Closer look at Tennessee

Tennessee enters the game ranked No. 7 in both the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today Top 25 polls after starting the season with consecutive wins against Temple, Arkansas-Monticello and Prairie View A&M. The Vols were ranked No. 7 in the preseason, their highest preseason ranking ever. Tennessee is led by a trio of Smiths on the roster with newcomer Tyler Smith leading the way at 13.0 ppg, followed by JaJuan Smith at 12.3 and Ramar Smith with 12.0. Wayne Chism leads Tennessee in rebounding with 7.0.

Tennessee has won five straight in tight series

Middle Tennessee and Tennessee have met six times on the hardwood with the Volunteers owning a 5-1 mark in the series. The Blue Raiders won the first-ever meeting between the two schools, 85-80, in the first round of the National Invitation Tournament March 18, 1988 in Murfreesboro. Tennessee has won five straight in the series since, including four at Thompson-Boling and one at the Gaylord Entertainment Center in Nashville. Three of the six meetings between the teams have been decided by five points or less. Tennessee won last year's contest, 83-52, in Knoxville.

Two of Bluegrass State's best go head-to-head

Two of the top prep players in the Kentucky class of 2004 will go against one another when Middle Tennessee's Demetrius Green and Tennessee's Chris Lofton square off. Green played at Catholic High School in Lexington, Ky., while Lofton prepped at Mason County High School in Maysville, Ky. Green finished runner-up to Lofton for the state's Mr. Basketball Award. Green and Lofton played against one another as their respective high schools were rivals. Green played two seasons at Daytona Beach Community College before transferring to Middle Tennessee and sitting out the 2006-07 season.

Volunteer State well represented

There are a total of 13 players from the state of Tennessee on the respective rosters for Middle Tennessee and Tennessee. The Blue Raiders have six players who hail from the Volunteer State (Nigel Johnson, Desmond Yates, Theryn Hudson, John Hopson, Broderick Gilchrest, and Josh Sain), while Tennessee has seven in-state players on the roster (Tyler Smith, JaJuan Smith, Wayne Chism, Quinn Cannington, Steven Pearl, J.P. Prince, and Rick Daniels-Mulholland).

Davis has made habit of winning in-state battles

Middle Tennessee has enjoyed tremendous success against in-state opponents under Head Coach Kermit Davis and it will look to continue the trend against Tennessee. The Blue Raiders are 18-9 (.667) overall in the 27 contests they have played against teams from Tennessee since Davis was hired in 2002, including winning 10 of the last 14.

O'Neil suffers season-ending knee injury

Middle Tennessee junior guard Calvin O'Neil will be out for the season after suffering a season-ending injury to his right knee in the opener against San Jose State. O'Neil, who is regarded as the team's top perimeter defender and leader, will take a redshirt season in 2007-08 and have two years of eligibility remaining.

Green enjoys strong Blue Raider debut

Junior guard Demetrius Green's long-awaited debut lived up the hype. Green sat out the 2006-07 season after transferring from Daytona Beach Community College but he made up for lost time with a sensational debut for the Blue Raiders. Green scored 17 points and pulled six rebounds, both game highs, against San Jose State in the season opener. He was 6-of-6 from the field, including 2-of-2 from 3-point range. His 17 points in the opener are the most by a Blue Raider in a game so far this sesaon.

Players shine in Raider debuts

While Demetrius Green made the most noise in his Blue Raider debut, he was not the only Middle Tennessee player to debut during the First Shot Exempt Tournament.

All four Blue Raider newcomers debuted in the tournament and all four scored. In addition to Green, Broderick Gilchrest and Uriah Hethington saw action against San Jose State. Gilchrest, a freshman from Memphis, played six minutes and had one point against the Spartans and Hethington, a 6-8 junior forward from Cairo, Ga., played 10 minutes and had four points. Freshman sensation Josh Sain made his debut one night later against Lipscomb and scored nine points in 13 minutes of action in his first collegiate game. Sain was 3-of-7 from the field and also added three rebounds.

Middle Tennessee offense is up in the early going

An injury-riddled Middle Tennessee offense averaged just 62.3 points per game in 2006-07 but the Blue Raider offense is clicking on all cylinders early in the 2007-08 season. Middle Tennessee is averaging 74.7 points through its first three games. The highest scoring average for a Blue Raider team under head coach Kermit Davis is 71.4 ppg in 2005-06. The most points Middle Tennessee scored in a game all of last season was 79 points and it did that in its third game this season (against Appalachian State). The Blue Raiders scored 70 or more points eight times all of last season and they have surpassed 75 points in two of their first three games already this season.

Kermit Davis File



In five seasons at Middle Tennessee, Kermit Davis has established himself as one of the most successful men's basketball coaches in program history, and he's done so while rebuilding a program that had fallen on hard times. Prior

to Davis' hiring in April, 2002, Middle Tennessee had endured losing seasons in three of the four previous years - and was one season removed from a 5-22 campaign, the worst in school history. The Blue Raiders registered four straight winning seasons under Davis to start his Blue Raider coaching career, making him only one of two of the 19 Middle Tennessee men's basketball coaches to start his Blue Raider career with four straight winning campaigns. The other was Bruce Stewart. The Blue Raiders' game against Indiana State (11/30/06) was Davis' 125th at Middle Tennessee. Davis' record after 125 games at Middle Tennessee was 71-54, making him the second-winningest coach in program history after 125 games. Davis is tied for third on the all-time Middle Tennessee wins list with 84.

Davis among leaders

Kermit Davis joined Bruce Stewart as the only head coaches in program history to begin their Blue Raider careers with four straight winning seasons in 2005-06. Davis moved into fourth on the Blue Raider career wins list with his 77th victory at UALR (01/20/07). He finished 2006-07 with 83 career victories and is one win shy of tying Randy Wiel (84) for third on the all-time Blue Raider list. Jimmy Earle is the program's all-time winningest coach with 164 wins. Davis also is third in winning percentage (.553) among Blue Raider men's basketball coaches with a minimum of 50 games coached, trailing only Jimmy Earle (.614), and Bruce Stewart (.648).

Davis produces third-best wins mark after 150 games

Kermit Davis coached in 150 games in his first five seasons as Middle Tennessee's head coach and his 83-67 mark in those contests represent the third most wins for a Blue Raider head coach in his first 150 games. Bruce Stewart (101-49) and Jimmy Earle (89) are the only former Blue Raider coaches with more wins in their first 150 games.

Davis notches 220th win

Kermit Davis secured his 220th win as a head coach when Middle Tennessee beat defending SBC champion and No. 1 seed South Alabama in the 2007 SBC quarterfinals. He owns 154 wins in nine years at the Division I level and 66 in three years in junior college.

Balance has been key for offense in early going

Middle Tennessee coach Kermit Davis appears to have more firepower in his offensive arsenal this year than he did last. Davis has used 10 Blue Raiders in each of the team's first three games and all 10 players scored in two of the contests while all 10 players he utilized in the win against Lipscomb scored. Nine of the 10 players who saw action against San Jose State scored with five players reaching double figures. All 10 players who got into the game against Lipscomb scored with nine of them scoring four points or more. All 10 players who played against Appalachian State scored with nine of them scoring six or more points.

Blue Raiders picked third in preseason Sun Belt poll

Middle Tennessee was picked to finish third in the SBC East Division in a preseason vote of the league's head coaches. The Blue Raiders received 51 points in the voting to finish behind Western Kentucky and South Alabama, respectively. Louisiana-Monroe was the favorite to win the West.

Kanaskie named to All-Sun Belt team

Middle Tennessee junior guard Kevin Kanaskie was named to the preseason All-Sun Belt Conference team, earning a spot on the third team in a vote of league coaches. He was named to the All-SBC team in 2006-07 after becoming the only player in Middle Tennessee history to lead the team in scoring (12.2), 3-point field goals made (67), and assists (185) in the same season. He led the Sun Belt in assists and assist/turnover ratio. Kanaskie scored double figures in 20 games and led the team in scoring 13 times.

Kanaskie climbing career charts

Kevin Kanaskie is starting to make a move on the Middle Tennessee career records charts with two full seasons remaining. The State College, Pa., native is ninth all-time with 272 assists and needs three more to move into eighth place. He is averaging 30.0 minutes for his career, which is 11th on the all-time list, and his 88 career 3-pointers are 10th most all time.

Blue Raider reserves making a dent

A deep bench is expected to be part of Middle Tennessee's success this season and the reserves have done their part in the early going. Middle Tennessee's bench is averaging 29 points per game in the first three contests. The reserves have shot 31-of-62 (50 percent) from the field and they are 7-of-20 (35 percent) from 3-point range. They are also averaging 12.3 rebounds. This total includes Demetrius Green's 17 points in the opener when he came off the bench. Freshman reserve Josh Sain is averaging 10 points per contest.

Middle Tennessee, WKU in Sun Belt Classic

Middle Tennessee and Western Kentucky will be featured live on national television when they play host to the Sun Belt Classic Dec. 15 at the Sommet Center in Nashville. Middle Tennessee will face Memphis at 6 p.m., in a game that will be televised on ESPN2, while WKU faces Tennessee at 8:30 p.m., on ESPNU. Officials at Middle Tennessee and Western Kentucky are expecting sellouts for the Sun Belt Classic.

Blue Raiders ink two during NCAA Early Signing Period

Middle Tennessee signed two players to national letters of intent during the NCAA Early Signing Period, which began Wednesday (11/14). The Blue Raiders landed in-state prospect DeMario Williams from Culleoka High School, and they also signed Aundra Williams, a highly-regarded forward from Orlando, Fla. DeMario Williams is a top-10 prospect in Tennessee and he averaged 18 points, eight assists and eight rebounds in 2006-07. The 6-3 point guard is a two-time Mr. Basketball Finalist. He is one of two players to be named Mr. Basketball Finalist in Tennessee as a sophomore and junior. The other was former North Carolina standout and NBA first-round pick Brandan Wright. Aundra Williams is a 6-8, 235-pound forward at Boone High in Orlando, Fla. He was rated a top-50 Florida prospect by Hoopscoop and the ABA team Miami Tropics' recruiting service.

Veteran Blue Raider squad still has room to grow

Middle Tennessee coach Kermit Davis will put his most experienced team on the court this winter with eight returning players who have combined to play in 297 college basketball games and earn 140 combined starts. While veteran leadership is evident the unit still has plenty of room to mature and continue to develop as there are no seniors on the roster. The Blue Raider breakdown includes six juniors, four sophomores, and two freshmen.

Yates looking to surpass outstanding rookie season

Desmond Yates enjoyed a breakout freshman season for Middle Tennessee and he believes the invaluable experience he gained as a rookie will enable him to have an even stronger sophomore campaign. Yates proved to be one of the best true freshmen to play for the Blue Raiders as he averaged right at 11 points, started 18 games and played in all 32. Yates had 19 double-figure scoring games and he led the team in scoring 10 times. In order to continue to improve and elevate his game Yates needs to become more of a force on the boards. The 6-foot-7 forward averaged 3.4 rebounds as a freshman.

Outshooting foes has been key

Outshooting the opposition does not guarantee victory for Middle Tennessee but it is a trend that comes as close to perfection as any under coach Kermit Davis. The Blue Raiders are 71-7 overall under Davis when the shooting percentage is higher than the opponent. Middle Tennessee had won 29 straight when outshooting the opposition before suffering a 75-69 overtime setback to Toledo last season, despite shooting 58 percent from the field. Overall, Middle Tennessee has won 44 of the last 49 games played when it has a higher shooting percentage than the opposition.

Did you know?

Middle Tennessee has hit at least one 3-pointer in 339 consecutive games. The last time the Blue Raiders failed to hit a shot from beyond the arc was Jan. 20, 1996 at Morehead State.
