## Adade, Cox Lead Tracksters at Yellowjacket Raiders run again next week at Auburn

**MURFREESBORO, Tenn.** - Junior Samuel Adade won the 100-meters and sophomore Brittany Cox regionally qualified in the shot put, leading Middle Tennessee's track teams Saturday at the rain-shortened Yellowjacket Invitational in Atlanta, Ga.

What started out as a beautiful day in Atlanta quickly turned to rain and lightning, delaying the event three times before officials finally ended the meet after another lightning delay.

Adade won the 100-meters in 10.76, while junior Carl Morgan and senior Carlos Morgan finished seventh and eighth, respectively, with times of 11.11 and 11.15.

Cox placed third in the shot put with a mark of 48-3.5, almost four feet better than last week's mark at the Clemson Relays. Sophomore MeLyn Thompson just missed regionally qualifying for the second straight week, finishing seventh with a mark of 46-3.25.

Freshman Festus Chemaoui placed third in the 3000-meter steeplechase in 9:45.18 and senior Matthew Young was eighth in 10:56.58.

Carlos Morgan finished fourth in the long jump with a mark of 23-2 and Carl Morgan was fifth with a mark of 22-7.75.

Junior TraMayne Gillyard placed fifth in the 400-meters in 55.86.


"We did well for what we were able to run," head coach Dean Hayes said. "Sammy had a good 100 and Brittany regionally qualified in the shot put. It was unfortunate because it started out a great day but that changed quickly."
