

## This Week In Blue Raider Baseball...

The Middle Tennessee baseball team will open the the season on the road for the first time since a three game sweep at Jacksonville State in 2008. The Blue Raiders boast of an overall record of 40-35-2 in series on opening weekend, and have opened the season at Memphis on one other occasion, sweeping both games in 1988.

#### **Scouting The Tigers...**

Memphis enters the season hoping to rebound from a 21-32 record in 2009. The Tigers went 7-16 in Conference USA play, but boasted an 11-7 record at home. The Blue Raiders hosted Memphis for two games last season, winning 18-4 and 18-3, respectively. The last MT loss to Memphis was a 17-11 14-inning slugfest in 2008 in Murfreesboro.

However, the Tigers do boast some young talent. Oufielder Drew Martinez hit .309 to lead the team in 2009, and utility player Adam McClain hit .288, hitting safely in 25 of his final 28 games. Both players were named to the conference's All-Freshmen team, the only Memphis players to earn postseason accolades. Freshman outfielder Derrick Thomas was drafted by the Boston Red Sox coming out of high school.

This weekend will mark the 85th, 86th and 87th meetings between Middle Tennessee and a Conference USA school since its creation in 1995. Overall, the Raiders boast of a 42-42 record versus the conference. The Blue Raiders have only played one C-USA team each season since 2001, in which they faced off against both Memphis and UAB.

**Series:** Middle Tennessee leads the series 39-38, Peterson is 33-30 vs. the Tigers **Last Meeting:** Blue Raiders swept Memphis, winning 18-4 and 18-3 in 2009.

#### Season Openers...

The Blue Raiders have a record of 17-19 on opening day, and an overall record of 40-35-2 in the opening series of the season. Under Peterson, MT has an 11-11 record in openers, including victories in each of the last four season openers. Peterson has also compiled a 29-22 record in the opening series of the season.

#### One of the best...

Junior outfielder/pitcher Bryce Brentz enters the season considered one of collegiate baseball's best players. After an impressive sophomore campaign, Brentz was chosen as the second-best player in the entire country by The Collegiate Baseball Blog. He was the only player in the Sun Belt Conference to be named in the Top 100.

After ending last season as a consensus first team All-American, Brentz has earned preseason first team accolades from the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association, Louisville Slugger, Baseball America, Ping!Baseball and Rivals.com.

#### Another one of the best...

Senior pitcher Kenneth Roberts has also earned a national

reputation as one of collegiate top baseball's players. The Murfreesboro native was named a third team All-American by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association, Louisville Slugger and Ping!Baseball.

Roberts was also selected as one of 30 candidates for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, which recognizes excellence in the classroom, character, community and competition among seniors across the NCAA's Division I. He was one of two Sun Belt players selected and the only player from a school in Tennessee.

#### Tabbed as Sun Belt Favorite...

Middle Tennessee took home eight of a possible 11 first place votes on the way to being chosen as the favorite for the Sun Belt Conference championship, as voted on by the conference coaches. It's the first time that the Blue Raiders have been chosen as the conference favorite since joining the Sun Belt in 2001.

#### Sun Belt's Best...

Junior Bryce Brentz was voted as the preseason Sun Belt Player of the Year, and senior Kenneth Roberts took home Pitcher of the Year honors. It marks the first time in Sun Belt history that the

Preseason Pitcher and Player of the Year picks have played for the same team. Brentz became the first Blue Raider ever chosen as the the Preseason Player of the Year while Roberts became just the second Raider selected as the Preseason Pitcher of the Year.

Junior Tyler Burnett also earned a spot on the Preseason All-Sun Belt team. The trio of Blue Raiders represents the most chosen for the preseason squad since four MT players were chosen in 2006.

#### A Historic Season...

Middle Tennessee is coming off of one of the best seasons in school history, posting a school-record 44 wins in 2009. The Blue Raiders also made their 14th trip to the NCAA Tournament, posting a win over Vanderbilt before ultimately being eliminated. The Raiders took home their second Sun Belt Conference Tournament title since joining the conference in 2001. It was the ninth time in school history that Middle Tennessee had taken home both the conference regular season and tournament championship in the same season. The Raiders also won a school record 21 games in conference, eclipsing the 17 wins that MT posted in 2001.

#### **NCAA Regionals...**

The Blue Raider baseball team capped off a spectacular season with a trip to the NCAA Louisville Regional. The trip marked the 14th time that Middle Tennessee had made it to a regional, and the first time since a 2004 trip to the Athens regional. The Raiders are looking to make back-to-back regional trips for the sixth time in program history.

Last year's trip marked the ninth time that Coach Peterson has taken the Blue Raiders into a regional, and the fourth time they've emerged with a victory in NCAA Regional play. The win over Vanderbilt was the first since beating Southwest Missouri State in 1995.

Middle Tennessee has an overall record of 11-28 in regionals, while Peterson holds a record of 5-18. Last season, the Blue Raiders posted an opening victory over Vanderbilt 5-4. MT fell to host Louisville in a hard fought 3-2 loss prior to being emliminated by Vanderbilt 6-0.

#### Receiving votes...

Middle Tennessee has drawn a national spotlight for the upcoming season. The USA Today/ESPN Preseason poll had the Blue Raiders receiving 13 votes to rank 38th in the country. The ranking is the highest among Sun Belt teams and the second highest from schools in the state of Tennessee. MT also received votes from the Collegiate Baseball Writers Association for their Preseason Top 25 poll.

#### Re-writing the record books...

Middle Tennessee set or matched twelve team records in the 2009 season. The Blue Raiders offense set new marks for at bats (2280), hits (776), batting average (.340), slugging percentage (.567), runs (545), doubles (164), home runs (101), runs batted in (516), and total bases (1293). The offense also finished in second for walks in a season (259). The pitching staff set a team record for saves with 16.

#### Looking to break more records...

Junior Bryce Brentz currently stands in striking distance of setting several team individual records. The slugger from Knoxville already sits a top the list in career slugging percentage (.807). He stands second on the career home runs list with 46 (record: 51), sixth on the career runs batted in list with 141 (record: 201), and tied for tenth on the career total bases list with 355 (record: 483).

In the 2009 campaign, Brentz set school records for highest batting average in a season (.465), hits in a season (107), runs in a season (79), home runs in a season (28), slugging percentage (.930), and total bases in a season (214). The historic season also saw Brentz record the third highest on-base percentage (.535) and second highest number of runs batted in (73).

#### **Sun Belt Competition...**

2009 marked the second time that the Blue Raiders have walked home with both the conference regular season and tournament championships since joining the Sun Belt in 2001. In the nine seasons MT has competed in the Sun Belt, the Blue Raiders have earned at least a share of the regular season crown four times (2001, 2003, 2004, 2009)

and the tournament crown on two occasions. (2003 and 2009).

#### The 40 Win Plateau...

The 44 wins from the 2009 season marks the fourth time the Blue Raiders have won 40 or more games, each season coming under the direction of Peterson. The last 40 win team for MT came in the 2004 campaign. The 44 wins are the most that a Middle Tennessee baseball team has posted in an individual season, beating the previous mark of 42, set in 1990.

#### Peterson is also one of the best...

Blue Raider baseball coach Steve Peterson took home a number of awards following the 2009 campaign. Three-time conference Coach of the Year Peterson was recognized as the state of Tennessee's best collegiate baseball coach by the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association. The American Baseball Coaches Association also named Peterson as the South Central Region Coach of the Year

Peterson also became a 700 game winner as a head coach last season with a 10-4 win over conference rival Western Kentucky. Peterson's record at MT is 707-549-3. The 707 wins make up over 64% of all the wins for Blue Raider baseball.

Blue Raider Baseball having each won their fair share of both conference and national honors last season.

Brentz, who spent the summer playing for USA Baseball, was a consensus first-team All-American, honored by six different organizations. Brentz was also a semifinalist for the Golden Spikes award, recognizing the nation's best collegiate baseball player. The Knox-ville native took home first team All-Sun Belt and All-Tournament honors. He also received three Sun Belt Player of the Week awards as well

Kenneth Roberts was recognized as a Second Team All-American by the American Baseball Coaches Association. He earned a place on the All-South Central Region Team by the ABCA. After putting on an impressive dsiplay in the conference tournament, Roberts was named the Most Outstanding Player. He was a First Team All-Conference performer and twice took home Sun Belt Pitcher of the Week awards.

#### Wearing the Red, White and Blue...

Junior Bryce Brentz spent most of the 2009 season proving he was one of the best collegiate players in the country and further cemented his reputation when he was one of 22 players named to the USA Baseball National Team.

Brentz received the invitation to tryout for the team after posting impressive numbers and recommendations from a number of the nation's top coaches.

Brentz joins Dewon Brazelton as recent Blue Raiders to be named to a USA National team.

#### No Place Like Home...

Middle Tennessee will play 27 games at Reese Smith Jr. Field this season after playing 31 at home last year, posting the most home victories for a Blue Raider team with 27 victories and only four losses. The previous record for home wins was set in 1990 as MT went 25-3 at home. Overall, the Blue Raiders have a 633-326-3 record in home match-ups. Since Coach Peterson took over 1988, he's posted a 390-217 record at Reese Smith Jr. Field.

#### **Dual Sport...**

Redshirt sophomore catcher Wes Caldwell is a rarity in college these days, earning varsity letters in two sports for the Blue Raiders. Caldwell was a wide receiver for the football team last fall, catching ten balls for 117 yards for MT and helping the football team to a Sun Belt record 10 wins and a New Orleans Bowl victory.

Caldwell has played in nine games for Middle Tennessee. In five at-bats last season, Caldwell batted .400 with two hits, a home run, two RBIs and three runs scored. His first collegiate hit was a single against Memphis when he came in as a pinch runner and stayed in to play outfield.

#### Local Flavor...

The 2010 edition boast of six players from the city of Murfreesboro, and a remarkable 30 of the 34 players hail from the state of Tennessee. Of the Murfreesboro athletes, three are from Riverdale High School, two are from Oakland High School, and one is from Siegel High School.

#### Roster By Class...

Middle Tennessee boasts of a roster laden with upperclassmen. There are nine Blue Raider seniors and 12 juniors. There's a solid influx of young talent as the rest of the team is comprised of three sophomores and 10 freshmen.

### 2009 SUN BELT CHAMPIONS



There are many words to describe Steve Peterson's role as Middle Tennessee's highly successful baseball coach since 1988. Coach, fundraiser, teacher, recruiter, and architect are just a few, but if you are looking for one word to describe the Blue Raiders' longtime skipper, try "winner."

Peterson begins his 23rd season as the school's all-time winningest coach, with 707 victories and a stockpile of conference championships and NCAA Tournament berths to his credit, demonstrating the consistency with which the driven captain has guided the club.

Peterson's drive for excellence has resulted in consistent success and has made Middle Tennessee a model program. The veteran coach has led Middle Tennessee to 11 regular-season conference championships, nine conference tournament titles, and nine NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections in the past seven years. Peterson guided the Blue Raiders to seven consecutive championships – either regular-season or tournament – during one stretch, proving Middle Tennessee doesn't rebuild, it reloads.

Peterson, who enters the 2010 season with a sterling 707-549-3 mark, has produced 14 seasons with 30 or more wins including a school-record 44 victories in 2009. He also has four campaigns of at least 40 wins including 2009's 44-18 record.

Consistent success during Peterson's tenure is a testament to his ability to recruit and develop talent, and the proof was never more evident than in 2001 – the Blue Raiders' first season in the Sun Belt Conference after years of success in the Ohio Valley.

Asked how the move into the Sun Belt, rated one of the nation's top five baseball leagues at the time and consistently a top 10 conference, would change his recruiting philosophy, Peterson quickly responded "Not at all." The 2001 Blue Raiders shared the Sun Belt championship with South Alabama after their first year in the highprofile league, and the chief contributors were many of the same players who led Middle Tennessee to the 2000 OVC championship.

The move to a higher-rated conference certainly helped Middle Tennessee's status. In their first five years in the Sun Belt, Peterson's teams won two regular-season championships and a tournament championship and earned three NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections for the first time in school history.

The 2001 squad earned national acclaim for its pitching and hitting and the season concluded with pitcher Dewon Brazelton being selected as the No. 3 overall pick of the Tampa Bay Devil Rays in the

Major League Baseball First-Year Amateur Player Draft. Brazelton was one of six players from the team to earn a spot on a professional baseball roster that season.

A program cannot enjoy consistent success without quality players and Peterson, a three-time Coach of the Year, has not only made a habit of making sure Middle Tennessee has its share of quality performers but he's also won by signing top prep players and developing them at the college level.

He has coached a Sun Belt Player of the Year and six OVC Players of the Year, a Sun Belt Pitcher of the Year and an OVC Pitcher of the Year, two First-Team All-Americans, five Third-Team All-Americans, four Freshman All-Americans, and 43 first-team All-Conference performers.

Players who have honed their skills under Peterson also have had outstanding success continuing their careers at the professional level. Professional baseball has seen 56 former Peterson performers earning the chance to play at the game's highest level, with four making their way to the Major Leagues.

Peterson's recruits have established most of the offensive records held at Middle Tennessee and seven players he has developed have hit .400 or better in a season. He has also coached the school's single-season and career home run record holders. His 2009 squad established the all-time record for batting average with .340.

Peterson's players have been solid on the field at the collegiate level and have continued their careers professionally, and a large

majority have taken skills and fundamentals learned at Middle Tennessee and are earning a living as coaches at various levels. Thirtyone former Blue Raiders are currently coaching at the high school, college, or professional levels.

Peterson's peers have recognized his achievements and contributions to the game by bestowing several honors on him. He was named the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association College Coach of the Year in 1992, 2000 and 2009. Peterson received his first ABCA Region Coach of the Year honor in 2009 after guiding the Blue Raiders in their record breaking season. He was also inducted into the Rutherford County Old Timers Baseball Hall of Fame in 2003. In 2007, Peterson was inducted into the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame and the Huntsville-Madison County (AL) Athletic Hall of Fame in April of 2009.

Fellow coaches have named Peterson Coach of the Year on three occasions - twice in the Ohio Valley and again in 2004, his first such honor in the Sun Belt.

Peterson's outgoing and personable style has made him a hit with fans, boosters, players, and recruits alike. Baseball enthusiasts throughout the Middle Tennessee community clearly appreciate his hard-nosed and aggressive style of coaching, and fans continue to flock to Reese Smith Field at a record pace.

The Blue Raiders established a single-game attendance record in 2001 at Reese Smith Field with a crowd of 2,733 against South Alabama. The team went on to set the single-season attendance mark that year with 26,218 coming through the gates. The 2001 squad saw 15 crowds of 1,000 or more during the season. Those numbers were surpassed in 2004 when the team set a single-game attendance record of 3,020 against Vanderbilt and set a new single-season attendance mark of 30,319, ranking 46th nationally. Fifteen contests drew more than 1,000 patrons during the record-setting campaign.

Not only has Peterson been a winner on the field but he's also been a successful fundraiser during his career. Events such as the annual Chuck Taylor Golf Tournament, the Groundhog Day Luncheon, and the Grand Slam Fish Fry in the fall have become mainstays on calendars of Blue Raider baseball supporters across middle Tennessee and have raised thousands of dollars for the improvement of Blue Raider baseball.

Peterson spearheaded the efforts to pay for the construction of the Stephen B. Smith Clubhouse and Indoor Training Facility, which opened its doors in 1998. One look inside the facility shows the time and effort spent toward this endeavor. It has become known as one of the finest collegiate clubhouses and training facilities in the country.

Reese Smith Field has also benefited from Peterson's fundraising abilities. He has helped transform the park into a fan-friendly area by leading efforts to expand the seating area, add an information center just inside the gate, and improve restroom and concession facilities.

Peterson guided efforts during the summer of 2001 to enlarge the dugouts at Reese Smith Field. He also spearheaded a capital campaign to do significant remodeling of the concession stand, improve and expand restroom facilities, and added a modern press box to accommodate radio, television, and print media.

While Peterson has spent 22 seasons leading the Middle Tennessee baseball program, his tenure with the program is much longer. He took two separate tours with the Blue Raiders as an assistant coach under John Stanford before becoming the team's head coach. During 1976-78 and 1985-87, he helped the Blue Raiders win two OVC titles and four Southern Division crowns.

During the interim, Peterson served as head coach at Roane State Community College in Harriman, Tenn. During his tenure from 1979 to 1984, Peterson's teams won a Tennessee state title in 1981, and he was twice named TJCAA Coach of the Year (1981, '84). While at Roane State, Peterson put together a sparkling record of 153-96 for a .614 winning percentage.

A native of Huntsville, Ala., Peterson stood out as a catcher under the legendary Rudy Abbott at Jacksonville State. He earned his bachelor's from Jacksonville State in 1973 and later earned a master's from Middle Tennessee in 1977.

Peterson is married to the former Rita Albert and the couple has three children, Jill, Jenny, and John, and three grandchildren. Away from the diamond, Peterson enjoys fishing for smallmouth bass.
