

# Middle Tennessee looks to regroup Sunday

## Match 5 of 8 at home in a row for Blue Raiders

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### **MURFREESBORO, Tenn. -**

Middle Tennessee women's tennis will look to bounce back from a loss Friday when it plays host to Memphis in the fifth of eight straight home matches Sunday at Noon at the Buck Bouldin Tennis Center.

"We need to come out with confidence and be ready to compete," head coach Melissa Schaub said. "There have been some encouraging signs lately, but we need to continue to develop those and put forth the effort it takes to win."

The Blue Raiders dropped a 5-2 decision to Arkansas State Friday. After starting with claiming the doubles point, Middle Tennessee was unable to sustain the momentum and was victorious just once in singles action. Junior Carla Nava was the lone Blue Raider to win in singles before the Red Wolves rallied for five-straight victories to claim the triumph.



Memphis owns a 9-6 record entering the contest after defeating Illinois State and Detroit in a pair of matches last Saturday. The Lady Tigers have won six consecutive outings overall and feature a trio of players with double-digit singles victories, all at the top-three positions.

Middle Tennessee lost last year's meeting, a 6-1 setback in Memphis, April 3.
