Series History

- Middle Tennessee is one of two SBC teams to have four straight winning seasons. WKU is the other.
- Middle Tennessee ranks first in the Sun Belt in scoring defense (64.1).
- Of the nine players who have seen action this season. seven are either freshmen or sophomores.
- Kyle Young ranks second in the SBC in field goal percentage with a 61.5 mark (48-of-78).
- Sophomore point guard Kevin Kanaskie is No. 14 nationally in assists with 5.8 per game, which is second in the SBC. He has led the Blue Raiders in assists in all 14 games.
- Sophomore guard Nigel Johnson leads the SBC in free-throw percentage at 86 percent (30-35).

Closer look at Troy

Troy is 6-9 overall, 1-3 in the SBC East, following a heart-breaking 82-78 overtime loss at Western Kentucky Wednesday. The Trojans have lost their three SBC contests by a combined 11 points. Troy features six players in double figures, led by O'Darien Bassett's 17.8 points per game, while Richard Chaney contributes 15.2. As a team Troy is averaging 75.4 points per game and shooting 42 percent from the field. The Trojans average 27 3-point attempts per game and are shooting 34 percent beyond the arc. Troy is seeking its first road win of the season and is 0-7 on the road during the 2006-07 campaign.

Winning with consistency

Middle Tennessee is one of only two current Sun Belt Conference members to enjoy winning seasons in each of the last four seasons. The only other school to do so is Western Kentucky. The Blue Raiders are also one of just two current conference members to go .500 or better in SBC play in each of the last four years with Western Kentucky being the other.

Blue Raiders enjoy SBC success under Davis

After struggling in their first two years as a member of the Sun Belt the Blue Raiders have found success in the league under fifth-year Head Coach Kermit Davis. In fact, Middle Tennessee has the third-best winning percentage (56 percent) and third-most wins among current SBC members since the start of the 2002-03 season - Davis' first leading the Blue Raiders. Western Kentucky (51) and Louisiana-Lafayette (49) are the only two SBC members with more league wins than Middle Tennessee during this stretch. Middle Tennessee earned its 38th SBC win under Davis against South Alabama (01/02/07). Prior to Davis' hiring, Middle Tennessee had seven SBC wins in the two previous seasons combined.

Blue Raiders among SBC's best winning away from home

One of the biggest reasons for Middle Tennessee's turnaround in the Sun Belt has been its ability to win on the road. Prior to Kermit Davis' hiring in 2002, Middle Tennessee was 2-17 on the road in SBC games but the Blue Raiders are tied for the most road wins of any SBC member during his four-plus seasons leading the program. The Blue Raiders are also just one of three league teams with winning road records since 2002-03 with Louisiana-Lafayette and Western Kentucky being the other two.

Youth is being served at Middle Tennessee

Middle Tennessee's future is extremely bright considering seven of the nine players who have seen action are either freshmen or sohomores; however, the present is in good shape, as well, considering the youthful Blue Raiders are 2-2 in SBC play and contending for a fifth-straight winning season. The Blue Raiders are the youngest team in the SBC with Louisiana-Lafayette next with five freshmen and one sophomore. The Ragin's Cajuns start two freshmen, two juniors, and one senior, while the Blue Raiders open with three sophomores, one freshman, and a senior. Middle Tennessee's two leading scorers are a sophomore (Kevin Kanaskie, 11.5 ppg) and a freshman (Desmond Yates, 10.6 ppg). Additionally, sophomores Calvin O'Neil, Nigel Johnson and Theryn Hudson have seen action in every game, as has freshman Darren Avery. Another freshman, Dino Hair, has played in 10 of 14 games. The seven underclassmen are responsible for 70 percent of the scoring, 66 percent of the rebounding, and 73 percent of the team's minutes so far this season.

Vogelsberg will redshirt in 2006-07

Senior guard Adam Vogelsberg will take a redshirt season in 2006-07 and return to the squad for the 2007-08 season, Head Coach Kermit Davis has announced. Vogelsberg has been out of action since suffering a broken bone in his right foot in preseason practice the week of the opener. He made his first appearance of the season against Western Kentucky Thursday (12/28/06) and played three minutes late in the second half before returning to the bench. Davis said Vogelsberg will go back into a cast for three weeks and confirmed he would use his redshirt season this year following the game. Dec. 28 was the target date for Vogelsberg's return but the healing process has been slow seven weeks into the rehabilitation. Vogelsberg was an All-SBC performer last season and was a preseason all-league pick this year. He was Middle Tennessee's leading scorer in 2005-06 and ended the season in the Top 10 of four Middle Tennessee single-season lists.

Kermit Davis File



In his fifth season at Middle Tennessee, Kermit Davis has established himself as one of the most successful men's basketball coaches in program history, and he's done so while rebuilding a program that had fallen on hard times. Prior to Davis'

hiring in April, 2002, Middle Tennessee had endured losing seasons in three of the four previous years - and was one season removed from a 5-22 campaign, the worst in school history. The Blue Raiders have registered four straight winning seasons under Davis, making him only one of two of the 19 Middle Tennessee men's basketball coaches to start his Blue Raider career with four straight winning campaigns. The other was Bruce Stewart. The Blue Raiders' game against Indiana State (11/30/06) was Davis' 125th at Middle Tennessee. Davis' record after 125 games at Middle Tennessee was 71-54, making him the second-winningest coach in program history after 125 games. Davis is fifth on the all-time Middle Tennessee wins list with 74.

Davis among leaders

Kermit Davis joined Bruce Stewart as the only head coaches in program history to begin their Blue Raider careers with four straight winning seasons in 2005-06. Davis moved into sixth on the all-time wins list at Middle Tennessee with 62 after the Blue Raiders beat Louisiana-Lafayette (01/28/06). He moved past Ed Diddle, Jr., (56) for seventh on the list with Middle Tennessee's 87-75 win at Belmont (12/10/05). Davis moved into fifth on the career wins list against Tennessee State (12/04/06) with 72 career victories. He is four wins shy of tying Charles Greer for fourth on the all-time Blue Raider list. Jimmy Earle is the program's all-time winningest coach with 164 wins. Davis also is third in winning percentage (.558) among Blue Raider men's basketball coaches with a minimum of 50 games coached, trailing only Jimmy Earle (.614), and Bruce Stewart (.648).

Davis produces second-best wins mark after 125 games

Kermit Davis earned a win in his 125th game leading the Blue Raider program to give him a 71-54 mark. That record is the second-most wins for a Blue Raider coach in his first 125 games. Bruce Stewart won 83 of the first 125 games he coached at Middle Tennessee to top the list, while Jimmy Earle's 69 wins after 125 games is third most.

Keep the travel bags packed

Basketball players across the nation generally do not get lengthy breaks during the holidays and the situation is holding true for Middle Tennessee players during this break. The Blue Raiders are in the midst of playing four games during a 12-day span, including three of those on the road. Middle Tennessee is in a stretch where it plays seven of 10 games away from home, which includes three of the next four. The Blue Raiders will make stops in Miami, Mobile, Ala., Boca Raton, Fla., and New Orleans, during this stretch. Middle Tennessee also faces the prospect of playing four of its next six conference games on the road.

Kanaskie emerging as team MVP

Kevin Kanaskie has been solid running the point for Middle Tennessee through the first 14 games of the season; however, his all-around play has made the sophomore the team's most valuable player and a serious all-league consieration at the outset of the 2006-07 campaign. Kanaskie leads the Blue Raiders with 11.5 points per game and his 17 steals are tied for the team lead. Factor in his 5.8 assists per game - which has him ranked No. 14 nationally - and Kanaskie is responsible for 323 of Middle Tennessee's 60.9 points per game - which is 38 percent of the team's offense. His nine double-figure scoring games this season are the most by a Blue Raider. He keyed Middle Tennessee's win against Indiana State by scoring 15 of his 17 points in the second half while establishing career highs for points (17), field goals made (6), and 3-point field goals made (3), and he tallied a career-high eight assists in the win against Tennessee State. Kanaskie established a new career high for points with 20 against Louisiana-Monroe, and followed that with 17 against Austin Peay and established a new career high for 3-point field goals made with four. He has enjoyed a career-high eight assists three different times this season.

Five straight winning seasons would be rare

Middle Tennessee is looking to accomplish a rather feat as it seeks a fifth consecutive winning season under Head Coach Kermit Davis in 2006-07. The Blue Raiders' current streak of four consecutive winning seasons is tied for fourth longest in the program's 84 years of men's basketball. The longest stretch of consecutive winning seasons is six, which was turned in by Jimmy Earle's teams from 1973-79. The current Blue Raiders are attempting to match Bruce Stewart's teams from 1984-89 for the second longest streak of consecutive winning seasons with five. The only other stretch of at least four consecutive seasons with winning records was 1922-26, and the Blue Raiders only played four games during the 1924-25 season. The 2006-07 Blue Raiders are attempting to accomplish five straight winning seasons for the first time since 1984-89 — a span of 22 years. Davis, in his fifth season, is one of only two coaches in program history to begin his career with four straight winning seasons. The other was Bruce Stewart.

Blue Raiders get defensive

Middle Tennessee has held six of its 14 opponents to 58 points or less this season and the team is 6-0 in those games, and the Blue Raiders lead the SBC in scoring defense at 64.1 points per game. The Blue Raiders are also third in the SBC in field goal percentage defense (.427). Middle Tennessee put together one of its finest defensive displays of the season on its first SBC road trip of the season at Florida International and South Alabama. The Blue Raiders held FIU to 46 points which were the second fewest under Head Coach Kermit Davis against a SBC member and the fewest since a 60-42 win against the Golden Panthers, March 1, 2004 - a span of 75 games. FIU managed just 13 field goals and its 24.5 shooting percentage (13-53) was the lowest against the Blue Raiders in a SBC contest. Middle Tennessee followed that performance by limiting defending SBC champion South Alabama to 51 points - its second lowest scoring output of the season. South Alabama's talented guard tandem was a combined 5-of-21 for 10 points against the Blue Raider defense and no member of the trio tallied double figures. The Blue Raiders allowed an average of 48.5 points to the two opponents.

Coach speaks, players respond

Kermit Davis said he had been disappointed and "alarmed" at Middle Tennessee's rebounding following the Western Kentucky game and said the "problem" would be addressed. Seems the vetern coach was able to get his point across quickly as the Blue Raiders racked up a resounding 83 rebounds on their recent SBC road trip to Florida International and South Alabama. Middle Tennessee grabbed a season-high 40 rebounds at Florida International to win the battle of the boards and followed that performance with a 43-rebound effort at South Alabama. More impressive than the 43 rebounds is the manner in which the Blue Raiders dominated the boards - 43-22. Middle Tennessee allowed just six offensive rebounds in the South Alabama game, leading to a mere two second-chance points. Middle Tennessee is 6-2 this season when it outrebounds the opposition and it is 58-23 under Davis when controlling the boards.

Yates growing up quickly

Middle Tennessee freshman Desmond Yates is making a nice transition into Division I basketball after sitting out the 2005-06 season. Yates is averaging 10.6 points per game, which is second on the squad, and he is shooting 53 percent from the field, which is fifth in the SBC. Over the last five games, Yates is averaging a team-best 11.2 points, 3.0 rebounds, and shooting 57 percent (24-42) from the field. His play on the recent SBC road swing to Florida International and South Alabama keyed two Blue Raider triumphs. Yates averaged 12.5 points, 4.5 rebounds and shot 63 percent from the field in the two games. The Somerville, Tenn., native poured in a personal-best 23 points against Belmont. He has scored double figures in eight of his last nine contests and he has led the Blue Raiders in scoring four times this season.



Who says nothing is free?

If you are in several close games - and Middle Tennessee qualifies since nine of its 14 contests have been decided by nine points or less - then you definitely want clutch free throw shooters at the line. The Blue Raiders top two guards - Kevin Kanaskie and Nigel Johnson - have been clutch at the line this season. Johnson leads the SBC in free-throw percentage with a 85.7 (30-35) clip, while Kanaskie is sixth in the league in that category with a 80 percent (48-60) showing. The duo is even more impressive in SBC contests. Kanaskie is 19-of-19 from the line in SBC contests, which is first in SBC games only. The sophomore point guard has hit 21 attempts in succession. Johnson is shooting 88 percent (15-17) from the charity stripe in league games only, which is fourth among league members in SBC games only. As a team, Middle Tennessee is shooting 68 percent (166-244) from the line in all games; however, the Blue Raiders are shooting 83 percent (54-65) from the stripe in league games only, which is tops among SBC members.

3-point streak intact but ...

Middle Tennessee has hit at least one 3-pointer in 319 consecutive games but the long streak has been in danger three times this season. The Blue Raiders managed just two treys against Tennessee and they had just one against Memphis. Darren Avery's 3-pointer midway through the second half kept the streak intact. The Blue Raiders were 0-of-4 from 3-point range in the first half against Western Kentucky and finally nailed a long-range shot midway through the second half before finishing with two. The most 3-pointers Middle Tennessee has hit in a game this season is eight and they have hit five or fewer in 13 of the 14 contests. The last time the Blue Raiders failed to hit a shot beyond the 3-point arc was Jan. 20, 1996 at Morehead State.

Offense a work in progress

Middle Tennessee Head Coach Kermit Davis stresses defense and the message is more important than ever so far this season. The Blue Raiders have yet to reach 70 points in 14 games this season which is the longest stretch they have gone under Davis without topping the 70-point mark. The loss of leading scorer Adam Vogelsberg and a limited Tim Blue (offseason knee surgery) have impacted the squad's lack of scoring punch and has created a slim margin of error. Middle Tennessee has been held to 60 points or less six times and it has been limited to 65 points or less in 11 of 14 games. The offensive woes have been felt hardest on the perimeter as Middle Tennessee is shooting 31 percent (56-180) from 3-point range.

Outshooting foes has been key once again

Outshooting the opposition does not guarantee victory for Middle Tennessee but it is a trend that comes as close to perfection as any under fifth-year coach Kermit Davis. The Blue Raiders are 6-1 this season and 61-4 overall under Davis when the shooting percentage is higher. Middle Tennessee had won 29 straight when outshooting the opposition before suffering a 75-69 overtime setback to Toledo earlier this season despite shooting 58 percent from the field. Overall, Middle Tennessee has won 34 of the last 36 games played when it has a higher shooting percentage than the opposition.

Blue registers first double double of season

Senior forward Tim Blue became the first Blue Raider to record a double double this season with 14 points and a game-high 11 rebounds in Middle Tennessee's 65-58 win against Indiana State. It marked the first double double for a Blue Raider since Blue accomplished the feat with 20 points and 11 rebounds against South Dakota State (02/13/06). The 11 rebounds tie a career high.

Blue returning to form following surgery

Tim Blue showed signs of promise for the future with his strong play at the end of the 2005-06 season his first as a Blue Raider; however, the senior forward suffered an off-season knee injury and required surgery. The lingering effects of the surgery slowed Blue at the outset of the 2006-07 season but the Palm Beach, Fla., native seems to be finding his rhythm and returning to form. In his last five games, Blue is averaging 9.2 points and 5.8 rebounds, while shooting 49 percent from the field. The greatest indicator of Blue getting closer to 100 percent is his minutes played. He is averaging 29 minutes in the last five contests and had his second-highest scoring output of the season with 15 against Western Kentucky.

Playing from the inside out

Middle Tennessee has featured a balanced offensive attack under Head Coach Kermit Davis but with senior guard Adam Vogelsberg out with an injury and a young corps of perimeter players still becoming acclimated to Division I basketball the Blue Raiders have enjoyed their greatest success going inside at the start of the 2006-07 season. They are averaging 20.6 points per game inside the paint, which is 34 percent of the team's 852 points scored. The Blue Raiders have scored 22 points or more inside the paint in eight games, including 42 against Toledo.. Coincidentally, the Blue Raiders are shooting less 3-pointers thus far in 2006 as they are averaging 13 attempts per game as a team. By comparison, the Blue Raiders averaged right at 20 treys per game in 2005-06. They have hit more than five treys as a team just once in a game to this point. Vogelsberg's worth to the team is evidenced by the fact he hit five or more 3-pointers in a game seven times last season and had four or more in a game 13 times. The Blue Raiders are averaging just four 3-point field goals per game as a team.

Shooting touch nothing new for Young

Kyle Young, who tied the Paradise Jam record for shooting percentage in three games (72.7 percent), is second in the Sun Belt in field goal percentage through 14 games with a 61.5 percentage (41-of-66). Young entered the 2006-07 season fifth on the career field goal percentage list at Middle Tennessee with a mark of 56.8 and has seen that rise to 57.6 percent (265-of-460), which is currently third on the career list at Middle Tennessee. Young shot 65.2 percent from the field in 2005-06, which was third on the single-season list at Middle Tennessee. The only player in school history ever to shoot higher than Young in a single season is Warren Kidd. The career mark for field goal percentage is held by Kidd, who shot 66.4 percent.

Young ties record in 'Paradise'

Middle Tennessee senior forward Kyle Young proved to be one of the most accurate shooters ever to play in the Paradise Jam Tournament during the team's stay at St. Thomas, Virgin Islands. Young was 16-of-22 from the field for a 72.7 field-goal percentage, which equaled the Paradise Jam Tournament record for best field-goal percentage by an individual in a minimum of three games. Young tied the mark set by Eastern Kentucky's Alonzo Hird (16-of-22) during the 2005 event. Young was 4-of-5 from the field against then No. 10 Alabama, 5-of-7 against Toledo, and 7-of-10 against College of Charleston.

Young has been constant for Blue Raiders

Kyle Young has been a fixture in the Middle Tennessee lineup throughout his Blue Raider career and his consistency and durability have him on the verge of the program's career Top 10 list for games played and games started. Young has played in 101 career games, which is six shy of LeRoy Coleman (1976-80), who is 10th on the list with 107. Young has started 75 games and is one start shy of tying former standout Ty Baynham (1985-88) for 10th on the career list in that category.

Young blocking opponents' path

With one block against Belmont, Kyle Young has four on the season and 48 for his career, which is seventh on the career list. Mantia Callender is sixth with 49. Young is two blocked shots shy of becoming just the sixth player in the Blue Raiders' 84-year history to register 50 or more blocks in a career.

Blue Raiders sign four during early period

Middle Tennessee Head Coach Kermit Davis announced the signing of four players during the NCAA Early Signing Period in November. The four signees include Antwaun Boyd, 6-2 guard at Anderson High School in Anderson, Ind.; Broderick Gilchrist, 6-0 guard at Hamilton High in Memphis, Tenn.; Keith Dodd, 6-9 foward at Bradley Central in Cleveland, Tenn.; and Uriah Hethington, a 6-8 foward at Okaloosa-Walton Junior College. The Blue Raiders also have guard Demetrius Green sitting out the 2006-07 season. Middle Tennessee expects to sign one more player to this class.




