MURFREESBORO, Tenn. -Jonathan Guillou finished third in the 1500-meters and Pete Senatus was fourth in the intermediate hurdles, leading the Middle Tennessee contingent on a cold and windy Saturday at the Ole Miss Invitational in Oxford, Miss. Guillou placed third in the 1500 with a time of 4:01.44, while Senatus was fourth in the 400-meter hurdles with a mark of 54.10. Douglas was ninth in the triple jump with a mark of 38-5.5. The Middle Tennessee track teams will
again be split next weekend, with part of the squad traveling to Knoxville, Tenn., for the Sea Ray
Relays and the remainder of the team participating in the Boston-Moon Invitational in Nashville,
