BLUE RAIDER FASTBREAK POINTS

- MT's 7-1 start is the best since the 1986-87 season.
- In the latest NCAA statistics (Nov. 27), MT led the nation in field goal percentage (.545) and ranked 11th in 3-point percentage (.445).
- MT went 3-0 against D-I opponents to start the season for the first time in program history.
- MT has won four straight road games for the first time since the 2006-07 season when the Blue Raiders reeled off five consecutive road victories in Sun Belt play. The last time MT won four consecutive road games to start the season was 1967-68.
- Head coach Kermit Davis needs just five wins to surpass Jimmy Earle as the program's all-time winningest coach. Davis currently has 160 victories at MT, four shy of Earle's 164.
- MT set a school-record with a 71.4 shooting percentage at UCLA on Nov. 15. The Blue Raiders shot 70.8 percent in the first half and 72 percent in the second half of the contest.
- MT's 90.9 3-point shooting percentage (10-for-11) at UCLA tied the fourth-best performance in NCAA history (min. 10 made). It also set Sun Belt and school records.

JASON JONES NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-SUN BELT TEAM

Junior guard Jason Jones was named to the 2011-12 Preseason All-Sun Belt Team, as voted on by the league's head coaches. Jones was the team's second-leading scorer last year with 13.1 points per game, while his 14.6 points per game in Sun Belt contests ranked eighth in the league and third among the SBC's returning players this season. In addition to registering 25 double-digit performances, the Memphis, Tenn., native was the team's top scorer in 12 games last season and the top rebounder in 10 last year.

SCOUTING THE ZIPS

The defending MAC champions enter Sunday's contest with a 3-3 record. Akron has dropped three of its last four contests, including a 77-56 loss at West Virginia on Monday. The Zips, however, opened the season with a 68-58 victory at Mississippi State, which is currently ranked No. 21/24 in the polls.

Akron has a pair of players averaging double figures in Nick Harney (10.8) and Quincy Diggs, while Zeke Marshall tops the team with a 71.9 field goal percentage. Additionally, the Zips lead the MAC in 3-point percentage offense (.391) and defense (.256).

NO. 500

Sunday's contest will mark the 500th game for Kermit Davis as a head coach. He has a career record of 297-202, which includes a 231-177 record at the Division I level.

QUADRUPLE THREAT

It's no surprise MT's offense is not only one of the best in the Sun Belt, but also in the nation. Four of the top six shooters in the league are Blue Raiders. Shawn Jones (.667) ranks first, LaRon Dendy (.574) is third, JT Sulton (.541) is fifth and Marcos Knight (.535) rounds out the group in sixth.

IT'S NOT JUST OFFENSE

While the Blue Raider offense has been hot, the defense is no slouch either. MT leads the Sun Belt in field goal percentage defense (.384) and 3-point defense (.275), holding each of its opponents under 50 percent shooting thus far. In fact, six of eight opponents have shot under 40 percent against the Blue Raiders.

ODEN IN THE CLUTCH

Senior guard Jimmy Oden was clutch against Tennessee State on Dec. 1. Oden finished with a career-high 14

points, going 11-for-12 from the stripe. In the final two minutes of the contest, Oden hit 10 consecutive free throws to seal the 77-62 victory.

STATISTICALLY SOUND

MT is currently one of the hottest offensive teams in the nation, leading the country in field goal percentage (.545) according to the NCAA as of Nov. 27. Additionally, the Blue Raiders rank in the top 35 in four other categories:

NATION TAKING NOTICE

The Blue Raiders were listed among those receiving votes in the third week of the season. MT received two votes for the Nov. 21 edition of the poll. The Blue Raiders currently rank No. 22 in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25.

STARTING IT OFF RIGHT

The Blue Raiders got off to a 4-0 start this season, marking the first 4-0 start since the 1994-95 season. It also marked the first time in program history MT defeated three Division I opponents to open the season. The 7-1 start for MT is the best since 1986-87 when the Blue Raiders also started 7-1. An 8-1 start would be the best since 1980-81 when MT started 12-1.

DAVIS NEARING RECORD

Head coach Kermit Davis is on track to become the winningest coach in MT history. Davis is four wins shy of matching former coach Jimmy Earle's 164 all-time coaching victories. This season, Davis joins Earle, who spent a decade guiding the Blue Raiders, as the longest tenured coaches in program history.

Blue Raider basketball is on the air! The 2011-12 basketball season marks the sixth year of the Blue Raider Network under the umbrella of a joint venture between Middle Tennessee athletics and Nelligan Sports Marketing. Nelligan started managing the exclusive athletics marketing rights in January 2007.

The Blue Raider Network, which actually debuted in the early 1960s, is blessed with two flagship stations for men's basketball and football. The local flagship is WGNS 1450 AM in Murfreesboro, and 560 AM.

Middle Tennessee fans throughout the southeast region also can follow their favorite teams on WMOT FM 89.5, which reaches a three-state area.

The combination of the three stations provides coverage to Middle Tennessee sports fans in a 100-mile radius of Murfreesboro.

WGNS and 560 AM carry all Blue Raider men's basketball games along with the Kermit Davis radio show.

WGNS, which made its return to carrying Blue Raider athletics in 2005, blankets the local area by reaching to McMinnville to the east, Columbia to the west, and Gallatin to the north.

All Blue Raider men's basketball broadcasts can also be heard on the Internet at GoBlueRaiders.com.

PREGAME INTERVIEWS

Middle Tennessee players will not be available for any media activities on the day of the game at home or away. Head coach Kermit Davis will be available following the team's gameday preparation practice. Media are suggested to contact Leslie Wilhite in advance to arrange this interview.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

The Middle Tennessee locker room is closed at home and on the road. Requested players will be made available in the media room at all home games following a 10-minute cooling off period. Head coach Kermit Davis will be brought to the media room and then he will conduct his postgame radio show at press row.

KERMIT DAVIS LIVE

Kermit Davis LIVE airs each Monday from Coach's Grill in Murfreesboro, located at 127 SE Broad St. Chip Walters, the voice of the Blue Raiders, hosts the show, which airs from 7-8 p.m. on WGNS (100.5 FM, 101.9 FM, 1450 AM), WMOT (89.5) and WNSR (560 AM).

2011-12 BLUE RAIDER TIDBITS

- It's the first time since 1989 that a Middle Tennessee team has had four straight seasons with double-digit wins in conference play: Sun Belt - 07-08 (11), 08-09 (10), 09-10 (13), 10-11 (10); Ohio Valley - 85-86 (10), 86-87 (11), 87-88 (11), 88-89 (10).
- Middle Tennessee is the only Sun Belt program to have double-figure conference wins in each of the last four seasons.
- Middle Tennessee and Florida Atlantic have the most Sun Belt wins in the past two seasons with 23. Arkansas State follows close behind with 22.
- Middle Tennessee is the only Sun Belt program to have its men's and women's team receive a first round by in the tournament the last two years.

KEEPING UP WITH THE JONES'

Both Shawn and Jason Jones have played key roles for the Blue Raiders this season. Shawn has had three double-figure games, including 13 points on a 6-of-6 performance against Austin Peay on Nov. 26. He is tied for 16th nationally with a .667 shooting percentage, according to ESPN.com, and also ranks second on the team with 11 blocks. After missing the first four games, Jason has since produced three double-figure games in four appearances. He also has chipped in six assists and three steals.

PLAYING EXTRA

MT and Belmont played into double overtime on Nov. 20, marking the first overtime game of the season for the Blue Raiders. Last season, MT played four overtime games, including one double-overtime contest, ironically, a loss to Belmont on Dec. 7, 2010. The two contests against Belmont are the only double-overtime games for the Blue Raiders since a triple overtime loss to New Mexico State in 2002.

SHOOTING THE LIGHTS OUT

MT's shooting performance against UCLA on Nov. 15 was one for the ages. The Blue Raiders smashed the school record, shooting a 71.4 percent clip from the field and surpassing the previous mark of 68.9 percent set in 1981. MT has now had four halves of basketball this season shooting 70 percent or better:

- 11/22 vs Cumberland 2nd half: 75.0%
- 11/15 vs. UCLA 2nd half: 72.0%
- 11/15 vs. UCLA 1st half: 70.8%
- 11/11 vs. Austin Peay: 70.0%

On record, the Blue Raiders had only bettered the 70-percent mark in one half three times in program history prior

to this year:

- .833 vs. Akron (2/4/82)
- .800 vs. Tennessee Tech (1/8/81)
- .724 vs. Austin Peay (1/12/87)

RAINING THREE'S

Not only did MT set a record from the field, but the Blue Raiders also hit a Sun Belt record 90.9 percent of their 3-pointers against UCLA. The mark, also a school record, surpassed the previous league record of 90.0 percent set by UAB in 1986 and is tied for fourth in NCAA history.

AND ONE MORE THING

MT hit its first nine treys and finished 10-of-11 from beyond the arc against UCLA. The Blue Raiders didn't miss a trey until 1:39 to go in the game. Before the streak ended, MT's 9-for-9 performance matched an NCAA record for highest perfect 3-point field goal percentage in a game, set by Minnesota against Penn State on Jan. 11, 2009.

SPREADING THE WEALTH

MT's 10-of-11 3-point performance against UCLA was far from a one-man show. In fact, it was a six-man show. Six different Blue Raiders hit a triple, led by Raymond Cintron and Bruce Massey, who each went 3-for-3. In addition, five Blue Raiders scored double-figures. Altogether, 10 Blue Raiders have had at least one double-digit performance this year.

IT'S GOOD TO BE 80

With multiple scoring threats, it's no surprise MT has cracked the 80-point mark six times in the first eight games. The Blue Raiders scored 80 or more only seven times all of last season.

CLOSING IT OUT

MT consistently closed out its opponents early in six of the first seven contests. The Blue Raiders never trailed in the final 29:30 against Austin Peay, 16:24 against Loyola Marymount, 27:31 against UCLA, 22:15 against UNCG and 39:12 against Cumberland. At Austin Peay, MT led for the entire contest, then led for the final 12:23 at Tennessee State. This means out of the total 280 minutes in those contests, the Blue Raiders went 158:15 without falling behind, which is nearly 57 percent of the time.

HAMMONDS STEPPING UP

Sophomore guard Kerry Hammonds reached double-figures for the third time in his career with 11 points against Cumberland, including a 3-for-3 performance from beyond the arc. Hammonds also recorded career-highs in assists (5) and blocks (4).

SULTON REIGNS

Junior forward JT Sulton became the first Blue Raider to record a double-double this season, collecting 12 points and 11 rebound at Loyola Marymount. It marked the third double-double of his career, with his last coming against UALR (21 pts, 11 reb) in the 2011 Sun Belt tournament. Sulton has reached double figures in five out of eight contests this season.

DENDY IS DANDY

After sitting out last season due to NCAA transfer rules, LaRon Dendy has made an immediate impact for the Blue Raiders. He netted 21 points in the season-opener against Austin Peay and was one rebound shy of a double-double, collecting nine boards. He notched his first double-double of the season at UCLA, collecting 16 points and 13 rebounds. He has also shown versatility on the court, ranking first on the team in scoring (14.0 ppg) and blocks (12) and third on the team with 17 assists.

TREMENDOUS TRANSFERS

In addition to Dendy, three other transfers have seen considerable time for the Blue Raiders through seven games:

- Chipola Junior College transfer Marcos Knight has started each contest. Knight is the team's second-leading scorer with 13.9 points per game points and tops the team with 6.6 rebounds per game. He posted his first career double-dou-

ble with 17 points and 11 rebounds against Belmont. Knight became the third Blue Raider to post a double-double this season and has reached double-figures in all but one contest.

- Bruce Massey dished out a career-high eight assists against Belmont and leads the team with 29 assists this season. In addition, the Dodge City Community College transfer went 3-for-3 from beyond the arc against UCLA, marking his first 3-point attempts of the season, and scored a season-high 14 points. He made it back-to-back games in double figures with 11 against UNC Greensboro. His 15 steals are second to Knight's 16.
- Mississippi Gulf Coast Junior College transfer Raymond Cintron came off the bench and sank a pair of free throws in his first D-I contest against Austin Peay, then added his first D-I triple against Loyola Marymount. He heated up against UCLA, draining 3-of-3 treys to finish 4-for-4 from the field with 11 points. He followed that performance with a career day against Belmont, going 5-for-9 from 3-point land en route to a career-high 18 points.

PAINTING THE TOWN BLUE

In seven out of the first eight games, the Blue Raiders have dominated their opponent in the paint. Altogether the Blue Raiders own a 268-177 advantage in the paint.

LaRon Dendy nearly averaged a double-double (14.5 ppg, 9.8 rpg) to lead the Blue Raiders. In the second contest against Alberta, Raymon Cintron knocked down seven 3-pointers, while Knight notched 22 points in the first game against Alberta.

ATOP THE TOPPERS

Middle Tennessee has won four in a row against Western Kentucky dating back to the 2009-10 season. It marks the first such run against its rival in 81 years.

to Davis' hiring in April 2002, Middle Tennessee had endured losing seasons in three of the four previous years and was one season removed from a 5-22 campaign, the worst in school history. The Blue Raiders registered four straight winning seasons under Davis to start his Blue Raider coaching career, making him one of only two of the 19 Middle Tennessee men's basketball coaches to start a Blue Raider career with four straight winning campaigns. The other was Bruce Stewart. The Blue Raiders' game against Indiana State (11/30/06) was Davis' 125th at Middle Tennessee. Davis' record after 125 games at Middle Tennessee was 71-54, making him the second-winningest coach in program history after 125 games. Davis is second on the all-time Middle Tennessee wins list with 160.

DAVIS SECURES CAREER WIN 250

Kermit Davis secured his 250th win as a head coach when Middle Tennessee beat Louisiana-Lafayette, 83-76 (1/29/09) at Murphy Center. Davis currently owns 231 wins in his 14th season at the Division I level and he won 66 in three years as a junior college head coach. He currently has 297 career wins.

DAVIS NOTCHES MT WIN NO.150

Davis recorded his 150th win as the head coach at Middle Tennessee with the 69-60 win over rival Western Kentucky on Feb. 10, 2011. Davis is just the second coach in program history to reach the milestone and is now just five wins away from passing Jimmy Earle as the program's most winningest coach.

DAVIS NOTCHES MILESTONE WIN

Davis became the second-fastest to reach 100 wins at Middle Tennessee when the Blue Raiders upset South Alabama, 82-73, in the semifinals of the 2008 Sun Belt Championships. Davis reached the milestone in his 182nd career game. The 100 wins under Davis in his first six seasons represent the best six-year total for the program since 1988-93 (105 wins). The Blue Raiders averaged 17 wins in Davis' first six seasons, which is the second-best wins average for any Middle Tennessee coach after six seasons.

DAVIS AMONG COACHING LEADERS

Davis joined Bruce Stewart as the only head coaches in program history to begin their Blue Raider careers with four straight winning seasons. He currently has 160 wins. Jimmy Earle is the program's all-time winningest coach with 164 wins. Davis also is third in winning percentage (.557) among Blue Raider men's basketball coaches with a minimum of 50 games coached, trailing only Jimmy Earle (.614), and Bruce Stewart (.648).

DAVIS AMONG SUN BELT'S ALL-TIME WINNINGEST COACHES

Davis is second in all-time victories among active Sun Belt coaches with 84, trailing only Ronnie Arrow in his second stint at South Alabama. Overall, Davis is among the league's all-time winningest coaches in Sun Belt play with 84 victories and is fourth all-time. The all-time Sun Belt wins leader is Gene Bartow, who won 111 games during his 12 seasons at former conference member UAB. These totals only include regular-season conference wins.

MT AMONG SBC'S BEST UNDER DAVIS

Middle Tennessee is one of four league members (WKU, North Texas, Louisiana-Lafayette) to play in multiple SBC Championship games (2003, 2008) since 2003, and it is just one of two SBC members (WKU) to reach the quarterfinals in each of the last eight years. Middle Tennessee and WKU are the only SBC schools to reach the league's semifinals four times in the last six years.
