Lady Raiders tied for 5th after 18 holes

TUSCALOOSA, Ala. - Fighting a tough course and windy conditions, Middle Tennessee's women's golf team opened the fall season with a solid 320 to stand in a tie for fifth place at the Alabama/Ann Rhoads Intercollegiate. The 14-team event is being held at the par 72 Ol' Colony Golf Course.

"The conditions today really kept the scores down and I was very pleased with the way our girls handled the situation," said Head Coach Rachael Short. "We put ourselves in a good situation to move up with tomorrow's final round. A top five here would be great because of the tough field and challenging course."

Senior [Kristin Lynch](#) (Tullahoma, Tenn.) picked up where she left off in the spring by pacing the Lady Raiders with a 75 on Monday. Lynch's effort has her tied for sixth overall. True freshman [Taryn Durham](#) (Glasgow, Kent.) carded a 79 to tie for 19th.

Sophomore [Maggie McGill](#) and freshman [Jamey Dillard](#) had a pair of 83s to tie for 38th, while senior [Kemmerlee Pennington](#) completed the scoring with an 87.

The Lady Raiders will tee off Tuesday morning for the final round of the 36-hole event. The tournament was shortened to 36 holes due to Hurricane Ivan.
