2004, Marks came back to pass for 2,083 yards in 2005.

SABB LEADS DEFENSE

■ Transfer J.K. Sabb made an immediate impact in his first year at linebacker for the Blue Raiders in 2005. The Augusta, Ga., native led Middle Tennessee in tackles with 71 total stops and had a team-best 13 tackles for loss. The 13 TFLs tied Kenny McDaniel for the eighth most in a single-season at Middle Tennessee. In his best game of the

MARKS CHASING COUNTS

■ Quarterback Clint Marks enters his senior season within striking distance of becoming the school's all-time leading passer. The southpaw has 5,425 career passing yards, which is 2,583 yards shy of breaking Wes Counts' record mark of 8,007. Mark's best year was 2004 when he threw for 2,749 yards. The Fort Myers, Fla., native enters the 2006 season ranked third all-time behind Counts and Kelly Holcomb (7,064).

SOLID YEAR FOR DEFENSE

■ After struggling most of the I-A era on the defensive side of the ball, Middle Tennessee found the right formula for stopping opponents in 2005. The Blue Raiders led the Sun Belt Conference in virtually every defensive statistical category while ranking among the top 35 nationally all year in total defense and in the top 20 in scoring defense. Middle Tennessee allowed just 333.5 yards a game and 18.7 points per contest.

CHICOLA FINISHES STRONG

■ Junior tight end Stephen Chicola enjoyed his best year as a collegian in 2005 and was particulary productive down the stretch for the Blue Raiders. Chicola ended the year with a career-best 29 receptions for 231 yards and a touchdown but had 21 of his catches during the last four games of the year. The 29 grabs were the most in a season by a tight end since Steve Dark had 36 in 1991. The Jacksonville, Fla., native had a career game at Troy when he hauled in

a personal-best nine receptions for a career-high 86 yards to record the most receptions in a game in school history by a tight end.

GROSS 4TH IN TOUCHDOWNS

■ Eugene Gross scored two rushing touchdowns against Troy at the end of the year to run his career total to 30. The senior is in fourth place on the all-time rushing touchdowns list and needs eight more to tie Kippy Bayless for third place.

MORE ON GROSS

■ Eugene Gross, who has had a knack for finding the endzone during his career, led the Sun Belt Conference in scoring with 84 points and tied for seventh on Middle Tennessee's top 10 single-season scoring list. For his career, Gross has 186 points to rank ninth on the all-time scoring list. Gross needs six more points to overtake Bobby Young for eighth place.

GOING OVERTIME

■ Middle Tennessee enters the FIU game having competed in four overtime games as a member of I-A and is 2-2 in those contests. The Blue Raiders had one overtime contest in 2000 and played three in 2003. In 2003, the Blue Raiders lost in one overtime at No. 23 Missouri, then bounced back to take an overtime win at Idaho before losing a four overtime game at home against Louisiana-Lafayette. The four overtime loss to the Ragin' Cajuns was the longest game in the history of Blue Raider football and was the longest in the history of the SBC.
