Notes: The Blue Raiders are on a six-game win streak after trouncing Tennessee 13-6 in Winchester, Tenn., on Tuesday. This is the second time this season the Blue Raiders have won six straight after beginning the season 6-0-1. The Blue Raiders began the win streak by defeating both Lipscomb and Belmont and sweeping Florida International in its weekend series. Middle Tennessee had its first sweep over a conference opponent since 2005 when it swept New Mexico State. The Blue Raiders won two of the three games against FIU in the top of the 10th inning including two home runs. One home run was by freshman Tyler Burnett for the win on Saturday and the other by junior Rawley Bishop which padded the lead going into the bottom of the inning.

SCOUTING THE GOVERNORS (16-18)

Austin Peay defeated Belmont 10-7 on Tuesday before entering tonight's game. APSU is 5-7 in Ohio Valley conference play.

Series: Middle Tennessee leads the all-time series 76-35; Peterson is 41-19 against the Governors. The Blue Raiders won the last meeting 5-4 on April 10, 2007.

LEAGUE ACTION

The Blue Raiders improved to 9-8 in Sun Belt Conference play with their sweep of Florida International over the weekend. Middle Tennessee

The week before UL-Lafayett won the series 2-1. Middle Tennessee rebounded to win the series 2-1 over Arkansas-Little Rock the week before after being swpet by Florida Atlantic. Middle Tennessee won the series over Arkansas State a week earlier 2-1 to improve to 3-2 in league play. In its first Sun Belt series against New Orleans wintry weather cancelled the Friday and Saturday games so the Blue Raiders played a double-header on Sunday.

BEST START TO A SEASON

The Blue Raiders had their best start in recorded history with a 10-4-1 record. Prior to 2008 Middle Tennessee's best start to a season was in 1990 when the Blue Raiders were 11-4 15 games into the season.

800 WINS AND COUNTING

Head coach Steve Peterson notched the 800th win of his career on Friday, March 28 against UALR. In 26 seasons, Peterson has amassed a record of 808-612-3. Peterson is reached the 650 wins milestone at Middle Tennessee with the win over Lipscomb on Tuesday. In 20 seasons, Peterson has a record of 655-516-3.

INCLEMENT/WINTRY WEATHER

Weather has been an issue for the Blue Raiders in 2008 as seven games have been affected in some way.

Middle Tennessee lost one game against Southern Illinois because of rain. Then in its first conference series with New Orleans lost one game because of snow and played a Sunday doubleheader.

On Wednesday, March 19 the game at Austin Peay was rescheduled because of inclement weather in the state of Tennessee. Middle Tennessee had

more weather issues in its three-game series with Florida Atlantic. Play was suspended on Saturday in the third inning because of inclement weather in Boca Raton. Then Sunday after finishing game two game and playing six innings of game three the game was called because of inclement weather.

Against UALR play was suspended again for Middle Tennessee on Saturday in the bottom of the third but the Blue Raiders rebounded to take a 34-8 win after play resumed. In its series against UL-Lafayette the Blue Raiders played a Saturday doubleheader after Friday's game had to be postponed due to inclement weather.

LENGTHY GAMES

Middle Tennessee has played 21 games this season that have lasted over three hours. The Blue Raiders are 10-11 when a game is longer than three hours. Middle Tennessee's longest game in two years was in its 12-10 loss to No. 9 Vanderbilt which lasted five hours and five minutes.

BURNETT'S HOT BAT COINCIDES WITH TEAM'S WIN STREAK

Freshman Tyler Burnett has hit his stride in the last 10 games batting .444 with 16 hits, four doubles, three home runs, nine RBI and 10 runs scored. This includes the two extra inning games

where Burnett hit a two-run shot to centerfield in the top of the 10th inning to give the Blue Raiders a 9-7 win over Florida International on Saturday. Burnett stepped to the plate in the top of the eighth and hit a two-run blast to right field tying the game at 6 which would force the extra inning on Friday. In the win over Tennessee, Burnett led the way going 3 for 4 with a home run, double, one RBI, scored two runs and a stolen base. The team has won six straight during this stretch.

EXTRA BASES

Middle Tennessee has 153 extra base hits in 2008. Among those hits are 84 doubles, 14 of which have been recorded by junior Nathan Hines. The Blue Raiders have 59 home runs on the season with freshman Bryce Brentz leading the way with 11. Sophomore Zach Hudson, juniors Taylor Dennis and Grant Box and freshmen Hunter Dawson and Bryce Brentz each have one triple on the season, while Hines has three and sophomore Blake McDade has two.

HITTING STREAKS

Junior Nathan Hines' hit streak ended at 13 as he did not get a hit in Saturday's game against Arkansas State. Junior Taylor Dennis has the longest active hitting streak on the team as he has hit in 13

JUNIOR LEADERSHIP

Junior Nathan Hines leads the Blue Raiders in doubles with 13 and is tied for second in home runs with nine as he is batting .391 with 61 hits in 156 at bats. Hines has driven in 36 runs, scored 35 more and has three triples.

DOUBLE PLAY KINGS

Middle Tennessee has turned 35 double plays in 2008. Nine of those came in its sweep of FIU in which the Blue Raiders turned four double plays on Friday and Sunday. SInce beginning the six-game win streak Middle Tennessee has turned 12 double plays.

MOVE TO WINCHESTER

Middle Tennessee has moved three of its games to Gamble Sports Complex in Winchester, Tenn. The Blue Raiders will play Tennessee on April 15 at 6 p.m. and its twogame series with Mississippi State on May 6-7 in Winchester.

Loel E. Bennett Stadium at Gamble Sports Complex was originally built for an independent minor league baseball team, the Tennessee Tomahawks, who played in Winchester from 1996 to 1998.

SERIES SWEEP

Middle Tennessee swept a conference opponent for the first time since 2001 as it took three from Florida International, two in extra innigs. The Blue Raiders last swept a Sun Belt series was May 20-22, 2001 against New Mexico State.

The Blue Raiders were swept by Florida Atlanic in their first conference series loss on the road since it lost the series to Western Kentucky on May 17-19, 2007. The last time Middle Tennessee was swept in a series by a Sun Belt opponent was April 13-15, 2007 against New Orleans.

KILLER B's

Four players whose last names begin with the letter B have all performed well for the Blue Raiders both offensively and defensivley. Senior Zach Barrett and junior Rawley Bishop anchor the infield with assistance from freshman Tyler Burnett at short stop while freshman Bryce Brentz has been a staple in left field. Senior Doug Birkofer and sophomore Grant Box have added assistance this season

On Sunday against Florida Atlantic all six of these players started for the Blue Raiders as just four players on the field had last names starting with a letter other than B. Of those six players five were in the infield to start the game - Barrett (3rd), Bishop (1st), Barrett (SS), Box (C), Brentz (P).

Barrett currently leads this group as he is batting .382 with five home runs, 13 doubles, 29 RBI and 38 runs scored. Brentz leads this bunch as well as the team in stolen bases as he is 8 for 8.

OFF THE BENCH

Sophomore Zach Hudson started both of Middle Tennessee's mid-week games in left field and has contributed at the plate. In those two games Hudson batted .667 with six hits, two doubles, one triple, three RBI and has scored two runs. Hudson had a slugging percentage of 1.111 with 10 total bases.

In 19 games, he is batting .370 with 17 hits including one home run, one triple, six doubles, seven RBI and has scored 17 runs. Defensively he has thrown out four runners trying to steal with four assists and 22 putouts.

Two-Way Player

Freshman Bryce Brentz ended his first collegiate weekend batting .500 as he was 6 for 12 with eight RBI, two doubles, two home runs and scored two runs. He had a slugging percentage of 1.167 with 14 total bases. Against Jacksonville State on Sunday, Brentz was 4 for 5 with five RBI, one home run, one double and scored two runs.

Brentz is now batting .307 with 35 hits in 114 at bats and leads the team in home runs with 11. Brentz also has seven doubles, one triple, 37 RBI and has scored 27 runs.

Brentz has been successful on the mound as well posting his first career win. Brentz allowed three hits in 6 2/3 shutout innings of work against UALR. Currently, Brentz leads the pitching staff with a 2.20 ERA as he has allowed nine runs, seven earned on 18 hits in 28.2 innings of work. He has also struck out 23 batters and given up just one home run. Batters are hitting just .178 against him.

RANDOM

Exactly seven years after Josh Renick hit a home run to begin the game against Cumberland on April 11, 2001, Nathan Hines did the same thing. Hines hit a home run to begin the series against Florida International on April 11, 2008.

DEAN STRONG AT PLATE

Junior Zach Dean is currently batting .333 with 27 hits in 81 at bats. He is third on the team in home runs with eight and has six doubles, 24 RBI and has scored 14 runs.

In his first start of the season, Dean went two for two in his first two at bats of the season. In those plate appearances, Dean had a two-run home run and an RBI single. Dean also scored two runs as he ended the day 3 for 4. Last week in games against Tennessee and Arkansas State, Dean was 5 for 11 with two doubles and three RBI as he batted .455.

Two-Sport Starter

Junior Joe Craddock became the first Middle Tennessee student-athlete since 1989-90 to start a game in two different revenue producing sports. In 2007, Craddock started the football season at quarterback but was sidelined with an injury for a few weeks and then split time at the position upon his return. Craddock received his first baseball start at second base on Saturday, March 1 in the second game of a double header. Craddock went 1 for 2 with a single in his first start. Mike Caldwell was the last Middle Tennessee student-athlete to start a game in more than one revenueproducing sport. In 1989-90 he started games in football, basketball and baseball.

TIE GAMES

The Blue Raiders tied 6-6 with Tennessee Tech on Tuesday, Feb. 26. The game was called in the middle of the seventh inning by the umpires because of weather in the area. Middle Tennessee has not had a game end in a tie since 1989 when Peterson's team tied with North Alabama in the third game of the season, 4-4. There were just six tie games in Blue Raider history prior to the game against the Golden Eagles.

SEASON OPENERS

Since 1974 the Blue Raiders are 18-19 in season openers. Under head coach Steve Peterson Middle Tennessee is 12-11 in season openers. Middle Tennessee has won two of its last three season openers which were all against Jacksonville State (2006 and 2008). Prior to 2006 the longest win streak in a season opener was from 2001 to 2002 when the Blue Raiders won two straight. Middle Tennessee won three straight season openers from 1983 to 1985 which is the longest season opening win streak in school history.

Young Arms

Sophomores Kenneth Roberts and Chad Edwards and freshmen Michael Adamson, Bryce Brentz and PJ Francescon have all seen action on the mound for Middle Tennessee early in the season.

Roberts recieved Middle Tennessee's first win as he pitched six shutout innings with just three hits and striking out four. Roberts currently has an ERA of 4.35 with a 4-2 record in eight appearances. Roberts has 24 strikeouts in 39.1 innings of work.

Edwards is 2-1 with a 5.34 ERA in 12 appearances. Edwards has struck out 15 in 30.1 innings of work.

The Blue Raiders have used nine pitchers in 2008 who are sophomores and freshmen.

TENNESSEE NATIVE

30 of Middle Tennessee's 39 student-athletes hail from the state of Tennessee. Seven of those 30 are from Murfresseboro and one is from La Vergne in Rutherford County.

BLUE RAIDERS BY CLASS

There are just four seniors on this year's squad. 11 juniors complete the list of upperclassmen while 11 sophomores and 13 freshmen compose the rest of the team.

SEEING DOUBLE

There are 10 players who have duplicate names on the 2008 roster. Three are named Tyler (Acker, Burnett, Hyde), and Zach (Barrett, Dawson, Dean) while two others are named Matt (Doss and Yurus) and Chad (Coley and Edwards).

DUAL-SPORT

In addition to playing baseball, freshman Wes Caldwell and junior Joe Craddock also play football for the Blue Raiders. Caldwell, a wide receiver, played in six games during the 2007 season. In 2007, Craddock started the season at quarterback but was sidelined with an injury for a few weeks and then split time at the position upon his return.

CALLED UP TO THE BIGS

Former Blue Raider standout Brett Carroll has made the 40-man roster of the Florida Marlins to begin the 2008 Major League Baseball season. Carrol has played in four games this season for the Marlins. He has a triple, an RBI and has scored one run in eight at bats.

BISHOP RECEIVES PRESEASON HONORS

Junior Rawley Bishop was named to the Preseason All-Sun Belt team as announced by the conference office on Feb. 12. In 2007, Bishop was voted Second Team All-Sun Belt and to the SBC Championships All-Tournament team as he batted .329 with 15 doubles and 17 homers, tying for sixth on the single-season home run charts. He also recorded a team-high 65 RBIs, ranking sixth in the single-season record books, and added 54 runs scored, second most on the club. Bishop had a 21-game hitting streak, the longest of his career and longest by any Blue Raider in at least a decade.

Bishop was also named to the pre-season release of the 2008 Brooks Wallace Player of the Year Award Watch List. The Wallace Award is presented to the nation's top collegiate baseball player in conjunction with the College Baseball Hall of Fame's annual induction festivities.

Bishop is one of just three Sun Belt players named to the 2008 Brooks Wallace Player of the Year Award Watch List. Florida Atlantic's William Block and Mike McKenna were also named to the list.

CONSTRUCTION ZONE

The home of the Blue Raiders, Reese Smith Field, is undergoing extensive renovations. The former dugouts have been removed and replaced with larger and roomier versions. The old metal bleachers installed in 1989 were also removed and will be replaced by newer versions. The seating area will be extended and raised over the dugouts, more like a minor league stadium and will include increased chairback seating. The former press box will also be replaced by a permanent structure at the top of the stands which will include a television booth, radio booth and press area.

Construction crews are working on the columns for the stands, elevator shaft and press box support as well as the backstop wall. Crews are laying brick on the elevator shaft and dugouts as well as the columns around the concourse. This week crews began the steel work that will support the press box and stands.

During the season, the press box and game operations will run out of a univeristy shuttle bus, Blue Raider Express. The seats will be removed and replaced with tables and chairs. Fans will watch the action from left and centerfields in the football stadium concourse. Bleachers are being brought into the football stadium so fans will have a comfortable way to watch the action.

Steve Peterson

Head Coach • Jacksonville State/1973 • 21st Season • 633-500-2 (.558), 786-594-2 (.569) overall



There are many adjectives to describe the job Steve Peterson has done as Middle Tennessee's highly successful baseball coach since 1988. Coach, fundraiser, teacher, recruiter, and architect are just a few, but if you are looking for one word to sum his contributions as the Blue Raiders' longtime skipper, try "winner."

Peterson begins his 20th Blue Raider season as the school's all-time winningest coach, with 636

victories and a stockpile of conference championships and NCAA Tournament berths to his credit, demonstrating the consistency with which the driven skipper has guided the club.

Peterson's drive for excellence has resulted in consistent success and has made Middle Tennessee a model program. The veteran coach has led Middle Tennessee to 10 regular-season conference championships, eight conference tournament titles, and seven NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections in the past six years. Peterson guided the Blue Raiders to seven consecutive championships – either regular-season or tournament – during one stretch, proving Middle Tennessee doesn't rebuild, it reloads.

Peterson, who enters the 2008 season with a sterling 636-502-2 mark, has produced 13 seasons with 30 or more wins including a school-record 42 victories in 1990. He also has three campaigns of at least 40 wins including 2004's 40-22 record.

Consistent success during Peterson's tenure is a testament to his ability to recruit and develop talent, and the proof was never more evident than in 2001 – the Blue Raiders' first season in the Sun Belt Conference after years of success in the Ohio Valley.

Asked how the move into the Sun Belt, rated one of the nation's top five baseball leagues at the time and consistently a top 10 conference, would change his recruiting philosophy, Peterson quickly responded, "not at all." The 2001 Blue Raiders shared the Sun Belt championship with South Alabama after their first year in the high-profile league, and the chief contributors were many of the same players who led Middle Tennessee to the 2000 OVC championship.

The move to a higher-rated conference certainly helped Middle Tennessee's status. In their first five years in the Sun Belt, Peterson's teams have won two regular-season championships and a tournament championship and earned three NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections for the first time in school history. The 2001 squad earned national acclaim for its pitching and hitting and the season concluded with pitcher Dewon Brazelton being selected as the No. 3 overall pick of the Tampa Bay Devil Rays in the Major League Baseball First-Year Amateur Player Draft. Brazelton was one of six players from the team to earn a spot on a professional baseball roster that season.

A program cannot enjoy consistent success without quality players and Peterson, a three-time Coach of the Year, has not only made a habit of making sure Middle Tennessee has its share of quality performers but he's also won by constantly signing prep players and developing them at the college level. He has coached a Sun Belt Player of the Year and six OVC Players of the Year, a Sun Belt Pitcher of the Year and an OVC Pitcher of the Year, two First-Team All-Americans, five Third-Team All-Americans, four Freshman All-Americans, and 43 first-team All-Conference performers.

Players who have honed their skills under Peterson also have had outstanding success continuing their careers at the professional level. Professional baseball has seen 55 former Peterson performers earning the chance to play at the game's highest level, with four making their way to the Major Leagues.

If that's not enough, Peterson's recruits have established most of the offensive records held at Middle Tennessee and four players he has developed have hit .400 or better in a season, along with the school's single-season and career home run record holders. His 1997 squad established the all-time record for batting average with a .323 clip.

Peterson's players have been solid on the field at the collegiate level and continued their careers professionally, and a large majority have taken skills and fundamentals learned at Middle Tennessee and are earning a living as coaches at various levels. Thirty-four former Blue Raiders are currently coaching at the high school, college, or professional levels.

Peterson's peers have recognized his achievements and contributions to the game by bestowing several honors on him. He was named the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association College Coach of the Year in 1992 and again in 2000. He was also inducted into the Rutherford County Old Timers Baseball Hall of Fame in 2003. In 2007, Peterson was inducted into the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame.

Fellow coaches have named Peterson Coach of the Year on three occasions – twice in the Ohio Valley and again in 2004, his first such honor in the Sun Belt.

Peterson's outgoing and personable style has made him a hit with fans, boosters, players, and recruits alike. Baseball enthusiasts throughout the Middle Tennessee community clearly appreciate his hardnosed and aggressive style of coaching, and as fans continue to flock to Reese Smith Field at a record pace. The Blue Raiders established a single-game attendance record in 2001 at Reese Smith Field with a crowd of 2,733 against South Alabama. The team went on to set the single-season at-

tendance mark that year with 26,218 coming through the gates. The 2001 squad saw 15 crowds of 1,000 or more during the season. Those numbers were surpassed in 2004 when the team set a single-game attendance record of 3,020 against Vanderbilt, and set a new single-season attendance mark of 30,319, ranking 46th nationally. Fifteen contests drew more than 1,000 patrons during the record-setting campaign.

Not only has Peterson been a winner on the field but he's also been a successful fundraiser during his career. Events such as the annual Chuck Taylor Golf Tournament, the Groundhog Day Luncheon, and the Grand Slam Fish Fry in the fall have become mainstays on calendars of Blue Raider baseball supporters across middle Tennessee and have raised thousands of dollars for the improvement of Blue Raider baseball.

Peterson spearheaded the efforts to pay for the construction of the Stephen B. Smith Clubhouse and Indoor Training Facility, which opened its doors in 1998. One look inside the facility shows the time and effort spent toward this endeavor. It has become known as one of the finest collegiate clubhouses and training facilities in the country.

Reese Smith Field has also benefited from Peterson's fundraising abilities. He has helped transform the park into a fan-friendly area by leading efforts to expand the seating area, add an information center just inside the gate, and improve restroom and concession facilities.

Peterson guided efforts during the summer of 2001 to enlarge the dugouts at Reese Smith Field. He is also spearheading an effort that will totally renovate the stadium beginning in June 2007. The plans call for a significant remodeling of the concession stand, improved and expanded restroom facilities, and a modern press box to accommodate radio, television, and print media.

While Peterson has spent 20 seasons leading the Middle Tennessee baseball program, his tenure with the program is much longer. He took two separate tours with the Blue Raiders as an assistant coach under John Stanford before becoming the team's head coach. During 1976-78 and 1985-87, he helped the Blue Raiders win two OVC titles and four southern division crowns.

During the interim, Peterson served as head coach at Roane State Community College in Harriman, Tenn. During his tenure from 1979-84, Peterson's teams won a Tennessee state title in 1981, and he was twice named TJCAA Coach of the Year (1981, '84). While at Roane State, Peterson put together a sparkling record of 153-96 for a .614 winning percentage.

A native of Huntsville, Ala., Peterson stood out as a catcher under the legendary Rudy Abbott at Jacksonville State. He earned his bachelor's from Jacksonville State in 1973 and later earned a master's from Middle Tennessee in 1977.

Peterson is married to the former Rita Albert and the couple has three children, Jill, Jenny, and John, and two grandchildren. Away from the diamond, Peterson enjoys fishing for smallmouth bass.
