**LEXINGTON, Ky.** - Junior [Alex McCann](#) won his first match of the ITA Southeast Championships hosted by the University of Kentucky on Friday.

McCann began the tournament by defeating Kennesaw State's Michael Langel 7-5, 6-4. In the second round, McCann fell to Florida's Dan Cash 6-2, 6-2.

In the doubles quarterfinals, sophomores [John Peers](#) and [Richard Cowden](#) fell to top-seeded Jamie Hunt and Nate Schnugg of Georgia, who are currently fourth in the country, 8-5.

Cowden fell to Sebastian Carlsson of LSU 6-4, 6-3 in his singles match.

Sophomore [Kyle Wishing](#) fell to LSU's James Cluskey, who is seeded 17th in the tournament, 6-2, 6-1.

Peers, who is currently 90th in the country, fell to Julien Gauthier of LSU 7-6, 4-6, 7-6 in the second round of play after receiving a bye in the first round.
