- ▶ THE SERIES: Saturday's game between Middle Tennessee and Troy will be the 19th meeting on the gridiron between the two schools. The series, which began in 1936, is led by MT, 11-7. Middle Tennessee won the first eight meetings before Troy picked up its first win in 1999. The Trojans have won the last five meetings and six of the last seven. The Blue Raiders have a mark of 4-3 at Troy with the last win coming in 2005.
- ▶ **CONFERENCE OPENERS:** Middle Tennessee is beginning its 11th season of Sun Belt Conference football and own a 5-5 record in league openers. The Blue Raiders had wins in 2001, 2003, 2006, 2009, and 2010 with 2001 and 2006 being league championship seasons and 2009 producing the league's first 10-win campaign. MT also advanced to a bowl game to end the 2010 season. Overall, MT is 3-3 in conference openers on the road.
- ▶ BATTLE OF THE PALLADIUM: Greek Mythology holds that The Palladium is a wooden statue that fell from the Heavens. It was kept at the Temple of Athena in the city of Troy. According to legend, as long as The Palladium was preserved within the walls of the city, Troy would be safe and could not be taken. However, a "Raider" by the name of Odysseus - also known as the Raider of Cities - stole The Palladium during the Trojan War leading to the fall of Troy. In the spirit of the Blue Raiders and Trojans Greek mythology link, Middle Tennessee and Troy compete in The Battle for The Palladium during their annual Sun Belt Conference game. Legend dictates the winner of The Palladium gains an unknown and unexplainable advantage over the other making it more difficult to regain control during future battles. The history between the two schools dates back to 1936 with the Blue Raiders owning an 11-7 advantage in the series. Many believe losing possession of The Palladium has an enduring effect, mystically influencing other athletic events throughout the year matching the Trojans and Raiders. It's just another factor to overcome in this rivalry game between Middle Tennessee and Troy.
- ▶ STOCK MOVING UP LIST: Middle Tennessee Head Coach Rick Stockstill needs one more win to tie Andy McCollum for fourth place on the all-time wins list. Stockstill owns 33 victories and is tied with Frank Faulkinberry for fifth but needs just three wins this year to move past Alfred Miles for third. Charles Murphy (1947-68) is the all-time winningest coach at Middle Tennessee with a mark of 155-63-8.
- ▶ MCDONALD CHASING 1.000: Senior WR Sancho

McDonald enters the Troy game needing just 11 more receiving yards to reach the 1,000-yard mark for his career. McDonald owns 989 yards on 80 receptions and also needs 250 more yards to crack Middle Tennessee's top 10.

- ▶ PROTECTING LOGAN: For the second year in a row, the Blue Raider offensive line has not allowed a sack in the season's first two games. MT did not give up a sack against Minnesota and Austin Peay to begin 2010 and have not allowed one this year following games against Purdue and Georgia Tech. In fact, the Blue Raiders are one of just 10 teams nationally that have not allowed a sack this season. Since going FBS in 1999, Middle Tennessee has never gone three straight games without giving up a sack.
- ▶ RUSSELL TOPS 1,000: KR Eric Russell became just the sixth player in school history to reach the 1,000-yard mark in career kickoff return yards with 93 yards in the loss to Georgia Tech. Russell, with 1,020 career yards, currently ranks sixth on the all-time list but needs only 49 more yards to take over third place from Walter Dunson (1,068 yards).
- ▶ QUICK HITTERS FROM GT: LB Darin Davis made his team leading 15th straight start ... OT Mike Williams made his team-leading 38th career start ... After making his first career start at center vs Purdue, Alex Stuart started at right tackle against GT ... WR Shane Blissard extended his streak to 12 straight games with at least one reception ... WR Reggie Whatley made his first career reception in the second quarter for 17 yards ... He finished with three grabs for 40 yards ... DT Morris Moore recorded the first sack of his career at the end of the first half ... R-Freshman Isaiah Anderson started at right tackle to begin the second half in place of Alex Stuart ... Jiajuan Fennell recorded his first career fumble recovery in the fourth quarter, a miscue he forced.
- ▶ CALIFORNIA CONNECTION: The Blue Raiders get the majority of its players from Georgia and Florida but they have also developed a nice link to California. MT currently has 10 players on its roster from California and four of those started last week at Purdue and seven played. The starters were QB Logan Kilgore, CB T.L. Edwards, S Eric Russell, and CB Arness Ikner.

APR SUCCESS

Middle Tennessee's success in the Academic Progress Rate (APR) has been unparalleled under Head Coach Rick Stockstill. When he arrived in 2006 the Blue Raiders had an APR score of just 892 and today it stands at **990**. Recently, MT was one of just **14** FBS football programs recognized by the NCAA during the association's 2011 Public Recognition Awards for APR score and Stockstill was ranked **10th** nationally among FBS coaches in APR performance. On top of that, the program tied for **4th** nationally among FBS teams with an APR score of **988** for the 2009-10 year.

- ▶ FENNELL OFF TO STRONG START: Redshirt freshman DE Jiajuan Fennell has been the equivalent of a stat sheet stuffer in basketball after his first two collegiate football games. In two games, he has six tackles (5 solos), 3 TFLs, 2 forced fumbles, a fumble recovery, and a pass breakup. The future is definitely bright for the South Pittsburg, TN native who is tied for 9th nationally in TFLs.
- ▶ KILGORE HAS CAREER DAY: Sophomore QB Logan Kilgore enjoyed a strong opener at Purdue by throwing for a career-high 330 yards and connecting with nine different receivers. The Rocklin, CA, native completed a personal-best 27 passes on 45 attempts to go with a career-best two touchdown passes. The 330 yards went down as the fourth-most by a QB under Rick Stockstill and the most on opening day in school history.
- ▶ **RUSSELL SHINES IN OPENER:** In his first collegiate start, senior Eric Russell had a game to remember at Purdue. The Cerritos, CA, product registered a career-high 31st nationally, and topped the 200-yard mark six times.



13 tackles, including 11 solo stops, while also adding his first career interception and quarterback sack to earn SBC Defensive Player of the Week honors. Russell's interception and sack both ended Purdue drives that were in Blue Raider territory. If that was not enough, Russell also finished with a game-high 133 all-purpose yards.

▶ RUNNING RAIDERS: After averaging just 124.5 yards a game on the ground during the first three years of the Rick Stockstill era, the Blue Raiders put an emphasis on the ground attack which has now been one of the best in the nation the past two years. The Blue Raiders churned up 186.0 yards per game in 2009 to rank 27th nationally while going over the 200-yard mark five times. In 2010, the Blue Raiders averaged 180.8 yards a game to rank 31st nationally, and topped the 200-yard mark six times.

Over the past 28 games, MT is averaging 180.2 yards a game on the ground and has topped the 200-yard mark 11 times.

- ▶ BEYAH, MCDONALD CHASING GOOD COMPANY: Senior wide receivers Malcolm Beyah and Sancho McDonald are on pace to become just the third duo of Blue Raider receivers to reach the 100-catch plateau and just the second to eclipse 1,000 yards. McDonald owns 80 receptions for 989 yards while Beyah has 76 catches for 1,096 yards. Kendall Newson (1998-2001) and Tyrone Calico (1999-2002) are the only pair to reach 100 catches and 1,000 yards while playing together. The only other tandem to reach 100 receptions at the same time was Cleannord Saintil (2004-2005) and Chris Henry (2002-2005).
- ▶ EXPERIENCED O-LINE: Middle Tennessee returns four starters along the offensive line in what may be the most experienced position on the field. The unit has combined for 114 career starts with senior Mike Williams leading the entire team with 38 starts. In fact, the left side of the line with Williams and Brandon McLeroy have combined for 69 starts. Other linemen with starts are: Colin Boss (17), Preston Bailey (12), Alex Stuart (10), Jadareius Hamlin (3), and Josh Walker (3).
- ▶ TURNOVERS BIG EMPHASIS IN OFFSEASON: Middle Tennessee gift wrapped six of its seven losses to the opposition because of turnovers in 2010 so it has been a point of emphasis since January. Normally one of the best in the country in turnover margin, the Blue Raiders were uncharacteristically 120th nationally with a margin

- of -1.46. Middle Tennessee finished with 38 total turnovers (24 INT, 14 fumbles) which went down as the most by a Blue Raider team since the 1981 squad also had 38 (22 INT, 16 fumbles).
- ▶ DISRUPTIVE DEFENSE: Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raider defense is all about being disruptive, pressuring the quarterback, and putting the offense behind the chains. In 2010, the Blue Raiders ranked 17th nationally in quarterback sacks and 10th nationally in tackles for loss. The Blue Raiders' 34 sacks in 2010 ranked third-most in a single season and just four off the school record of 38 set in 2009. Their 96 tackles for loss was third on the all-time list. Here is a look at the national rankings in sacks and tackles for loss under Stockstill:

- ▶ BLOCK PARTY: Rick Stockstill teams have always emphasized special teams play and how it can change a game. Under Stockstill, the Blue Raiders have blocked 20 kicks in 65 games. However, over the past 28 games MT has rejected 14 kicks with 9 being field goals, 3 on punts, and 2 PATs. Despite all the blocks during that span, MT only has one player on its current roster that has ever recorded a blocked kick. Senior SaCoby Carter blocked a punt against FAU in 2009.
- ▶ ONE POINT MAGIC: Head Coach Rick Stockstill seems to have a little magic going in tight games. In his six years at the helm, the Blue Raiders are an impressive 5-1

▶ Since he arrived to take over the Middle Tennessee program, Rick Stockstill has elevated the Blue Raiders to an unprecedented level. During his short tenure, the Blue Raiders have captured a league title, won the 2009 New Orleans Bowl, made three bowl appearances, appeared on national television a record and Sun Belt-best 16 times, and produced six of the top eight crowds in Floyd Stadium history.

▶ Before arriving at Middle Tennessee, Stockstill served as an assistant coach at South Carolina, East Carolina, Clemson, Central Florida, and Bethune-Cookman. He has coached under the likes of Bobby Bowden, Tommy Bowden, Danny Ford, Ken Hatfield, Lou Holtz, Steve Spurrier, and Tommy West.

▶ A 1982 graduate of Florida State, Stockstill was the Seminoles guarterback under Bobby Bowden from 1977 to 1982 where he was an honorable mention All-American and played in three bowl games.

▶ SCORING ON THE GROUND: Middle Tennessee had 41 offensive touchdowns in 2010 and 32 of the scores came on the ground. The 32 scores rank as the most in the Rick Stockstill era and the most by the Blue Raiders since they registered 32 in 2001. MT has three rushing scores in 2011.

Most Points in 2nd Half: 41 vs Tennessee Tech in 2006

▶ PUNTING DUO WORKS: It's not often you utilize two punters the way Middle Tennessee does but it seems to work. Josh Davis and Nathaniel Toulson combined for 74 punts in 2010 and a 41.9-yard average but more importantly, 27 of the 74 punts were downed inside the opponent's 20-yard line. Davis, who went on to earn second team all-conference honors, placed 19 of his 58 punts inside the 20 while Toulson put eight of his 16 kicks inside the 20-yard line with six actually being inside the 5-yard line. In 2011, the duo has combined for 10 punts, a 42.3-yard average, and five punts have been downed inside the 20. The Blue Raiders rank 25th nationally in net punting at 39.5.

▶ TURNOVER BATTLE STORY: Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders have always excelled in the important turnover margin department until 2010. In 64 games of the Stockstill era, MT is +15 in turnover margin. However, MT was an uncanny -1.46 in turnover margin in 2010. MT is -1 in 2011.

▶ **GENDREAU MR. CLUTCH:** Senior place-kicker Alan Gendreau must have ice in his veins because he has proven to be quite a cool customer during key moments for the Blue Raiders. In 2008, he provided the dramatic game-winning point following a "Hail Mary" against FAU with no time remaining then in 2009 he nailed a 19-yard field goal with no time left to give the Blue Raiders an upset of Maryland on the road.

▶ MOST WINS IN SUN BELT HISTORY: Middle Tennessee has an overall mark of 43-28 in Sun Belt action all-time, including a 25-11 record at home and an 18-17 mark on the road. Middle Tennessee is 25-12 in league games under Rick Stockstill and 12-7 on the road. The 43 league wins rank as the most victories in Sun Belt history with Troy second at 40.

▶ SUN BELT VS BIG SIX: Since the Sun Belt added football in 2001, the league has picked up 13 wins against teams from the Big Six conferences. The league has had at least one win against the Big Six every year except 2006 and 2010 and had two wins in 2008 and 2009. MT owns five of those wins to lead the league.

▶ 100 IS KEY: Being able to run the football is paramount, especially at Middle Tennessee. During its history, Middle Tennessee owns an impressive 136-48-1 (.738) record when a back gains 100 or more yards rushing. Under Rick Stockstill, a Blue Raider has reached the 100-yard mark 12 times and the team has an 11-1 mark in those games.

▶ ALL THREE PHASES: Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders have scored in all three phases of the game on two occasions. They accomplished the feat in Stockstill's first season against FAU on November 4, 2006, and then did it a second time last year at WKU. Both times MT came away with a victory.

▶ GOING OVERTIME: Middle Tennessee enters the Troy game having competed in four overtime games as a member of I-A (FBS) and is 2-2 in those contests. The Blue Raiders had one overtime contest in 2000 and played three in 2003. In 2003, the Blue Raiders lost in one overtime at No. 23 Missouri, then bounced back to take an overtime win at Idaho before losing a four overtime game at home against UL-Lafayette. The four overtime loss to ULL was the longest game in the history of MT football and was the longest in the history of the SBC at the time.

▶ GIVE ME 30: Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders are virtually a lock for victory if they put up 30 points or more. MT is 23-1 under Stockstill when scoring 30 points, including a perfect 9-0 mark in 2009. The lone loss came at Louisville in 2007 when the Blue Raiders fell, 58-52.

▶ ACADEMICS: TOP PRIORITY AT MT: Academic success at Middle Tennessee has been a high priority for sixth year coach Rick Stockstill. Under his reign, the Blue Raiders have seen 82 of 87 student-athletes earn their

WEST LAFAYETTE, IN - Middle Tennessee led for much of the day, but a last-minute touchdown and blocked field goal allowed Big Ten foe Purdue to escape with a 27-24 victory in front of 42,110 at Ross-Ade Stadium in West Lafayette, Ind. The Blue Raiders had one last chance to force the first overtime contest in the Rick Stockstill era but were denied on the game's final play.

Quarterback Logan Kilgore led the MT offense with 330 yards on 27-of-45 with two touch-downs and just one interception. He found nine different receivers, a pack paced by Tavarres Jefferson with a career-best seven catches for 61 yards. Malcolm Beyah, Sancho McDonald and Benny Cunningham collected four receptions apiece with Beyah topping the squad with 89 yards.

Cunningham was the leading ground gainer with 65 yards on 14 attempts. His total equaled exactly one-half of the Blue Raiders' team accumulation.

Eric Russell set the bar on the defense with 13 tackles, including 11 stops and one for loss which was a sack. He also grabbed the lone MT interception. Craig Allen was next with nine tackles, three more than T.L. Edwards' half dozen.

Logan Kilgore led the Blue Raiders in passing with 114 yards on 16-of-28. Jeff Murphy added 54 yards on 5-of-6, while Andrew Banks was 1-of-1 for 27 yards through the air.

Sancho McDonald grabbed a game-high five receptions for 44 yards, including the squad's only scoring catch. He was one of nine different Middle Tennessee players with a catch.

Defensively, Omar McLendon had a career night, collecting a personal-best 10 tackles, including eight solo stops. He was the only player for either team to reach double-digit tackles.

Georgia Tech was led offensively by Synjyn Days and David Sims with 91 yards on the ground apiece. The pair guided the triple-option rushing attack to 382 yards on 65 carries and five touchdowns

GT was also efficient through the air, as starter Tevin Washington hit on 5-of-8 passes for 202 yards and a pair of scores.
