This Week in Blue Raider Baseball...

Middle Tennessee will look to continue its four-game win streak as it faces Tennessee Tech in its second midweek match-up before playing host to Jacksonville State for the weekend. The Blue Raiders defeated Belmont 12-10 in the 10th inning after a double by sophomore Justin Miller drove in the winning runs. Freshman Brett Wilson recorded the win in his first outing for Middle Tennessee while junior Coty Woods picked up his second consecutive save.

Scouting the Golden Eagles...

Tennessee Tech began the 2009 season 3-1 as it played a four-game series with St. Peters College. Evan Webb and Heath Cheverton batted .533 on the weekend to guide the Golden Eagles. Both players had four doubles while Webb had five RBI and scored seven runs.

Series: MT leads the series 71-30-1; Peterson is 36-20-1 against TTU.

Last Meeting: Middle Tennessee lost the last meeting 15-11 on March 25, 2008.

Scouting the Gamecocks...

Jacksonville State opened the season 0-3 after being swept by Appalachian State. Then in their only midweek game the Gamecocks lost a 10-4 decision to UAB.

Steven Leach is guiding JSU at the plate as he is the only one batting over .400. Leach is batting .471 with eight hits, two doubles, one triple and three RBI. On the mound, the Gamecocks' Tanner Freshour has worked eight innings in two appearances allowing five runs on five hits and five strikeouts with an 0-1 record.

Series: MT leads the series 22-13; Peterson is 19-10 against the Gamecocks.

Last Meeting: Middle Tennessee swept the series to open the 2008 season.

Hot Bats...

Junior Drew Robertson batted .727 after the first weekend of action with eight hits, three doubles and drove in four runs. Robertson is now batting .625 with five doubles and has just four hits less to open the season than he did total for the 2008 season.

There are currently six of Middle Tennessee's starters who are batting .300 or

better. Five of those six are batting above .400.

Junior Blake McDade is batting .526 with 10 hits, two doubles, nine RBI and has scored nine runs.

Double Duty...

Sophomore Bryce Brentz started the 2009 season on the mound for the Blue Raiders notching the first win after allowing one run on two hits in five innings of work. Brentz then moved to the designated hitter position after being relieved on the mound. Brentz then hit a three-run home run in his second at bat of the game. Brentz ended the weekend hitting .333 with four hits, three RBI and scored two runs.

Freshman Justin Guidry also pulled double duty over the weekend beginning in left field on Friday and then pitching two innings of relief on Sunday.

Preseason Honors...

Senior Nathan Hines and sophomore Bryce Brentz were named to the Sun Belt Preseason team as outfielders. Brentz

received a number of postseason awards including Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-America, NCBWA Freshman All-America, 2008 Ping! All-Freshman First Team and ABCA First Team All-Region after putting together a stellar freshman campaign.

800 Wins and Counting...

Head coach Steve Peterson notched the 800th win of his career on Friday, March 28 against UALR. In 27 seasons, Peterson has amassed a record of 819-627-3. Peterson reached the 650 wins milestone at Middle Tennessee with the win over Lipscomb on April 8. In 21 seasons, Peterson has a record of 666-531-3.

Win Percentage...

In the last 35 years of Middle Tennessee baseball history head coach Steve Peterson has accounted for 65% of the program's wins.

Season Openers...

Since 1974 the Blue Raiders are 19-19 in season openers. Under head coach Steve Peterson Middle Tennessee is 13-11 in season openers. Middle Tennessee has won three of its last four season openers. Prior to 2006 the longest win streak in a season opener was from 2001 to 2002 when the Blue Raiders won two straight. Middle Tennessee won three straight season openers from 1983 to 1985 which is the longest season opening win streak in school history.

No Place Like Home...

Middle Tennessee will play 34 games at Reese Smith Field this season after competing in 25 last season after having games cancelled due to weather and moved because of construction. The Blue Raiders will also play nine of their first 10 games at home which is the most to begin a season since 2003, when they played their first six games at home.

2008 Season Recap..

Middle Tennessee ended the season on a four-game losing streak including two hard losses in the Sun Belt Tournament. Middle Tennessee lost eight of its last nine games of the season. Prior to that streak the Blue Raiders had won five of six games. Middle Tennessee stayed consistent until the end of the season winning as many as seven straight which included a win over Tennessee.

The Blue Raiders did have their best start in recorded history with a 10-4-1 record. Prior to 2008 Middle Tennessee's best start to a season was in 1990 when the Blue Raiders were 11-4 15 games into the season.

Tennessee Native...

30 of Middle Tennessee's 35 student-athletes hail from the state of Tennessee. Seven of those 30 are from Murfreesboro and one is from La Vergne in Rutherford County. Two attended Riverdale High School while another four played at Oakland.

Blue Raiders by Class...

There seven seniors on this year's squad. 12 juniors complete the list of upperclassmen while 10 sophomores and six freshmen compose the rest of the team.

Seeing Double...

There are 11 players who have duplicate names on the 2008 roster. Three are named Tyler (Acker, Burnett, Hyde) while the others are named Zach (Hudson, Dean), Brett (Smalley, Wilson), Matt (Doss, Yurus) and Chad (Coley, Edwards).

Dual-Sport...

In addition to playing baseball, redshirt freshman Wes Caldwell also plays football for the Blue Raiders. Caldwell, a wide receiver, played in all 12 games during the 2008 season. Caldwell had 27 receptions for 265 yards averaging 9.8 yards per catch.

Record Breakers...

Three current Blue Raiders found their way onto the career and single-season record books with their performances in 2008.

Senior Rawley Bishop holds the career record for hit by pitch (31) and is third on the career list for slugging percentage (.630). Bishop is also fourth in home runs (39), RBI (156) and second in putouts (1,260). He has also topped the single-season records in RBI (3rd), home runs (tied-5th), total bases (3rd) and putouts (4th).

Senior Nathan Hines is tied for 10th on the career list for triples (7). Hines holds the single-season record for at bats (253). He is tied for fifth on the single-season list for triples (5) and ranks 11 on the single-season list for hits (87).

In just his first season, freshman Bryce Brentz is tied for fourth on the single-season list for RBI (68) and tied in home runs (18) for fifth.

Construction Zone...

The home of the Blue Raiders, Reese Smith Field, underwent extensive renovations during the 2008 season. The former dugouts were removed and replaced with larger and roomier versions. The old metal bleachers installed in 1989 were also removed and replaced by newer versions. The seating area was extended and raised over the dugouts, more like a minor league stadium and includes increased chairback seating. The former press box was also replaced by a permanent structure at the top of the stands which includes a television booth, radio booths and press area in addition to two luxury suites.

The Blue Raiders played at home as scheduled with the exception of a few games that were moved due to construction issues. The press box and game operations were run out of a university shuttle bus, Blue Raider Express. The seats were removed and replaced with tables and chairs. Fans watched games from left and centerfields in the football stadium concourse. Bleachers were brought into the football stadium so fans had a comfortable way to watch the action.

22nd Season

There are many words to describe Steve Peterson's role as Middle Tennessee's highly successful baseball coach since 1988. Coach, fundraiser, teacher, recruiter, and architect are just a few, but if you are looking for one word describe the Blue Raiders' longtime skipper, try "winner."

Peterson begins his 22nd season as the school's all-time winningest coach, with 663 victories and a stockpile of conference championships and NCAA Tournament berths to his credit, demonstrating the consistency with which the driven skipper has guided the club.

Peterson's drive for excellence has resulted in consistent success and has made Middle Tennessee a model program. The veteran coach has led Middle Tennessee to 10 regular-season conference championships, eight conference tournament titles, and seven NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections in the past seven years. Peterson guided the Blue Raiders to seven consecutive championships – either regular-season or tournament – during one stretch, proving Middle Tennessee doesn't rebuild, it reloads.

Peterson, who enters the 2009 season with a sterling 663-531-3 mark, has produced 13 seasons with 30 or more wins including a school-record 42 victories in 1990. He also has three campaigns of at least 40 wins including 2004's 40-22 record.

Consistent success during Peterson's tenure is a testament to his ability to recruit and develop talent, and the proof was never more evident than in 2001 – the Blue Raiders' first season in the Sun Belt Conference after years of success in the Ohio Valley.

Asked how the move into the Sun Belt, rated one of the nation's top five baseball leagues at the time and consistently a top 10 conference, would change his recruiting philosophy, Peterson quickly responded "Not at all." The 2001 Blue Raiders shared the Sun Belt championship with South Alabama after their first year in the high-profile league, and the chief contributors were many of the same players who led Middle Tennessee to the 2000 OVC championship.

The move to a higher-rated conference certainly helped Middle Tennessee's status. In their first five years in the Sun Belt, Peterson's teams have won two regular-season championships and a tournament championship and earned three NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections for the first time in school history.

The 2001 squad earned national acclaim for its pitching and hitting and the season concluded with pitcher Dewon Brazelton being selected as the No. 3 overall pick of the Tampa Bay Devil Rays in the Major League Baseball First-Year Amateur Player Draft. Brazelton was one of six players from the team to earn a spot on a professional

baseball roster that season.

A program cannot enjoy consistent success without quality players and Peterson, a three-time Coach of the Year, has not only made a habit of making sure Middle Tennessee has its share of quality performers but he's also won by signing top prep players and developing them at the college level. He has coached a Sun Belt Player of the Year and six OVC Players of the Year, a Sun Belt Pitcher of the Year and an OVC Pitcher of the Year, two First-Team All-Americans, five Third-Team All-Americans, four Freshman All-Americans, and 43 first-team All-Conference performers.

Players who have honed their skills under Peterson also have had outstanding success continuing their careers at the professional level. Professional baseball has seen 56 former Peterson performers earning the chance to play at the game's highest level, with four making their way to the Major Leagues.

Peterson's recruits have established most of the offensive records held at Middle Tennessee and four players he has developed have hit .400 or better in a season. He has also coached the school's single-season and career home run record holders. His 2008 squad established the all-time record for batting average with a .329 clip.

Peterson's players have been solid on the field at the collegiate level and have continued their careers professionally, and a large majority have taken skills and fundamentals learned at Middle Tennessee and are earning a living as coaches at various levels. Thirty-two former Blue Raiders are currently coaching at the high school, college, or professional levels.

Peterson's peers have recognized his achievements and contributions to the game by bestowing several honors on him. He was named the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association College Coach of the Year in 1992 and again in 2000. He was also inducted into the Rutherford County Old Timers Baseball Hall of Fame in 2003. In 2007, Peterson was inducted into the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame. Peterson was inducted into the Huntsville-Madison County Athletic Hall of Fame in January of 2009.

Fellow coaches have named Peterson Coach of the Year on three occasions – twice in the Ohio Valley and again in 2004, his first such honor in the Sun Belt.

Peterson's outgoing and personable style has made him a hit with fans, boosters, players, and recruits alike. Baseball enthusiasts throughout the Middle Tennessee community clearly appreciate his

hard-nosed and aggressive style of coaching, and fans continue to flock to Reese Smith Field at a record pace.

The Blue Raiders established a single-game attendance record in 2001 at Reese Smith Field with a crowd of 2,733 against South Alabama. The team went on to set the single-season attendance mark that year with 26,218 coming through the gates. The 2001 squad saw 15 crowds of 1,000 or more during the season. Those numbers were surpassed in 2004 when the team set a single-game attendance record of 3,020 against Vanderbilt and set a new single-season attendance mark of 30,319, ranking 46th nationally. Fifteen contests drew more than 1,000 patrons during the record-setting campaign.

Not only has Peterson been a winner on the field but he's also been a successful fundraiser during his career. Events such as the annual Chuck Taylor Golf Tournament, the Groundhog Day Luncheon, and the Grand Slam Fish Fry in the fall have become mainstays on calendars of Blue Raider baseball supporters across middle Tennessee and have raised thousands of dollars for the improvement of Blue Raider baseball.

Peterson spearheaded the efforts to pay for the construction of the Stephen B. Smith Clubhouse and Indoor Training Facility, which opened its doors in 1998. One look inside the facility shows the time and effort spent toward this endeavor. It has become known as one of the finest collegiate clubhouses and training facilities in the country.

Reese Smith Field has also benefited from Peterson's fundraising abilities. He has helped transform the park into a fan-friendly area by leading efforts to expand the seating area, add an information center just inside the gate, and improve restroom and concession facilities.

Peterson guided efforts during the summer of 2001 to enlarge the dugouts at Reese Smith Field. He also spearheaded a capital campaign to do significant remodeling of the concession stand, improve and expand restroom facilities, and a modern press box to accommodate radio, television, and print media.

While Peterson has spent 20 seasons leading the Middle Tennessee baseball program, his tenure with the program is much longer. He took two separate tours with the Blue Raiders as an assistant coach under John Stanford before becoming the team's head coach. During 1976-78 and 1985-87, he helped the Blue Raiders win two OVC titles and four southern division crowns.

During the interim, Peterson served as head coach at Roane State Community College in Harriman, Tenn. During his tenure from 1979 to 84, Peterson's teams won a Tennessee state title in 1981, and he was twice named TJCAA Coach of the Year (1981, '84). While at Roane State, Peterson put together a sparkling record of 153-96 for a .614 winning percentage.

A native of Huntsville, Ala., Peterson stood out as a catcher under the legendary Rudy Abbott at Jacksonville State. He earned his bachelor's from Jacksonville State in 1973 and later earned a master's from Middle Tennessee in 1977.

Peterson is married to the former Rita Albert and the couple has three children, Jill, Jenny, and John, and two grandchildren. Away from the diamond, Peterson enjoys fishing for smallmouth bass.
