### This Week In Blue Raider Baseball...

The Middle Tennessee baseball team is coming off their second consecutive Sun Belt series win of the season, taking two out of three from visiting ULM at Reese Smith Jr. Field last weekend. The Blue Raiders won 15-9 on Friday and rebounded from an 8-3 setback on Saturday to take home the finale 6-2 on Sunday.

### Middle Tennessee in April...

Middle Tennessee is 9-9 this season in April. Under the direction of head coach Steve Peterson, Middle Tennessee has been remarkably successful, posting an overall record of 275-201, including a 112-102 record on the road and a 163-104 mark at home.



### Scouting the Red Wolves...

Arkansas State enters Friday with a 19-24 record including a 7-11 mark in Southeastern Conference play, and are coming off of winning two out of three over Florida Atlantic at home. The Red Wolves are 13-12 at Tomlinson Stadium this season.

Todd Baumgartner has been the engine of the Red Wolf offense this season, boasting of a .353 average and leads the team in runs scored (41), doubles (15) and home runs (6). Ryan Emery is hitting .303 and has knocked in a team-best 30 runs.

The Blue Raiders are slated to face off against Andy Ferguson, Brad Allen and Jacob Lee on the mound. Lee and Ferguson have been especially impressive for ASU, holding ERAs of 2.08 and 3.33, respectively with Ferguson holding opposing hitters to a .224 batting average. Lee carries a 4-3 record, Ferguson is 4-2, and Allen is 2-4.

This weekend marks the 32nd, 33rd and 34th meeting between the Blue Raiders and Red Wolves under the direction of head coach Steve Peterson. Middle Tennessee holds an overall record of 23-8 in the series with 10-5 mark in Jonesboro, winning two out of three at Tomlinson Stadium last season.

### Will Skinner named SBC Player of the Week...

Senior Hunter Adkins was named Sun Belt Player of the Week on Monday after helping the Blue Raiders to three victories with some impressive offensive numbers. The award is a first for Skinner and a first for the Middle Tennessee program this season.

Skinner recorded three home runs, seven runs scored and seven runs batted in over a span of five games to lead the Blue Raiders to a 3-2 victory. The senior also boasted of a .526 average to go along with an outstanding 1.105 slugging percentage.

### Drake picks up first career win...

Matthew Drake didn't enter 2011 as a pitcher, but due to injuries, the junior has now become a dependable arm for the Blue Raiders. Drake pitched a perfect four and a third on April 20 at Memphis, earning his first career win and shutout after the game was called in five innings due to inclement weather.

### Acker key in streak...

Tyler Acker isn't an everyday starter at catcher, but the senior is on fire behind the plate. The Nashville native caught shutouts in three consecutive starts in April, helping call both victories over Troy and a win at Memphis.

### **Hunter Adkins named SBC Pitcher of the Week...**

Sophomore Hunter Adkins was named Sun Belt Pitcher of the Week on Monday after tossing eight scoreless innings against 18th-ranked Troy on Saturday.

The outing handed MT their first SBC Pitcher of the Week this season, and Adkins became just the second sophomore in school history to take home the honors since joining the conference in 2001.

### Blue Raiders knock off Troy...

On April 16 and 17, Middle Tennessee notched back-to-back shutout victories over 18th-ranked Troy, giving the Blue Raiders their first victories over a ranked opponent since beating No. 1 Vanderbilt in the 2007 season. The wins also marked the first back-to-back shutouts for Middle Tennessee since holding New Orleans scoreless for three consecutive games in the 2004 season.

### Skinner's power surge...

Senior Will Skinner is having a memorable season individually with this hometown Blue Raiders, tallying 11 home runs this season. The Murfreesboro native leads the team with a .370 average, 34 runs batted in, and a .660 slugging percentage.

### Peterson notches 900th win...

With Middle Tennessee's 7-5 win over Southern Illinois, head coach Steve Peterson recorded his 900th career win. Peterson recorded another milestone on April 3, 2011 when he picked up his 750 win at Middle Tennessee when he led his team to a 13-11win over South Alabama in 10 innings. Peterson is now 904-690-3 in his career, including a 751-594-3 mark in 23-plus years at Middle Tennessee.

### No Place Like Home...

Middle Tennessee will play 29 games at Reese Smith Jr. Field this season after playing 30 at home last year, posting a 21-9 record. The record for home wins was set in 2009 as MT went 27-4. Since Peterson took over in 1988, MT holds an overall record of 424-239 in home contests at Reese Smith Jr. Field.

### Gunning for state supremacy...

The Blue Raiders will play 14 games vs. in-state foes this season. This is not new territory for MT as the school has played at least 12 games vs. Tennessee foes each year under the direction of head coach Steve Peterson. This season, the Blue Raiders are 4-6 with wins against Tennessee Tech, Austin Peay and Memphis.

Since Peterson took the reins of the program in 1988, MT holds an overall 244-159-1 mark vs. colleges in Tennessee, and a 132-64 record in Murfreesboro.

#### Local Flavor...

The 2010 edition boast of four players from the city of Murfreesboro, and a remarkable 26 of the 33 players hail from the state of Tennessee. Of the Murfreesboro athletes, two are from Riverdale High School, one is from Oakland and one is from Siegel.

### **Roster By Class...**

Middle Tennessee boasts of a roster laden with underclassmen. Ther are nine Blue Raider seniors and three juniors. 12 sophomores make up the largest class, and there are also nine freshmen.

### **Blue Raiders picked seventh**

After losing a number of talented players due to the MLB Draft and graduation last season, Middle Tennessee will be looking to a crop of fresh faces to carry the load this season.

The SBC preseason coaches poll is a reflection of that as the Blue Raiders were chosen seventh, due in part to the untested hands of many of the expected starters for 2011. No Blue Raiders were picked to the Preseason All-SBC Team.

### Seven Blue Raiders head to the pros...

A school record seven players were selected in the 2010 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft. Bryce Brentz was selected 36th overall by the Boston Red Sox. He became the highest Blue Raider draftee since Dewon Brazelton was selected third overall in 2001.

Five more players were drafted in day two. Alex McClure, who sat out the 2010 season due to the NCAA transfer rule, was picked in the 11th round by the Kansas City Royals. Tyler Burnett (Houston Astros) and Justin Miller (Washington Nationals) were selected in the 17th and 18th rounds, respectively, after strong junior campaigns. Graduating seniors Blake McDade and Kenneth Roberts were both taken by the Colorado Rockies later in the day.

On the third and final day, Drew Robertson was selected by the Royals in the 46th round.

The seven draftees breaks the previous record, set in the 2001 and 2004 seasons, which each saw four Blue Raiders get drafted.

### **Sun Belt Competition...**

The Blue Raiders finished in third place in the Sun Belt in 2010 with an 18-12 record. Overall, Middle Tennessee holds a 142-120 record in Sun Belt play since joining the league in 2001, including a 39-20 mark over the last two seasons.

In the ten seasons MT has competed in the Sun Belt, the Blue Raiders have earned at least a share of the regular season crown four times (2001, 2003, 2004, 2009) and the tournament crown on two occasions. (2003 and 2009).

There are many words to describe Steve Peterson's role as Middle Tennessee's highly successful baseball coach since 1988. Coach, fundraiser, teacher, recruiter, and architect are just a few, but if you are looking for one word to describe the Blue Raiders' longtime skipper, try "winner."

Peterson begins his 24th season as the school's all-time winningest coach, with 742 victories and a stockpile of conference championships and NCAA Tournament berths to his credit, demonstrating the consistency with which the driven captain has guided the club.

Peterson's drive for excellence has resulted in consistent success and has made Middle Tennessee a model program. The veteran coach has led Middle Tennessee to 11 regular-season conference championships, nine conference tournament titles, and nine NCAA Regional berths including two at-large selections in the past seven years. Peterson guided the Blue Raiders to seven consecutive championships – either regular-season or tournament – during one stretch, proving Middle Tennessee doesn't rebuild, it reloads.

Peterson, who enters the 2011 season with a sterling 742-572-3 mark, has produced 15 seasons with 30 or more wins including a school-record 44 victories in 2009. He also has four campaigns of at least 40 wins including 2009s 44-18 record.

Consistent success during Peterson's tenure is a testament to his ability to recruit and develop talent, and the proof was never more evident than in 2001 – the Blue Raiders' first season in the Sun Belt Conference after years of success in the Ohio Valley.

Asked how the move into the Sun Belt, rated one of the nation's top five baseball leagues at the time and consistently a top 10 conference, would change his recruiting philosophy, Peterson quickly responded "Not at all." The 2001 Blue Raiders shared the Sun Belt championship with South Alabama after their first year in the high-profile league, and the chief con-

tributors were many of the same players who led Middle Tennessee to the 2000 OVC championship.

The move to a higher-rated conference certainly helped Middle Tennessee's status. In their first five years in the Sun Belt, Peterson's teams won two regular season championships and a tournament championship and earned three NCAA Regional berths including

all pick of the Tampa Bay Devil Rays in the Major League Baseball First-Year Amateur Player Draft. Brazelton was one of six players from the team to earn a spot on a professional baseball roster that season.

A program cannot enjoy consistent success without quality players and Peterson, a three-time Coach of the Year, has not only made a habit of making sure Middle Tennessee has its share of quality performers but he's also won by signing top prep players and developing them at the college level. He has coached a Sun Belt Player of the Year and six OVC Players of the Year, a Sun Belt Pitcher of the Year and an OVC Pitcher of the Year, two First-Team All-Americans, five Third-Team All-Americans, four Freshman All-Americans, and 43 first-team All-Conference performers.

Players who have honed their skills under Peterson also have had outstanding success continuing their careers at the professional level. Professional baseball has seen 59 former Peterson performers earning the chance to play at the game's highest level, with four making their way to the Major Leagues.

Peterson's recruits have established most of the offensive records held at Middle Tennessee and seven players he has developed have hit .400 or better in a season. He has also coached the school's single-season and career home run record holders. His 2009 squad established the all-time record for batting average with .340.

Peterson's players have been solid on the field at the collegiate level and have continued their careers professionally, and a large majority have taken skills and fundamentals learned at Middle Tennessee and are earning a living as coaches at various levels. Thirty-one former Blue Raiders are currently coaching at the high school, college, or professional levels.

Peterson's peers have recognized his achievements and contributions to the game by bestowing several honors on him. He was named the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association College Coach of the Year in 1992, 2000 and 2009. Peterson received his first ABCA Region Coach of the Year honor in 2009 after guiding the Blue Raiders in their record-breaking season. He was also inducted into the Rutherford County Old Timers Baseball Hall of Fame in 2003. In 2007, Peterson was inducted into the Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame and the Huntsville-Madison County (AL) Athletic Hall of Fame in April of 2009. In the fall of 2010, Peterson was inducted into the Blue Raider Hall of Fame by Middle Tennessee State University.

Fellow coaches have named Peterson Coach of the Year on three occasions – twice in the Ohio Valley and again in 2004, his first such honor in the Sun Belt.

Peterson's outgoing and personable style has made him a hit with fans, boosters, players, and recruits alike. Baseball enthusiasts throughout the Middle Tennessee community clearly appreciate his hard-nosed and aggressive style of coaching, and fans continue to flock to Reese Smith Field at a record pace.

The Blue Raiders established a single-game attendance record in 2001 at Reese Smith Field with a crowd of 2,733 against South Alabama. The team went on to set the single-season attendance mark that year with 26,218 coming through the gates. The 2001 squad saw 15 crowds of 1,000 or more during the season. Those numbers were surpassed in 2004 when the team set a single-game attendance record of

3,020 against Vanderbilt and set a new single-season attendance mark of 30,319, ranking 46th nationally. Fifteen contests drew more than 1,000 patrons during the record-setting campaign.

Not only has Peterson been a winner on the field but he's also been a successful fundraiser during his career. Events such as the annual Chuck Taylor Golf Tournament, the Groundhog Day Luncheon, and the Grand Slam Fish Fry in the fall have become mainstays on calendars of Blue Raider baseball supporters across middle Tennessee and have raised thousands of dollars for the improvement of Blue Raider baseball.

Peterson spearheaded the efforts to pay for the construction of the Stephen B. Smith Clubhouse and Indoor Training Facility, which opened its doors in 1998. One look inside the facility shows the time and effort spent toward this endeavor. It has become known as one of the finest collegiate clubhouses and training facilities in the country.

Reese Smith Jr. Field has also benefited from Peterson's fundraising abilities. He has helped transform the park into a fan-friendly area by leading efforts to expand the seating area, add an information center just inside the gate, and improve restroom and concession facilities.

Peterson guided efforts during the summer of 2001 to enlarge the dugouts at Reese Smith Field. He also spearheaded a capital campaign to do significant remodeling of the concession stand, improve and expand restroom facilities, and added a modern press box to accommodate radio, television, and print media.

While Peterson has spent 23 seasons leading the Middle Tennessee baseball program, his tenure with the program is much longer. He took two separate tours with the Blue Raiders as an assistant coach under John Stanford before becoming the team's head coach. During 1976-78 and 1985-87, he helped the Blue Raiders win two OVC titles and four Southern Division crowns.

During the interim, Peterson served as head coach at Roane State Community College in Harriman, Tenn. During his tenure from 1979 to 1984, Peterson's teams won a Tennessee state title in 1981, and he was twice named TJCAA Coach of the Year (1981, '84). While at Roane State, Peterson put together a sparkling record of 153-96 for a .614 winning percentage.

A native of Huntsville, Ala., Peterson stood out as a catcher under the legendary Rudy Abbott at Jacksonville State. He earned his bachelor's from Jacksonville State in 1973 and later earned a master's from Middle Tennessee in 1977.

Peterson is married to the former Rita Albert and the couple has three children, Jill, Jenny, and John, and four grandchildren. Away from the diamond, Peterson enjoys fishing for smallmouth bass.
