LEADING OFF

- MT's seven-game winning streak is the longest since the Blue Raiders won seven in a row in 2008
- Hunter Adkins was named the Sun Belt Pitcher of the Week after pitching 8.0 innings of shutout ball vs. Ball State in the season-opener
- · Adkins has gone at least seven innings in each of his first three outings, giving up just one run in 23 innings
- · Sophomore LHP Johnathan Frebis and junior OF Trent Miller earned Preseason All-Sun Belt honors
- MT was picked to finish sixth by the league's coaches
- The roster features 14 seniors this year, the most of any team in the Sun Belt
- The Blue Raiders got off to their best start since 2009 when they also started 9-2
- · MT has scored in the first inning four times this year, including three of the last four games, and has been the first to score eight times

BREAK OUT THE BROOMS

MT knocked off host Auburn in the opening game of the Auburn Tournament on Feb. 23. It marked the first win for MT over Auburn since Feb. 20, 1999, and just the third in program history. The Blue Raiders went on to sweep the weekend with wins over Indiana State and College of Charleston.

MT kept sweeping the following weekend, taking three from Kennesaw State to extend the seven-game winning streak. The Blue Raiders out-scored the Owls 22-4 in the series.

ADKINS NAMED PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Adkins got the Blue Raiders off on a high note to start the 2013 campaign, earning Sun Belt Pitcher of the Week honors after leading MT to a 1-0 victory against Ball State in the season opener. He retired the first seven batters he faced and allowed just four hits through eight innings of work and struck out seven. Adkins allowed Ball State to hit just .160 in the contest. It marked the third weekly honor of his career.

He followed that up with another dominating performance, going eight innings to pick up the win against Auburn on Feb. 22. He allowed just one run on three hits while striking out five in the contest. Through 23 innings, he has allowed just one run and gone at least seven innings in each outing.

AND THE OTHER ADKINS

Sophomore catcher Michael Adkins ripped his first career home run against Austin Peay on Feb. 19. Adkins took the first pitch he saw over the left field wall at Reese Smith Jr. Field, a two-

run shot with two outs. A week later, he went 4-for-4 with four runs at Tennessee Tech. He also walked in the contest, meaning he reached base in five straight plate appearances.

THOMAS DELIVERS

Second baseman Johnny Thomas drove in the game-winning run in Middle Tennessee's first three victories, including a two-run blast against Auburn. In the fourth game, he knocked in the tying run. Thomas reached base safely in the first 11 games of the season.

OPENING DAY DOMINANCE

Middle Tennessee recorded its first opening game shutout since 1978 with the 1-0 victory over Ball State on Friday. The last opening day shutout was a 7-0 win over Indiana State on March 6.

FIRST FOR MCGUIRE

The win over Ball State on Feb. 15 was the first under the direction of head coach Jim McGuire. McGuire, who served alongside former head coach Steve Peterson for 20 years, took the helm last summer.

NEW IN BLUE

Three Blue Raiders made their Middle Tennessee debut opening weekend and one on Feb. 19. Jake Ellison, a junior transfer from Walters State Community College, started all three games and smacked a pair of doubles. Trevor Haggard, a redshirt freshman, quickly made his presence known, getting a hit in his first at-bat and finishing 3-for-5 in Sunday's contest. Zac Curtis, a junior transfer from Volunteer State Community College, earned the start on the

mound Feb. 17 and tossed five innings. Freshman Garrett Ring earned the start the following Tuesday (Feb. 19), going three innings.

THE BEGINNING

MT got off to a 2-0 start and won its opening series for the first time in four years. The Blue Raiders swept the opening series against Missouri State and started 5-0 in 2009.

SEEING DOUBLE

The Middle Tennessee infield has been adept at turning double plays over the years, leading the conference in the statistic in each of the past five seasons. After helping the Blue Raiders turn 64 double plays in 2011, MT turned 61 last year to rank 14th nationally. The Blue Raiders averaged 1.03 per game, good for 15th nationally.

GUNNING FOR STATE SUPREMACY

The Blue Raiders will play 12 games vs. in-state foes this season. Last season, MT went 6-7 vs. state foes. The Blue Raiders have posted the most victories against former conference rivals Austin Peay (83) and Tennessee Tech (81).

LOCAL FLAVOR

The 2013 Blue Raiders boast three players from Murfreesboro, and 30 of the 35 players hail from the state of Tennessee. Of the Murfreesboro athletes, two hail from Riverdale HS (Ryan Stephens, Johnathan Frebis) and one is from Blackman HS (Jonathan Sisco).

SUN BELT COMPETITION

The Blue Raiders finished in sixth place in the Sun Belt in 2012 with a 14-16 record. Overall, Middle Tennessee holds a 162-160 record in Sun Belt play since joining the league in 2001.

In the 12 seasons MT has competed in the Sun Belt, the Blue Raiders have earned at least a share of the regular season crown four times (2001, 2003, 2004, 2009) and the tournament crown on two occasions. (2003 and 2009).

Jim McGuire was promoted to the head coaching position on Aug. 9, 2012, after serving as an assistant and associate head coach for 20 years at Middle Tennessee.

McGuire became just the third different Blue Raider coach since 1974, following John Stanford (1974-87) and Peterson (1988-2012). He is the 21st coach since the program began in 1913.

After eight years as an assistant under Peterson, McGuire was elevated following the 2000 season to associate head coach and moved up once again following Peterson's retirement in July of 2012.

During his tenure, McGuire served as recruiting coordinator for the program and worked with the infielders and hitters. He also has taken an active role in coordinating evaluation visits with professional scouts as well as organizing baseball camps and the annual 'Boro Bash summer tournament.

He helped Peterson with all three of the Blue Raiders' major fundraisers — the Grand Slam Fish Fry, the Groundhog Day Luncheon, and the Chuck Taylor Golf Tournament — and served as liaison for placing players on summer teams across the country.

After the Blue Raiders' historical season in 2009, SEBaseball.com named McGuire the Sun Belt Assistant Coach of the Year for his work with the recordbreaking offense.

Throughout his 20 years in Murfreesboro, McGuire has been a key ingredient in making Blue Raider

baseball known throughout the country. He has been a part of 14 winning seasons, six trips to the NCAA Tournament, seven league championships, and five conference tournament titles. McGuire has helped mold 58 players who have been drafted by the pros and 98 first-team all-conference performers, including six conference players of the year and 10 All-Americans. The Blue Raiders are 626-520-1 during his tenure, a .546 winning percentage.

Before joining the Blue Raider staff in the summer of 1992, McGuire was head coach at Rend Lake (III.) Junior College from 1989 to 1992. During his stint there, he compiled a record of 220-116, a winning percentage of .655. During his four-year tenure, McGuire's teams turned in four second-place finishes in the Great Rivers Athletic Conference. His 1992 squad was Section III champion and Region 24 runner-up.

McGuire served as assistant coach at Rend Lake from 1987 to 1988 and began his coaching career at Missouri-St. Louis in 1986.

McGuire's playing career began at Illinois State before he transferred to Rend Lake CC. The final two years of his collegiate career were spent under the legendary Woody Hunt at Cumberland University in Lebanon, Tenn.

The Belleville, Ill., native played baseball and basketball at Freeburg High School.

McGuire is married to the former Lynn Christophe from Belleville, Ill., and they have two daughters, Kristen and Katie.
