Notes: Middle Tennessee ends a five-game road swing with a three-game conference series against Arkansas State in Jonesboro. The Blue Raiders have won 2-of-3 games in all three previous SBC series in Jonesboro against ASU ... Sophomore Rawley Bishop has a career-best 11-game hitting streak heading into Friday's opener, while senior Matt Campbell has hit in eight straight ... Middle Tennessee returns home next week, playing five of six contests at Reese Smith Field starting Tuesday against former OVC-rival Austin Peay.

Scott Pitches Well Despite Record

Senior Matt Scott has pitched well in his five starts this season despite his 2-2 record, dropping a pair of outings in hardfought Friday battles. The Smyrna, Tenn., native has worked into the sixth inning or longer in all five starts and allowed three earned runs or fewer in four of the five outings. Scott enters Friday's game with a 3.56 earned-run-average and 17 strikeouts in 30.1 innings of work. The righthander picked up a victory with six strong innings in the season opener against Jacksonville State, allowing one run on two hits with two strikeouts. He tossed five innings the following Friday versus Bowling Green despite battling the flu all week and then suffered a tough-luck loss at Missouri State, giving up two runs with five strikeouts in six innings. The LaVergne HS product worked into the sixth inning at Troy in the conference opener, allowing four runs but picking up his second win of the year. He then worked eight innings last Friday against Louisiana-Lafayette, allowing three earned runs but 10 hits, suffering his second loss of the season.

Reilley Reliable Out of the Pen

Senior Brett Reilley has filled a valuable role out of the bullpen so far this season, tossing two-plus innings in six of his 12 appearances. The righthander has allowed just four runs with 23 strikeouts in 22.1 innings of work, posting an impressive 1.61 ERA. Reilley has also given up just 10 hits during his time on the mound. He tossed four innings against Jacksonville State, giving up an unearned run, and posted his first win of the year with three innings of work versus Bowling Green. Reilley struck out five in 2.1 innings at Missouri State and tossed 2.2 innings on both Friday and Sunday, both Blue Raider victories, in the conference opening series at Troy. Reilley worked 1.1 scoreless frames against Southern Illinois, picking up his second victory. He tossed in all three games against Louisiana-Lafayette, tossing 3.1 innings and striking out five in Sunday's series clincher. In nine of his 12 outings, Reilley has allowed zero earned runs and has given up two runs on just one occasion and opponents are batting just .132.

Robinson Steadies Rotation

Junior Brad Robinson stepped into the starting rotation three weeks ago at Missouri State, tossing a no-hitter into the seventh inning and picking up his first victory of the year. Since Robinson moved into the starting rotation, the Blue Raiders have won two of three contests and

lost the other, 4-3. The righthander is 2-0 with a 3.08 ERA in seven appearances this season, including three starts. Robinson struck out six in 6.1 innings of work at Missouri State for his first win. He only lasted 4.1 innings at Troy two weeks ago, giving up two runs and walking three, but rebounded with six innings last weekend against Louisiana-Lafayette, striking out five in a Middle Tennessee victory. The Oakland HS product has 26 strikeouts in 22.1 innings of work, giving up only nine runs with opponents batting just .198.

Taylor Delivers After Being Pressed into Starting Duty

Sophomore Taylor Dennis was pressed into starting duty for the first time in his career after regular shortstop Matt Ray dislocated his shoulder on March 10 at Troy. Since then Taylor has started seven of the team's games, batting .355 (11-for-31) with 10 runs scored, four doubles and five RBIs. He has started all seven contests at second base, with senior Wayne Kendrick moving over to shortstop. Dennis had two hits with three runs scored and three RBIs in her first start of the year on Sunday at Troy, just the second start of her career. She had three hits and three runs scored against Southern Illinois and a pair of singles on Sunday versus Louisiana-Lafayette. He collected his third multi-hit game of the year with three hits and two runs scored on Wednesday at Memphis and has hit safely in the last three games.

Bishop Extends Hitting Streak to 11 Games

Sophomore Rawley Bishop extended his hitting streak to a team-high 11 games with two hits on Wednesday at Memphis. Bishop leads the Blue Raiders with six home runs and ranks second on the club with 21 RBIs as well as batting .338, third best on the club. Bishop has 14 hits and 10 RBIs during the 11-game streak. His longest previous hitting streak was six games in 2006. Bishop has played 17 games at first base and four as the designated hitter after battling a hamstring injury. He also has a team-leading 16 walks

Kendrick Leading the Way at the Plate

Senior Wayne Kendrick started the season as Middle Tennessee's leading returning hitter and currently leads the Blue Raiders with a .356 batting average through 23 contests. He leads the club with 35 hits and 24 runs scored and has added four doubles, 11 walks and 11 runs scored. The Murfreesboro, Tenn., native has registered 11

multi-hit games, including a pair of four-hit contests (Feb. 16 vs. Jacksonville State, March 7 at Belmont). He has six multi-run contests, including four in last Saturday's win versus Louisiana-Lafayette and four three-hit games, including three in his last six outings. Kendrick started the year at second base but has played seven of the last eight games at shortstop after Matt Ray's dislocated shoulder on March 10 at Troy. He has also hit in the first three spots in the order, three times at leadoff, five in the two hole and 15 in the three spot.

Warren Driving Home Opportunities

Senior Adam Warren drove in a career-high 41 runs last season and is one pace to easily surpass that number in 2007, leading the Blue Raiders with 22 RBIs through 23 games. The Jackson, Tenn., native has 33 hits and 14 runs scored as well. Warren has seven multi-RBI games this year and hit safely in 17 of 23 contests. He is on pace to drive in 53 runs this season and leads Middle Tennessee this season, one ahead of Rawley Bishop. Warren also leads the Blue Raiders with eight stolen bases in nine attempts and has just nine strikeouts in 91 at-bats, making for a tough out.

Smalley Can't Pick Up Victories

Despite working five or more innings in three of five starts and giving up more than two earned runs just once,

sophomore Brett Smalley has posted a 1-3 record and a 3.16 ERA. Smalley has suffered a pair of 3-1 losses, at Samford and at Lipscomb. He struck out five in 4.1 innings at Samford and tossed five innings at Lipscomb, scattering nine hits. He picked up his only victory of the year with five innings at Belmont, giving up just one run, but suffered his third loss against Southern Illinois, allowing two earned runs but walking four. With his good work Smalley drew the Sunday start against Louisiana-Lafayette, striking out five in 4.1 innings and giving up one run on three hits. He walked four again but got no decision in a 3-1 Middle Tennessee victory. Smalley has 20 strikeouts in 25.2 innings of work this season in six appearances.

All-Time Versus Arkansas State

Middle Tennessee leads the all-time series with Arkansas State, 14-5, with all 19 of the contests since the Blue Raiders joined the Sun Belt. Middle Tennessee is 6-3 all-time in the series in Jonesboro, winning 2-of-3 games in all three series. Last season the Blue Raiders won both meetings in Murfreesboro, with Sunday's contest rained

out. Friday starter Matt Scott is 2-0 all-time against ASU but with a 4.61 ERA three career outings. He has won the first game of the series the last two years, a 12-6 victory in Jonesboro in the first game of a doubleheader on Saturday two years ago and an 18-8 triumph in Murfreesboro last season on Friday.

A Sun Belt first

Middle Tennessee faced a difficult task starting Sun Belt Conference play against defending champion and preseason favorite Troy, and a Louisiana-Lafayette team picked second in a preseason vote of league coaches. The Blue Raiders started league play with consecutive series wins for the first time since joining the SBC in 2001 when it took the decisive game from Louisiana-Lafayette this past Sunday. The Blue Raiders opened league play by taking 2-of-3 at Troy as well. Middle Tennessee earned both series wins by taking Sunday's rubber game. The series win against Louisiana-Lafayette also marked the first for Middle Tennessee against the Ragin' Cajuns since 2001.

Injuries Taking Their Toll

Middle Tennessee has been hit hard by injuries already this season and including the end of the 2006 campaign. Senior hurler Langdon Stanley missed the second half of 2006 and will not be available to pitch this year until sometime in April. Junior outfielder Nathan Hines, sophomore pitcher Chad Edwards and junior catcher Alex Watson were all lost for the season in February, while Hines and Edwards have both already undergone season-ending surgery. The injuries continued to rack up when senior shortstop Matt Ray dislocated his left shoulder diving for a ball on at Troy (3/10). Freshman Matt Yurus suffered an injury (3/11) after making a pitch to the plate the next day. Ray is out 2-4 weeks and may return this weekend at Arkansas State, while Yurus must make a decision about whether to undergo season-ending surgery or try rehab for the next 8-10 months.

Youth is Served

After the loss of four seniors and one junior from last year's starting lineup, Middle Tennessee head coach Steve Peterson had several holes to fill heading into 2007. Because of several factors, including injuries and continued good play, Peterson has two true freshmen

and at least one redshirt freshman in the lineup everyday and there have been days with even more. Freshman Blake McDade got a chance to start opening weekend in rightfield and has been one of the team's most consistent players, batting .275 in 20 starts, including six doubles, two home runs and 19 RBIs. Freshman Drew Robertson had to step in behind the plate and has been more than steady, starting 19 games, collecting three doubles with six RBIs and seven runs scored. Several other freshmen have seen extended playing time, including redshirt freshmen Myles Ervin and Justin Jones, along with freshman Zach Hudson. Ervin has started 15 games, scoring eight runs and driving in five more. Jones has started seven times this year, including three games at Troy, batting .240 with three doubles, a home run and seven RBIs as well as five runs scored. Hudson has scored four runs in 11 games and has one RBI.

Steve Peterson

Head Coach • Jacksonville State/1973 • 20th Season • 614-487-2 (.557), 767-581-2 (.568) overall



There are many adjectives to describe the job Steve Peterson has done as Middle Tennessee's highly successful baseball coach since 1988. Coach, fundraiser, teacher, recruiter, and architect are just a few, but if you are looking for one word to sum his contributions as the Blue Raiders'

longtime skipper, try "winner."

Peterson was inducted into the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame in January 2007. He begins his 20th Blue Raider season as the school's all-time winningest coach, with 604 victories and a stockpile of conference championships and NCAA Tournament berths to his credit, demonstrating the consistency with which the driven skipper has guided the club.

Peterson's drive for excellence has resulted in consistent success and has made Middle Tennessee a model program. The veteran coach has led Middle Tennessee to 10 regular-season conference championships, eight conference tournament titles, and seven NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections in the past five years. Peterson guided the Blue Raiders to seven consecutive championships – either regular-season or tournament – during one stretch, proving Middle Tennessee doesn't rebuild, it reloads.

Peterson, who enters the 2007 season with a sterling 604-474-2 mark, has produced 12 seasons with 30 or more wins including a school-record 42 victories in 1990. He also has three campaigns of at least 40 wins including 2004's 40-22 record.

Consistent success during Peterson's tenure is a testament to his ability to recruit and develop talent, and the proof was never more evident than in 2001 – the Blue Raiders' first season in the Sun Belt Conference after years of success in the Ohio Valley.

Asked how the move into the Sun Belt, rated one of the nation's top five baseball leagues at the time and consistently a top 10 conference, would change his recruiting philosophy, Peterson quickly responded, "not at all." The 2001 Blue Raiders shared the Sun Belt championship with South Alabama after their first year in the high-profile league, and the chief contributors were many of the same players who led Middle Tennessee to the 2000 OVC championship.

The move to a higher-rated conference certainly helped Middle Tennessee's status. In their first five years in the Sun Belt, Peterson's teams have won two regular-season championships and a tournament championship and earned three NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections for the first time in school history. The 2001 squad earned national acclaim for its pitching and hitting and the season concluded with pitcher Dewon Brazelton being selected as the No. 3 overall pick of the Tampa Bay Devil Rays in the Major League Baseball First-Year Amateur Player Draft. Brazelton was one of six players from the team to earn a spot on a professional baseball roster that season.

A program cannot enjoy consistent success without quality players and Peterson, a three-time Coach of the Year, has not only made a habit of making sure Middle

Tennessee has its share of quality performers but he's also won by constantly signing prep players and developing them at the college level. He has coached a Sun Belt Player of the Year and six OVC Players of the Year, a Sun Belt Pitcher of the Year and an OVC Pitcher of the Year, two First-Team All-Americans, five Third-Team All-Americans, four Freshman All-Americans, and 43 first-team All-Conference performers.

Players who have honed their skills under Peterson also have had outstanding success continuing their careers at the professional level. Professional baseball has seen 55 former Peterson performers earning the chance to play at the game's highest level, with four making their way to the Major Leagues.

If that's not enough, Peterson's recruits have established most of the offensive records held at Middle Tennessee and four players he has developed have hit .400 or better in a season, along with the school's single-season and career home run record holders. His 1997 squad established the all-time record for batting average with a .323 clip.

Peterson's players have been solid on the field at the collegiate level and continued their careers professionally, and a large majority have taken skills and fundamentals learned at Middle Tennessee and are earning a living as coaches at various levels. Thirty-four former Blue Raiders are currently coaching at the high school, college, or professional levels.

Peterson's peers have recognized his achievements and contributions to the game by bestowing several honors on him. He was named the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association College Coach of the Year in 1992 and again in 2000. He was also inducted into the Rutherford County Old Timers Baseball Hall of Fame in 2003. Fellow coaches have named Peterson Coach of the Year on three occasions – twice in the Ohio Valley and again in 2004, his first such honor in the Sun Belt.

Peterson's outgoing and personable style has made him a hit with fans, boosters, players, and recruits alike. Baseball enthusiasts throughout the Middle Tennessee community clearly appreciate his hard-nosed and aggressive style of coaching, and as fans continue to flock to Reese Smith Field at a record pace. The Blue Raiders established a single-game attendance record in 2001 at Reese Smith Field with a crowd of 2,733 against South Alabama. The team went on to set the single-season attendance mark that year with 26,218 coming through the gates. The 2001 squad saw 15 crowds of 1,000 or more during the season. Those numbers were surpassed in 2004 when the team set a single-game attendance record of 3,020 against Vanderbilt, and set a new single-season attendance mark of 30,319, ranking 46th nationally. Fifteen contests drew more than 1,000 patrons during the record-setting campaign.

Not only has Peterson been a winner on the field but he's also been a successful fundraiser during his career. Events such as the annual Chuck Taylor Golf Tournament, the Groundhog Day Luncheon, and the Grand Slam Fish Fry in the fall have become mainstays on calendars of Blue Raider baseball supporters across middle Tennessee and have raised thousands of dollars for the improvement of Blue Raider baseball.

Peterson spearheaded the efforts to pay for the con-

struction of the Stephen B. Smith Clubhouse and Indoor Training Facility, which opened its doors in 1998. One look inside the facility shows the time and effort spent toward this endeavor. It has become known as one of the finest collegiate clubhouses and training facilities in the country.

Reese Smith Field also has benefited from Peterson's fundraising abilities. He has helped transform the park into a fan-friendly area by leading efforts to expand the seating area, add an information center just inside the gate, and improve restroom and concession facilities.

Peterson guided efforts during the summer of 2001 to enlarge the dugouts at Reese Smith Field. He is also spearheading an effort that will totally renovate the stadium beginning in June 2007. The plans call for a significant remodeling of the concession stand, improved and expanded restroom facilities, and a modern press box to accommodate radio, television, and print media.

While Peterson has spent 19 seasons leading the Middle Tennessee baseball program, his tenure with the program is much longer. He took two separate tours with the Blue Raiders as an assistant coach under John Stanford before becoming the team's head coach. During 1976-78 and 1985-87, he helped the Blue Raiders win two OVC titles and four southern division crowns.

During the interim, Peterson served as head coach at Roane State Community College in Harriman, Tenn. During his tenure from 1979-84, Peterson's teams won a Tennessee state title in 1981, and he was twice named TJCAA Coach of the Year (1981, '84). While at Roane State, Peterson put together a sparkling record of 153-96 for a .614 winning percentage.

A native of Huntsville, Ala., Peterson stood out as a catcher under the legendary Rudy Abbott at Jacksonville State. He earned his bachelor's from Jacksonville State in 1983 and later earned a master's from Middle Tennessee in 1977.

Peterson is married to the former Rita Albert and the couple has three children, Jill, Jenny, and John, and two grandchildren. Away from the diamond, Peterson enjoys fishing for smallmouth bass.
