BLUE RAIDERS MAKE HISTORY: Middle Tennessee held off a seventh inning rally by No. 15 Louisiana-Lafayette (21-6, 1-2 SBC) to defeat the Ragin Cajuns, 4-3, and take the first Sun Belt series of the season. It marks the first time in Sun Belt Conference play that the Ragin Cajuns have dropped a series to a league member. The Blue Raiders lost the opening game of the series, 4-1, but bounced back to take the last two games. The club took the nightcap of the doubleheader, 5-3, to set up the series win the following day.

PITCHING PROWESS: Middle Tennessee sophomore Sam Floyd also made history, as she became the first pitcher in Blue Raider history to earn a win over Louisiana-Lafayette. She allowed just three hits and struck out three. Freshman Lindsey Vander Lugt was involved in both wins against the Ragin Cajuns. In the first game, the lefty hurler tossed three innings of scoreless ball to pick up the first save of her career. In the single game on Thursday, Vander Lugt pitched her 10th complete game of the season to earn the second win of the series over Louisiana-Lafayette. She allowed three runs on eight hits and struck out four.

The Record: Troy holds a slight edge over the Blue Raiders, the Trojans are 20-13 against Middle Tennessee.

Last Game: Middle Tennessee became the first league school in Sun Belt Conference play to take a series from Louisiana-Lafayette. The Blue Raiders won the last two games to take the series.

LONG BALL WINS IT: In both wins against Louisiana-Lafayette it was a homerun that helped secure the win for the Blue Raiders. The long ball proved to be Middle Tennessee's closest friend in the series with Louisiana-Lafayette and it was crucial in the game on Thursday. Ashley Cline's sent one out as her homer over the left field wall gave her a round trip and also plated Davis for the second and third runs of the fourth inning. In the win on Thursday, it was a three-run homer by Katie Mielke to help secure the win.

HIGHEST RANKED WIN: Middle Tennessee's pair of wins over No. 15 Louisiana-Lafayette was just the second ranked opponent the Blue Raiders have defeated in school history and the highest as well. In 2001, Middle Tennessee defeated No. 25 Texas A&M. The Blue Raiders are now 2-4 against Top-25 opponents this season.

VANDER LUGT HONORED BY SBC: Middle Tennessee softball player Lindsey Vander Lugt has been named Sun Belt Pitcher of the Week. It is first time in four years the Blue Raiders have had Sun Belt Pitcher of the Week and it took a freshman to lead the team to the honor. The lefty hurler Vander Lugt showed flashes of future dominance at the 2007 Georgia Tech Buzz Classic and was rewarded with a spot on the Buzz Classic All-Tournament team. Vander Lugt was the winning pitcher of record in all three of Middle Tennessee's victories at the Georgia Tech Buzz Classic. She ended the tournament with a 2.51 ERA making five appearances, in six games, starting four games, tossing four complete games and recording two shutouts. She tossed 30.2 innings surrendering just one walk, and just six total in 89.2 innings pitched, and recorded 27 strikeouts. She tossed a shutout against Wright State to start the tournament allowing just two hits and striking out two. In her second win of the tournament, Vander Lugt tossed nine innings, in the extra inning affair against Purdue, recording a season-high nine strikeouts and allowing eight hits and three earned runs. Against Morehead State, Vander Lugt had a perfect game for five and two-thirds innings before surrendering the lone hit in the game. She retired 17 consecutive Morehead State batters before allowing the hit. It was her second shutout of the tournament and she also struck out six batters.

THEY LIKE TO STEAL: The Blue Raiders currently have 47 stolen bases as a team in 24 games played, averaging 1.95 steals per game. In the Buzz Classic last weekend, the Blue Raiders had 16 stolen bases.

MEMORABLE MEETING WITH TROY: Middle Tennessee took the series from Troy, at home, in the regular season last season but Troy returned the favor in the Sun Belt Tournament. The Trojans defeated the Blue Raiders twice to knock Middle Tennessee out of the tournament. The most memorable recent meeting between the two schools was the 13- inning marathon the clubs played in the second game of the doubleheader. With the score tied at six, Katie Mielke hit a frozen rope to center field to score Melissa Weiland and Muriel Ledbetter for the win. Sam Floyd came into the game in the fourth inning, as a relief pitcher, and ended up tossing the final 10 innings.

STEAL LEADERS: Junior Ashley Cline and senior Shelby Stiner led the club in stolen bases as Cline had five Stiner had four at the Buzz Classic. Cline has 14 stolen bases in 23 games played and needs just four to take over sixth place from teammate Stiner. Cline is just nine stolen bases away from taking over second place for stolen bases in a season. She also leads the Sun Belt Conference. Stiner has 25 stolen bases for her career and needs just 15 to reach the top-five in career stolen bases.

BRACKET PLAY: Middle Tennessee made bracket play in all four tournaments the club competed in this season.

HOMERUN WATCH: Two Blue Raiders are chasing the Middle Tennessee homerun record. Seniors Melissa Weiland and Muriel Ledbetter are

each eyeing the long ball crown this season. The record is 23 homeruns for a career set by Laura Brockman. Currently, Ledbetter is in the lead with 17 homeruns. Weiland is a close second with 16. Last season, Ledbetter broke the school record for homeruns in a season with 11 in 2006.

UP NEXT: Middle Tennessee continues its seven game home stand by heading out of confernece play to host Jacksonville State March 14.
