- Noteworthy: Although the two schools have never met, LMU head coach Max Good is quite familiar with MT from his head coaching days at Eastern Kentucky from 1981-89 when both schools were a member of the Ohio Valley Conference. The Blue Raiders were 14-6 against Good during his EKU tenure.

BLUE RAIDER FASTBREAK POINTS

- MT shot 55.1 (27-49) percent in the season-opener against Austin Peay, marking the first time since Dec. 18, 2010 vs. Evansville the Blue Raiders surpassed the 55-percent mark. In that contest, MT shot .580 (29-50).
- Three of the Blue Raiders' starting five in the season-opener transferred to MT and made their debut on Friday. Senior forward LaRon Dendy (lowa State) and junior guards Bruce Massey (Dodge City CC) and Marcos Knight (Chipola JC) each earned the starting nod, while two additional newcomers came off the bench. Junior forward Raymond Cintron (Mississippi Gulf Coast JC) and freshman forward Jacquez Rozier each saw time in the opener.
- The Blue Raiders were picked to finish second in the Sun Belt East Division by the league's head coaches in the preseason poll.
- Junior guard Jason Jones was selected to the 2011-12 Preseason All-Sun Belt Team by the league's head coaches, seasons.
- Head coach Kermit Davis needs just 11 wins to surpass Jimmy Earle as the program's all-time winningest coach. Davis currently has 154 victories at MT, 10 shy of Earle's 164.

SCOUTING THE LIONS

Lovola Marymount opened the 2011-12 season on Friday as well, knocking off No. 17 UCLA, 69-58, at LA Sports Arena. The Lions were led by Ashley Hamilton and Quincy Lawson, with 23 and 21 points, respectively.

Although the Lions finished the 2010-11 season 11-21 and 2-12 in the WCC, going 5-13 in games decided by less than 10 points, they return 73 percent of their offense and 70 percent of the rebounding this year. The Lions returning starters include preseason All-WCC selection Drew Viney, redshirt junior Ashley Hamilton, sophomore Anthony Ireland and sophomore Godwin Okonji. They also have five others who have started in their careers back this season, including Jarred DuBois who is back after a medical redshirt.

HALF IS TWICE AS NICE

MT's second-half performance against Austin Peay will go down as one of the best in program history. The Blue Raiders shot 70 percent from the field, and have, on record, only bettered that mark three times in program history. Ironically, the most recent occurrence was also against the Governors.

DENDY IS DANDY

After sitting out last season due to NCAA transfer rules, LaRon Dendy made an immediate impact for the Blue Raiders in his first collegiate game

since leaving Iowa State. He netted 21 points in the season-opener against Austin Peav and was one rebound shy of a double-double, collecting nine boards.

TREMENDOUS TRANSFERS

In addition to Dendy, three other transfers saw time in the opener. Juco transfers Marcos Knight and Bruce Massey each earned the start and played key roles in the victory. Knight scored 15 points and added eight rebounds, while Massey dished out a game-high six assists, collected three steals and four rebounds to go along with two points. Raymond Cintron came off the bench and sank a pair of free throws in his first D-I contest.

EXHIBITION TIDBITS

Six Blue Raiders made their debut on Monday against North Alabama in MT's lone exhibition, including three who started the contest. Junior transfers Marcos Knight and Bruce Massey each got the start, along with senior forward LaRon Dendy, who scored a game-high 21 points highlighted by an 11-for-13 performance from the stripe. Knight had contributions across the board, with four points, five rebounds, three assists, two blocks and a steal, while Massey dished out four assists to go along with three points.

True freshman Jacquez Rozier put on a show as well, netting 17 points on 7-of-9 shooting and blocking two shots. Raymond Cintron, another juco transfer, demonstrated his long-range skills with a trio of 3-pointers and handed out a game-high five

The 2011-12 basketball season marks the sixth year of the Blue Raider Network under the umbrella of a joint venture between Middle Tennessee athletics and Nelligan Sports Marketing. Nelligan started managing the exclusive athletics marketing rights in January 2007.

The Blue Raider Network, which actually debuted in the early 1960s, is blessed with two flagship stations for men's basketball and football. The local flagship is WGNS 1450 AM in Murfreesboro, and 560 AM.

Middle Tennessee fans throughout the southeast region also can follow their favorite teams on WMOT FM 89.5, which reaches a three-state area.

The combination of the three stations provides coverage to Middle Tennessee sports fans in a 100mile radius of Murfreesboro.

WGNS and 560 AM carry all Blue Raider men's basketball games along with the Kermit Davis radio show

WGNS, which made its return to carrying Blue Raider athletics in 2005, blankets the local area by reaching to McMinnville to the east, Columbia to the west, and Gallatin to the north.

assists. True freshman Julian Edmonson rounded out the newcomers with a triple in the contest.

MORE THAN HALF OF OFFENSE RETURNS

The Blue Raiders return 57.4 percent of the offense this season. Junior guard Jason Jones was the team's second-leading scorer last year with 13.1 ppg and accounted for nearly 20 percent of the scoring last season.

BEST IN THE BELT

MT has been one of the most successful teams in the Sun Belt under Davis. The Blue Raiders lead the Sun Belt, along with Florida Atlantic, with 23 league wins over the past two seasons, finishing 10-6 last year and 13-5 in 2009-10. MT is the only team with double-digit conference victories in each of the past four years, earning 10 victories in 2008-09 and 11 in 2007-08. MT has been dominant on the road as well, collecting 40 conference road wins during Davis' tenure, making the Blue Raiders the winningest Sun Belt road team over the past nine years.

DAVIS NEARING RECORD

Head coach Kermit Davis is on track to become the winningest coach in MT history. Davis is just 10 wins shy of matching former coach Jimmy Earle's 164 all-time coaching victories. This season, Davis joins Earle, who spent a decade guiding the Blue Raiders, as the longest tenured coaches in program history.

ATOP THE TOPPERS

Middle Tennessee has won four in a row against Western Kentucky dating back to the 2009-10 season. It marks the first such run against its rival in 81 years.

OH CANADA

The Blue Raiders spent a week in Canada in August to gear up for the 2011-12 campaign. MT won all four games in Calgary, Alberta. LaRon Dendy nearly averaged a double-double (14.5 ppg, 9.8 rpg) to lead the Blue Raiders. In the second contest against Alberta, Raymon Cintron knocked down seven 3-pointers, while Knight notched 22 points in the first game against Alberta.

2011-12 BLUE RAIDER TIDBITS

- It's the first time since 1989 that a Middle Tennessee team has had four straight seasons with double-digit wins in conference play: Sun Belt - 07-08 (11), 08-09 (10), 09-10 (13), 10-11 (10): Ohio Valley -85-86 (10, 86-87 (11), 87-88 (11), 88-89 (10).
- Middle Tennessee is the only Sun Belt program to have double-figure conference wins in each of the last four seasons.
- Middle Tennessee and Florida Atlantic have the most Sun Belt wins in the past two seasons with 23. Arkansas State follows close behind with 22.
- · Middle Tennessee is the only Sun Belt program to have its men's and women's team receive a first round by in the tournament the last two years.

In nine seasons at Middle Tennessee, Kermit Davis has established himself as one of the most successful men's basketball coaches in program history, and he's done so while rebuilding a program that had fallen on hard times. Prior

to Davis' hiring in April 2002, Middle Tennessee had endured losing seasons in three of the four previous years and was one season removed from a 5-22 campaign, the worst in school history. The Blue Raiders registered four straight winning seasons under Davis to start his Blue Raider coaching career, making him one of only two of the 19 Middle Tennessee men's basketball coaches to start a Blue Raider career with four straight winning campaigns. The other was Bruce Stewart. The Blue Raiders' game against Indiana State (11/30/06) was Davis' 125th at Middle Tennessee. Davis' record after 125 games at Middle Tennessee was 71-54, making him the second-winningest coach in program history after 125 games. Davis is second on the all-time Middle Tennessee wins list with 154.

DAVIS SECURES CAREER WIN 250

Kermit Davis secured his 250th win as a head coach when Middle Tennessee beat Louisiana-Lafayette, 83-76 (1/29/09) at Murphy Center. Davis currently owns 225 wins in his 14th season at the Division I level and he won 66 in three years as a junior college head coach. He currently has 291 career wins.

DAVIS NOTCHES MT WIN NO.150

Davis recorded his 150th win as the head coach at Middle Tennessee with the 69-60 win over rival Western Kentucky on Feb. 10, 2011. Davis is just the second coach in program history to reach the milestone and is now just 11 wins away from passing Jimmy Earle as the program's most winningest coach.

DAVIS NOTCHES MILESTONE WIN

Davis became the second-fastest to reach 100 wins at Middle Tennessee when the Blue Raiders upset South Alabama, 82-73, in the semifinals of the 2008 Sun Belt Championships. Davis reached the milestone in his 182nd career game. The 100 wins under Davis in his first six seasons represent the best six-year total for the program since 1988-93 (105 wins). The Blue Raiders averaged 17 wins in Davis' first six seasons, which is the second-best wins average for any Middle Tennessee coach after six seasons.

DAVIS AMONG COACHING LEADERS

Davis joined Bruce Stewart as the only head coaches in program history to begin their Blue Raider careers with four straight winning seasons. He currently has 154 wins. Jimmy Earle is the program's all-time winningest coach with 164 wins. Davis also is third in winning percentage (.550) among Blue Raider men's basketball coaches with a minimum of 50 games coached, trailing only Jimmy Earle (.614), and Bruce Stewart (.648).

DAVIS AMONG SUN BELT'S ALL-TIME WINNINGEST COACHES

Davis is second in all-time victories among active Sun Belt coaches with 84, trailing only Ronnie Arrow in his second stint at South Alabama. Overall, Davis is among the league's all-time winningest coaches in Sun Belt play with 84 victories and is fourth all-time. The all-time Sun Belt wins leader is Gene Bartow, who won 111 games during his 12 seasons at former conference member UAB. These totals only include regular-season conference wins.

MT AMONG SBC'S BEST UNDER DAVIS

Middle Tennessee is one of four league members (WKU, North Texas, Louisiana-Lafayette) to play in multiple SBC Championship games (2003, 2008) since 2003, and it is just one of two SBC members (WKU) to reach the quarterfinals in each of the last eight years. Middle Tennessee and WKU are the only SBC schools to reach the league's semifinals four times in the last six years.
