Notes: Middle Tennessee hosts Lipscomb in its final nonconference contest of the season ... The Blue Raiders lost to the Bisons, 3-1, on February 28 in Nashville but own a 17-14 overall mark against Lipscomb all-time, including 10-4 at Reese Smith Field ... Since the Bisons moved to Division I in 2001, Middle Tennessee has won 11 of the 15 meetings ... The Blue Raiders hit the road this weekend for the final Sun Belt road series of the year with three games at Florida International.

Barrett Continues Hot Hitting

Junior Zach Barrett continued his hot hitting last weekend against Florida Atlantic, collecting six hits in 11 at-bats (.545) with two doubles, two RBIs and four runs scored. The third baseman collected his third three-hit game of the season in Saturday's first game, going 3-for-4 with one RBI. He followed that with two hits in the second contest with a run and one RBI. He doubled in both games on Saturday. In the series finale, Barrett had just one hit but scored a career-best three runs, drawing a pair of walks. Barrett was a steady performer for the Blue Raiders for the first 24 games of the season, but then he went through an awful slump, going 3-for-28 (.107) from March 24-April 4. Barrett broke out of his slump at Arkansas-Little Rock the first weekend of April, collecting five hits in 12 at-bats (.417), and continued his hot hitting the next weekend against New Orleans, going 6-for-14 (.429) with his first career home run as well as five RBIs. The Evansville, Ind., native currently has a seven-game hitting streak, recording 15 hits in 28 at-bats (.536) with four doubles, four RBIs and seven runs scored. Included in that stretch was his second four-hit game of year, both against Belmont. Barrett has hit safely in 14 of his last 15 games, with the only hiccup an 0-for-3 outing with a sacrifice fly against Vanderbilt on April 18. For the year the Olney Central CC product is batting .331 with nine doubles, 27 RBIs and 27 runs scored in 47 contests.

Ray Streak Ends at 15 Games

Senior Matt Ray had his 15-game hitting streak snapped during Saturday's twinbill against Florida Atlantic, though it took a strange turn of events because of weather and television coverage. Ray entered the series on a 14-game hitting streak and was 0-for-4 in the opener when rain suspended the contest. Because of TV coverage of the second game, statistics from the first outing

did not count until it was completed. Ray went 3-for-5 with two runs scored in the second game, extending the hitting streak to 15 games, before making the final out in the suspended game, ending the stretch. The Riceville, Tenn., native also had one hit in Sunday's finale and has hit safely in 22 of 25 games since returning from injury in late March. During his 15-game hitting streak, Ray batted .426 (29-for-68) with 11 doubles, 12 RBIs and 17 runs scored. He was voted the Sun Belt Player of the Week on May 23 after helping the Blue Raiders to a conference series win at South Alabama and a victory over No. 1 Vanderbilt. Ray is batting a team-best .386 in Sun Belt games (ninth best in the league) with 22 runs scored in 20 contests. For the season Ray is hitting .333 with 37 runs scored, 15 doubles, 24 RBIs and 24 walks in 38 starts. He also has 17 stolen bases in 21 attempts, ranking fourth in the Sun Belt in thefts.

Warren Just About 100 Percent

Senior Adam Warren has battled a hamstring injury for most of the season and it knocked the senior out of the lineup for almost five complete games and limiting his mobility for another five. The 10-day break for Middle Tennessee from April 26-May 5 was a big help for the centerfield, and it showed in his play last weekend against Florida Atlantic. Warren went 6-for-12 (.500) with four runs scored in the series. He went 2-for-4 with a run in the opener on Saturday, added another hit in the second game and had three hits, including a homer and a double, and scored three times in the finale on Sunday. For the season Warren is batting .343, second best on the squad, with six home runs, 37 RBIs and 35 runs scored in 44 contests. He also has 14 stolen bases, though none since April 7 at Arkansas-Little Rock, the day before he re-injured his hamstring.

Middle Tennessee heads to Florida International this weekend for a very important series in terms of both making the Sun Belt Tournament and seeding in the eight-team field. The Blue Raiders head into the weekend tied for third with Troy and own the tiebreaker with the Trojans after taking 2-of-3 in the first SBC series of the year. Louisiana-Lafayette (18-6) owns a four-game lead over New Orleans (14-10) in the race for first place, but from UNO in second place to Florida International in seventh (11-12), six teams have between 10 and 12 losses [Troy, Middle Tennessee (13-11), Louisiana-Monroe (14-12), Western Kentucky (12-12), Florida International (11-12)] in league play. If the tournament began today, South Alabama (9-14), Arkansas State (9-15), and Arkansas-Little Rock (8-15) would all be left out.

in the Top 5 in the Sun Belt in individual statistics. As a team Middle Tennessee ranks fifth in the league in hitting (.303), eighth in pitching (5.94) and third in fielding (.966). Kendrick ranks fifth in the Sun Belt in hitting (.393) and also is third in hits (77) and third in doubles (18). Bishop is tied for fifth in home runs as well (13). Ray ranks fourth in the league in stolen bases with 17. Reilley ranks sixth in the conference in pitching with a 3.17 ERA in 48.1 innings, posting a 4-1 record and five saves. In conference games only, Ray is tied for first in the conference in doubles (11), tied for second in stolen bases (8) and ninth in batting (.386), while Reilley ranks eighth in the league with a 3.34 ERA in 29.2 innings of work with a 2-1 mark and three saves.

In the National Statistics

Seniors Wayne Kendrick and Matt Ray and sophomore Rawley Bishop all rank in the NCAA National Statistics this week for individuals. As a team Middle Tennessee ranks 40th nationally in home runs per game (0.94), 61st in scoring (7.0) and 57th in double plays per game (0.92). The Blue Raiders have 45 home runs and 94 doubles as a team and have turned 44 double plays this season. Individually, Kendrick ranks 72nd in the country in batting average (.393) and is also 70th in doubles per game (18, 0.38) and 21st in toughest-to-strikeout (12, 16.3). Bishop is 37th nationally in home runs per game (0.28), 31st in home runs (13) and 87th in RBIs per game (1.04). Ray is tied with Kendrick for 70th in doubles per game (15, 0.38).

Bishop Makes History

Sophomore Rawley Bishop belted three home runs and collected four RBIs in Middle Tennessee's win over Belmont on April 25. Bishop became just the sixth player in school history to hit three home runs in a single game and the first since Michael McKenry did it against Florida International on May 8, 2005. The redshirt sophomore had homers in his first three at-bats of the contest, solo shots in the second and fifth innings and a two-run homer in the third.

Box Fills DH Spot

Sophomore Grant Box played sparingly in 2006 (two games to be exact), but the backup catcher has found a role this season as a hitter. Box has served as the designated hitter in seven of the last eight games, collecting six hits in 14 at-bats (.429) against Vanderbilt and South Alabama and then going 4-for-11 (364) last weekend versus Florida Atlantic. The Cordova, Tenn., native recorded three doubles and four RBIs as well as two walks, a sacrifice fly and just one strikeout in the four contests against Vandy and USA and collected a career-high three hits in Sunday's finale versus FAU. Box had a pair of doubles and three RBIs in the 11-8 victory over Vandy and added two RBIs and one run against the Owls on Sunday. For the year he is batting .333 in 28 games with 15 starts with eight runs scored, three home runs and 16 RBIs. Box has

Senior Wayne Kendrick recorded one of the best games of his career against Vanderbilt on April 18, going 3-for-4 with three runs scored and four RBIs, including his third home run of the season. Kendrick has defied the odds throughout much of his baseball career and may be the smallest three-hole hitter in college baseball, standing all of 5-foot-6, 144 pounds. The senior has followed a good junior season with an exceptional senior year, leading the Blue Raiders and ranking fifth in the Sun Belt in hitting at .393. Kendrick hit a two-run homer in the first inning and consecutive run-scoring doubles in his next two at-bats in the win over Vanderbilt. The Commodores subsequently intentionally walked Kendrick in the seventh. Two weekends ago at South Alabama the Murfreesboro, Tenn., native struggled a bit, collecting four hits in 13 at-bats with one run scored and two RBIs, but he rebounded with five hits in 11 at-bats last weekend against Florida Atlantic, including his fourth homer of the year. For the season Kendrick has 77 hits, third most in the Sun Belt, and is on pace to challenge Jeff Beachum's school record of 98 set last season. At his current pace, Kendrick would end the 56-game regular season with 90 hits and have the Sun Belt Tournament to add to his totals. Kendrick also leads the club with 18 doubles and 46 runs scored. He has added 24 walks and 35 RBIs as well. His 18 doubles rank third in the conference.

Rag-Arm Reilley

Senior Brett Reilley posted solid numbers last season after transferring from Olney Central CC in Illinois, recording a 1-1 mark and a 4.59 ERA in 19 contests, working 33.1 innings, with 16 of the 19 appearances in relief. But the righthander has been, without a doubt, the Blue Raiders best pitcher this season, tossing 48.1 innings in 26 appearances, posting a 4-1 record with five saves and a 3.17 ERA. Reilley's ERA jumped over a run after perhaps the worst outing of his career last weekend against Florida Atlantic, as the righthander allowed six runs on five hits in two-thirds of an inning. Reilley is currently sixth in the Sun Belt in pitching in all games. He has allowed just five of 22 inherited runners to score this season. Twelve of the 26 appearances have been for two innings or longer, including 6.1 innings of relief on April 8 at Arkansas-Little Rock, while the Fort Wayne, Ind., native has allowed no runs in 16 contests and zero earned runs in 18 of his 26 outings. He picked up his third save of the season with two scoreless innings against top-ranked Vanderbilt on April 18 and saved the first two games of the series at South Alabama, getting three outs on Friday and four outs on Saturday. In Sun Belt action, Reilley is 2-1 with a 3.34 ERA in 15 appearances and 29.2 innings. He has three saves and has allowed just five earned runs with opponents batting only .192.

Bullpen Used Early and Often

Middle Tennessee's bullpen has been a big reason for the team's success in 2007, posting a 10-4 mark and a 5.13 ERA so far in 2007. The bullpen has tossed 200.0 innings, just 26 innings less than the starting staff, and opponents are batting just .276 against the group. Senior Brett Reilley has been the biggest contributor to the unit's success, working in 26 of the team's games and posting a 4-1 record with a 3.17 ERA. The righthander has five saves in 48.1 innings of work, with opponents batting just .203. He has 36 strikeouts and has allowed just 17 earned runs. Reilley worked a career-long 6.1 innings in relief on March 8 at Arkansas-Little Rock, picking up his fourth win of the year. Sophomore Jordan Alvis has also been a big contributor, appearing in 22 games with a 4.59 ERA. The righthander has 25 strikeouts in 33.1 innings of work. Alvis drew his first career start last weekend against Florida Atlantic, tossing a career-long five innings. The best picture of the Blue Raider bullpen in 2007 came at South Alabama on April 21 when head coach Steve Peterson used five hurlers to get the final 12 outs, mixing and matching righties and lefties against the Jaguars. Chad Coley, Brett Smalley, Nick Marrs, Tyler Copeland and Reilley all worked in the contest, with Reilley getting the final four outs in the 6-5 victory.

Bishop Streak Ends at 21 Games

Redshirt sophomore Rawley Bishop had his 21-game hitting streak end Friday, April 6, at Arkansas-Little Rock with an 0-for-4 effort. The 21-game streak was the longest by a Blue Raider since at least 1999, surpassing the previous best of 17 games by Todd Martin in 2006. During the 21 games, the Germantown, Tenn., native batted .370 (30-for-81) with five doubles, six home runs and 25 RBIs as well as 23 runs scored and 13 walks. He had eight multi-hit and six multi-RBI contests during the 21 games, including a five RBI outing on March 14 versus Southern Illinois and a six RBI contest against Louisiana-Monroe on March 31. For the season the first baseman is batting .314 in 46 games. He has 10 doubles and is the team leader with 13 home runs and 48 RBIs as well as 29 walks and has been hit a team-leading 10 times. Bishop is tied for fifth in the Sun Belt in home runs.

Season Tidbits

Senior Wayne Kendrick is batting .443 (31-for-70) with runners in scoring position this season. Zack Barrett (20-for-54, .370) is the only other regular hitting above .324 with runners in scoring position ... The 14-inning game at Arkansas State on March 25 was the longest game for Middle Tennessee since playing 14 innings on March 20, 2005, at Missouri State. It was the longest Sun Belt contest since the Blue Raiders played 14 innings versus Louisiana-Lafayette on April 2, 2004. In the last 25 years, Middle Tennessee has never played three consecutive extra-inning games, which it did in the threegame series against ASU (10 innings on Friday and Saturday), and the 14-inning game tied for the longest in recorded school history ... Redshirt freshman Myles Ervin and senior Adam Warren both collected five hits in the March 31 victory over Louisiana-Monroe. Ervin and Warren both accomplished a feat only 15 players in school history had previously recorded, the last coming in 2006 when Jeff Beachum had five hits against Lipscomb. The Blue Raiders collected 25 hits as a team in the game, three short of the school record of 28 set in 2001 versus Lipscomb and the most since recording 22 hits at New Mexico State on April 6, 2002 ... The Blue Raider pitching staff scattered six hits in posting a 7-0 shutout at Tennessee Tech on April 4, the first shutout for the staff since winning at Southern Illinois, 9-0, on March 10, 2006, a stretch of 78 games. Before the SIU shutout last season, the last road blanking was the three straight at New Orleans on May 7-9, 2004, a string of 78 contests. In this decade, Middle Tennessee has played 198 road games and posted just 10 shutouts, including three in 2001 and four in 2004 ... Middle Tennessee was swept at home April 13-15 by New Orleans, the first sweep by an opponent at Reese Smith Field since Louisiana-Lafayette won all three games on April 26-28, 2002, a span of 20 conference series ... The Blue Raider pitching staff allowed 25 hits in the first game of the series to UNO, more than any other opponent has posted in a game since at least before 1993. The previous high was 24 by Florida International on May 18, 2002, and Clemson on May 28, 2000.

Youth is Served

After the loss of four seniors and one junior from last year's starting lineup, Middle Tennessee head coach Steve Peterson had several holes to fill heading into 2007. Because of several factors, including injuries and continued good play, Peterson has two true freshmen and at least one redshirt freshman in the lineup everyday and there have been days with even more. Freshman Blake McDade got a chance to start opening weekend in rightfield and has been one of the team's most consistent players, batting .283 in 32 starts with seven doubles, five home runs and 31 RBIs. Freshman Drew Robertson had to step in behind the plate and has been more than steady, starting 41 games, collecting six doubles with 10 RBIs and 20 runs scored. Redshirt freshman Myles Ervin has also been a big contributor, starting 34 games and batting .286 with five home runs, 26 runs scored and 20 RBIs.

Ray Voted Player of the Week

Middle Tennessee senior Matt Ray was voted the Sun Belt Player of the Week on May 23 after helping the Blue Raiders to a conference series win at South Alabama and a victory over No. 1 Vanderbilt. Ray went 7-for-14 (.500) in four games, as Middle Tennessee knocked off top-ranked Vanderbilt and won 2-of-3 at South Alabama. Ray scored seven runs, recorded three doubles and drove in four runs in the four contests. The senior went 3-for-4 with three runs scored and two RBIs in the 11-8 victory over Vanderbilt. In the series at South Alabama, Ray reached base in 10 of 16 plate appearances, collecting four hits and walking six times. He scored four runs in the series and had two RBIs.

Barrett Voted Player of the Week

Middle Tennessee third baseman Zach Barrett was voted the Sun Belt Player of the Week on March 13 after helping the Blue Raiders to three wins in four games, including a series victory

at Troy. Barrett batted .588 (10-for-17) in four games, as the Blue Raiders won 3-of-4, including a series victory at Troy to open conference play. Barrett scored four runs and drove in seven, collecting three doubles, two walks and three stolen bases. The third baseman was 4-for-5 with two doubles and five RBIs in a victory at Belmont on March 7. He then had six hits in 12 at-bats in three games at Troy, collecting a pair of hits in each game against the Trojans. Barrett scored twice and drove in a run in the opening 13-4 victory on Friday against Troy and doubled, scored once and drove in a run in Sunday's series clincher.

Robinson Voted Pitcher of the Week

Middle Tennessee's Brad Robinson was voted Sun Belt Pitcher of the Week on March 6 after tossing a no-hitter for six innings in his first career start. In just the fifth appearance of his Middle Tennessee career, Robinson took a no-hitter into the sixth inning on Sunday against Missouri State before a single to center with one out. The righthander retired 17 of the first 19 batters of the game, walking the other two. The Murfreesboro, Tenn., native worked 6.1 innings in the contest, allowing three runs on four hits with six strikeouts.

Blue Raiders Picked Sixth by Coaches

Middle Tennessee's baseball team was picked to finish sixth in the Sun Belt this season in a poll of the league's coaches released in January. The Blue Raiders finished sixth in 2006 in league play, but the Sun Belt has expanded for the 2007 campaign, with Florida Atlantic and Louisiana-Monroe full members for this season. Defending regular season and tournament champion Troy received six first-place votes and 115 total points, edging Louisiana-Lafayette for the top spot in the poll. The Ragin' Cajuns received five first-place votes and 114 total points. South Alabama (94) was third, followed by Florida Atlantic (84), Florida International (68) and the Blue Raiders in sixth with 66 points. New Orleans (60), Arkansas State (42), Western Kentucky (37), Arkansas-Little Rock (23) and Louisiana-Monroe (23) rounded out the poll.

Steve Peterson

Head Coach ● Jacksonville State/1973 ● 20th Season ● 629-497-2 (.558), 782-591-2 (.569) overall



There are many adjectives to describe the job Steve Peterson has done as Middle Tennessee's highly successful baseball coach since 1988. Coach, fundraiser, teacher, recruiter, and architect are just a few, but if you are looking for one word to sum his contributions as the Blue Raiders'

longtime skipper, try "winner."

Peterson was inducted into the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame in January 2007. He begins his 20th Blue Raider season as the school's all-time winningest coach, with 604 victories and a stockpile of conference championships and NCAA Tournament berths to his credit, demonstrating the consistency with which the driven skipper has guided the club.

Peterson's drive for excellence has resulted in consistent success and has made Middle Tennessee a model program. The veteran coach has led Middle Tennessee to 10 regular-season conference championships, eight conference tournament titles, and seven NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections in the past five years. Peterson guided the Blue Raiders to seven consecutive championships – either regular-season or tournament – during one stretch, proving Middle Tennessee doesn't rebuild, it reloads.

Peterson, who enters the 2007 season with a sterling 604-474-2 mark, has produced 12 seasons with 30 or more wins including a school-record 42 victories in 1990. He also has three campaigns of at least 40 wins including 2004's 40-22 record.

Consistent success during Peterson's tenure is a testament to his ability to recruit and develop talent, and the proof was never more evident than in 2001 – the Blue Raiders' first season in the Sun Belt Conference after years of success in the Ohio Valley.

Asked how the move into the Sun Belt, rated one of the nation's top five baseball leagues at the time and consistently a top 10 conference, would change his recruiting philosophy, Peterson quickly responded, "not at all." The 2001 Blue Raiders shared the Sun Belt championship with South Alabama after their first year in the high-profile league, and the chief contributors were many of the same players who led Middle Tennessee to the 2000 OVC championship.

The move to a higher-rated conference certainly helped Middle Tennessee's status. In their first five years in the Sun Belt, Peterson's teams have won two regular-season championships and a tournament championship and earned three NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections for the first time in school history. The 2001 squad earned national acclaim for its pitching and hitting and the season concluded with pitcher Dewon Brazelton being selected as the No. 3 overall pick of the Tampa Bay Devil Rays in the Major League Baseball First-Year Amateur Player Draft. Brazelton was one of six players from the team to earn a spot on a professional baseball roster that season.

A program cannot enjoy consistent success without quality players and Peterson, a three-time Coach of the Year, has not only made a habit of making sure Middle

Tennessee has its share of quality performers but he's also won by constantly signing prep players and developing them at the college level. He has coached a Sun Belt Player of the Year and six OVC Players of the Year, a Sun Belt Pitcher of the Year and an OVC Pitcher of the Year, two First-Team All-Americans, five Third-Team All-Americans, four Freshman All-Americans, and 43 first-team All-Conference performers.

Players who have honed their skills under Peterson also have had outstanding success continuing their careers at the professional level. Professional baseball has seen 55 former Peterson performers earning the chance to play at the game's highest level, with four making their way to the Major Leagues.

If that's not enough, Peterson's recruits have established most of the offensive records held at Middle Tennessee and four players he has developed have hit .400 or better in a season, along with the school's single-season and career home run record holders. His 1997 squad established the all-time record for batting average with a .323 clip.

Peterson's players have been solid on the field at the collegiate level and continued their careers professionally, and a large majority have taken skills and fundamentals learned at Middle Tennessee and are earning a living as coaches at various levels. Thirty-four former Blue Raiders are currently coaching at the high school, college, or professional levels.

Peterson's peers have recognized his achievements and contributions to the game by bestowing several honors on him. He was named the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association College Coach of the Year in 1992 and again in 2000. He was also inducted into the Rutherford County Old Timers Baseball Hall of Fame in 2003. Fellow coaches have named Peterson Coach of the Year on three occasions – twice in the Ohio Valley and again in 2004, his first such honor in the Sun Belt.

Peterson's outgoing and personable style has made him a hit with fans, boosters, players, and recruits alike. Baseball enthusiasts throughout the Middle Tennessee community clearly appreciate his hard-nosed and aggressive style of coaching, and as fans continue to flock to Reese Smith Field at a record pace. The Blue Raiders established a single-game attendance record in 2001 at Reese Smith Field with a crowd of 2,733 against South Alabama. The team went on to set the single-season attendance mark that year with 26,218 coming through the gates. The 2001 squad saw 15 crowds of 1,000 or more during the season. Those numbers were surpassed in 2004 when the team set a single-game attendance record of 3,020 against Vanderbilt, and set a new single-season attendance mark of 30,319, ranking 46th nationally. Fifteen contests drew more than 1,000 patrons during the record-setting campaign.

Not only has Peterson been a winner on the field but he's also been a successful fundraiser during his career. Events such as the annual Chuck Taylor Golf Tournament, the Groundhog Day Luncheon, and the Grand Slam Fish Fry in the fall have become mainstays on calendars of Blue Raider baseball supporters across middle Tennessee and have raised thousands of dollars for the improvement of Blue Raider baseball.

Peterson spearheaded the efforts to pay for the con-

struction of the Stephen B. Smith Clubhouse and Indoor Training Facility, which opened its doors in 1998. One look inside the facility shows the time and effort spent toward this endeavor. It has become known as one of the finest collegiate clubhouses and training facilities in the country.

Reese Smith Field also has benefited from Peterson's fundraising abilities. He has helped transform the park into a fan-friendly area by leading efforts to expand the seating area, add an information center just inside the gate, and improve restroom and concession facilities.

Peterson guided efforts during the summer of 2001 to enlarge the dugouts at Reese Smith Field. He is also spearheading an effort that will totally renovate the stadium beginning in June 2007. The plans call for a significant remodeling of the concession stand, improved and expanded restroom facilities, and a modern press box to accommodate radio, television, and print media.

While Peterson has spent 19 seasons leading the Middle Tennessee baseball program, his tenure with the program is much longer. He took two separate tours with the Blue Raiders as an assistant coach under John Stanford before becoming the team's head coach. During1976-78 and 1985-87, he helped the Blue Raiders win two OVC titles and four southern division crowns.

During the interim, Peterson served as head coach at Roane State Community College in Harriman, Tenn. During his tenure from 1979-84, Peterson's teams won a Tennessee state title in 1981, and he was twice named TJCAA Coach of the Year (1981, '84). While at Roane State, Peterson put together a sparkling record of 153-96 for a .614 winning percentage.

A native of Huntsville, Ala., Peterson stood out as a catcher under the legendary Rudy Abbott at Jacksonville State. He earned his bachelor's from Jacksonville State in 1983 and later earned a master's from Middle Tennessee in 1977.

Peterson is married to the former Rita Albert and the couple has three children, Jill, Jenny, and John, and two grandchildren. Away from the diamond, Peterson enjoys fishing for smallmouth bass.
