

Blue Raiders Drop Final Game of Kennesaw Classic

Whittney Padgett hits first career homerun

KENNESAW, Ga. - Brittney Banania and Whittney Padgett continued their strong starts to their Middle Tennessee careers but the Blue Raiders (1-3, 0-0) could not get it going offensively as they lost 7-1 to host Kennesaw State (4-0, 0-0) in the final game of the Kennesaw State Classic on Saturday evening. Kellie Head (1-1) made her second career start and picked up the loss for the Blue Raiders. The young pitcher allowed three earned runs on 11 hits and struck out one in the complete game. Brittany Matthews (3-0) got the win for the Owls, allowing one run on four hits while striking out 13 in seven innings of action. Kennesaw State took an early lead in the 1st inning off a Jessica Cross homerun to center field. The game remained with the Owls up by a run until the 5th inning when Jenna Closner nailed a grand slam homerun to straight



centerfield to make it 5-0. Kennesaw State added two more runs in the 6th inning to make it 7-0 before Whittney Padgett belted a two out homerun to deep right field, the first of her career. Banania was two-for-three to improve her weekend batting average to .417.
