Notes: Middle Tennessee continues a five-game homestand with its SBC home opener after splitting its mid-week series with Southern Illinois ... The Blue Raiders and Ragin' Cajuns have played 26 times since Middle Tennessee joined the SBC in 2001. The series is tied, 13-13 ... Adam Warren leads the Blue Raiders with a .443 batting average and sports a seven-game hit streak ... Rawley Bishop has hit five of his team-leading six home runs at Reese Smith Field ... The Blue Raiders have just five errors combined in their eight wins this season.

These teams have history

Middle Tennessee is in its seventh season as a member of the Sun Belt Conference but it already has developed a strong rivalry with league perennial power Louisiana-Lafayette. The Blue Raiders and Ragin' Cajuns have split the 26 games played since Middle Tennessee joined the league in 2001 but the manner in which the teams split the contests has added to the series. The Ragin' Cajuns have dominated the regular-season contests, taking 12 of the 18 contests; however, Middle Tennessee is 7-1 against Louisiana-Lafayette in the SBC Championships, including eliminating Louisiana-Lafayette from the tournament in each of the last four seasons.

At the Reese in the SBC

Middle Tennessee is 41-34 in Sun Belt Conference games at Reese Smith Field since joining the league in 2001. The Blue Raiders, who open the SBC home portion of their slate this weekend against Louisiana-Lafayette, have won seven or more SBC home games in four of the previous six seasons. Middle Tennessee is 2-7 against Louisiana-Lafayette at Reese Smith Field in three SBC weekend series.

Kendrick key to Blue Raider success

Middle infielder Wayne Kendrick is a cog in the Blue Raider offense but there's no doubting his value to the team's success, particularly at the start of the 2007 season. In Middle Tennessee's eight wins, Kendrick is hitting .545 (18-for-33) with 11 runs scored and a 61 percent on-base showing; however, in the team's 10 losses, Kendrick is hitting .244 with seven runs scored.

Love playing at Reese Smith

Rawley Bishop, Wayne Kendrick, and Adam Warren are the only three Blue Raiders to start in all 10 home games heading into this weekend's

series against Louisiana-Lafayette, and it's easy to see why Head Coach Steve Peterson enjoys penciling the trio of players into the everyday lineup. Bishop, Kendrick, and Warren have combined to hit .412 (40-for-97) with 27 runs scored, nine home run, 30 RBI, 71 total bases, and 5-for-5 in stolen base attempts. They are also perfect in the field.

Smalley Better than Record Shows

Sophomore righthander Brett Smalley has posted a 1-3 record with a 3.43 ERA in four starts this season, but his record does not indicate just how well he has pitched. Smalley suffered two straight losses to start the year, losing 3-1 in both games, at Samford on February 21 and again on February 28 at Lipscomb. Smalley allowed three runs on five hits in 4.1 innings at Samford and then battled his way through 5.1 innings at Lipscomb, giving up just two runs despite allowing nine hits. The Hixson, Tenn., native got off the schneid last Wednesday with five solid innings at Belmont, allowing one run on six hits to pick up his first victory of the season. Smalley made his 11th career start in 17 appearances last Tuesday against Southern Illinois and against pitched in tough luck. He allowed two earned runs in five innings of work but was saddled with the loss. He will get the Sunday start against the Ragin' Cajuns.

Mr. Robinson's neighborhood

Junior Brad Robinson, a former Oakland standout, will make his first home start against Louisiana-Lafayette Saturday. Robinson is 1-0 with a 2.21 ERA and earned a no decision in his first SBC start at Troy (3/10/07). He has made six appearances this season but his four relief appearances to start the season earned him starts in the last two outings.

Barrett Has Big Week

Junior newcomer Zach Barrett was named the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week this week after another sterling weekend. Barrett won the starting job at third base heading into the season and has been one of the team's most consistent performers. Barrett has played well at third base and enjoyed his best offensive output in Middle Tennessee's four games last week. Barrett batted .588 (10-for-17) in the four contests against Belmont and Troy, as the Blue Raiders won 3-of-4, including a series victory at Troy to open conference play. Barrett scored four runs and drove in seven, collecting three doubles, two walks and three stolen bases. The Evansville, Ind., native was 4-for-5 with two doubles and five RBIs in Wednesday's victory at Belmont. He then had six hits in 12 at-bats in three games at Troy, collecting a pair of hits in each game against the Trojans. Barrett scored twice and drove in a run in the opening 13-4 victory on Friday against Troy and doubled, scored once and drove in a run in Sunday's series clincher. He has hit safely in the

last five games as well. For the season Barrett is batting .333, third best on the club, with nine RBIs and eight runs scored in 15 games, including 14 starts for the Blue Raiders.

Reilley Continues to Pitch Well

Senior Brett Reilley has been Middle Tennessee's best reliever thus far this season and had a big hand in the Blue Raiders' last four wins. Opponents batted just .136 against Reilley, who walked two and struck out five in the four outings, all wins. The righthander tossed one shutout inning on Wednesday against Belmont and then 2.2 scoreless innings at Troy on Friday in Middle Tennessee's 13-4 victory. On Sunday Reilley came back with 2.2 innings again, allowing one run on three hits with three strikeouts. He pitched 1.1 innings of scoreless relief in Wednesday's win

against Southern Illinois. For the year Reilley is 2-0 with a 2.08 ERA in eight appearances, tossing 17.1 innings with 15 strikeouts. Opponents are batting just .16 against the senior.

Youth is Served

After the loss of four seniors and one junior from last year's starting lineup, Middle Tennessee head coach Steve Peterson had several holes to fill heading into 2007. Because of several factors, including injuries and continued good play, Peterson has two true freshmen and at least one redshirt freshman in the lineup every-day and there have been days with even more. Freshman Blake McDade got a chance to start opening weekend in rightfield and has been one of the team's most consistent players, batting .313 with 14 starts, including five doubles, two

home runs and 16 RBIs, tied for the team lead. Freshman Drew Robertson had to step in behind the plate and has been more than steady, starting 14 games, collecting three doubles with five RBIs and four runs scored. He has also thrown out 4-of-9 attempted base stealers. Several other freshmen have seen extended playing time, including redshirt freshmen Myles Ervin and Justin Jones, along with freshman Zach Hudson. Ervin has started nine games, scoring six runs and driving in two more, mostly as the designated hitter but also with two starts in leftfield. Jones has started six times this year, including three games over the weekend at Troy, batting .286 with three doubles, a home run and seven RBIs as well as five runs scored. Hudson has scored four runs in eight games and has one RBI.

Injuries Taking Their Toll

Middle Tennessee has been hit hard by injuries already this season and including the end of the 2006 season. Senior hurler Langdon Stanley missed the second half of the 2006 campaign and will not be available to pitch this year until sometime in April. Junior outfielder Nathan Hines, sophomore pitcher Chad Edwards and junior catcher Alex Watson were all lost for the season in February, while Hines and Edwards have both already undergone season-ending surgery. The injuries continued to rack up this past weekend at Troy, with senior shortstop Matt Ray dislocating his left shoulder diving for a ball on Saturday. Then on Sunday, freshman Matt Yurus suffered an injury in the first inning after making a pitch to the plate. Ray and Yurus will both be re-evaluated this week before the extent of their injuries can be determined.

Steve Peterson

Head Coach • Jacksonville State/1973 • 20th Season • 612-484-2 (.557), 765-578-2 (.569) overall



There are many adjectives to describe the job Steve Peterson has done as Middle Tennessee's highly successful baseball coach since 1988. Coach, fundraiser, teacher, recruiter, and architect are just a few, but if you are looking for one word to sum his contributions as the Blue Raiders'

longtime skipper, try "winner."

Peterson was inducted into the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame in January 2007. He begins his 20th Blue Raider season as the school's all-time winningest coach, with 604 victories and a stockpile of conference championships and NCAA Tournament berths to his credit, demonstrating the consistency with which the driven skipper has guided the club.

Peterson's drive for excellence has resulted in consistent success and has made Middle Tennessee a model program. The veteran coach has led Middle Tennessee to 10 regular-season conference championships, eight conference tournament titles, and seven NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections in the past five years. Peterson guided the Blue Raiders to seven consecutive championships – either regular-season or tournament – during one stretch, proving Middle Tennessee doesn't rebuild, it reloads.

Peterson, who enters the 2007 season with a sterling 604-474-2 mark, has produced 12 seasons with 30 or more wins including a school-record 42 victories in 1990. He also has three campaigns of at least 40 wins including 2004's 40-22 record.

Consistent success during Peterson's tenure is a testament to his ability to recruit and develop talent, and the proof was never more evident than in 2001 – the Blue Raiders' first season in the Sun Belt Conference after years of success in the Ohio Valley.

Asked how the move into the Sun Belt, rated one of the nation's top five baseball leagues at the time and consistently a top 10 conference, would change his recruiting philosophy, Peterson quickly responded, "not at all." The 2001 Blue Raiders shared the Sun Belt championship with South Alabama after their first year in the high-profile league, and the chief contributors were many of the same players who led Middle Tennessee to the 2000 OVC championship.

The move to a higher-rated conference certainly helped Middle Tennessee's status. In their first five years in the Sun Belt, Peterson's teams have won two regular-season championships and a tournament championship and earned three NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections for the first time in school history. The 2001 squad earned national acclaim for its pitching and hitting and the season concluded with pitcher Dewon Brazelton being selected as the No. 3 overall pick of the Tampa Bay Devil Rays in the Major League Baseball First-Year Amateur Player Draft. Brazelton was one of six players from the team to earn a spot on a professional baseball roster that season.

A program cannot enjoy consistent success without quality players and Peterson, a three-time Coach of the Year, has not only made a habit of making sure Middle

Tennessee has its share of quality performers but he's also won by constantly signing prep players and developing them at the college level. He has coached a Sun Belt Player of the Year and six OVC Players of the Year, a Sun Belt Pitcher of the Year and an OVC Pitcher of the Year, two First-Team All-Americans, five Third-Team All-Americans, four Freshman All-Americans, and 43 first-team All-Conference performers.

Players who have honed their skills under Peterson also have had outstanding success continuing their careers at the professional level. Professional baseball has seen 55 former Peterson performers earning the chance to play at the game's highest level, with four making their way to the Major Leagues.

If that's not enough, Peterson's recruits have established most of the offensive records held at Middle Tennessee and four players he has developed have hit .400 or better in a season, along with the school's single-season and career home run record holders. His 1997 squad established the all-time record for batting average with a .323 clip.

Peterson's players have been solid on the field at the collegiate level and continued their careers professionally, and a large majority have taken skills and fundamentals learned at Middle Tennessee and are earning a living as coaches at various levels. Thirty-four former Blue Raiders are currently coaching at the high school, college, or professional levels.

Peterson's peers have recognized his achievements and contributions to the game by bestowing several honors on him. He was named the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association College Coach of the Year in 1992 and again in 2000. He was also inducted into the Rutherford County Old Timers Baseball Hall of Fame in 2003. Fellow coaches have named Peterson Coach of the Year on three occasions – twice in the Ohio Valley and again in 2004, his first such honor in the Sun Belt.

Peterson's outgoing and personable style has made him a hit with fans, boosters, players, and recruits alike. Baseball enthusiasts throughout the Middle Tennessee community clearly appreciate his hard-nosed and aggressive style of coaching, and as fans continue to flock to Reese Smith Field at a record pace. The Blue Raiders established a single-game attendance record in 2001 at Reese Smith Field with a crowd of 2,733 against South Alabama. The team went on to set the single-season attendance mark that year with 26,218 coming through the gates. The 2001 squad saw 15 crowds of 1,000 or more during the season. Those numbers were surpassed in 2004 when the team set a single-game attendance record of 3,020 against Vanderbilt, and set a new single-season attendance mark of 30,319, ranking 46th nationally. Fifteen contests drew more than 1,000 patrons during the record-setting campaign.

Not only has Peterson been a winner on the field but he's also been a successful fundraiser during his career. Events such as the annual Chuck Taylor Golf Tournament, the Groundhog Day Luncheon, and the Grand Slam Fish Fry in the fall have become mainstays on calendars of Blue Raider baseball supporters across middle Tennessee and have raised thousands of dollars for the improvement of Blue Raider baseball.

Peterson spearheaded the efforts to pay for the con-

struction of the Stephen B. Smith Clubhouse and Indoor Training Facility, which opened its doors in 1998. One look inside the facility shows the time and effort spent toward this endeavor. It has become known as one of the finest collegiate clubhouses and training facilities in the country.

Reese Smith Field also has benefited from Peterson's fundraising abilities. He has helped transform the park into a fan-friendly area by leading efforts to expand the seating area, add an information center just inside the gate, and improve restroom and concession facilities.

Peterson guided efforts during the summer of 2001 to enlarge the dugouts at Reese Smith Field. He is also spearheading an effort that will totally renovate the stadium beginning in June 2007. The plans call for a significant remodeling of the concession stand, improved and expanded restroom facilities, and a modern press box to accommodate radio, television, and print media.

While Peterson has spent 19 seasons leading the Middle Tennessee baseball program, his tenure with the program is much longer. He took two separate tours with the Blue Raiders as an assistant coach under John Stanford before becoming the team's head coach. During 1976-78 and 1985-87, he helped the Blue Raiders win two OVC titles and four southern division crowns.

During the interim, Peterson served as head coach at Roane State Community College in Harriman, Tenn. During his tenure from 1979-84, Peterson's teams won a Tennessee state title in 1981, and he was twice named TJCAA Coach of the Year (1981, '84). While at Roane State, Peterson put together a sparkling record of 153-96 for a .614 winning percentage.

A native of Huntsville, Ala., Peterson stood out as a catcher under the legendary Rudy Abbott at Jacksonville State. He earned his bachelor's from Jacksonville State in 1983 and later earned a master's from Middle Tennessee in 1977.

Peterson is married to the former Rita Albert and the couple has three children, Jill, Jenny, and John, and two grandchildren. Away from the diamond, Peterson enjoys fishing for smallmouth bass.
