#### **SERIES HISTORY**

Saturday's football game between Middle Tennessee and FAU will mark the 10th meeting between the two schools on the gridiron. The series, which began in 2003, is led by MT, 6-3. The Owls upset the Blue Raiders with a last second touchdown pass in 2003, then came back the following year to Murfreesboro to down the Blue Raiders once again, 27-20. Middle Tennessee picked up its first win in the series in 2005 in Boca Raton, 35-14, and won by the same score in 2006. FAU bounced back with a 27-14 decision inthe 2007 season opener at FAU before MT took a last second victory in Murfreesboro in 2008, 14-13. The Blue Raiders came from behind with two fourth quarter touchdowns to win in 2009 and took a 38-14 decision in 2010. MT won at FAU last year, 38-14. MT is 3-2 against the Owls in Boca Raton and 5-1 overall under Rick Stockstill.

#### **MT-FAU NOTES**

- In the 2011 game, QB Logan Kilgore set a school record by completing his first 19 passes.
- MT scored in all three phases of the game in 2006 with points from the offense, defense, and special teams.
  - Second half scoring in the series stands MT 131, FAU
- MT's best quarter in the series has been the fourth with 104 points, including 14 in three of the past four meetings.
- There have been 139 penalties called in the series. MT has been flagged 72 times and FAU 67.
- MT has allowed just two 100-yard rushers in the series (2008 and 2011) while collecting six of their own. Eugene Gross owns two, and Dwight Dasher, D.D. Kyles, Phillip Tanner, and William Pratcher make up the final four.

#### **BLUE RAIDERS AT FLOYD STADIUM**

- Since Floyd Stadium opened in 1933, the Blue Raiders have compiled an overall mark of 266-112-13 (.698), including a record 31-game win streak from 1987-94.
- MT is 45-27 at Floyd Stadium since the renovation in 1998 and has won 26 of its last 43.
  - The Blue Raiders are 26-16 at home in SBC play.
- Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders are 18-15 overall at Floyd Stadium and 13-10 in SBC games.
- Since 2007, MT has had home games against Virginia, Maryland, Mississippi State, Minnesota, and Georgia Tech and will host BYU in 2014 and Vandy in 2015, 2017.

#### **CONFERENCE OPENERS**

■ Middle Tennessee is beginning its 12th season of Sun Belt Conference football and own a 5-6 record in league openers. The Blue Raiders had wins in 2001, 2003, 2006, 2009, and 2010 with 2001 and 2006 being league championship seasons and 2009 producing the league's first 10-win campaign. MT also advanced to a bowl game to end the 2010 season. Overall, MT is 3-3 in conference openers on the road and 2-3 at home.

#### TWO COACHES FOR THE BOYS UP FRONT

■ For the first time as a head coach, Rick Stockstill has appointed two coaches to man the offensive line. During the offseason, Stockstill hired Matt Moore to oversee the tackles and tight ends, while bringing in former Blue Raider Glen Elarbee to handle the centers and guards. It marks the first time MT has had two coaches on the offensive line in the FBS era.

#### **WELCOME BACK GLEN**

■ Glen Elarbee, a former player for the Blue Raiders from 1999 to 2002, returned to campus in the offseason to join Rick Stockstill's staff. Elarbee, a member of the first I-A team at MT, is the first former player to be on staff since Elarbee and Floyd Walker in 2005.

#### **SMALL SENIOR CLASS**

■ Middle Tennessee enters the 2012 season with only 11 scholarship seniors on its roster. That total ranks tied for the eighth fewest seniors on an FBS roster this year and matches the fewest in the Sun Belt with North Texas and FAU. Indiana, Colorado, and Rice lead the nation with eight, while Alabama, Marshall, and Wisconsin have nine. Louisville is next with 10.

#### **NOTING THE BLUE RAIDERS**

- In the second home game of the season, Middle Tennessee is 5-1 in those contests under Rick Stockstill. The lone loss came in 2009 against Mississippi State.

went down as the second-most in school history. The record is 955 by the 2009 team.

- MT had just 14 rushing TDs in 2011, its fewest since having 14 in 1996.
- Middle Tennessee had four scoring drives of 90-yards or more in 2011 to rank among the top 15 nationally.
- Middle Tennessee has scored 30 or more points 28 times under Rick Stockstill, including four times in 2011. The most 30-point games in a season under Stockstill is nine (2009).
- Middle Tennessee recorded 450 or more yards of total offense five times in 2011 to finish with 4,813 total yards of offense. That mark ranks as the fifth most in school history for a single-season.
- The per game average of 401.1 yards in 2011 marked just the second time under Rick Stockstill the Blue Raiders have topped the 400-yard mark.

- MT forced a season-high six turnovers against FAU. It went down as the most forced turnovers since MT got six from UL-Lafayette in 2006.
- MT had just four interceptions in 2011, which was its fewest in the modern era. The last interception came against ASU on Nov. 19.
- MT allowed 5,293 yards of total offense in 2011 which was the most in school history.
- The Blue Raiders gave up 2,539 passing yards in 2011, the fewest under Rick Stockstill.
- Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raider defense is all about being disruptive, pressuring the quarterback, and putting the offense behind the chains. In 2010, the Blue Raiders ranked 17th nationally in quarterback sacks and 10th nationally in tackles for loss. The Blue Raiders' 34 sacks in 2010 ranked third-most in a single season and just four off the school record of 38 set in 2009. Their 96 tackles for loss was third on the all-time list. Here is a look at the national rankings in sacks and tackles for loss under Stockstill:

#### **QB LOGAN KILGORE**

- With 240 passing yards against McNeese, Logan Kilgore became the 15th 3,000-yard passer in school history. Kilgore now has 3,011 career passing yards.
- Kilgore has 23 career touchdown passes and needs four more to tie Joe Craddock for 10th on the all-time list.
- Kilgore was named to the 2011 Capital One Academic All-District III Football Team.
- MT had four scoring drives of 94 or more yards in 2011 and all four were engineered by Kilgore. He added a fifth in the season opener by taking the Raiders 97 yards for a score.
- With 148 passing yards against ULM last season, quarterback Logan Kilgore went over the 2,000-yard mark. Kilgore became just the ninth player in school history to have 2,000 or more yards passing in a single-season.
- Logan Kilgore set a new school record when he completed the first 19 passes he attempted against FAU

- in 2011. The previous record for consecutive completions was 15 set by Wes Counts in 2001. The NCAA record for consecutive completions for a single game is 26 by ECU QB Dominique Davis against Navy on Oct. 22, 2011.
- Kilgore threw 18 touchdown passes in 2011 to rank third on the single-season list. The most TD passes thrown in a season is 23 by Dwight Dasher in 2009.
- QB Logan Kilgore recorded his second career 300-yard passing game, and first over 400, when he threw for 415 yards against Troy. Kilgore, who was playing in just his sixth career game, also recorded a personal-best five touchdown passes to best his previous mark of two set against Purdue in the 2011 season opener. The five TD passes rank in a tie for second on the MT single-game list, while his 415 yards are the third most in school history. The five scoring tosses went to five different receivers.
- Kilgore owns eight career 200-yard passing games to rank tied for 7th all-time. He needs four more to tie for 5th.
- Kilgore's 2,231 passing yards in 2011 ranked 6th on the single-season list.
- Kilgore's 202.8 yards passing per game in 2011 ranked 7th on the single-season list.
- Kilgore's 214 completions in 2011 ranked 5th on MT's single-season list and his 365 attempts also placed 5th.
- Kilgore went over the 1,000-yard passing mark in 2011 after just four games following a 277-yard effort

against Memphis. Kilgore became the fifth signal-caller at MT to reach 1,000 yards through the first four games of a season since the Blue Raiders joined the FBS ranks in 1999. The other four were Wes Counts in 1999 (1,068 yards), Clint Marks in 2004 (1,072 yards), Joe Craddock in 2008 (1,076 yards), and Dwight Dasher in 2009 (1,028 yards).

#### **QB JEFF MURPHY**

- Is showing tremendous courage by playing his senior season with a torn ACL suffered late in spring drills.
  - Has seen action in 12 career games with three starts.

#### **RB BENNY CUNNINGHAM**

- Led team with 4 rushing TDs last season and paced all backs with 17 receptions.
- Missed 4 straight games in 2011 following a broken bone in his foot suffered against Memphis. Returned vs ULM.
- Rushed for career-high 117 yards on 19 carries at Troy.
- Added a career-best four catches at Purdue while forcing a fumble on the punt team.

#### **RB WILLIAM PRATCHER**

- William Pratcher, who started 2011 as the third team back, went over the 100-yard rushing mark in consecutive games. Pratcher registered 106 yards on 16 carries vs WKU then had a career-high 125 yards on 23 carries against FAU.
- Pratcher finished as the team's leading rusher with a career-best 585 yards on 122 attempts.
- Pratcher was the first Blue Raider to record back-toback 100-yard games since D.D. Kyles and Dwight Dasher in 2009.
- Pratcher notched his career-high in rushing four different times during 2011.
  - In 2011, Pratcher had 20 runs of 10 yards or more.
- In 2011, Pratcher rushed for 70 or more yards four times.

#### **WR KYLE GRISWOULD**

- Has played in all 13 games of his career with five
- Owns 36 career receptions and 25 have come over his last five games.

#### **WR ANTHONY AMOS**

- Set his career-high with 8 receptions against Mc-Neese State to go along with a touchdown.
- One of the big surprises to the season was the play of walk-on receiver Anthony Amos. The Fayetteville, NC, native recorded the first 100-yard receiving game of his career after registering seven catches for 100 yards and a touchdown against WKU.
- Amos, who ranked fifth on the team with 27 catches for 379 yards last season, hauled in a touchdown pass in three straight games during the middle of the season prior to his injury. All three TD catches came in the fourth quarter with less than five minutes to play, including the game-winner with 11 seconds left against Memphis.
  - Amos was put on scholarship during the spring.

#### **LB LEIGHTON GASQUE**

- Reserve linebacker Leighton Gasque recorded his team-leading 7th sack against Arkansas State in 2011 despite his limited snaps. Gasque, who played less than 100 defensive snaps all season, had 17 total tackles on the year and 7 were sacks. Gasque ranked tied for third in sacks in the SBC and was 44th nationally. He was third among all freshmen nationally in sacks at .58 per game.
  - In 2011, Gasque shared the team lead with 5 hurries.
  - Five of Gasque's seven sacks came against SBC foes.
  - Gasque had at least one sack in 5 of the last 8 games.

■ Middle Tennessee set a new single-game school record in kickoff return yards with 241 against McNeese on six returns. That broke the previous mark of 220 yards set against Louisville in 2006.

MURFREESBORO, TN - A furious fourth quarter comeback by Middle Tennessee fell short as the McNeese State Cowboys escaped Floyd Stadium with a 27-21 victory.

The Blue Raiders (0-1) outscored the Cowboys (1-0) 15-to-3 in the final quarter. In the fourth quarter, Middle Tennessee completed a 97-yard drive to make it a 24-14 contest. With less than five minutes remaining, MT used an 85-yard kick return by Reggie Whatley to put the Blue Raider offense in prime scoring position. Just one play later, Logan Kilgore connected with Kyle Griswould for 15 yards to put the Raiders within six.

On the next offensive possession, McNeese State used the clock to its advantage before punting back to MT. An attempted lateral play did not work for the Blue Raiders, as Middle Tennessee fell short in the season opener.

Kilgore completed 27 passes for 240 yards and two touchdowns. The redshirt junior finished just a completion short of his career-best 28 set last season against Florida Atlantic and Troy. Anthony Amos grabbed eight passes for a team-best 70 yards and a touchdown. Griswould added five catches for 63 yards and a touchdown grab in the loss.

Defensively, three Blue Raiders reached double-digit tackles. Jajuan Harley, Christian Henry and Kevin Byard all totaled 11 tackles.
