## Bivens Fires 71, Blue Raiders In Fourth

**GULF BREEZE, Fla.** - Middle Tennessee junior [Blake Bivens](#) shot his best round of golf this season, firing a sizzling 1-under-par 71 in the second round, to lead the Blue Raiders in the Emerald Coast Collegiate in Gulf Breeze, Fla., Saturday.

The Blue Raiders enter today's final round in fourth place with a two-round total of 621, three strokes behind third-place Georgia College and State University. The University of West Florida (604) leads, followed by Columbus State University (614). Middle Tennessee finished the first two rounds ahead of Valdosta State (622) and Nebraska (624).

Bivens was Middle Tennessee's top golfer Saturday with a two-round total of 153, which is tied for No. 12 overall and five strokes off the overall lead. His second-round of 71 was his top performance early in the spring season, two strokes better than the round of 73 he shot at the Rio Pinar Intercollegiate. The round of 71 also tied for the best round by a Blue Raider this spring. His strong second round followed a disappointing 82 in the first round.

"I think Bivens came back and played an excellent round of golf," Middle Tennessee coach Johnny Moore said. "He shot a 71 and was actually 3-under with three holes to go. He just had no help."

While Bivens was blistering the course during the second round of action, his Blue Raider teammates continued their struggles from the first round. Junior [Kenny Green](#) was second with a 156, which was good for No. 22 and [Chris Webb's](#) 157 tied for No. 27, but [Josh Nelms](#) and [Charlie Gibson](#) tied at No. 43 with two-round totals of 161.

The Blue Raiders had a strong shot of heading into today's final round in second entering the second round, but aside of Bivens' 71, there were few bright spots as the next three scores that counted were a combined 22-over-par.

"When you have a player shoot (71) you should shoot better than 310. That's unacceptable," Moore said. "It's a hard course, a long course, but it's not that hard. I'm not too disappointed, but we should have done better."
