Tournament History

Middle Tennessee is 5-6 in the SBC Championship games since joining the league for the 2000-01 season, including a 4-4 mark under fifth-year Head Coach Kermit Davis. The Blue Raiders have reached the semifinals twice (2003, 2004) and the championship once (2003) under Davis. In SBC Championships, Middle Tennessee is 2-2 in the first round, 2-2 in the quarterfinal round, 1-1 in the semifinals, and 0-1 in the championship.

Noteworthy

● The game at Troy marks the first time Middle Tennessee has been on the road for a tournament contest since 2000 when it won at Tennessee Tech, 87-70.

● Middle Tennessee is 8-2 in its last 10 conference tournament openers, including a 3-1 mark under Kermit Davis.

● Point guard Kevin Kanaskie was named to the All-Sun Belt Conference third team in a vote of league coaches and media.

● Of the nine players who have seen action this season, seven are either freshmen or sophomores.

● Middle Tennessee leads the Sun Belt in scoring defense (64.0) and is third in the conference in field goal percentage defense (.425).

● Sophomore point guard Kevin Kanaskie is No. 11 nationally in assists with 6.1 per game.

Closer look at Troy series

Troy and Middle Tennessee are playing for the third time this season and the second time in one week. The Blue Raiders lost a 73-70 decision at Troy last Thursday (2/22/07) after a furious second-half comeback fell just short. The Trojans swept the regular-season series having won the earlier meeting in Murfreesboro and they have won three straight overall against the Blue Raiders since joining the Sun Belt Conference last season. Troy leads the all-time series, 3-2. Wednesday's contest is the first between the teams in the postseason. The teams ended the regular season in a three-way tie, along with UALR, for eighth with Troy winning the tie-breaker and earning the No. 8 seed. The Blue Raiders are the No. 9 seed.

Kanaskie named All-Sun Belt

Middle Tennessee sophomore guard Kevin Kanaskie was named to the All-Sun Belt Conference team, earning a spot on the third team in a vote of league coaches and media, the league announced Tuesday. Kanaskie was one of 10 guards, including five on the third team, to earn a spot on the 15-member squad in a season when the SBC was perceived to be guard heavy. Kanaskie leads Middle Tennessee in scoring (12.3) and his 6.1 assist average not only leads the SBC, but also is 10th nationally. Kanaskie became the first Blue Raider in program history to register double-figure assists three times in the same season (13, 12, 11) and he is currently the only player in school history to lead his team in scoring, 3-point shooting, assists and steals in the same season. Kanskie's 178 assists are fifth on the single-season list. He has scored double figures in 19 games this season and has lead the team in scoring 13 times, as well as leading it in assists in 23 games. **(Complete All-SBC team on page nine of these notes).**

Middle Tennessee's all-time tournament play

Middle Tennessee is 28-30 all-time in conference tournament postseason action. This mark includes a 5-6 record in the Sun Belt and a 23-24 ledger in the Ohio Valley Conference.

Middle Tennessee vs. the field

Middle Tennessee is 3-6 against teams in hits half of the SBC Championship bracket. The Blue Raiders are 1-0 against Denver and Louisiana-Lafayette, and 1-1 against No. 1 overall seed South Alabama. They are 0-2 against Troy and Louisiana-Monroe, and 0-1 against North Texas.

New tournament format for SBC

The Sun Belt Conference announced a new format for its postseason tournament beginning in 2007. Beginning this season each division winner received a bye into the conference tournament, along with the team with the next best conference record regardless of division. The first round of the tournament will be played at campus sites with the higher seed hosting the lower seed (seeds 4-through-8 will host first-round games). The winners of the five on-campus games will advance to join the top three seeds in Lafayette, La., where the quarterfinals, semifinals and finals will be held.

Kanaskie in class by self

At the end of the regular season point guard Kevin Kanaskie is doing something no Blue Raider has in the 84-year history of the program. Entering the SBC Tournament Kanaskie is the only player to lead his team in scoring (12.3), 3-pointers (63), assists (178), and steals (30) in the same season. He moved into seventh on the single-season 3-point field goals made list with one against Florida Atlantic - his 63rd of the season. Kanaskie has hit at least one 3-pointer in 17 straight and 28 of the 29 games played. The only contest in which he failed to connect from beyond the arc was at Memphis.

Requested Blue Raider basketball players will be made available for postgame interviews in the media room at all home games following a 10-minute cooling off period. Head Coach Kermit Davis will conduct his postgame radio show at press row and then he will be brought to the media room.

Blue Raiders enjoy SBC success under Davis

After struggling in their first two years as a member of the Sun Belt the Blue Raiders have found success in the league under fifth-year Head Coach Kermit Davis. In fact, Middle Tennessee has the fourth-best winning percentage (54 percent) and has the fourth-most wins among current SBC members since the start of the 2002-03 season - Davis' first leading the Blue Raiders. Western Kentucky (59), Louisiana-Lafayette (56), and South Alabama (47) are the only SBC members with more league wins than Middle Tennessee during this stretch. Middle Tennessee earned its 45th SBC win under Davis against Florida Atlantic (02/24/07). Prior to Davis' hiring, Middle Tennessee had seven SBC wins in the two previous seasons combined.

Blue Raiders among SBC's best winning away from home

One of the biggest reasons for Middle Tennessee's turn-around in the Sun Belt has been its ability to win on the road. Prior to Kermit Davis' hiring in 2002, Middle Tennessee was 2-17 on the road in SBC games but the Blue Raiders have 20 SBC road wins since - tied with South Alabama for the most road wins of any SBC member during his four-plus seasons leading the program. Middle Tennessee, South Alabama, and Western Kentucky are the only Sun Belt Conference teams with winning road records since the start of the 2002-03 season.

In his fifth season at Middle Tennessee, Kermit Davis has established himself as one of the most successful men's basketball coaches in program history, and he's done so while rebuilding a program that had fallen on hard times. Prior to Davis' hiring in April, 2002, Middle Tennessee had endured losing seasons in three of the four previous years - and was one season removed from a 5-22 campaign, the worst in school history. The Blue Raiders have registered four straight winning seasons under Davis, making him only one of two of the 19 Middle Tennessee men's basketball coaches to start his Blue Raider career with four straight winning campaigns. The other was Bruce Stewart. The Blue Raiders' game against Indiana State (11/30/06) was Davis' 125th at Middle Tennessee. Davis' record after 125 games at Middle Tennessee was 71-54, making him the second-winningest coach in program history after 125 games. Davis is fourth on the all-time Middle Tennessee wins list with 81.

Davis among leaders

Kermit Davis joined Bruce Stewart as the only head coaches in program history to begin their Blue Raider careers with four straight winning seasons in 2005-06. Davis moved into fourth on the Blue Raider career wins list with his 77th victory at UALR (01/20/07). He currently has 81 career victories and is three wins shy of tying Randy Wiel (84) for third on the all-time Blue Raider list. Jimmy Earle is the program's all-time winningest coach with 164 wins. Davis also is third in winning percentage (.551) among Blue Raider men's basketball coaches with a minimum of 50 games coached, trailing only Jimmy Earle (.614), and Bruce Stewart (.648).

Davis produces second-best wins mark after 125 games

Kermit Davis earned a win in his 125th game leading the Blue Raider program to give him a 71-54 mark. That record is the second-most wins for a Blue Raider coach in his first 125 games. Bruce Stewart won 83 of the first 125 games he coached at Middle Tennessee to top the list, while Jimmy Earle's 69 wins after 125 games is third most.

Davis notches 215th win

Kermit Davis secured his 215th win as a head coach against Louisiana-Lafayette (01/27/07). With three wins since, he presently has 218 career wins. He owns 152 wins in nine years at the Division I level and 66 in three years in junior college.

O'Neil coming on strong

Sophomore guard Calvin O'Neil had one of his best career games against Florida Atlantic with a team-high 15 points in the regular-season finale (02/24/07). O'Neil also had a career-high six field goals made on 6-of-9 shooting, dished out five assists and had no turnovers. The 15 points were the second-highest scoring output of his career and just two points shy of his career high of 17. His two steals also tied a season high and were one shy of his career high. The five assists are the second most in his career. O'Neil has 11 assists and one turnover in his last two games vs. Troy and vs. Florida Atlantic.

Johnson on upswing

Sophomore guard Nigel Johnson helped spark Middle Tennessee to its highest-scoring output of the season with his second straight double-figure scoring game against Florida Atlantic in the regular-season finale. Johnson scored 11 points on 3-of-4 shooting from the field - all 3-pointers - to give him double figure scoring games in succession for the first time as a Blue Raider. He scored 10 at Troy last Thursday. The three 3-pointers are also a career high for Johnson.

Blue finishing strong

Senior Tim Blue is putting together his best stretch of the season at the most important time. He has scored double figures in three of the last four games, including 14 against Florida Atlantic in the regular-season finale, and he has pulled seven or more rebounds in three of the last four games. Over the last five games Blue is averaging 10.6 points and 6.2 rebounds while shooting 60 percent (22-of-37) from the field.

Kanaskie joins elite company

Sophomore point guard Kevin Kanaskie became the only player in school history to produce three double-figure assist games in the same season with 11 against Florida Atlantic in the regular-season finale, while committing no turnovers. Kanaskie, who is No. 10 nationally in assists per game (6.1), also had 12 in an earlier game at Florida Atlantic and a career-high 13 against Louisiana-Lafayette. He has an eye-popping 7.2-to-1 assist-to-turnover ration in those three games with 36 assists and just five turnovers. They are also three of the top 11 assist games in school history.

Kanaskie climbing Blue Raider charts

Kevin Kanaskie's ability to get players involved and put them good scoring opportunities has him putting up record numbers on a team that doesn't produce gaudy offensive numbers. He had a career-high 13 assists against Louisiana-Lafayette. Kanaskie has 178 for the season and 252 in his career. He is fifth on the single season and the 252 career assists are ninth on the all-time list. Kanaskie's current 6.1 assists per game average is third on the single-season list and is the highest single-season average since Gerald Harris averaged 6.7 in 1988-89. Kanaskie's 13-assist performance against the Ragin' Cajuns were seventh most in a single game and the most by a Blue Raider since Greg Christian handed out 14 against Kennesaw State in 1990. Kanaskie assisted on 13 of Middle Tennessee's 25 field goals against Louisiana-Lafayette and he's assisted 26 percent of the team's field goals this season.

Kanaskie responsible for 40 percent of offense

Kevin Kanaskie may not be confused as a one-man wrecking crew; however, the sophomore's numbers indicate he is as valuable to Middle Tennessee as any single player is to his team in the Sun Belt. Kanaskie leads the team in scoring at 12.3 points per game and when you factor in his 6.1 assists per game (considering each assist is worth at least two points) he is generating 40 percent of the Blue Raiders' offense. All told Kanaskie has scored 358 points and his assists have led to a minimum of 354 points for a total of 712 of Middle Tennessee's 1,808 points this season or 24.5 points per game. The Blue Raiders average 62.3 points per contest.

Kanaskie also scoring option for Blue Raiders

Sophomore point guard Kevin Kanaskie turned in his second double double of the season against Louisiana-Lafayette with a game-high 18 points and a career-high 13 assists against just two turnovers. Kanaskie recorded his first career double double 17 days earlier when he scored 19 points and added 12 assists against Florida Atlantic (01/10/07). Kanaskie has scored double figures in 19 of 29 games this season and he has led the Blue Raiders in scoring 12 times. He is the only player to start in every game and he is tied for third in the SBC for minutes played at 36.6 per game. He has made 40 consecutive starts dating to last season, the longest such streak on the team.



Kanaskie puts on shooting clinic at Troy

Sophomore point guard Kevin Kanaskie has enjoyed a solid season for Middle Tennessee but he turned in his best offensive performance of the season at Troy Thursday (02/22/07). Kanaskie scored a career-high 26 points and also established career highs for field goals made (10) and attempted (20), while tying his career marks for 3-point field goals made (5) and attempted (11). He was 8-of-12 in the second half when he scored 21 of his 26 points. The five 3-pointers against Troy give Kanaskie 62 for the season, which moves him into a tie for seventh on the single-season list in that category. He needs eight more treys to move into 10th on the career 3-point field goals made list. The 26-point performance against Troy was the most by a Blue Raider this season and the highest output since Mike Dean scored 30 against Arkansas State on Jan. 15, 2004. Kanaskie, who is 11th nationally in assists per game, also dished out five helpers and is averaging 6.0 for the season, which is third on the single-season list.

Frosh making solid impact for Blue Raiders

Middle Tennessee freshman guard/forward Desmond Yates has proven to be an impact player during his rookie year in the Sun Belt Conference. Yates, who is averaging 11.1 ppg., is second among SBC freshmen in scoring. He is averaging 11.9 points in league games. Yates has turned in 18 double figure scoring games this season and he has led the Blue Raiders in scoring nine times. He ranks fifth in the SBC in field goal percentage (130-243, 53.5). Yates has scored double figures in 17 of the team's last 24 games and he is averaging 10.4 points and 3.7 rebounds over the last 10 games. Yates has scored 21 or more in a game four times this season, including his career high of 23 twice (vs. Belmont and Arkansas State).

Youth being served at Middle Tennessee

Middle Tennessee features the youngest team in the Sun Belt in terms of game experience. The Blue Raiders have started two freshmen and three sophomores, while bringing another freshman and sophomore off the bench. Louisiana-Lafayette is the next youngest team in the SBC with five freshmen and one sophomore. Middle Tennessee's two leading scorers are a sophomore (Kevin Kanaskie, 12.3 ppg), and a freshman (Desmond Yates, 11.1). Additionally, sophomores Calvin O'Neil, Nigel Johnson and Theryn Hudson have seen action in every game, while freshman Darren Avery has played in 28 of 29, earning eight starts. Another freshman, Dino Hair, has played in 23 games and he has earned one start. In all, Middle Tennessee's three freshmen have combined for 26 starts. The seven underclassmen are responsible for 73 percent of the scoring, 67 percent of the rebounding, and 74 percent of the team's minutes so far this season.

Blue Raiders getting it done on the road

Middle Tennessee set the school record for consecutive conference road wins with its sixth straight in a 61-60 win at UALR (01/20/07). Interestingly, the win streak began at UALR last February. The Blue Raiders, who have won seven of their last 11 SBC road games dating to last season, broke the previous school record of five consecutive road wins by the 1974-75 squad. The Blue Raiders saw the SBC road streak end in a 66-53 loss at North Texas (01/25/07). Middle Tennessee is 5-4 on the road in SBC contests this season and is just one of three league teams with a winning road record in conference play.

Winningest January since 1998

Middle Tennessee concluded the month of January with consecutive wins against Louisiana-Lafayette and South Dakota State to complete a 6-3 month. The six wins represent the most in January since the 1998 Blue Raiders won nine games in the first month of the year. Middle Tennessee is 24-19 in January in Davis' five seasons.

80 Key Number

Middle Tennessee has been almost unbeatable when scoring 80 or more points under Head Coach Kermit Davis. Overall, the Blue Raiders are 17-1 when scoring 80 or more under Davis. The lone setback was an 85-83 overtime loss at Western Kentucky, Feb. 24, 2005.

Shooting touch nothing new for Young

Kyle Young, who tied the Paradise Jam record for shooting percentage in three games (72.7 percent), is second in the Sun Belt in field goal percentage through 29 games with a 59.3 percentage (96-of-162). Young entered the 2006-07 season fifth on the career field goal percentage list at Middle Tennessee with a mark of 56.8 and has seen that rise to 57.5 percent (313-of-544), which is currently third on the career list at Middle Tennessee. Young shot 65.2 percent from the field in 2005-06, which was third on the single-season list at Middle Tennessee. The only players in school history ever to shoot higher than Young in a single season are Warren Kidd, who shot 70 percent from the field in 1990-91, and 66.4 in 1991-92, and Bob Martin, who shot 57.4 from the field in 1976-78.

Young ties record in 'Paradise'

Middle Tennessee senior forward Kyle Young proved to be one of the most accurate shooters ever to play in the Paradise Jam Tournament during the team's stay at St. Thomas, Virgin Islands. Young was 16-of-22 from the field for a 72.7 field-goal percentage, which equaled the Paradise Jam Tournament record for best field-goal percentage by an individual in a minimum of three games. Young tied the mark set by Eastern Kentucky's Alonzo Hird (16-of-22) during the 2005 event. Young was 4-of-5 from the field against then No. 10 Alabama, 5-of-7 against Toledo, and 7-of-10 against College of Charleston.

Young has been constant for Blue Raiders

Kyle Young has been a fixture in the Middle Tennessee lineup throughout his Blue Raider career and his consistency and durability have placed him on the program's career Top 10 list for games played and games started. Young has played in 116 career games, which is third on the all-time list. Young's 87 career starts are seventh on the all-time list.

Young blocking opponents' path

With one block against Louisiana-Monroe, Kyle Young has 14 on the season and 58 for his career - fourth on the career list. Young is the sixth player in the Blue Raiders' 84-year history to register 50 or more career blocks.

Outshooting foes has been key once again

Outshooting the opposition does not guarantee victory for Middle Tennessee but it is a trend that comes as close to perfection as any under fifth-year coach Kermit Davis. The Blue Raiders are 12-5 this season and 68-7 overall under Davis when the shooting percentage is higher. Middle Tennessee had won 29 straight when outshooting the opposition before suffering a 75-69 overtime setback to Toledo earlier this season despite shooting 58 percent from the field. Overall, Middle Tennessee has won 41 of the last 46 games played when it has a higher shooting percentage than the opposition. The Blue Raiders, on the other hand, are 0-10 this season when the opponent has a higher shooting percentage.

Blue Raiders get defensive

Middle Tennessee has held 11 of its 29 opponents to 59 points or less this season and the team is 10-1 in those games. The Blue Raiders lead the SBC in scoring defense at 64.0 points per game. The Blue Raiders are third in the SBC in field goal percentage defense (.425). Middle Tennessee put together one of its finest defensive displays of the season on its first SBC road trip of the season at Florida International and South Alabama. The Blue Raiders held FIU to 46 points which were the second fewest under Head Coach Kermit Davis against a SBC member and the fewest since a 60-42 win against the Golden Panthers, March 1, 2004 - a span of 75 games. FIU managed just 13 field goals and its 24.5 shooting percentage (13-53) was the lowest against the Blue Raiders in a SBC contest. Middle Tennessee followed that performance by limiting defending SBC champion South Alabama to 51 points - its second lowest scoring output of the season.

Second-half vs. Denver a defensive dandy

Middle Tennessee tightened the clamps on Denver in the second half of its 75-49 win against the Pioneers (02/01/07). After allowing 32 first-half points, the Blue Raiders gave up just 17 points in the second half, limiting the Pioneers to just four field goals and an 18.2 percent showing from the field over the game's final 20 minutes. The four second-half field goals were the fewest allowed in a half by Middle Tennessee this season and it marked the fourth time the Blue Raiders have held an opponent to single digit field goals in the second half this season. They are 4-0 in those games. Denver's 32.6 showing from the field is the second lowest against the Blue Raiders this season.

Unselfish play sparks top output

Middle Tennessee scored a season-high 19 points against Florida Atlantic in the regular-season finale and a key was the unselfish play exhibited by the guards. The Blue Raiders had a season-high 21 assists on their 29 field goals made and the starting trio of guards (Kevin Kanaskie, Nigel Johnson, and Calvin O'Neil) combined for 19 of them with just one turnover. The trio also combined for 33 points in the win.

Vogelsberg will redshirt in 2006-07

Senior guard Adam Vogelsberg will take a redshirt season in 2006-07 and return to the squad for the 2007-08 season.. Vogelsberg has been out of action since suffering a broken bone in his right foot in preseason practice the week of the opener. He made his first appearance of the season against Western Kentucky Thursday (12/28/06) and played three minutes late in the second half before returning to the bench. After spending an additional three weeks in a cast, Vogelsberg has returned to practice. Vogelsberg was an All-SBC performer last season and a preseason all-league pick this year. He was the team's leading scorer in 2005-06 and ended the season in the Top 10 of four Middle Tennessee single-season lists.

Did you know?

Middle Tennessee has hit at least one 3-pointer in 334 consecutive games. The last time the Blue Raiders failed to hit a shot from beyond the arc was Jan. 20, 1996 at Morehead State.

Getting everyone involved

Middle Tennessee has shared the ball well all season; however, with point guard Kevin Kanaskie dishing a career-high 13 assists against Louisiana-Lafayette the Blue Raiders finished with a season-high 18 helpers on 25 field goals for a percentage of .720. Middle Tennessee's 11 first-half field goals were accompanied by 10 assists.

Blue Raiders sign four during early period

Kermit Davis announced the signing of four players during the NCAA Early Signing Period in November. The four signees include Antwaun Boyd, 6-2 guard at Anderson High School in Anderson, Ind.; Broderick Gilchrist, 6-0 guard at Hamilton High in Memphis, Tenn.; Keith Dodd, 6-9 forward at Bradley Central in Cleveland, Tenn.; and Uriah Hethington, a 6-8 forward at Okaloosa-Walton Junior College. The Blue Raiders also have guard Demetrius Green sitting out the 2006-07 season.

Johnson ties Paradise Jam steals record

Middle Tennessee sophomore guard Nigel Johnson tied a Paradise Jam single-game record when he recorded five steals against Toledo (11/18/06). The five steals equals the mark shared by Jonathan Modica (Arkansas), Jason McLeish (Eastern Kentucky), and Michael Ross (Eastern Michigan). The five steals are the most in a game by a Blue Raider since Bryan Smithson swiped five against Austin Peay (12/23/03).

Holy Toledo!!! Blue Raiders light it up vs. Rockets

Middle Tennessee had one of the best shooting performances for a half in school history in its game against Toledo in the second game of the Paradise Jam Tournament. The Blue Raiders blistered the nets for a 72.7 percent shooting clip (16-22) in the first half. The mark is the third-best in school history for a half and it marked the best first-half shooting performance in school history. Middle Tennessee finished the game shooting 58.3 percent (28-48).

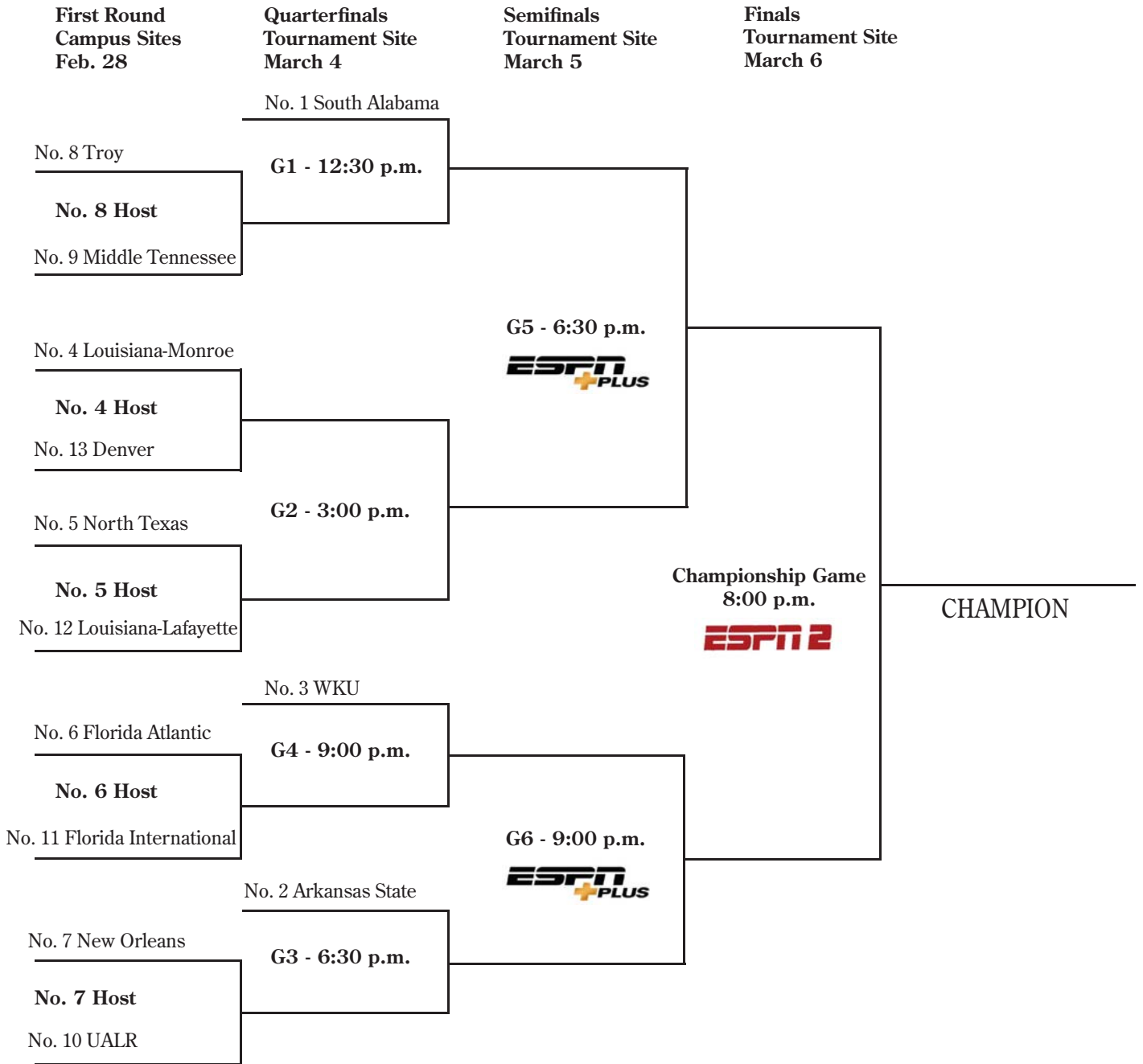

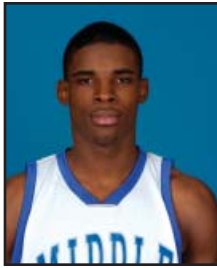
