

# Eight-match homestand begins Saturday

## Blue Raiders host Cajuns at 11 a.m. in tilt moved to Nashville

The Middle Tennessee women's tennis team will return to action when it opens an eight-match homestand at 11 a.m. Saturday by playing host to Louisiana at the Nashboro Village Indoor Courts in Nashville, Tenn.

"We are excited about getting back to playing matches, especially at home," head coach Melissa Schaub said. "It has been a good week of practices and everyone is looking forward to playing in front of our home fans, who support us so much."

The Blue Raiders enter the match with a 4-3 record with the three setbacks coming to nationally-ranked opponents. Middle Tennessee is 2-0 at home this season, including its only previous outdoor home contest, a 6-1 decision against Murray State Feb. 18.

Sophomore Yuiiri Nomoto continues to pace the squad in singles action with her 5-2 ledger at the No. 1 spot. Juniors Marietta Bigus and Carla Nava are both 4-3 at the No. 2 and 3 positions, respectively.

In doubles action, both the No. 1 and 2 slots have contributed 4-3 records, although the top position has seen two different pairs combine for the mark.

The Ragin' Cajuns are 5-4 on the campaign and knocked off Florida Atlantic 4-2 in their last match Sunday. Louisiana also has faced a pair of nationally-ranked foes, dropping both contests.

The Sun Belt Conference does not recognize a formal league schedule, therefore, a league win or



loss will not be determined at the conclusion of the match.
