We will cover all areas of the game, from offense, defense, special teams, strength and conditioning, all the way to the equipment that is worn. The clinic will begin with a highlight video and a welcome from Coach Stockstill before being turned over to the offensive coaches to teach the positions of offensive line, wide receivers, running backs, and quarterbacks.

Following lunch in the stadium pressbox, the defensive coaches will go over the defensive line, linebackers, safeties, and special teams.

The clinic will conclude with a tour of the Sports Medicine Department, the weight room, locker room, and stadium.
