Also in the first round, freshman **John Peers** won his match with Jim Brouleau of New Mexico State 6-2, 6-2.

Auburn's Lukas Maroun defeated freshman **Derrick Davison** 6-2, 6-1.

Peers rebounded in the second round of singles play defeating Auburn's Alex Petropolous 6-3, 6-2.

Peers will play the 40th ranked player in the country on Saturday.

Also in consolation play, Davison fell to Arizona State's Murilo Souza 6-3, 6-0.

Davison and Wishing fell to Arizona State's T.J. Bellama and Rebaza 8-2.
