- The 2013 campaign is the 99th season of football in the history of Middle Tennessee.

- Logan Kilgore needs 14 touchdown passes to break the school record of 50 established by Wes Counts (1998-2001).
- DT Jimmy Staten has played in a team-best 37 career games with Josh Davis and Josh Walker ranking second with 36.
- Consecutive Starts Leaders: Jimmy Staten 24, Roderic Blunt 19, Kyle Griswould 15, Logan Kilgore 13 and Josh Walker 12.



# **PLAYER**TOWATCH #6 Jordan Parker

Sophomore Jordan Parker is coming off a memorable season where he set the Blue Raider freshman rushing record with 851 yards. Following a strong camp, Parker is poised to make a run at 1,000 yards.

#### **MT-WCU SERIES NOTES**

- The series stands deadlocked at 2-2 and this will be the first meeting since 1981 when gas was \$1.25/gallon.
- The home team has never won a game in the series.
- This will be the fourth different coach WCU has faced during the series. Bill Peck in 1973, Ben Hurt in 1975, and Boots Donnelly in 1980 and 1981.
- The last time the two team's met, MT had an enrollment of 11,250 and today stand at nearly 26,000.

#### THIS'N'THAT

- MT was **+10** in turnover margin last season.
- MT had 18 plays 45 or more yards last year.
- The 49 points at Georgia Tech in 2012 went down as the most on the road for MT since putting up 66 in a win at Connecticut on Nov. 4, 2000.
- Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders have been involved in 11 games that were decided in the final minute of regulation or overtime (3 in 2011).
- Head Coach Rick Stockstill is third on the school's all-time wins list with **43** victories.
- MT has won the opening coin toss 14 times over its last 24 games.
- MT has scored a touchdown on its opening drive of the game 19 times under Stockstill.
- The Blue Raiders are 5-1 under Rick Stockstill in one point games.
- In 87 games under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders are +18 in turnover margin.
- The longest offensive drive in the Rick Stockstill era was 9:33 at North Texas in 2006. It resulted in a TD.
- Middle Tennessee has scored 30 or more points 34 times under Rick Stockstill, including 6 times in 2012. The most 30-point games in a season under Stockstill is nine (2009).
- When Jordan Parker and Drayton Calhoun both topped the 100-yard mark with 117 and 104, respectively, against FAU last season, it marked the first time the Blue Raiders had two players go over 100 yards in the same game since Nov. 7, 2009 against FIU (Kyles and Dasher).
- MT averaged **193.6** yards a game rushing in seven road games last season (**153.0** at home)

# **BLUE RAIDERS AT FLOYD STADIUM**

- Since Floyd Stadium opened in 1933, the Blue Raiders have compiled an overall mark of 269-114-13 (.695), including a record 31-game win streak from 1987-94.
- MT is 48-29 at Floyd Stadium since the renovation in 1998 and has won 28 of its last 47.
- Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders are 21-16 overall at Floyd Stadium and 15-11 in conference games.
- Since 2007, MT has had home games against Virginia, Maryland, Mississippi State, Minnesota, and Georgia Tech and will host BYU in 2014 and Vandy in 2015, 2017.

#### **SEASON OPENERS**

■ Middle Tennessee has an overall mark of 57-39-2 in season-opening games, and has won 18 of its last 32. The Blue Raiders have won their opening game just three times since elevating to the FBS level in 1999. MT defeated SEC member Vanderbilt in 2001 on the road and then upset Akron on the road in 2004. The Blue Raiders also won the 2006 opener at home against FIU.

#### **MID-WEEK GAMES**

■ Since Middle Tennessee joined the FBS ranks in 1999, the Blue Raiders have played 18 mid-week games with the MT-WCU contest being the 19th (15th on a Thursday). However, the majority of those games have come during the Rick Stockstill era. Under Stockstill, the Blue Raiders

will be playing their 17th mid-week game. Overall, the Blue Raiders have played games on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday since 1999.

#### NATION'S BEST TURNAROUND

■ Following a 2-10 season in 2011, Middle Tennessee bounced back with vengeance last season and owned the nation's best turnaround. The Raiders' +6 win total from 2011 joined Ohio State and Kent State for the biggest win increase in the country in 2012.

#### **WATCH LISTS**

■ Middle Tennessee has players represented on two prominent national watch lists for 2013. QB Logan Kilgore is on the Manning Award Watch List, while safety Kevin Byard is a member of the Jim Thorpe Award List.

#### **ROAD WARRIORS**

■ The Raiders carried an impressive road record of 5-2 in 2012, which ranked as the most road wins under Rick Stockstill and in the FBS era. The biggest victory away from Murfreesboro came in late September when the Raiders upset eventual ACC Coastal Division Champion Georgia Tech.

#### **BOWL ELIGIBLE ... AGAIN**

■ Middle Tennessee has reached bowl eligible status three times in the last four years. The Blue Raiders reached bowl status following a win at WKU in week nine last year. It's also the fourth time in seven years MT has been bowl eligible under Rick Stockstill (2006, 2009, 2010, 2012).

#### **NEWEST ADDITIONS**

■ The Blue Raiders have three new additions to their coaching staff in 2013. Geep Wade coaches the offensive line after arriving from Marshall, and Rick Mallory is in charge of the offensive tackles and tight ends. Mike Polly, a former graduate assistant under Rick Stockstill, joined the staff to oversee the Blue Raider running backs.

#### THE PROTECTORS

■ Over the past two years, Middle Tennessee's offensive line has been the best in the country in protecting the quarterback. During that span, the Blue Raiders o-line has given up just .625 (15 total) sacks per game. The Blue Raiders ranked second nationally in 2012 after allowing

#### **LOOKING FOR 100**

■ During its history, Middle Tennessee owns an impressive **144-50-1** (.740) record when a back gains 100 or more yards rushing. Under Rick Stockstill, a Blue Raider has reached the 100-yard mark **25** times and the team has a **22-3** mark in those games.

#### **30 IS MAGIC**

■ Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders are **30-3** when scoring 30 points or more. The three losses came at Louisville in 2007 when the Blue Raiders fell, 58-42, at Troy in 2011, 38-35, and at home against WKU in 2011, 36-33 (20T).

#### **KILGORE CHASING RECORDS**

- Currently stands fourth in career touchdown passes at MT and needs 14 this season to break the school record of 50 set by Wes Counts (1998-2001).
- One of just five signal-callers in MT history to top 5,000 career yards, Kilgore has a chance to break the school record of 8,007 yards set by Wes Counts (1998-2001).

Kilgore currently has 5,342 yards and is just 302 yards shy of passing Dwight Dasher for fourth place on the all-time list.

- Owns 14 career 200-yard passing games to rank third all-time at Middle Tennessee. He needs five more this season to break the record of 18 held by both Wes Counts and Clint Marks.
- Kilgore has a career completion percentage of 61.0 and has a chance to become only the fourth quarterback in school history to finish above the 60 percent mark.
- Kilgore has a chance to do something this season that no one in the history of Blue Raider football has accomplished throw for 2,000 or more yards in three straight seasons.

#### **MORE ON KILGORE**

- Kilgore was named to the 2011 Capital One Academic All-District III Football Team. Already with an undergraduate degree, Kilgore will receive his MBA in December.
- Kilgore has engineered seven career drives of 90 or more yards. He had four in 2011 and three in 2012. His career long drive was a 98 yarder in a win over Troy in 2012.
- Logan Kilgore set a new school record when he completed the first 19 passes he attempted against FAU in 2011. The previous record for consecutive completions was 15 set by Wes Counts in 2001.
- Kilgore's three 300-yard passing games is tied for 2nd all-time at MT. Wes Counts owns record with 7.

#### PARKER LOOKING FOR MORE

- RB Jordan Parker is coming off a record-breaking season where he set a new freshman rushing mark with 851 yards in 2012. His yardage came in just six starts after the season-ending injury to Benny Cunningham.
- Parker's 851 yards in 2012 ranked as the seventh most by a freshman nationally.
- Parker owns four 100-yard rushing games and three came in the last four games of the 2012 season.
- Over his last four games, Parker is averaging 129.3 rushing yards a game.
- Parker's 98-yard TD run vs Troy (2012) was the longest in MT history.
- Parker set his career-high rushing total on the road last year against South Alabama with 154 yards on 24 carries.
- Parker rushed for 117 yards on just 17 attempts in his second collegiate game against FAU. He became the first true freshman to top 100 yards since Dwight Dasher in 2007.

#### WR KYLE GRISWOULD

- Griswould has hauled in at least one reception in 22 straight games which is the longest current streak on the team. His streak also ranks tied for sixth on MT's all-time list with Cleannord Saintil. Griswould has a shot to surpass Demetric Mostiller (32) for second but can not catch all-time leader Kendall Newson's 43.
- Griswould's 76 career receptions has him in range of cracking the career top 10 list at MT. He needs 28 more catches to tie 10th place David Youell (1999-2002).
- Had a personal-best 140 receiving yards on 3 catches (2 for TDs) vs North Texas on Oct. 27, 2012. TD catches were 72 and 49 yards.
- Griswould enters the WCU game with 921 career receiving yards and needs just 79 more to reach 1,000 yards. He would become the fifth receiver under Stockstill to obtain 1,000 career yards (Malcolm Beyah, Anthony Amos, Sancho McDonald, Patrick Honeycutt).

#### **LB LEIGHTON GASQUE**

- Owns 11 career sacks to rank tied for 7th all-time despite playing mainly on passing situations.
- Had seven sacks as a freshman and four last year as a sophomore.
- Had career-best **2** sacks against Georgia Tech.
- As a freshman, Gasque had 17 total tackles and seven were sacks, while collecting 22 stops in 2012 and four were sacks.

#### **S KEVIN BYARD**

- Earned First Team Freshman All-American honors last year by the FWAA.
- Is on the Jim Thorpe Watch List.
- Equaled the school record last year with two interceptions returned for touchdowns (vs Memphis, Troy).
- In 2012, Byard set the MT single-season record with 167 interception return yards.
- Forced 3 turnovers, including two interceptions in win over Troy in 2012. His second pick was returned 77 yards for the game-winning TD and ranked as the sixth longest in school history.

#### **RB/KR REGGIE WHATLEY**

■ Reggie Whatley ranked **4th** nationally in KO return yards in 2012 with a school record **30.5** yard average.

- Had returns of 96, 85, and 60 yards in 2012.
- Had a 96-yard kickoff return for a TD vs WKU and a school record 222 kickoff return yards.
- Whatley's 762 kickoff return yards in 2012 ranked 4th on the single-season list. The all-time record is 910 yards by Desmond Gee in 2009.
- Whatley has 827 career kickoff return yards to rank eighth all-time at MT. He needs just 173 more yards to become only the seventh player in school history to top 1,000 yards.

#### **TAVARRES JEFFERSON**

- After missing all but the first game of 2012, senior Tavarres Jefferson is back healthy in 2013.
- Jefferson enters the 2013 campaign having hauled in at least one reception in 13 straight games.
- Jefferson's 85 career receptions has him in range of cracking the career top 10 list at MT. He needs 19 more catches to tie 10th place David Youell (1999-2002).

#### **RAIDER ROUNDUP**

- The top scoring quarter in the Rick Stockstill era is the **second quarter**. Here is a combined total for each quarter: 1st 501 points; 2nd **671** points; 3rd 442 points; 4th 600 points, and 10 in overtime.
- Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders have scored on their opening possession 29 times in 87 games (20 TDs) while the opposition has scored 31 times on its first possession of the game.
- When both teams are held under 20 points, the Blue Raiders are 2-0 under Rick Stockstill.
- As a FBS (I-A) member (166 games), the Blue Raiders have scored 50 or more points 12 times.
- The Blue Raiders are 57-10 in the FBS era when leading at the half and are 64-9 when leading a game entering the 4th quarter during that time.
- When trailing at the half, the Blue Raiders are just 16-72 in the FBS (I-A) era.
- The Blue Raiders have scored in **189** of their last **196** games and broke a string of scoring in 55 straight when they were shutout at Tennessee in 2011. MT has been shutout four other times during the FBS era. The Blue Raiders were shutout 10-0 on the road against UL-Monroe in 1999, 55-0 in 2000 at Florida, a 44-0 setback at LSU in 2007, and 45-0 at Arkansas State in 2012. Dasher against FIU in 2008 was the first under Rick Stockstill and the first by the Blue Raiders since Kerry Wright hauled in a pass from Andrico Hines at Idaho in 2003. MT had two in 2012 with one against McNeese State and another in win over Troy.

#### ACADEMICS A TOP PRIORITY FOR BLUE RAIDERS

■ Academic success at MT has been a high priority for eighth year coach Rick Stockstill. Under his reign, the Blue Raiders have seen 112 of 117 student-athletes earn their degree entering the 2013 season. MT, who also owns an impressive APR score of 972, has been publicly recognized by the NCAA for APR success twice in the last three years. Also under Stockstill, the Blue Raiders have taken home six Academic All-District honors and produced an Academic All-American.

Winning on the field, off the field and having a firstclass football program from top to bottom is the goal of any University at the highest level of intercollegiate athletics. That is exactly what Middle Tennessee has as a result of the leadership of Head Coach Rick Stockstill.

Entering his eighth season at the helm of the Blue Raiders, Stockstill has captured a league title, won the 2009 New Orleans Bowl, made three bowl appearances, earned two public recognition awards from the NCAA for APR success, appeared on national television a school record 20 times, and produced six of the top eight crowds in Floyd Stadium history.

Under his watch, the Blue Raiders have also produced five all-American's, including one academic all-American, three defensive players of the year, and a bowl game MVP. Middle Tennessee also became the first Sun Belt team to win 10 games in a season, and set the Floyd Stadium single-game attendance record. He also has three NFL Draft picks with Erik Walden in 2008, Chris McCoy in 2010, and Rod Issac in 2011.


Some regard the 2012 season as his best coaching job after leading the Blue Raiders to the nation's biggest win improvement from the previous year. His seventh MT squad went 8-4, won an FBS school record five road games, received votes in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll three straight weeks, and upset ACC Coastal Division Champion Georgia Tech. Along the way, he produced a freshman all-American, eight all-conference players, and a national offensive player of the week.

In 2010, Stockstill's team battled back from a tough start to make back-to-back bowl games for the first time in school history. The coach also had an Academic All-American in Jeremy Kellem, the SBC Defensive Player of the Year in Jamari Lattimore, and a total of nine players who were recognized on the All-Conference team.

The 2009 season was one for the record books as that squad accomplished what few believed possible with an FBS-record 10 wins, a final ranking of 33rd nationally in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches poll, a bowl victory, a seven-game winning streak, the most Sun Belt victories in school history, five road victories, and a second straight undefeated month of November. It all resulted in Stockstill being named Sun Belt Conference Co-Coach of the Year and 11 players earning All-Conference honors, including co-Defensive Player of the Year Chris

McCoy, who was taken in the 7th round of the NFL Draft by the Miami Dolphins. To top things off, quarterback Dwight Dasher earned New Orleans Bowl MVP honors and became just the fourth player in NCAA history to pass for more than 2,500 yards and rush for 1,000 yards in the same season.

Stockstill, who owns upsets over Maryland (2008 and 2009) and Georgia Tech (2012), has also shown a commitment to academics during his tenure. The Blue Raiders have gone from an APR score of 892 to a very impressive 983, the biggest increase of any program in the country. The Blue Raiders have also been crowned with the Sun Belt Conference Academic Award on two occasions (2006-07, 2007-08) and earned two public recognition awards from the NCAA for APR success (2011, 2012). For his efforts, Stockstill was inducted as an honorary member into Phi Kappa Phi Honor Society in April 2010.

#### 2013 C-USA FOOTBALLCHAMPIONSHIP GAME/C-USA BOWLGAMES



Conference USA will host its ninth football championship game in 2013.

The event is slated for Saturday, December 7, and will be televised by ESPN or ESPN2. The team with the highest league winning percentage will serve as host site for the game.

The title game will feature champions from the East and West divisions of the league. The champion has never had more than two losses in the conference.

#### **2013 C-USA BOWL SYNOPSIS**

Conference USA has guaranteed spots in six games during the 2013 season. The AutoZone

Liberty Bowl has the top selection of C-USA teams and the league will also send teams to the Beef'O' Brady's Bowl St. Petersburg, Heart of Dallas Bowl, Military Bowl, R+L Carriers New Orleans Bowl and Sheraton Hawai'i Bowl this season.

The 55th annual AutoZone Liberty Bowl is scheduled for Tuesday, December 31 in Memphis. The AutoZone Liberty Bowl matches the first selection from Conference USA against an opponent from either the Southeastern Conference or the American Athletic Conference in a game that will air on ESPN with a 3 p.m. CT kickoff.

For the sixth straight year, C-USA will play in the Beef'O' Brady's Bowl St. Petersburg will take place on Monday, December 23 at 1 p.m. ET. Conference USA will face an opponent from the American Athletic Conference at Tropicana Field in a game that will air on ESPN.

C-USA will participate in the fourth annual Heart of Dallas Bowl at historic Cotton Bowl Stadium on New Year's Day. The league's representative will face an opponent from the Big Ten Conference in a game that will air on ESPNU, beginning at 11 a.m. CT.

Conference USA is scheduled to participate in the R+L Carriers New Orleans for the 10th time in

12 seasons when it plays in the Saturday, December 21st contest. C-USA will play a representative from the Sun Belt Conference at the Mercedes-Benz Superdome, beginning at 8 p.m. CT on ESPN.

For the 10th time in the bowl's 12-year history, C-USA will compete in the Sheraton Hawai'i Bowl on Tuesday, December 24 in Honolulu. The league's representative will face a Mountain West Conference opponent in the game, which will kick off at 3 p.m. HT (8 p.m. ET) and be televised by ESPN.

The league also has an agreement to play an opponent from the ACC in the Washington, D.C.-based Military Bowl. This year's game will be played at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium in Annapolis, Md. on Friday, December 27 at 2:30 p.m. ET on ESPN.

It is important to note that a Conference USA champion may qualify for the Bowl Championship Series if ranked in the BCS final Top 12 or, in the BCS Top 16 and ranked higher than a team which receives automatic qualification.
