This Week In Blue Raider Baseball...

Middle Tennessee split its midweek games with Austin Peay and Lipscomb. The Blue Raiders committed five errors and walked seven batters in the loss to Austin Peay. Senior Zach Hudson hit a walk-off home run to right field in the bottom of the 12th inning to give the Blue Raiders a 21-20 win over Lipscomb in the waning hours of Wednesday night. Hudson reached base seven of eight times going 4 for 5 with two walks, a home run, double, two RBI and scored three runs. The Nashville, Tenn., native scored a run after reaching on a hit in the ninth inning rally in which the Blue Raiders scored five runs to force extra innings. Hudson was the leadoff batter in the 12th inning.

Scouting the Owls (15-9, 6-3)...

Florida Atlantic fell to No. 15 Miami in its only midweek game on Wednesday and won its series at UL-Lafayette 2-1 last weekend. Currently the Owls are led by Andy Mee who is batting .390 with 41 hits, 21 RBI and has scored 24 runs. Just three batters are hitting over .300 for the Owls. On the mound, Mike Gipson, the Saturday starter, has a 2.09 ERA with a 5-0 record allowing 12 runs, 10 earned, in 43 innings of work.

Series: Middle Tennessee leads the all-time series 8-6. The two schools last met on May 22, 2009 in the Sun Belt Championship with the Blue Raiders winning 12-7. The Blue Raiders have won the last four meetings, all of which were in 2009.

McDade goes on a tear...

Blake McDade has one of the most important line-up spots for Middle Tennessee, hitting after All-American Bryce Brentz. So far this season, he's held up his part of the bargain. The senior leads the team in on base percentage (.521), reaching more than half the times he comes to the plate. However, his most impressive feat occurred lagainst Southern Illinois and Jacksonville State earlier this season as he went 13 consecutive plate appearances without recording an out. The only other player who has accomplished the same feat this season is Kansas State's Adam Muenster.

McDade has continues to impress throughout this season, and is currently second on the team with a .442 batting average. At Lipscomb, McDade went 4-5 before being replaced by a pinch hitter in the eighth, ending the game a home run short of the cycle.

Climbing up the RBI charts...

Senior Blake McDade and junior Bryce Brentz started the season neck-and-neck in runs batted in, and now the duo is climbing up the career list in pursuit of the record (201) that Rawley Bishop set last season. McDade is currently fourth with 161 while Brentz is sixth with 158 and they have swapped positions several times over the past few weeks.

Most Improved...

Sophomore Justin Guidry is one of the most improved players on the Blue Raider roster from the 2009 season. The Mount Juliet, Tenn., native is currently batting .454 with 49 hits, 29 RBI and has scored 24 runs while guiding the Blue Raider pitching staff. Guidry leads the team with a 3.66 ERA allowing 11 runs in 19.2 innings of work with10 strikeouts.

As a freshman, he played in 20 games batting .366 with 15 hits, six RBI and scored eight runs while on the mound he posted an 8.29 ERA allowed 31 earned runs and struck out 27 in 33.2 innings of work.

Give me 5...

In the series opener against South Alabama, sophomore Justin Guidry ended the night 5-5 with a double, home run, three RBI and scored two runs. He is the first Blue Raider since Zach Barrett on May 2, 2008 to record five hits in a game.

Against Lipscomb, Guidry did it again this time going 5 for 8 with a two RBI double, five total RBI and scored three runs.

Also against Lipscomb, senior Blake McDade became the first Blue Raider since Eric McNamaee in 2005 to score five or more runs in a game.

Driving them in...

Junior Justin Miller tied the school record for RBI in a game with eight against South Alabama. Miller hit two three-run home runs on his way to

tying the record ending the game 3 for 6. The last Blue Raider to record eight RBI in a game was Cale Lawson against Tennessee State in 1989.

The Knoxville, Tenn., native continues to drive in runs with five against Lipscomb and six total in the midweek. He now leads the team with 40, 11 more than any other player on the team.

Random...

Exactly three years to the day Middle Tennessee scored the same number of runs, 21. Against UL-Monroe on March 31, 2007 the Blue Raiders scored 21 runs and the team scored the same number on March 31, 2010 against Lipscomb.

Career win...

Junior Hunter Dawson posted his first win on the mound as a Blue Raider after playing third base for 11 innings. Dawson allowed no runs or hits in one and one-thirds of an inning and struck out two batters.

The Atoka, Tenn., native started the game at third base, with junior Tyler Burnett being the designated hitter, and went 1 for 6 at the plate with two walks and scored two runs.

Going, Going, Gone...

Middle Tennessee hit five home runs in its two midweek games with juniors Will Skinner and Justin Miller each recording two. This season the Blue Raiders have 44 home runs led by Miller who has 11.

Adkins has impressive debut...

"It was as good a start as I've seen from a freshman pitcher in a long time at Middle Tennessee."

Those were the words of Blue Raider head coach Steve Peterson following Hunter Adkins' first career appearance at Southern Illinois. The Signal Mountain, Tenn. native went six innings, allowing just three hits and one earned run.

Brentz breaks record...

It took until the eighth game of the season for All-American Bryce Brentz to hit his first home run, but he's rolling now and recorded his sixth home run of the season on Saturday, March 13 against ULM, passing Rawley Bishop as Middle Tennessee's most prolific slugger with 52 career homers. Brentz set the record in just his 129th career game. Brentz currently has 54 home runs in his career.

One of the best...

Junior outfielder/pitcher Bryce Brentz entered the season considered one of collegiate baseball's best players. After an impressive sophomore campaign, Brentz was chosen as the second-best player in the entire country by The Collegiate Baseball Blog. He was the only player in the Sun Belt Conference to be named in the Top 100.

After ending last season as a consensus first team All-American, Brentz has earned preseason first team accolades from the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association, Louisville Slugger, Baseball America, Ping!Baseball and Rivals.com.

Brentz also drew high local praise as well. The Knoxville native was named the 2009 Ed Temple Amatuer Athlete of the Year by the Nashville Sports Council in late February. Brentz beat out fellow Blue Raider Alysha Clark, Virginia golfer Calle Nelson, Vanderbilt football player Warren Norman, and Notre Dame football player Golden Tate.

Another one of the best...

Senior pitcher Kenneth Roberts has also earned a national reputation as one of collegiate top baseball's players. The Murfreesboro native was named a third team All-American by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association, Louisville Slugger and Ping!Baseball.

Roberts was also selected as one of 30 candidates for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, which recognizes excellence in the classroom, character, community and competition among seniors across the NCAA's Division I. He was one of two Sun Belt players selected and the only player from a school in Tennessee.

Tabbed as Sun Belt Favorite...

Middle Tennessee took home eight of a possible 11 first place votes on the way to being chosen as the favorite for the Sun Belt Conference championship, as voted on by the conference coaches. It's the first time that the Blue Raiders have been chosen as the conference favorite since joining the Sun Belt in 2001.

Best in the Belt...

Junior Bryce Brentz was voted as the preseason Sun Belt Player of the Year, and senior Kenneth Roberts took home Pitcher of the Year honors. It marks the first time in Sun Belt history that the Preseason Pitcher and Player of the Year picks have played for the same team. Brentz became the first Blue Raider ever chosen as the Preseason Player of the Year while Roberts became just the second Raider selected as the Preseason Pitcher of the Year.

Junior Tyler Burnett also earned a spot on the Preseason All-Sun Belt team. The trio of Blue Raiders represents the most chosen for the preseason squad since four MIddle Tennessee players were chosen in 2006.

Looking to break more records...

Junior Bryce Brentz currently stands in striking distance of setting several career records. The slugger from Knoxville already sits a top the list in batting average (.393), slugging percentage (.789) and home runs (54). He stands fifth on the total bases list with 412 (record: 483), fifth in runs batted in with 158 (record: 201) and ninth in the runs scored with 157 (record: 215).

In the 2009 campaign, Brentz set school records for highest batting average (.465), hits (107), runs (79), home runs (28), slugging percentage (.930), and total bases (214). The historic season also saw Brentz record the third highest on-base percentage (.535) and second highest number of runs batted in (73).

Senior Blake McDade currently sits fifth in doubles (55) on the all-time list. McDade is also fourth on the career RBI list (161), eighth in singes (155) and is eighth in hits (235).

Sun Belt Competition...

2009 marked the first time that the Blue Raiders have walked home with both the conference regular season and tournament championships since joining the Sun Belt in 2001. In the nine seasons MT has competed in the Sun Belt, the Blue Raiders have earned at least a share of the regular season crown three times (2001, 2004, 2009) and the tournament crown on two occasions (2003 and 2009).

Peterson a top skipper...

Blue Raider baseball head coach Steve Peterson took home a number of awards following the 2009 campaign. A three-time conference Coach of the Year, Peterson was recognized as the state of Tennessee's best collegiate baseball coach by the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association. The American Baseball Coaches Association also named Peterson as the South Central Region Coach of the Year.

Peterson also won his 700th game as the Blue Raiders' head coach last season with a 10-4 win over conference rival Western Kentucky. Peterson's record at Middle Tennessee is 723-558-3. The 723 wins make up over 64% of total wins in Blue Raider baseball history.

Nationally Recognized...

Junior Bryce Brentz and senior Kenneth Roberts both return to Blue Raider Baseball having each won their fair share of both conference and national honors last season.

Brentz, who spent the summer playing for USA Baseball, was a consensus first-team All-American, honored by six different organizations. Brentz was also a semifinalist for the Golden Spikes award, recognizing

the nation's best collegiate baseball player. The Knoxville, Tenn., native took home first team All-Sun Belt and All-Tournament honors. He also received three Sun Belt Player of the Week awards as well.

Kenneth Roberts was recognized as a Second Team All-American by the American Baseball Coaches Association. He earned a place on the All-South Central Region Team by the ABCA. After putting on an impressive dsiplay in the conference tournament, Roberts was named the Most Outstanding Player. He was a First Team All-Conference performer and twice took home Sun Belt Pitcher of the Week awards.

Wearing the Red, White and Blue...

Junior Bryce Brentz spent most of the 2009 season proving he was one of the best collegiate players in the country and further cemented his reputation when he was one of 22 players named to the USA Baseball National Team.

Brentz received the invitation to tryout for the team after posting impressive numbers and recommendations from a number of the nation's top coaches.

Brentz joins Dewon Brazelton as recent Blue Raiders to be named to a USA National team.

No Place Like Home...

Middle Tennessee will play 27 games at Reese Smith Jr. Field this season after playing 31 at home last year, posting the most home victories for a Blue Raider team with 27 and just four losses. The previous record for home wins was set in 1990 as MT went 25-3 at home.

Overall, the Blue Raiders have a 637-328-3 record in home matchups. Since Peterson took over in 1988, he's posted a 394-219 record at Reese Smith Jr. Field.

Team

Dual Sport...

Redshirt sophomore catcher Wes Caldwell is a rarity in college these days, earning varsity letters in two sports for the Blue Raiders.

Caldwell is a wide receiver for the football team last. In 2009 he caught ten balls for 117 yards and helped the Blue Raider football team to a Sun Belt record 10 wins and a New Orleans Bowl victory.

Caldwell has played in nine games for Middle Tennessee. In five at-bats last season, Caldwell batted .400 with two hits, a home run, two RBIs and three runs scored. His first collegiate hit was a single against Memphis when he came in as a pinch runner and stayed in to play outfield.

Local Flavor...

The 2010 edition boast of six players from the city of Murfreesboro, and a remarkable 30 of the 34 players hail from the state of Tennessee. Of the Murfreesboro athletes, three are from Riverdale High School, two are from Oakland High School, and one is from Siegel High School.

Roster By Class...

Middle Tennessee boasts of a roster laden with upperclassmen. There are nine Blue Raider seniors and 12 juniors. There's a solid influx of young talent as the rest of the team is comprised of three sophomores and 10 freshmen.

There are many words to describe Steve Peterson's role as Middle Tennessee's highly successful baseball coach since 1988. Coach, fundraiser, teacher, recruiter, and architect are just a few, but if you are looking for one word to describe the Blue Raiders' longtime skipper, try "winner."

Peterson begins his 23rd season as the school's all-time winningest coach, with 707 victories and a stockpile of conference championships and NCAA Tournament berths to his credit, demonstrating the consistency with which the driven captain has guided the club.

Peterson's drive for excellence has resulted in consistent success and has made Middle Tennessee a model program. The veteran coach has led Middle Tennessee to 11 regular-season conference championships, nine conference tournament titles, and nine NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections in the past seven years. Peterson guided the Blue Raiders to seven consecutive championships – either regular-season or tournament – during one stretch, proving Middle Tennessee doesn't rebuild, it reloads.

Peterson, who enters the 2010 season with a sterling 707-549-3 mark, has produced 14 seasons with 30 or more wins including a school-record 44 victories in 2009. He also has four campaigns of at least 40 wins including 2009's 44-18 record.

Consistent success during Peterson's tenure is a testament to his ability to recruit and develop talent, and the proof was never more evident than in 2001 – the Blue Raiders' first season in the Sun Belt Conference after years of success in the Ohio Valley.

Asked how the move into the Sun Belt, rated one of the nation's top five baseball leagues at the time and consistently a top 10 conference, would change his recruiting philosophy, Peterson quickly responded "Not at all." The 2001 Blue Raiders shared the Sun Belt championship with South Alabama after their first year in the highprofile league, and the chief contributors were many of the same players who led Middle Tennessee to the 2000 OVC championship.

The move to a higher-rated conference certainly helped Middle Tennessee's status. In their first five years in the Sun Belt, Peterson's teams won two regular-season championships and a tournament championship and earned three NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections for the first time in school history.

The 2001 squad earned national acclaim for its pitching and hitting and the season concluded with pitcher Dewon Brazelton being selected as the No. 3 overall pick of the Tampa Bay Devil Rays in the

Major League Baseball First-Year Amateur Player Draft. Brazelton was one of six players from the team to earn a spot on a professional baseball roster that season.

A program cannot enjoy consistent success without quality players and Peterson, a three-time Coach of the Year, has not only made a habit of making sure Middle Tennessee has its share of quality performers but he's also won by signing top prep players and developing them at the college level. He has coached a Sun Belt Player of the Year and six OVC Players of the Year, a Sun Belt Pitcher of the Year and an OVC Pitcher of the Year, two First-Team All-Americans, five Third-Team All-Americans, four Freshman All-Americans, and 43 first-team All-Conference performers.

Players who have honed their skills under Peterson also have had outstanding success continuing their careers at the professional level. Professional baseball has seen 56 former Peterson performers earning the chance to play at the game's highest level, with four making their way to the Major Leagues.

Peterson's recruits have established most of the offensive records held at Middle Tennessee and seven players he has developed have hit .400 or better in a season. He has also coached the school's single-season and career home run record holders. His 2009 squad established the all-time record for batting average with .340.

Peterson's players have been solid on the field at the collegiate level and have continued their careers professionally, and a large majority have taken skills and fundamentals learned at Middle Tennessee and are earning a living as coaches at various levels. Thirtyone former Blue Raiders are currently coaching at the high school, college, or professional levels.

Peterson's peers have recognized his achievements and contributions to the game by bestowing several honors on him. He was named the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association College Coach of the Year in 1992, 2000 and 2009. Peterson received his first ABCA Region Coach of the Year honor in 2009 after guiding the Blue Raiders in their record breaking season. He was also inducted into the Rutherford County Old Timers Baseball Hall of Fame in 2003. In 2007, Peterson was inducted into the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Associa-

tion Hall of Fame and the Huntsville-Madison County (AL) Athletic Hall of Fame in April of 2009.

Fellow coaches have named Peterson Coach of the Year on three occasions - twice in the Ohio Valley and again in 2004, his first such honor in the Sun Belt.

Peterson's outgoing and personable style has made him a hit with fans, boosters, players, and recruits alike. Baseball enthusiasts throughout the Middle Tennessee community clearly appreciate his hard-nosed and aggressive style of coaching, and fans continue to flock to Reese Smith Field at a record pace.

The Blue Raiders established a single-game attendance record in 2001 at Reese Smith Field with a crowd of 2,733 against South Alabama. The team went on to set the single-season attendance mark that year with 26,218 coming through the gates. The 2001 squad saw 15 crowds of 1,000 or more during the season. Those numbers were surpassed in 2004 when the team set a single-game attendance record of 3,020 against Vanderbilt and set a new single-season attendance mark of 30,319, ranking 46th nationally. Fifteen contests drew more than 1,000 patrons during the record-setting campaign.

Not only has Peterson been a winner on the field but he's also been a successful fundraiser during his career. Events such as the annual Chuck Taylor Golf Tournament, the Groundhog Day Luncheon, and the Grand Slam Fish Fry in the fall have become mainstays on calendars of Blue Raider baseball supporters across middle Tennessee and have raised thousands of dollars for the improvement of Blue Raider baseball.

Peterson spearheaded the efforts to pay for the construction of the Stephen B. Smith Clubhouse and Indoor Training Facility, which opened its doors in 1998. One look inside the facility shows the time and effort spent toward this endeavor. It has become known as one of the finest collegiate clubhouses and training facilities in the coun-

Reese Smith Field has also benefited from Peterson's fundraising abilities. He has helped transform the park into a fan-friendly area by leading efforts to expand the seating area, add an information center just inside the gate, and improve restroom and concession facilities.

Peterson guided efforts during the summer of 2001 to enlarge the dugouts at Reese Smith Field. He also spearheaded a capital campaign to do significant remodeling of the concession stand, improve and expand restroom facilities, and added a modern press box to accommodate radio, television, and print media.

While Peterson has spent 22 seasons leading the Middle Tennessee baseball program, his tenure with the program is much longer. He took two separate tours with the Blue Raiders as an assistant coach under John Stanford before becoming the team's head coach. During 1976-78 and 1985-87, he helped the Blue Raiders win two OVC titles and four Southern Division crowns.

During the interim, Peterson served as head coach at Roane State Community College in Harriman, Tenn. During his tenure from 1979 to 1984, Peterson's teams won a Tennessee state title in 1981, and he was twice named TJCAA Coach of the Year (1981, '84). While at Roane State, Peterson put together a sparkling record of 153-96 for a .614 winning percentage.

A native of Huntsville, Ala., Peterson stood out as a catcher under the legendary Rudy Abbott at Jacksonville State. He earned his bachelor's from Jacksonville State in 1973 and later earned a master's from Middle Tennessee in 1977.

Peterson is married to the former Rita Albert and the couple has three children, Jill, Jenny, and John, and three grandchildren. Away from the diamond, Peterson enjoys fishing for smallmouth bass.
