Notes: Middle Tennessee ends a five-game road swing with Tuesday's contest at Austin Peay. The Blue Raiders defeated the Govs, 9-8, in Murfreesboro on March 27 ... Middle Tennessee owns a 75-35 mark all-time against Austin Peay, including 33-20 in Clarksville. Since the Blue Raiders left the OVC before the 2001 season, Middle Tennessee is 3-2 at Raymond C. Hand Park with APSU's 8-4 victory last season ending a three-game winning streak ... Middle Tennessee begins a four-game homestand this weekend against New Orleans and hosts Vanderbilt next Wednesday.

Anderson Gets Second Straight Start

Senior Josh Anderson will draw his second start of the season and just the third of his career in 55 appearances on Tuesday at Austin Peay. The lefthander made his first start of the year last Wednesday at Tennessee Tech, tossing four shutout innings to pick up the victory. He allowed just two hits, struck out three and did not walk a batter. In 12 appearances this season, Anderson is 1-0 with a 3.18 ERA with eight strikeouts. He has pitched three times in his career against the Govs, getting two outs in 2005 and working two scoreless innings last season. He allowed two runs on two hits in one-third of an inning earlier this season against APSU on March 27 in Murfreesboro.

Kendrick Has Big Weekend

Senior Wayne Kendrick has been Middle Tennessee's leading hitter most of the season, but the Murfreesboro, Tenn., native had a big weekend at Arkansas-Little Rock to raise his season average to .390, best on the team and fourth in the Sun Belt. Kendrick collected seven hits in 15 at-bats (.467) at UALR with three runs scored and three RBIs. He recorded two hits apiece on Friday and Saturday, including an RBI triple on Friday, and had three consecutive hits to start Sunday's contest. Kendrick is the team leader not only in average but also in hits (60), runs scored (36) and doubles (14) and also has 23 RBIs. He also ranks second on the club with 16 walks and has six stolen bases in as many attempts while starting every game, 25 times at second base and 11 more at shortstop. Kendrick is also on pace to challenge the single-season record for hits established in 2006 by Jeff Beachum, who collected 98 hits. At his current pace, Kendrick would end the 56-game schedule before the Sun Belt Championships with 93 hits.

Barrett Comes Out of His Slump

Junior Zach Barrett was a steady performer for the Blue Raiders for the first 24 games of the season, but the third baseman went through an awful

slump, going 3-for-28 (.107) from March 24-April 4. Barrett broke out of his slump at Arkansas-Little Rock, collecting five hits in 12 at-bats (.417) with two runs scored and one RBI. He was 2-for-3 with a sacrifice bunt on Friday and followed that with an RBI single and a run scored on Saturday and two more hits on Sunday. Barrett has also played good defense at the hot corner, a position with no given starter until the season began. Barrett has nine errors in 105 chances, though three of the miscues came in one inning at Memphis on March 21. Subtract those errors and Barrett has a respectable .941 fielding percentage.

Ray's Swing Slowly Returning

Senior Matt Ray stepped right into the starting shortstop position and leadoff roles this season for the Blue Raiders, but he suffered a dislocated left shoulder on March 10 at Troy diving for a ball. Ray missed almost two weeks of action and returned March 23 at Arkansas State, although he played leftfield that weekend and did not make his first start at shortstop on March 28 at Vanderbilt. Since his return, Ray's swing has slowly improved, jumping more than 50 points to its current .308. In the last eight games, the Riceville, Tenn., native is batting .412 (14-for-34) with three doubles, a home run, six RBIs and seven runs scored. Last weekend at Arkansas-Little Rock, Ray collected six hits in 15 at-bats (.400) with three doubles, three RBIs and two runs scored. He collected two hits and one RBI on Saturday and had two doubles, including a two-run two-bagger, in Sunday's finale. For the year Ray has six doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs and 22 runs scored in 28 games. He also ranks second on the club with 12 stolen bases in 16 attempts.

Warren the Latest Casualty

After battling for month than a month with a balky hamstring, senior Adam Warren finally took himself out of the game on Sunday after running out a ground ball in the top of the first. He played in the

All-Time Against Austin Peay

Middle Tennessee stands 75-35 all-time against Austin Peay, including 33-20 in Clarksville. The Blue Raiders had a three-game winning streak snapped at Raymond C. Hand Park with last year's 8-4 Gavs victory. Middle Tennessee has won three of the five meetings in Clarksville since the Blue Raiders left the OVC before the 2001 season. Senior Wayne Kendrick has nine hits in 17 career at-bats (.529) in five games against Austin Peay with five runs scored and three RBIs. He is the only Blue Raider hitter who has more than 10 career at-bats versus APSU.

Bishop Streak Ends at 21 Games

Redshirt sophomore Rawley Bishop had his 21-game hitting streak end Friday, April 6 at Arkansas-Little Rock with an 0-for-4 effort. The 21-game streak was the longest by a Blue Raider

since at least 1999, surpassing the previous best of 17 games by Todd Martin in 2006. During the 21 games, the Germantown, Tenn., native batted .370 (30-for-81) with five doubles, six home runs and 25 RBIs as well as 23 runs scored and 13 walks. He had eight multi-hit and six multi-RBI contests during the 21 games, including a five RBI outing on March 14 versus Southern Illinois and a six RBI contest against Louisiana-Monroe on March 31. For the season the first baseman is batting .339 in 34 games. He has 10 doubles and is the team leader with 10 home runs and 38 RBIs as well as 24 walks and has been hit a team-leading nine times. Bishop is tied for fifth in the Sun Belt in home runs and is sixth in the league in RBIs.

Robinson Continues String of Good Outings

Junior Brad Robinson tossed 7.1 innings at Arkansas-Little Rock last Saturday, allowing one run on

outfield in the bottom of the inning before being removed for Doug Birkofer. Warren is the latest victim of the injury bug for the Blue Raiders, though at least his ailment is not as severe as many of the others. Middle Tennessee has been hit hard by injuries already this season and including the end of the 2006 campaign. Senior hurler Langdon Stanley missed the second half of 2006 and will not be available to pitch this year until sometime in April. Junior outfielder Nathan Hines, sophomore pitcher Chad Edwards and junior catcher Alex Watson were all lost for the season in February, all three with season-ending surgery, while transfer Zach Dean came to Middle Tennessee with an injury and also underwent year-ending surgery in the fall. The injuries continued to rack up when senior shortstop Matt Ray dislocated his left shoulder diving for a ball on at Troy (3/10) and missed two weeks of action. Freshman Matt Yurus suffered an injury (3/11) after making a pitch to the plate at Troy as well and became the sixth Blue Raider to undergo season-ending surgery in the last 12 months in late March.

six hits to continue his string of strong outings in 2007. The righthander improved to 4-0 with the victory against UALR, striking out four and walking three. Robinson tied his career-long outing against UALR, tossing 7.1 innings the previous Saturday versus Louisiana-Monroe, and lowered his ERA to 2.70. Middle Tennessee is 4-1 in Robinson's five Sun Belt starts, with the only loss a 4-3 decision at Troy the opening weekend. The past four SBC series Robinson has helped the Blue Raiders tie the series with a Saturday victory. For the year Robinson has 36 strikeouts in 46.2 innings of

work and opponents are batting just .232. He has appeared in 10 games with six starts and allowed just eight extra-base hits.

Raiders Rolling in the Sun Belt

Middle Tennessee won its fifth straight conference series at Arkansas-Little Rock, keeping its string alive to start the league campaign. The Blue Raiders are the only Sun Belt team to win all five series this season and have done so against three of the league's top teams, winning Sunday rubber games all five weekends. Middle Tennessee faced

a difficult task starting SBC play against defending champion and preseason favorite Troy, and a Louisiana-Lafayette team picked second in a pre-season vote of league coaches. The Blue Raiders started league play with consecutive series wins for the first time since joining the conference in 2001. The series win against UL also marked the first for Middle Tennessee against the Ragin' Cajuns since 2001. Middle Tennessee won 2-of-3 games at Arkansas State on March 23-25, with all three games going extra innings. The Blue Raiders added then league-leading Louisiana-Monroe to the list, taking 2-of-3 from the Warhawks March 30-April 1 as well, before taking 2-of-3 at Arkansas-Little Rock last weekend. Middle Tennessee is off to a 10-5 start in Sun Belt Conference play, its best-ever start in league play since joining the SBC seven years ago. The Blue Raiders' previous best beginning to league play after five series was 9-6 in 2001, a season the squad finished 17-10 in SBC action. Middle Tennessee has also won five straight series for the first time ever to begin conference play and only the second time since joining the league. The Blue Raiders won the last six series of 2004 and the last five series of 2001.

Bullpen Big Reason for Success

Middle Tennessee's bullpen has been a big reason for the team's success, posting an 8-4 mark and a 4.22 ERA so far in 2007. The bullpen has tossed 149.1 innings, just 19 innings less than the starting staff, and opponents are batting just

.255 against the group through 36 games. Senior Brett Reilley has been the biggest contributor to the unit's success, working in 20 of the team's games and posting a 4-1 record with a 2.06 ERA. The righthander has two saves in 39.1 innings of work, with opponents batting just .181. He has 29 strikeouts and has allowed just nine earned runs. Reilley worked a career-long 6.1 innings in relief on March 8 at Arkansas-Little Rock, picking up his fourth win of the year. Sophomore Jordan Alvis has also been a big contributor, appearing in 17 games with a 2.66 ERA. The righthander has 15 strikeouts in 20.1 innings of work and opponents are batting only .247. Senior Josh Anderson has been the team's first lefthander out of the bullpen all season, appearing in 12 games and working 17.0 innings. Anderson has posted a 3.18 ERA and opponents are batting .262.

Season Tidbits

The 14-inning game at Arkansas State on March 25 was the longest game for Middle Tennessee since playing 14 innings on March 20, 2005, at Missouri State. It was the longest Sun Belt contest since the Blue Raiders played 14 innings versus Louisiana-Lafayette on April 2, 2004. In the last 25 years, Middle Tennessee has never played three consecutive extra-inning games, which it did in the three-game series against ASU, and the 14-inning game tied for the longest in recorded school history ... Redshirt freshman Myles Ervin and senior Adam Warren both collected five hits in the March 31 victory over Louisiana-Monroe. Ervin and Warren both accomplished a feat only 15 players in school history had previously recorded, the last coming in 2006 when Jeff Beachum had five hits against Lipscomb. The Blue Raiders collected 25 hits as a team in the game, three short of the school record of 28 set in 2001 versus Lipscomb and the most since recording 22 hits at New Mexico State on April 6, 2002 ... Middle Tennessee stands 8-4 in Sun Belt play after four weekends, the only time since joining the league the Blue Raiders have won their first four conference series. It is also two games better than any previous 12-game SBC record, besting the 6-6 marks of the 2001 and 2004 clubs ... The Blue Raider pitching staff scattered six hits in posting a 7-0 shutout at Tennessee Tech on April 4, the first shutout for the staff since winning at Southern Illinois, 9-0, on March 10, 2006, a stretch of 78 games. Before the SIU shutout last season, the last road blanking was the three straight at New Orleans on May 7-9, 2004 at New Orleans, a string of 78 contests. In this decade, Middle Tennessee has played 191 road games and posted just 10 shutouts, including three in 2001 and four in 2004 ... Middle Tennessee has won nine of its last 12 games since March 24, with one loss each to third-ranked Vanderbilt, Louisiana-Monroe and Arkansas-Little Rock. With Sunday's win at UALR, the Blue Raiders improved to two games over .500 for the first time all season. Senior Wayne Kendrick is batting .491 (26-for-53) with runners in scoring position this season, including 5-for-5 over the weekend at Arkansas-Little Rock.

Youth is Served

After the loss of four seniors and one junior from last year's starting lineup, Middle Tennessee head coach Steve Peterson had several holes to fill heading into 2007. Because of several factors, including injuries and continued good play, Peterson has two true freshmen and at least one redshirt freshman in the lineup everyday and there have been days with even more. Freshman Blake McDade got a chance to start opening weekend in rightfield and has been one of the team's most consistent players, batting .283 in 26 starts with seven doubles, two home runs and 24 RBIs. Fresh-

man Drew Robertson had to step in behind the plate and has been more than steady, starting 29 games, collecting three doubles with six RBIs and 12 runs scored. Several other freshmen have seen extended playing time, including redshirt freshman Myles Ervin, who has started 24 games, batting .326 with 18 runs scored and 11 RBIs.

Barrett Voted Player of the Week

Middle Tennessee third baseman Zach Barrett was voted the Sun Belt Player of the Week on March 13 after helping the Blue Raiders to three wins in four games, including a series victory at Troy. Barrett batted .588 (10-for-17) in four games, as the Blue Raiders won 3-of-4, including a series victory at Troy to open conference play. Barrett scored four runs and drove in seven, collecting three doubles, two walks and three stolen bases. The third baseman was 4-for-5 with two doubles and five RBIs in a victory at Belmont on March 7. He then had six hits in 12 at-bats in three games at Troy, collecting a pair of hits in each game against the Trojans. Barrett scored twice and drove in a run in the opening 13-4 victory on Friday against Troy and doubled, scored once and drove in a run in Sunday's series clincher.

Robinson Voted Pitcher of the Week

Middle Tennessee's Brad Robinson was voted Sun Belt Pitcher of the Week on March 6 after tossing a no-hitter for six innings in his first career start. In just the fifth appearance of his Middle Tennessee career, Robinson took a no-hitter into the sixth inning on Sunday against Missouri State before a single to center with one out. The righthander retired 17 of the first 19 batters of the game, walking the other two. The Murfreesboro, Tenn., native worked 6.1 innings in the contest, allowing three runs on four hits with six strikeouts.

Blue Raiders Picked Sixth by Coaches

Middle Tennessee's baseball team was picked to finish sixth in the Sun Belt this season in a poll of the league's coaches released in January. The Blue Raiders finished sixth in 2006 in league play, but the Sun Belt has expanded for the 2007 campaign, with Florida Atlantic and Louisiana-Monroe full members for this season. Defending regular season and tournament champion Troy received six first-place votes and 115 total points, edging Louisiana-Lafayette for the top spot in the poll. The Ragin' Cajuns received five first-place votes and 114 total points. South Alabama (94) was third, followed by Florida Atlantic (84), Florida International (68) and the Blue Raiders in sixth with 66 points. New Orleans (60), Arkansas State (42), Western Kentucky (37), Arkansas-Little Rock (23) and Louisiana-Monroe (23) rounded out the poll.

Steve Peterson

Head Coach • Jacksonville State/1973 • 20th Season • 623-491-2 (.558), 776-585-2 (.569) overall



There are many adjectives to describe the job Steve Peterson has done as Middle Tennessee's highly successful baseball coach since 1988. Coach, fundraiser, teacher, recruiter, and architect are just a few, but if you are looking for one word to sum his contributions as the Blue Raiders'

longtime skipper, try "winner."

Peterson was inducted into the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame in January 2007. He begins his 20th Blue Raider season as the school's all-time winningest coach, with 604 victories and a stockpile of conference championships and NCAA Tournament berths to his credit, demonstrating the consistency with which the driven skipper has guided the club.

Peterson's drive for excellence has resulted in consistent success and has made Middle Tennessee a model program. The veteran coach has led Middle Tennessee to 10 regular-season conference championships, eight conference tournament titles, and seven NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections in the past five years. Peterson guided the Blue Raiders to seven consecutive championships – either regular-season or tournament – during one stretch, proving Middle Tennessee doesn't rebuild, it reloads.

Peterson, who enters the 2007 season with a sterling 604-474-2 mark, has produced 12 seasons with 30 or more wins including a school-record 42 victories in 1990. He also has three campaigns of at least 40 wins including 2004's 40-22 record.

Consistent success during Peterson's tenure is a testament to his ability to recruit and develop talent, and the proof was never more evident than in 2001 – the Blue Raiders' first season in the Sun Belt Conference after years of success in the Ohio Valley.

Asked how the move into the Sun Belt, rated one of the nation's top five baseball leagues at the time and consistently a top 10 conference, would change his recruiting philosophy, Peterson quickly responded, "not at all." The 2001 Blue Raiders shared the Sun Belt championship with South Alabama after their first year in the high-profile league, and the chief contributors were many of the same players who led Middle Tennessee to the 2000 OVC championship.

The move to a higher-rated conference certainly helped Middle Tennessee's status. In their first five years in the Sun Belt, Peterson's teams have won two regular-season championships and a tournament championship and earned three NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections for the first time in school history. The 2001 squad earned national acclaim for its pitching and hitting and the season concluded with pitcher Dewon Brazelton being selected as the No. 3 overall pick of the Tampa Bay Devil Rays in the Major League Baseball First-Year Amateur Player Draft. Brazelton was one of six players from the team to earn a spot on a professional baseball roster that season.

A program cannot enjoy consistent success without quality players and Peterson, a three-time Coach of the Year, has not only made a habit of making sure Middle

Tennessee has its share of quality performers but he's also won by constantly signing prep players and developing them at the college level. He has coached a Sun Belt Player of the Year and six OVC Players of the Year, a Sun Belt Pitcher of the Year and an OVC Pitcher of the Year, two First-Team All-Americans, five Third-Team All-Americans, four Freshman All-Americans, and 43 first-team All-Conference performers.

Players who have honed their skills under Peterson also have had outstanding success continuing their careers at the professional level. Professional baseball has seen 55 former Peterson performers earning the chance to play at the game's highest level, with four making their way to the Major Leagues.

If that's not enough, Peterson's recruits have established most of the offensive records held at Middle Tennessee and four players he has developed have hit .400 or better in a season, along with the school's single-season and career home run record holders. His 1997 squad established the all-time record for batting average with a .323 clip.

Peterson's players have been solid on the field at the collegiate level and continued their careers professionally, and a large majority have taken skills and fundamentals learned at Middle Tennessee and are earning a living as coaches at various levels. Thirty-four former Blue Raiders are currently coaching at the high school, college, or professional levels.

Peterson's peers have recognized his achievements and contributions to the game by bestowing several honors on him. He was named the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association College Coach of the Year in 1992 and again in 2000. He was also inducted into the Rutherford County Old Timers Baseball Hall of Fame in 2003. Fellow coaches have named Peterson Coach of the Year on three occasions – twice in the Ohio Valley and again in 2004, his first such honor in the Sun Belt.

Peterson's outgoing and personable style has made him a hit with fans, boosters, players, and recruits alike. Baseball enthusiasts throughout the Middle Tennessee community clearly appreciate his hard-nosed and aggressive style of coaching, and as fans continue to flock to Reese Smith Field at a record pace. The Blue Raiders established a single-game attendance record in 2001 at Reese Smith Field with a crowd of 2,733 against South Alabama. The team went on to set the single-season attendance mark that year with 26,218 coming through the gates. The 2001 squad saw 15 crowds of 1,000 or more during the season. Those numbers were surpassed in 2004 when the team set a single-game attendance record of 3,020 against Vanderbilt, and set a new single-season attendance mark of 30,319, ranking 46th nationally. Fifteen contests drew more than 1,000 patrons during the record-setting campaign.

Not only has Peterson been a winner on the field but he's also been a successful fundraiser during his career. Events such as the annual Chuck Taylor Golf Tournament, the Groundhog Day Luncheon, and the Grand Slam Fish Fry in the fall have become mainstays on calendars of Blue Raider baseball supporters across middle Tennessee and have raised thousands of dollars for the improvement of Blue Raider baseball.

Peterson spearheaded the efforts to pay for the con-

struction of the Stephen B. Smith Clubhouse and Indoor Training Facility, which opened its doors in 1998. One look inside the facility shows the time and effort spent toward this endeavor. It has become known as one of the finest collegiate clubhouses and training facilities in the country.

Reese Smith Field also has benefited from Peterson's fundraising abilities. He has helped transform the park into a fan-friendly area by leading efforts to expand the seating area, add an information center just inside the gate, and improve restroom and concession facilities.

Peterson guided efforts during the summer of 2001 to enlarge the dugouts at Reese Smith Field. He is also spearheading an effort that will totally renovate the stadium beginning in June 2007. The plans call for a significant remodeling of the concession stand, improved and expanded restroom facilities, and a modern press box to accommodate radio, television, and print media.

While Peterson has spent 19 seasons leading the Middle Tennessee baseball program, his tenure with the program is much longer. He took two separate tours with the Blue Raiders as an assistant coach under John Stanford before becoming the team's head coach. During 1976-78 and 1985-87, he helped the Blue Raiders win two OVC titles and four southern division crowns.

During the interim, Peterson served as head coach at Roane State Community College in Harriman, Tenn. During his tenure from 1979-84, Peterson's teams won a Tennessee state title in 1981, and he was twice named TJCAA Coach of the Year (1981, '84). While at Roane State, Peterson put together a sparkling record of 153-96 for a .614 winning percentage.

A native of Huntsville, Ala., Peterson stood out as a catcher under the legendary Rudy Abbott at Jacksonville State. He earned his bachelor's from Jacksonville State in 1983 and later earned a master's from Middle Tennessee in 1977.

Peterson is married to the former Rita Albert and the couple has three children, Jill, Jenny, and John, and two grandchildren. Away from the diamond, Peterson enjoys fishing for smallmouth bass.
