## March 16, 2009

### This Week in Blue Raider Baseball...

Middle Tennessee began the week by defeating Lipscomb 8-3 on Wednesday and never looked back. The Blue Raiders swept Arkansas State to improve to 5-1 in SBC play. Middle Tennessee is off to its best Sun Belt start since joining the league in 2001. Middle Tennessee overcame many weather and field adversities over the weekend to sweep Arkansas State. The Blue Raiders' Friday game was suspended in seventh inning tied at five due to inclement weather after the rain started at game time. Middle Tennessee and Arkansas State came back to a soaked field on Saturday to resume play. ASU took a 7-6 lead in the top of the ninth but the Blue Raiders did not give up as senior Nathan Hines hit a solo shot to tie it and force extra innings. In the bottom of the 10th tied at 8, Hines stepped to the plate again hitting a two-run walk-off home run for the win. It was the first time since May 8, 2008 that a Middle Tennessee player hit home runs in consecutive at-bats. On Sunday, Hines drove in six of Middle Tennessee's 10 runs in a 10-3 win which gave the Blue Raiders the sweep over Arkansas State. Hines ended the day a single short of the cycle as he led the Blue Raiders at the plate throughout the game. Hines went 3 for 4 with a double, triple, home run, six RBI and scored two runs. It is the first time since sweeping New Mexico State in May 2005 that the Blue Raiders have swept a league opponent at home.

### Scouting the Salukis...

Southern Illinois (6-12) lost two of three to North Dakota over the weekend. The Salukis are led at the plate by Chris Murphy who is batting .324 with five doubles, two home runs, 13 RBI and has scored 15 runs.

**Series:** Tied 5-5; Peterson is 5-5 against Southern Illinois.

**Last Meeting:** The Blue Raiders won the last meeting 7-3 on March 5, 2008.

### Scouting the Owls...

Arkansas State (6-6) won its opening conference series 2-1 over Louisiana-Lafayette. The Red Wolves are led at the plate by Tod Baumgartner who is batting .356 with four doubles, one home run, four RBI and has scored six runs. There are just four ASU players batting over .300 with non batting over .400.

**Series:** FAU leads the series 6-3; Peterson is 3-6 against the Owls.

**Last Meeting:** The Blue Raiders were swept by the Owls in the regular season. Middle Tennessee was also put out of the conference tournament by FAU as it took a 12-7 win.

### Hot Bats...

There are currently eight of Middle Tennessee's starters who are batting .300 or better. Three of those eight are batting above .400.

Junior Drew Robertson is batting .527 with 29 hits, eight doubles, a home run, 12 RBI and has scored 15 runs. In the two game series with Memphis, Robertson went 7 for 8 with two doubles, one home run, five RBI and scored five runs. Junior Stuart Meinhart is also adding assistance to the offense as he is batting .452 with 14 hits, three doubles, one home run, 13 RBI and has scored nine runs.

### Sun Belt Honors...

Senior Nathan Hines was named SBC Player of the Week on March 16 after handing Middle Tennessee two wins over Arkansas State on its way to a sweep. This is the first weekly league honor received by any Middle Tennessee player this season.

### Double Duty...

Sophomore Bryce Brentz started the 2009 season on the mound for the Blue Raiders notching the first win after allowing one run on two hits in five innings of work. Brentz then moved to the designated hitter position after being relieved on the mound. Brentz then hit a three-run home run in his second at bat of the game. Brentz ended the weekend hitting .333 with four hits, three RBI and scored two runs. Brentz has hit a two-run home run in each of the Blue Raiders last two games.

Brentz has appeared in every game this season either on the mound or in the field. Brentz is currently batting .389 with 21 hits, a double, two triples, five home runs and 14 RBI. On the mound, he has an ERA of 3.68 with a 1-0 record in four appearances with 15 strikeouts.

Freshman Justin Guidry has also been pulling double duty playing in eight games with five appearances on the mound.

**Off to a Good Start...**

The Blue Raiders are off to one of their best start in recorded history with a 13-2 record. The last best start by a Middle Tennessee team was in 2001 at 14-15 games into the season.

In league play at 5-1, Middle Tennessee is off to its best Sun Belt start since joining the league in 2001.

**Record Breakers...**

Senior Rawley Bishop needs six RBI to become the school's career leader. The current record of 168 was set by George Zimmermann, who played at Middle Tennessee from 1986-89.

Bishop is now the school's career putout leader after having one putout against Jacksonville State. Josh Archer who played for the Blue Raiders from 2002-05 previously held the record.

Bishop also holds the career record for hit by pitch (33) and is fourth on the career list for slugging percentage (.618). Bishop is tied for second in home runs (40), is seventh in runs (158) and eighth in walks (99).

Bishop is five home runs away from becoming the school's career home run leader. The record (44) is currently held by Josh Pride who played for the Blue Raiders from 1997-2000.

Senior Nathan Hines is also moving up the record books. Hines is tied for fifth in triples (8), fifth in RBI (145), seventh in hits (211) and tied for ninth in doubles (43).

**Leading the League...**

Middle Tennessee is currently second in the Sun Belt in batting with a .347 average behind Western Kentucky who has a team batting average of .358. There are seven schools in the league batting over .300 as a team.

The Blue Raiders are also in pitching with a 4.02 team ERA.

Individually, junior Drew Robertson is first in batting with a .527 average and junior Stuart Meinhart is fifth in the league with a .419 batting average. Junior Nick Montgomery is fourth in the league in pitching with a 1.76 ERA.

Robertson is also second in the league in hits with 29 and third in doubles with eight. Senior Rawley Bishop is second in runs scored with 21. Senior Nathan Hines is fourth in RBI with 22 while sophomore Bryce Brentz is tied for third in home runs with five.

**League Action...**

The Blue Raiders opened league play by take the series from New Orleans 2-1. Middle Tennessee has three players batting over .300 lead by junior Stuart who batted .500 on the weekend with six hits, a double, three RBI and scored two runs. The Blue Raiders had 24 hits in the series with just eight accounting for extra bases which included six home runs.

Middle Tennessee then swept Arkansas State scoring 34 runs with 16 extra base hits while holding the Red Wolves to just 14 runs and nine extra base hits.

**Preseason Honors...**

Senior Nathan Hines and sophomore Bryce Brentz were named to the Sun Belt Preseason team as outfielders. Brentz received a number of postseason awards including Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-America, NCBWA Freshman All-America, 2008 Ping! All-Freshman First Team and ABCA First Team All-Region after putting together a stellar freshman campaign.

Brentz and senior Rawley Bishop were also selected to Ping!Baseball's all-preseason team.

### **Season Openers...**

Since 1974 the Blue Raiders are 19-19 in season openers. Under head coach Steve Peterson Middle Tennessee is 13-11 in season openers. Middle Tennessee has won three of its last four season openers. Prior to 2006 the longest win streak in a season opener was from 2001 to 2002 when the Blue Raiders won two straight. Middle Tennessee won three straight season openers from 1983 to 1985 which is the longest season opening win streak in school history.

### **No Place Like Home...**

Middle Tennessee will play 34 games at Reese Smith Field this season after competing in 25 last season after having games cancelled due to weather and moved because of construction. The Blue Raiders will also play nine of their first 10 games at home which is the most to begin a season since 2003, when they played their first six games at home.

Middle Tennessee has now played 11 games at Reese Smith Jr. Field posting a 10-1 record.

### **Tennessee Native...**

30 of Middle Tennessee's 35 student-athletes hail from the state of Tennessee. Seven of those 30 are from Murfreesboro and one is from La Vergne in Rutherford County. Two attended Riverdale High School while another four played at Oakland.

### **Blue Raiders by Class...**

There seven seniors on this year's squad. 12 juniors complete the list of upperclassmen while 10 sophomores and six freshmen compose the rest of the team.

### **Seeing Double...**

There are 11 players who have duplicate names on the 2009 roster. Three are named Tyler (Acker, Burnett, Hyde) while the others are named Zach (Hudson, Dean), Brett (Smalley, Wilson), Matt (Doss, Yurus) and Chad (Coley, Edwards).

### **Win Percentage...**

In the last 35 years of Middle Tennessee baseball history head coach Steve Peterson has accounted for 65% of the program's wins.

### **Dual-Sport...**

In addition to playing baseball, redshirt freshman Wes Caldwell also plays football for the Blue Raiders. Caldwell, a wide receiver, played in all 12 games during the 2008 season. Caldwell had 27 receptions for 265 yards averaging 9.8 yards per catch.

Caldwell has played in two games for Middle Tennessee. In two at-bats Caldwell is batting .500 with one hit. His first collegiate hit was a single against Memphis when he came in as a pinch runner and stayed in to play outfield.

# STEVE PETERSON 25

Head Coach  
22nd Season

There are many words to describe Steve Peterson's role as Middle Tennessee's highly successful baseball coach since 1988. Coach, fundraiser, teacher, recruiter, and architect are just a few, but if you are looking for one word describe the Blue Raiders' longtime skipper, try "winner."

Peterson begins his 22nd season as the school's all-time winningest coach, with 663 victories and a stockpile of conference championships and NCAA Tournament berths to his credit, demonstrating the consistency with which the driven skipper has guided the club.

Peterson's drive for excellence has resulted in consistent success and has made Middle Tennessee a model program. The veteran coach has led Middle Tennessee to 10 regular-season conference championships, eight conference tournament titles, and seven NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections in the past seven years. Peterson guided the Blue Raiders to seven consecutive championships – either regular-season or tournament – during one stretch, proving Middle Tennessee doesn't rebuild, it reloads.

Peterson, who enters the 2009 season with a sterling 663-531-3 mark, has produced 13 seasons with 30 or more wins including a school-record 42 victories in 1990. He also has three campaigns of at least 40 wins including 2004's 40-22 record.

Consistent success during Peterson's tenure is a testament to his ability to recruit and develop talent, and the proof was never more evident than in 2001 – the Blue Raiders' first season in the Sun Belt Conference after years of success in the Ohio Valley.

Asked how the move into the Sun Belt, rated one of the nation's top five baseball leagues at the time and consistently a top 10 conference, would change his recruiting philosophy, Peterson quickly responded "Not at all." The 2001 Blue Raiders shared the Sun Belt championship with South Alabama after their first year in the high-profile league, and the chief contributors were many of the same players who led Middle Tennessee to the 2000 OVC championship.

The move to a higher-rated conference certainly helped Middle Tennessee's status. In their first five years in the Sun Belt, Peterson's teams have won two regular-season championships and a tournament championship and earned three NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections for the first time in school history.

The 2001 squad earned national acclaim for its pitching and hitting and the season concluded with pitcher Dewon Brazelton being selected as the No. 3 overall pick of the Tampa Bay Devil Rays in the Major League Baseball First-Year Amateur Player Draft. Brazelton was one of six players from the team to earn a spot on a professional

baseball roster that season.

A program cannot enjoy consistent success without quality players and Peterson, a three-time Coach of the Year, has not only made a habit of making sure Middle Tennessee has its share of quality performers but he's also won by signing top prep players and developing them at the college level. He has coached a Sun Belt Player of the Year and six OVC Players of the Year, a Sun Belt Pitcher of the Year and an OVC Pitcher of the Year, two First-Team All-Americans, five Third-Team All-Americans, four Freshman All-Americans, and 43 first-team All-Conference performers.

Players who have honed their skills under Peterson also have had outstanding success continuing their careers at the professional level. Professional baseball has seen 56 former Peterson performers earning the chance to play at the game's highest level, with four making their way to the Major Leagues.

Peterson's recruits have established most of the offensive records held at Middle Tennessee and four players he has developed have hit .400 or better in a season. He has also coached the school's single-season and career home run record holders. His 2008 squad established the all-time record for batting average with a .329 clip.

Peterson's players have been solid on the field at the collegiate level and have continued their careers professionally, and a large majority have taken skills and fundamentals learned at Middle Tennessee and are earning a living as coaches at various levels. Thirty-two former Blue Raiders are currently coaching at the high school, college, or professional levels.

Peterson's peers have recognized his achievements and contributions to the game by bestowing several honors on him. He was named the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association College Coach of the Year in 1992 and again in 2000. He was also inducted into the Rutherford County Old Timers Baseball Hall of Fame in 2003. In 2007, Peterson was inducted into the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame. Peterson was inducted into the Huntsville-Madison County Athletic Hall of Fame in January of 2009.

Fellow coaches have named Peterson Coach of the Year on three occasions – twice in the Ohio Valley and again in 2004, his first such honor in the Sun Belt.

Peterson's outgoing and personable style has made him a hit with fans, boosters, players, and recruits alike. Baseball enthusiasts throughout the Middle Tennessee community clearly appreciate his

hard-nosed and aggressive style of coaching, and fans continue to flock to Reese Smith Field at a record pace.

The Blue Raiders established a single-game attendance record in 2001 at Reese Smith Field with a crowd of 2,733 against South Alabama. The team went on to set the single-season attendance mark that year with 26,218 coming through the gates. The 2001 squad saw 15 crowds of 1,000 or more during the season. Those numbers were surpassed in 2004 when the team set a single-game attendance record of 3,020 against Vanderbilt and set a new single-season attendance mark of 30,319, ranking 46th nationally. Fifteen contests drew more than 1,000 patrons during the record-setting campaign.

Not only has Peterson been a winner on the field but he's also been a successful fundraiser during his career. Events such as the annual Chuck Taylor Golf Tournament, the Groundhog Day Luncheon, and the Grand Slam Fish Fry in the fall have become mainstays on calendars of Blue Raider baseball supporters across middle Tennessee and have raised thousands of dollars for the improvement of Blue Raider baseball.

Peterson spearheaded the efforts to pay for the construction of the Stephen B. Smith Clubhouse and Indoor Training Facility, which opened its doors in 1998. One look inside the facility shows the time and effort spent toward this endeavor. It has become known as one of the finest collegiate clubhouses and training facilities in the country.

Reese Smith Field has also benefited from Peterson's fundraising abilities. He has helped transform the park into a fan-friendly area by leading efforts to expand the seating area, add an information center just inside the gate, and improve restroom and concession facilities.

Peterson guided efforts during the summer of 2001 to enlarge the dugouts at Reese Smith Field. He also spearheaded a capital campaign to do significant remodeling of the concession stand, improve and expand restroom facilities, and a modern press box to accommodate radio, television, and print media.

While Peterson has spent 20 seasons leading the Middle Tennessee baseball program, his tenure with the program is much longer. He took two separate tours with the Blue Raiders as an assistant coach under John Stanford before becoming the team's head coach. During 1976-78 and 1985-87, he helped the Blue Raiders win two OVC titles and four southern division crowns.

During the interim, Peterson served as head coach at Roane State Community College in Harriman, Tenn. During his tenure from 1979 to 84, Peterson's teams won a Tennessee state title in 1981, and he was twice named TJCAA Coach of the Year (1981, '84). While at Roane State, Peterson put together a sparkling record of 153-96 for a .614 winning percentage.

A native of Huntsville, Ala., Peterson stood out as a catcher under the legendary Rudy Abbott at Jacksonville State. He earned his bachelor's from Jacksonville State in 1973 and later earned a master's from Middle Tennessee in 1977.

Peterson is married to the former Rita Albert and the couple has three children, Jill, Jenny, and John, and two grandchildren. Away from the diamond, Peterson enjoys fishing for smallmouth bass.
