McKenzie falls to Parkes at NCAA Championships Will pair with Peers for doubles action on Thursday

COLLEGE STATION, Texas - Senior **Robert McKenzie** put up a fight in the first round of the NCAA Individual Championships which began on Wednesday.

McKenzie forced a third set with New Mexico's Johnny Parkes before falling by scores of 3-6, 6-1, 6-1.

The Melbourne, Australia native ends his singles season with a 21-2 record with both of his losses coming against ranked opponents.

McKenzie's season is not done however as he will pair with sophomore **John Peers** on Thursday, May 21 in doubles play at the NCAA Individual Championships. The pair will have a rematch with Austen and Simon Childs of Louisville in the first round. Peers and McKenzie lost to the pair in a tie-breaker 9-8 (7).
