



# RULES

Rules are as follows:

- Each participating organization must create a “guest list” of the organizations' members, and/or students who have agreed to represent that organization in attendance.
- Guest lists must have a minimum of 50 participants. Organizations can include current members as well as friends of the organization in team list.
- A maximum of 3 organizations may team up on 1 list.
- Each participant must be a current MT student, with a valid ID card.
- Students can only place their name on 1 guest list. Students whose names appear on more than one list will be thrown off each list.
- Organizations must submit attendance list to [rkershaw@mtsu.edu](mailto:rkershaw@mtsu.edu) by Noon on Thursday, November 5<sup>th</sup>.
- When students scan their ID card at Middle Tennessee Football games against Florida International University on 11/7, Louisiana –Lafayette on 11/14, and Arkansas State on 11/21 their attendance will be recorded and credited for their organization.
- The organization who has the highest percentage of their guest list in attendance at all three games will win their choice from the three prizes.
